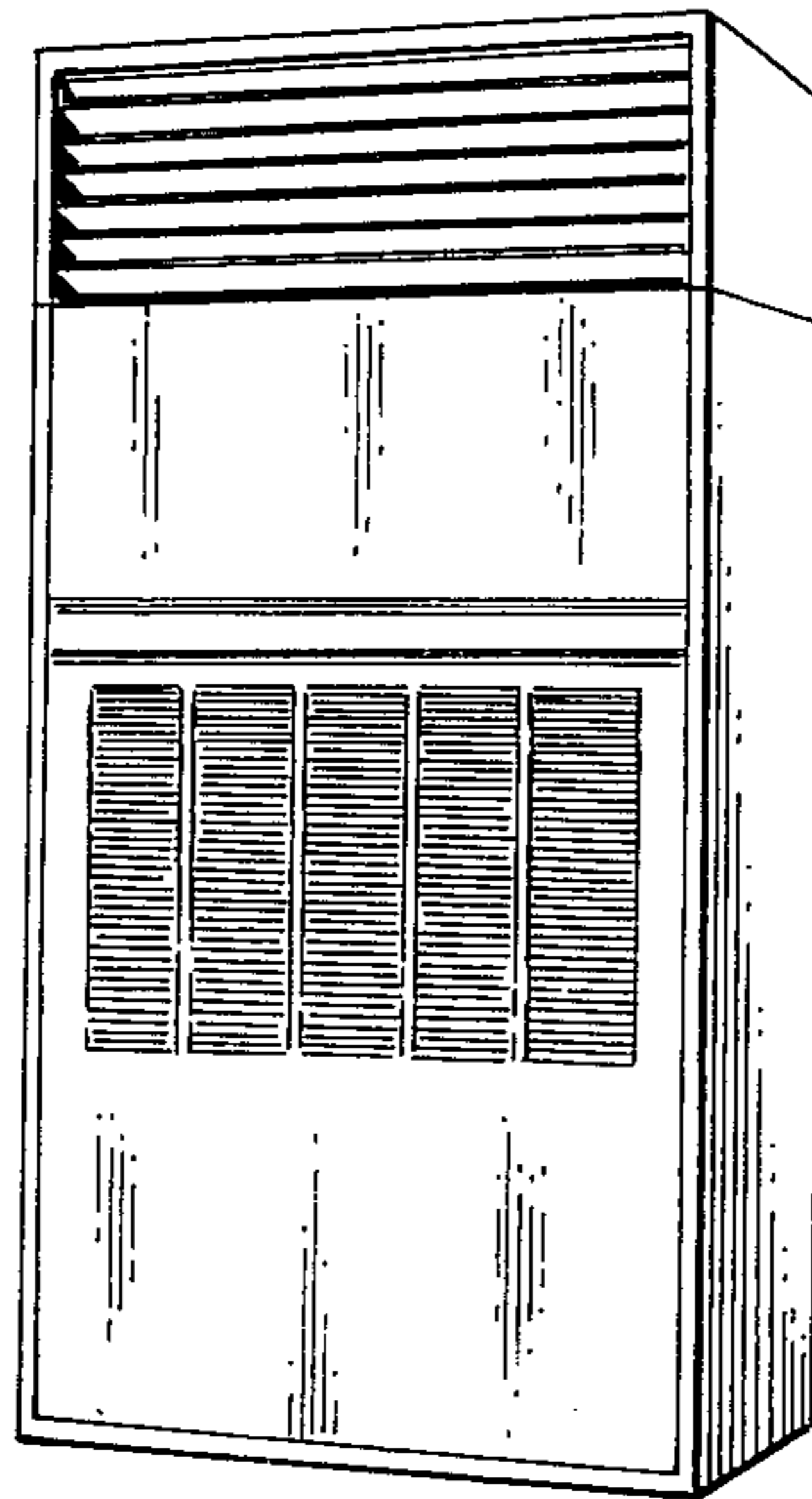

The ornamental design for a casing for a packaged air
