The ornamental design for a champagne glass, as shown, and described.

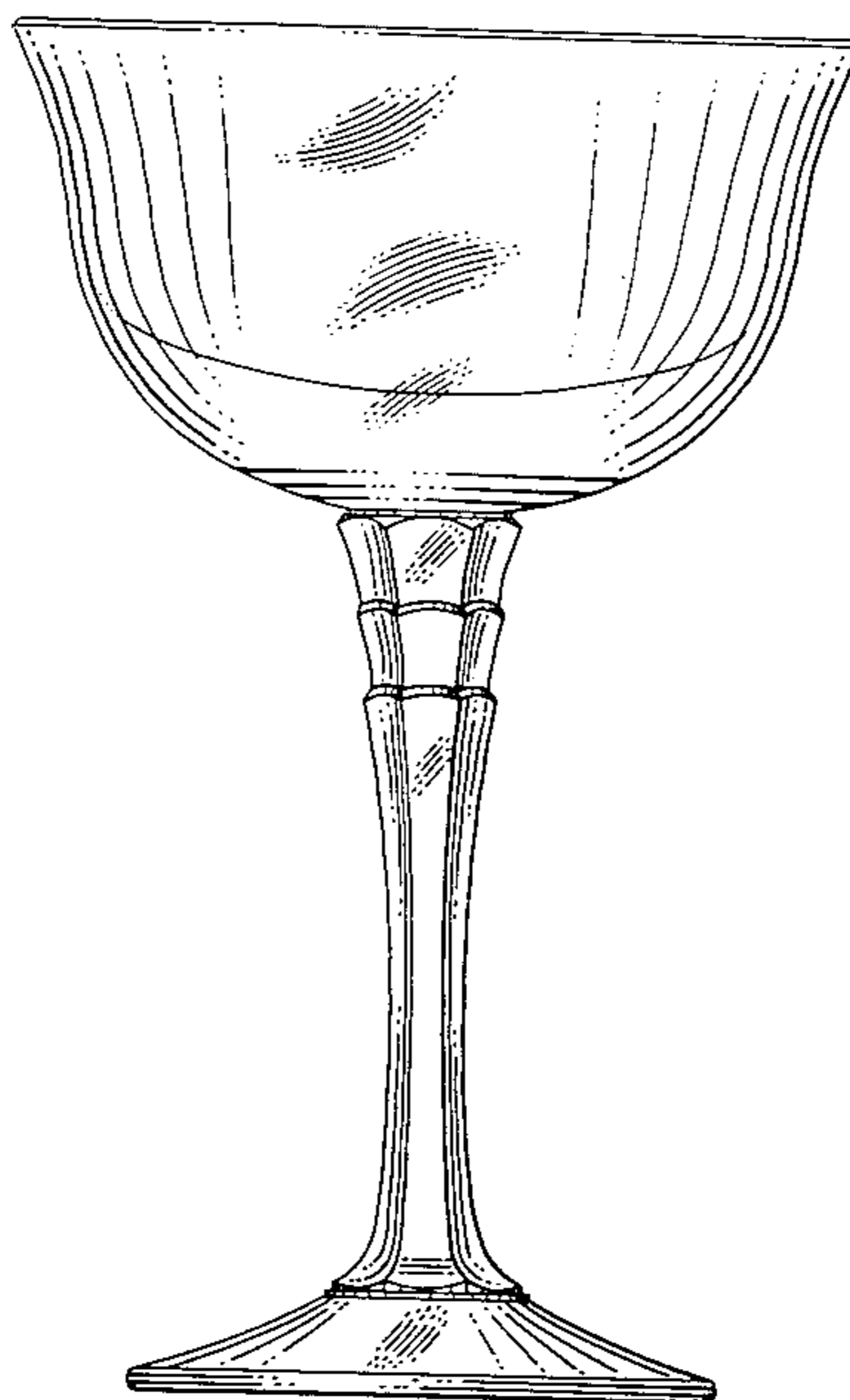
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof.



