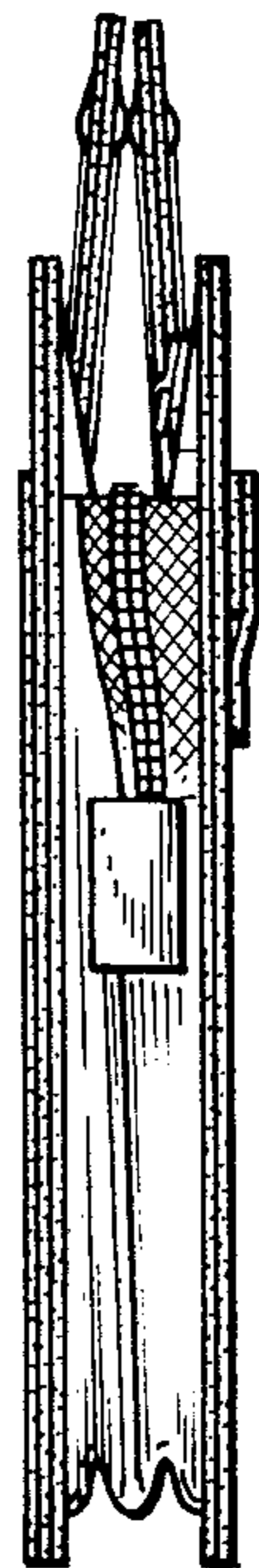
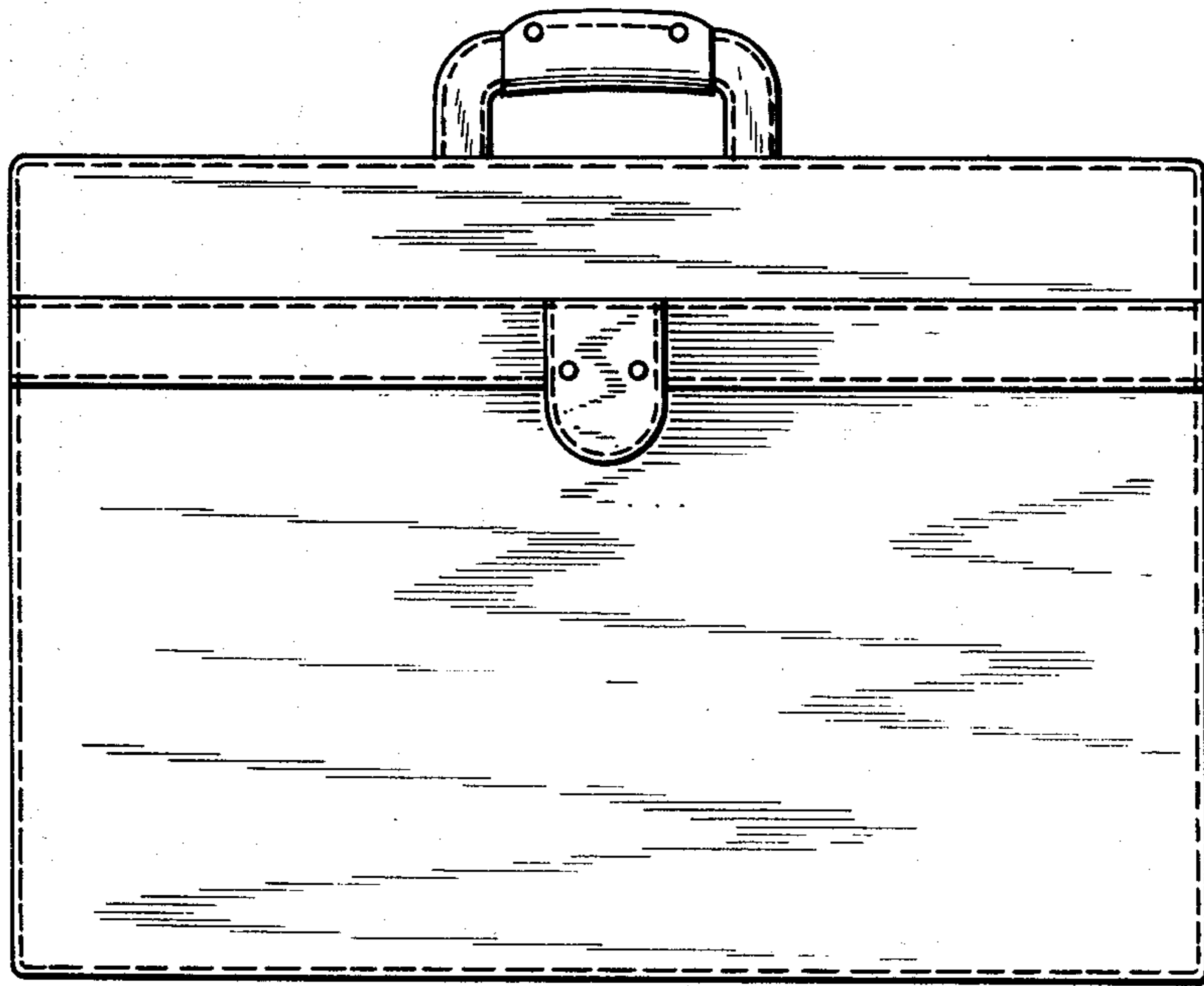

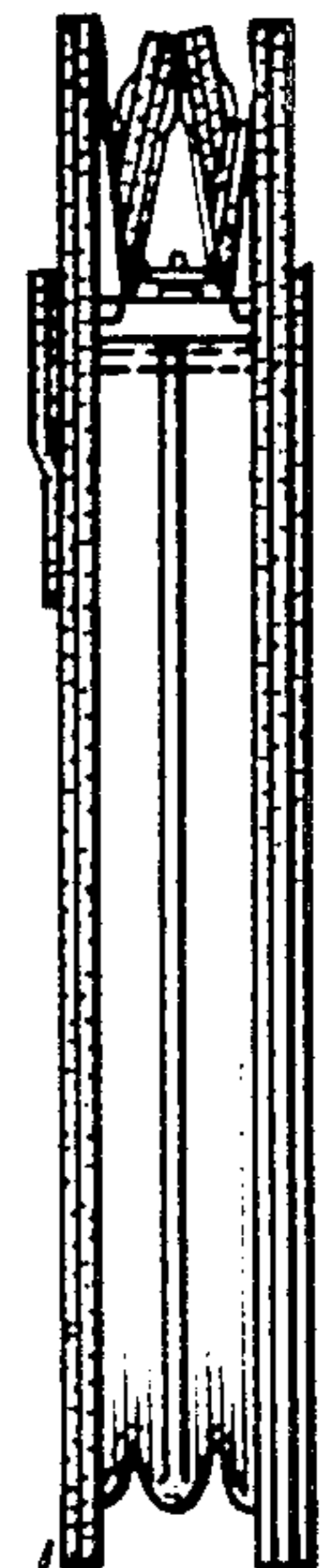
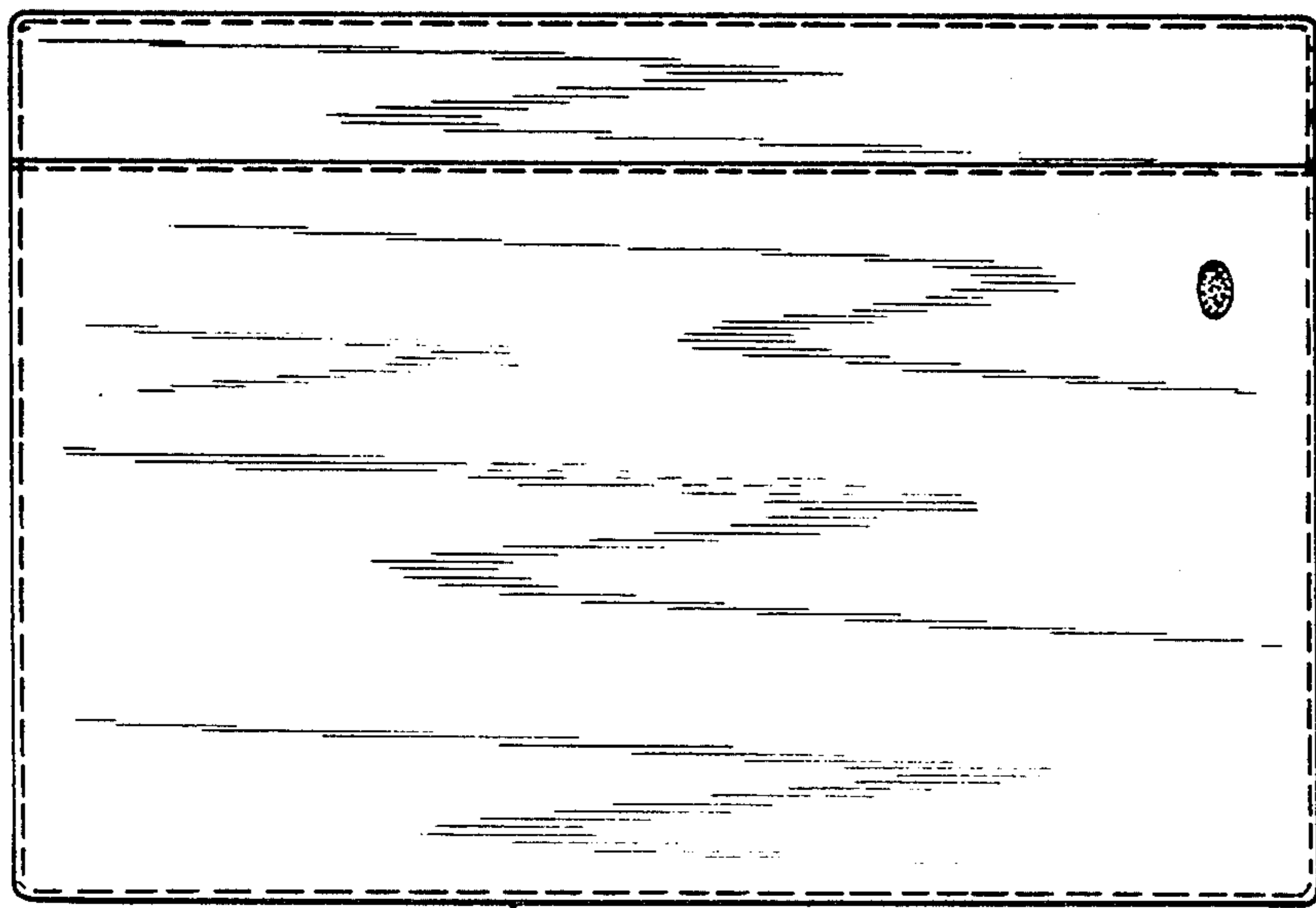