conditioning unit, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the front and
right side of a casing for a packaged air conditioning
unit showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



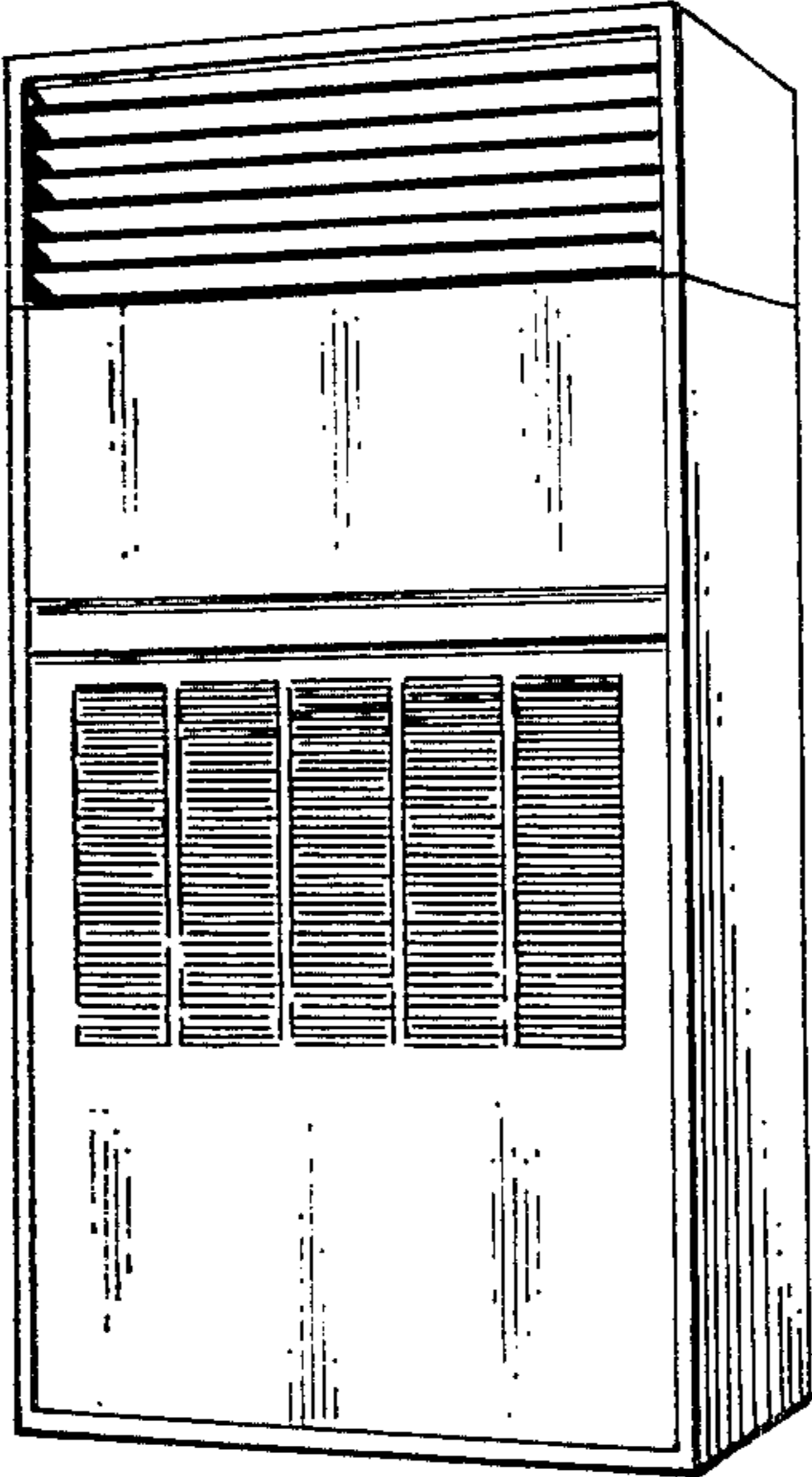

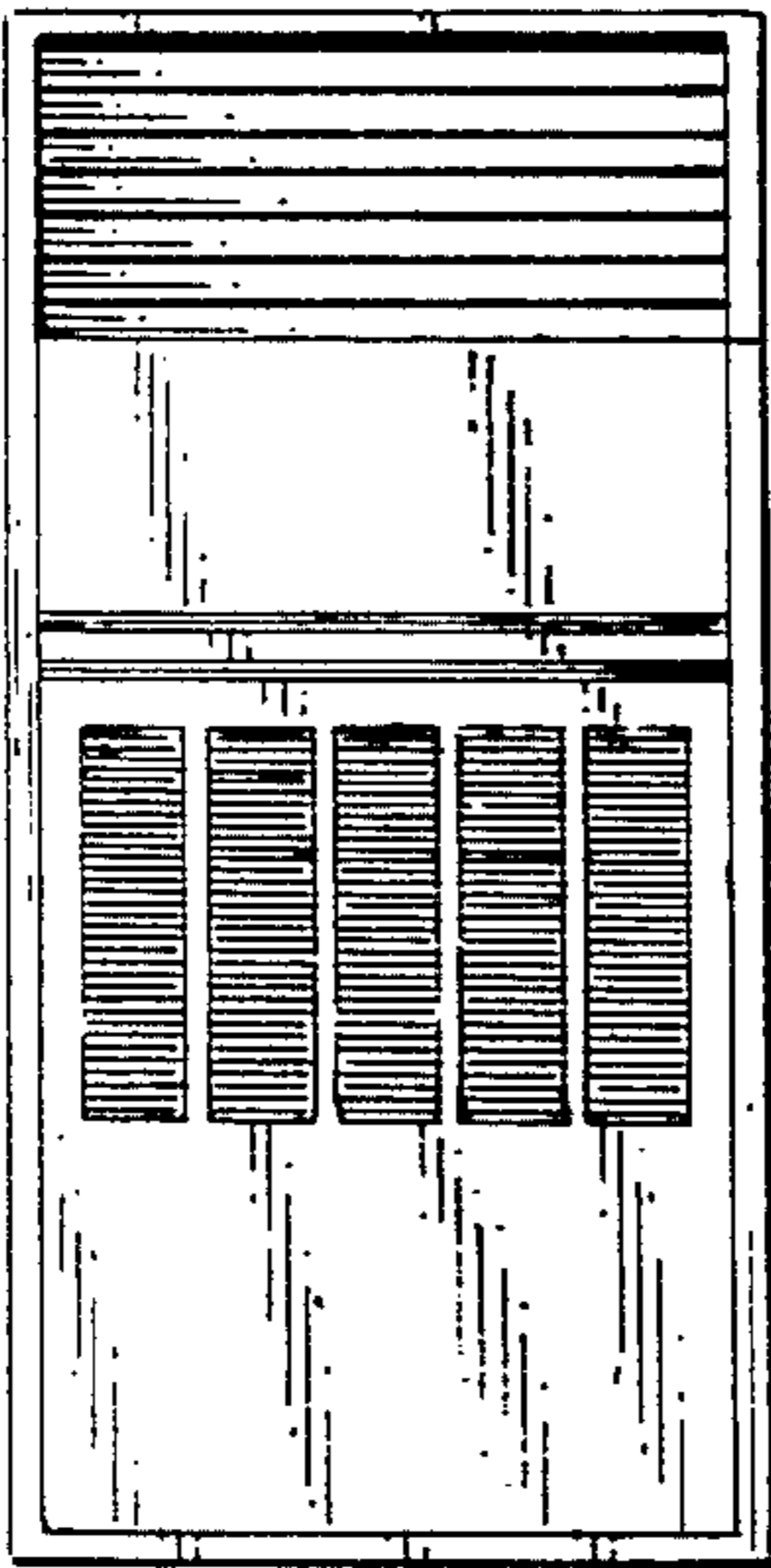

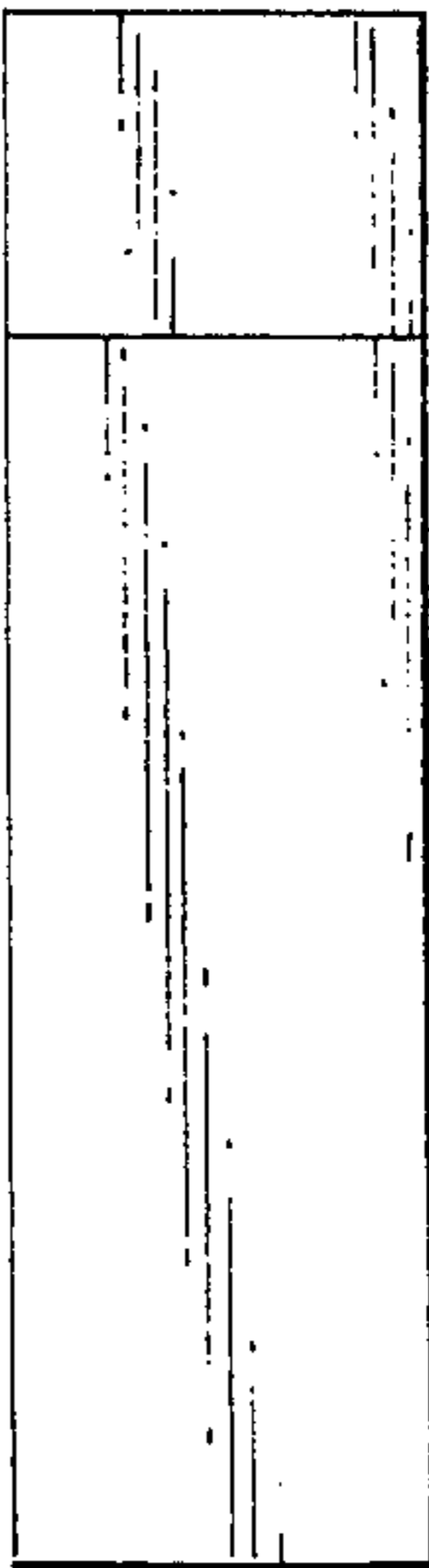