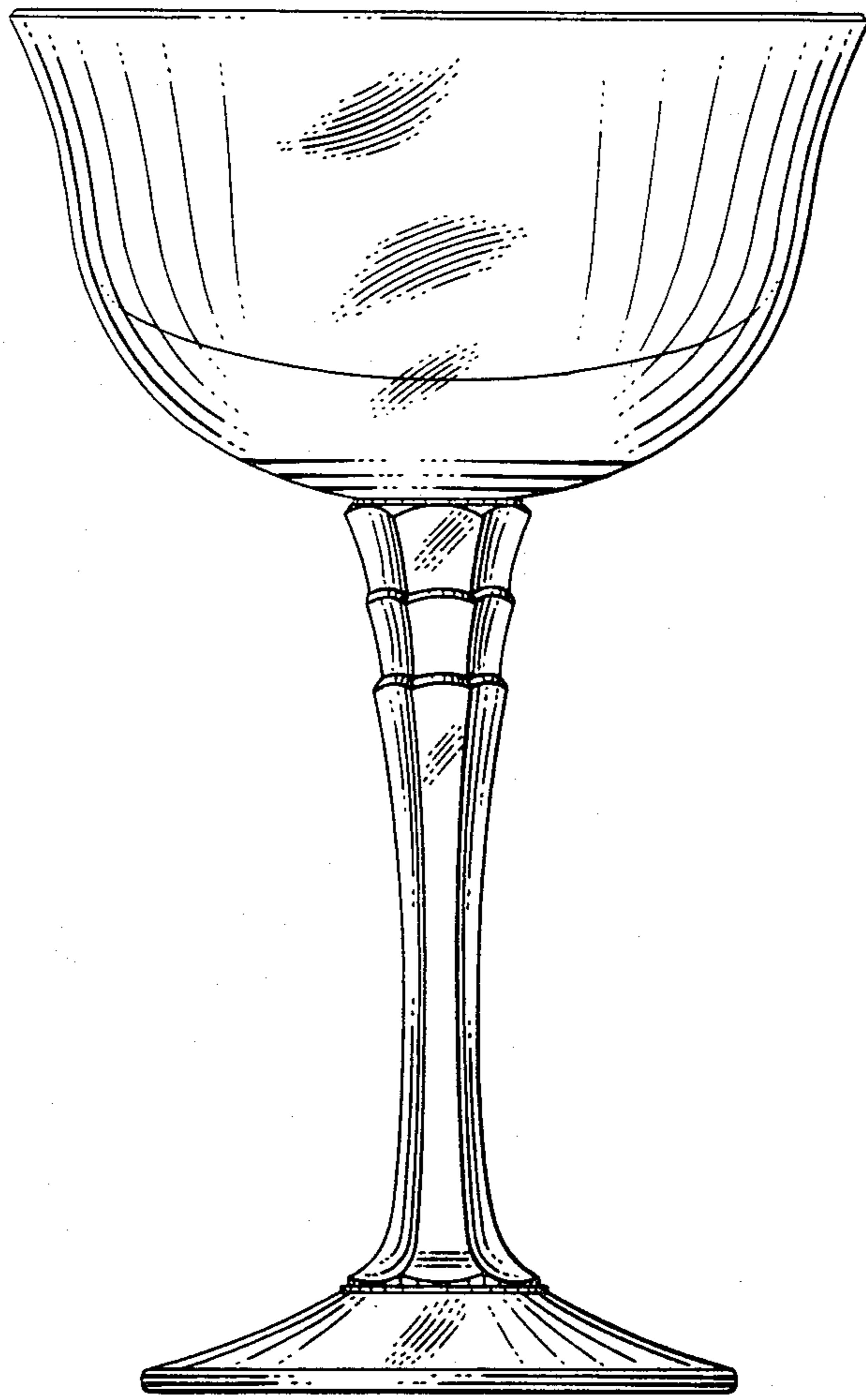

