The ornamental design for a loud speaker, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, bottom and right side perspective view of a loud speaker showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view, thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