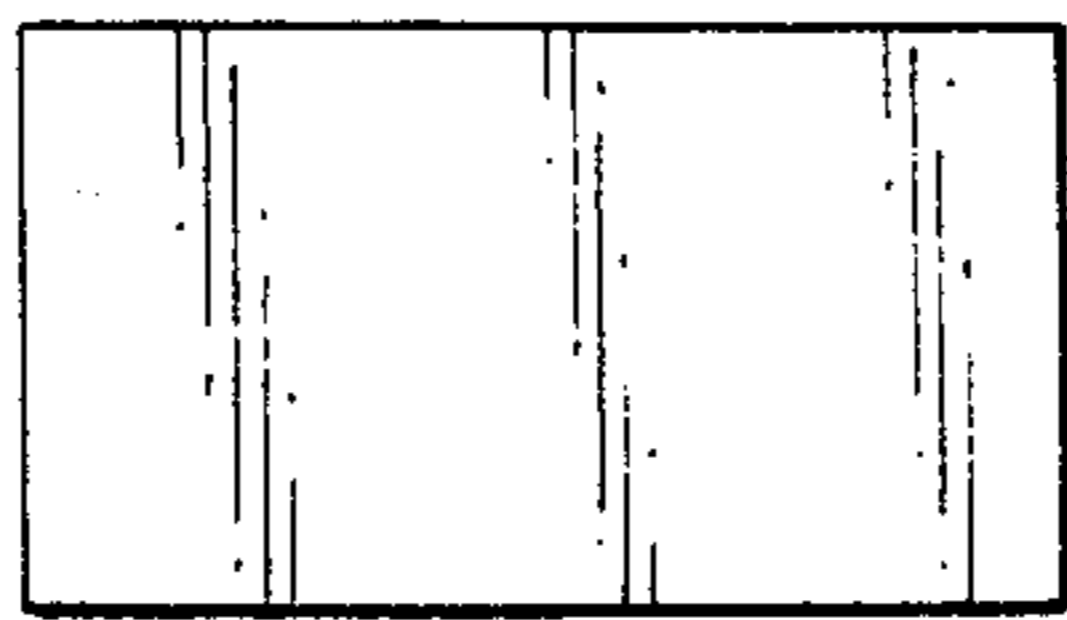

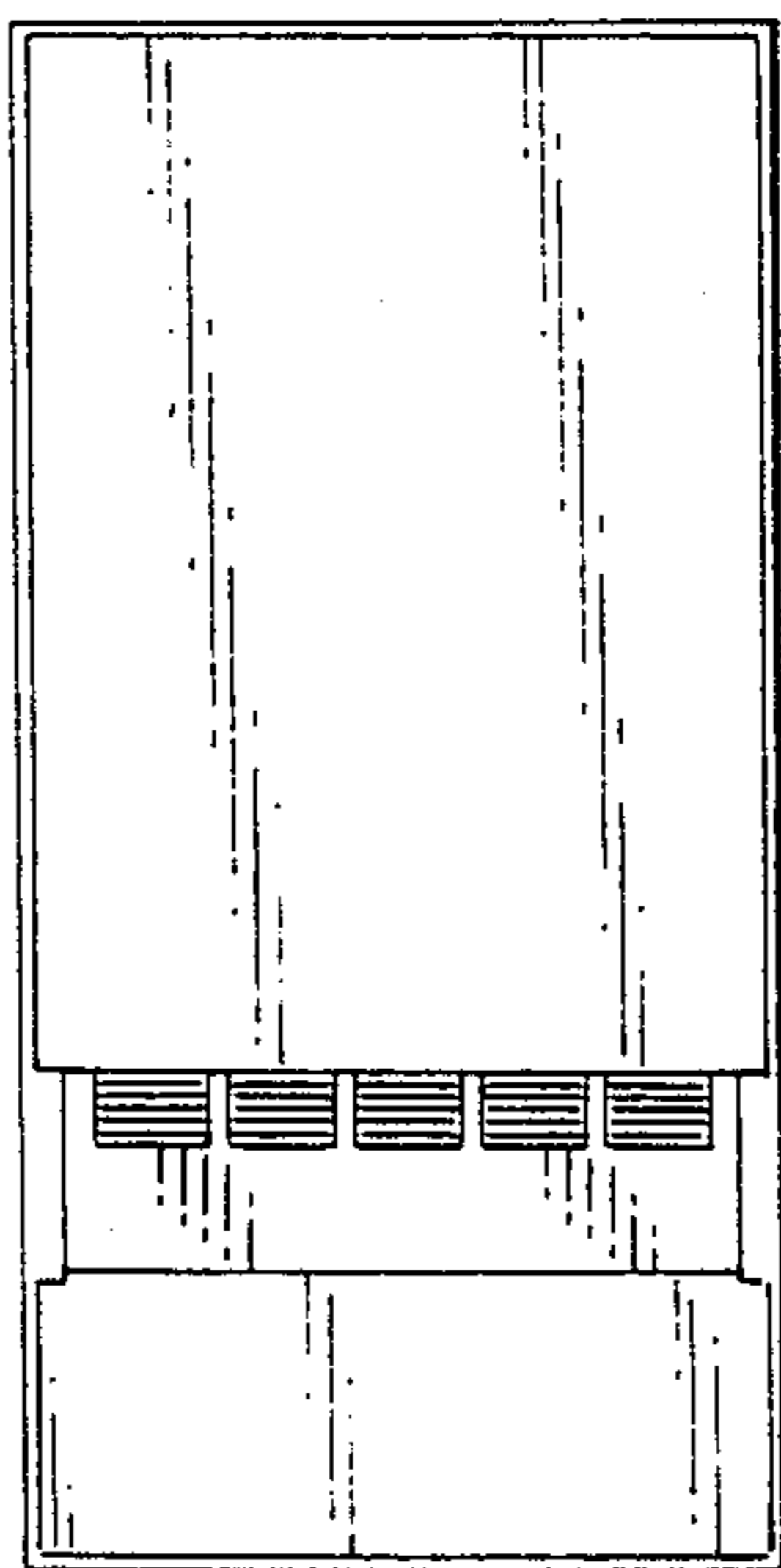