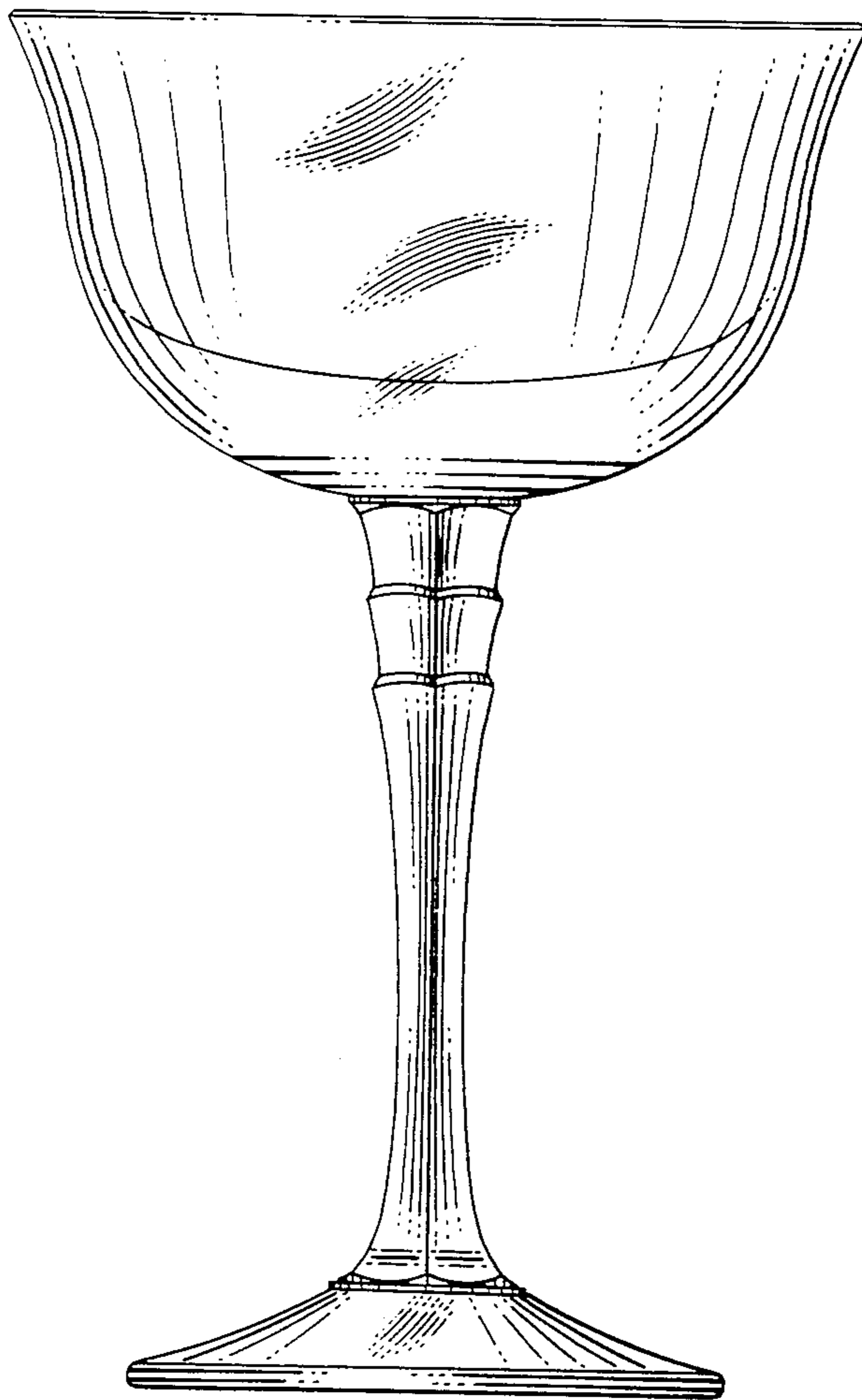

