[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a buoy, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The single FIGURE is a top and one side perspective view of a buoy showing my new design, the side opposite being identical.

The vanes around the top portion of the buoy are equally spaced and identical in shape.