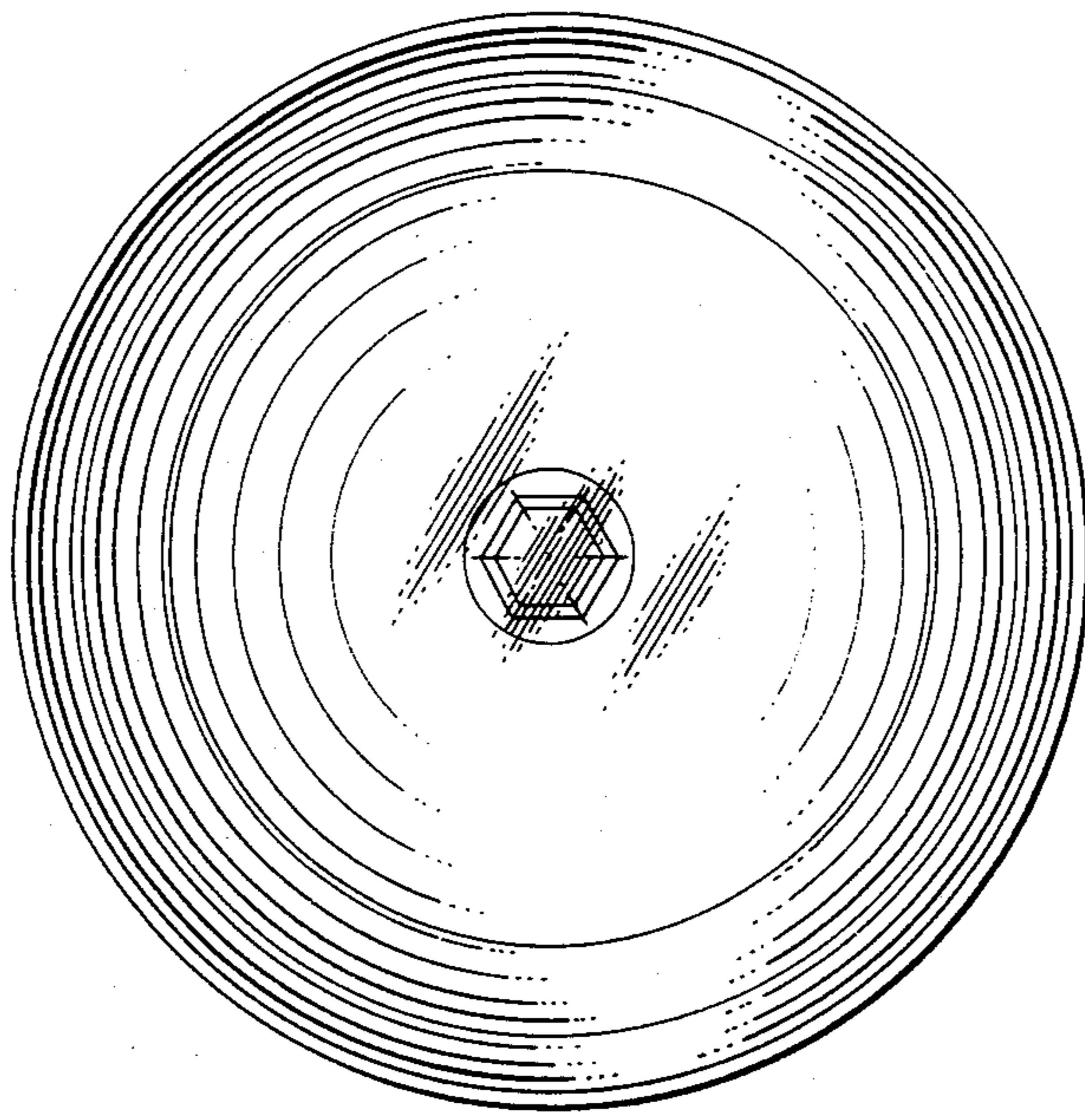

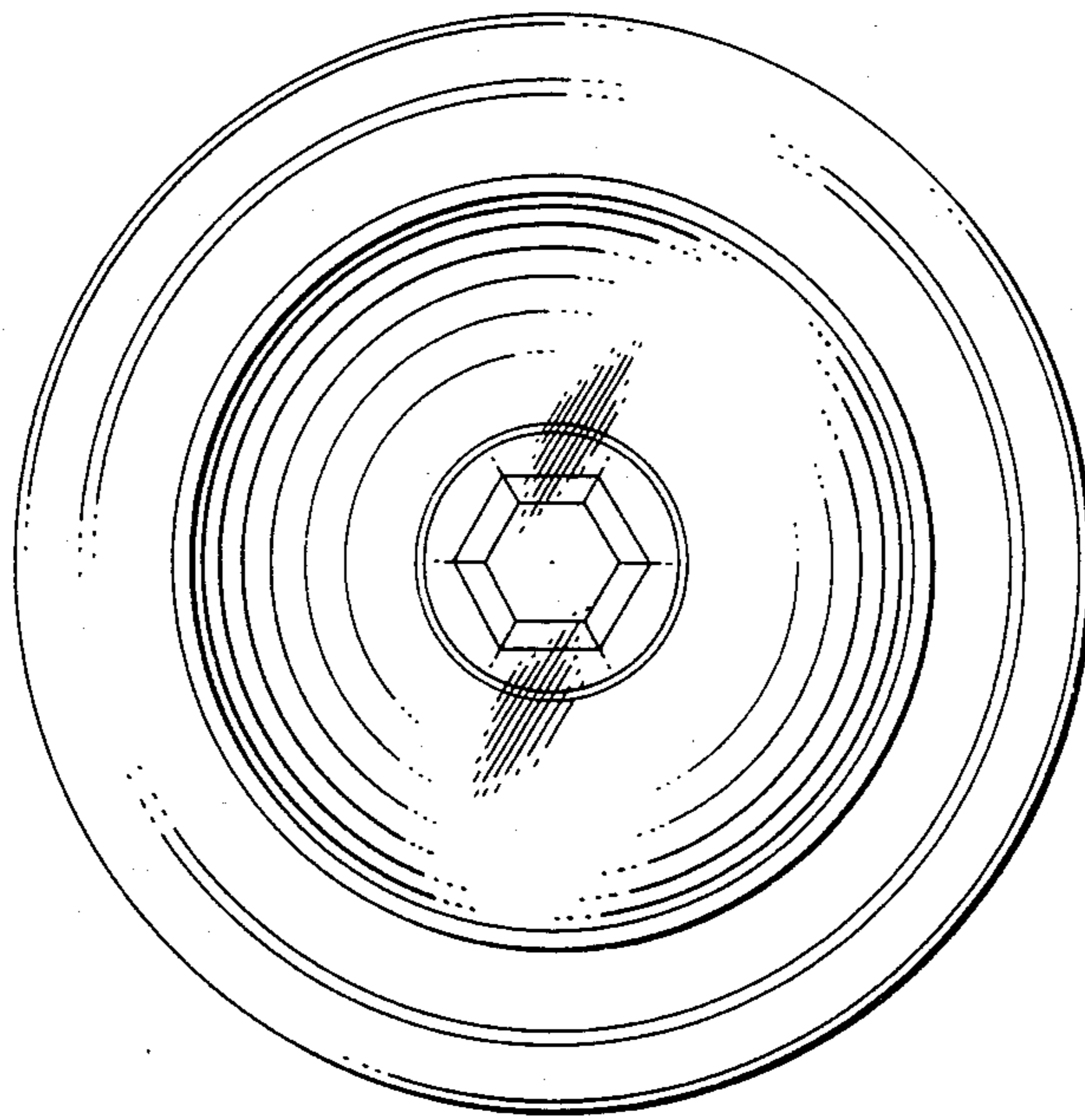