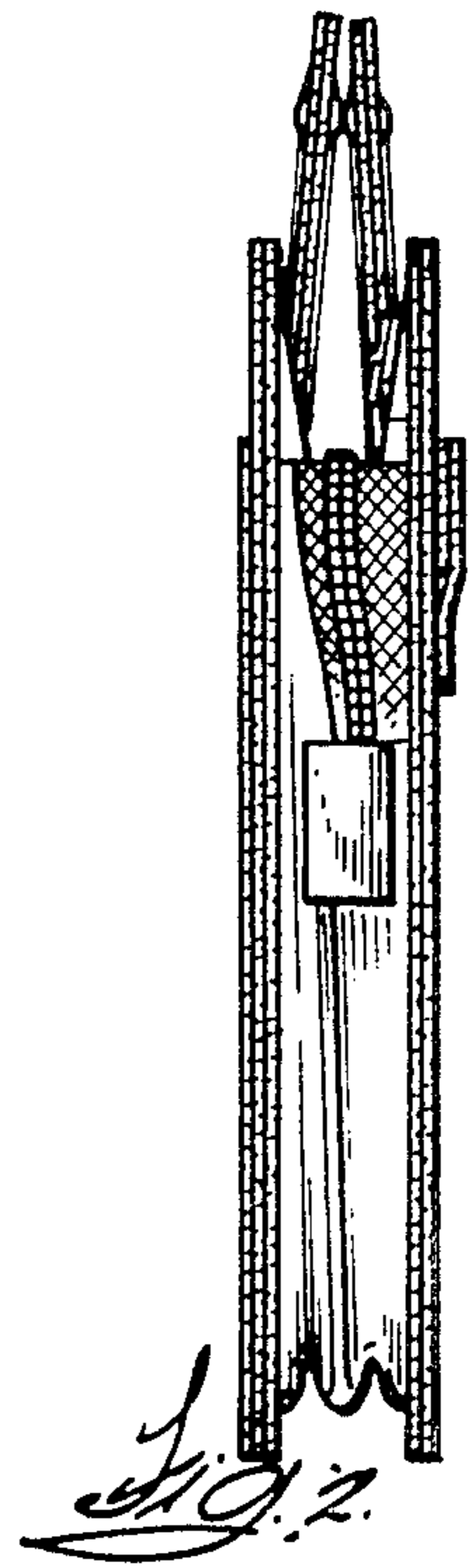
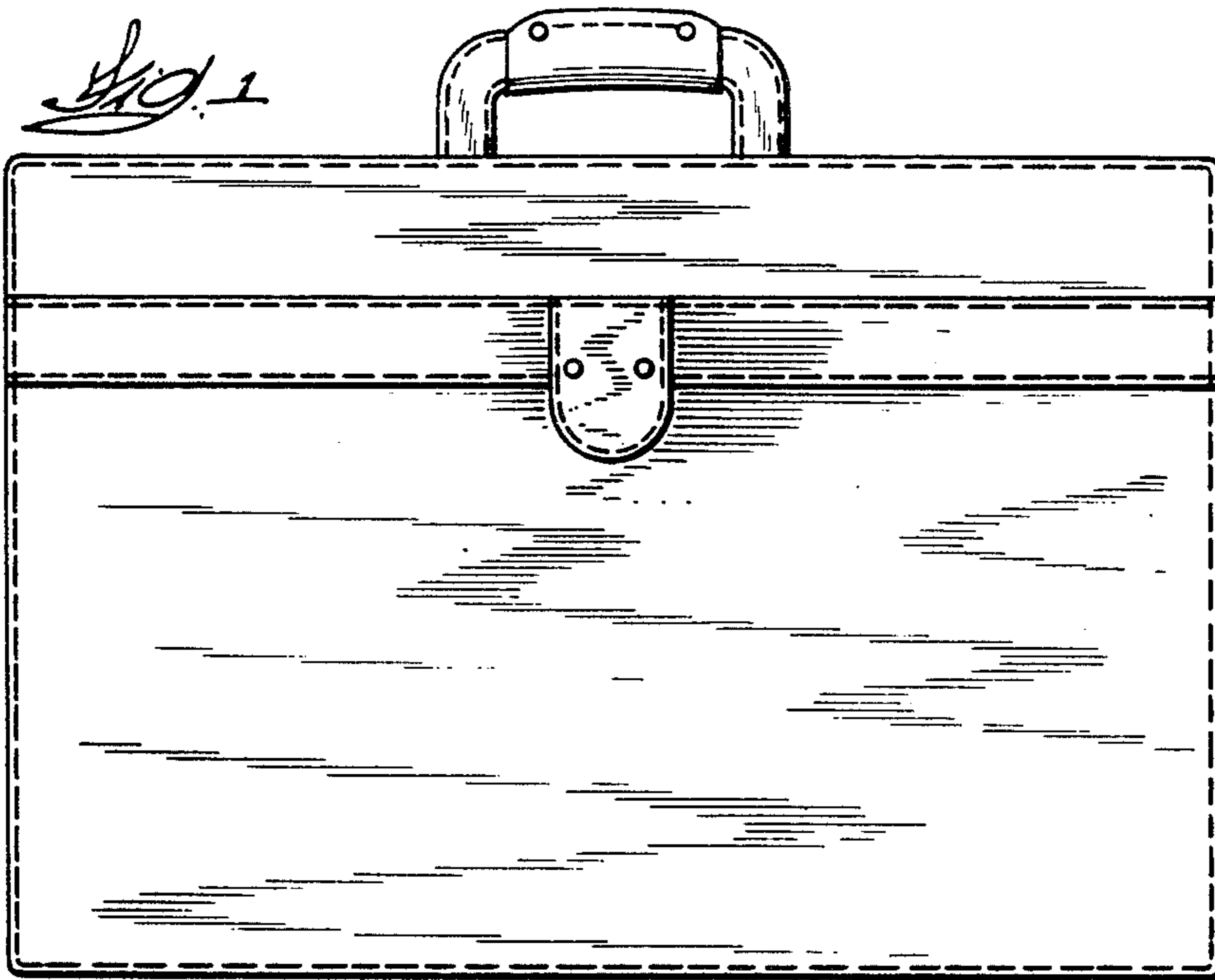
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an executive case, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an executive case showing our new design with the handles extended; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the design, showing its handles retracted; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 3; FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the design; and FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the design.



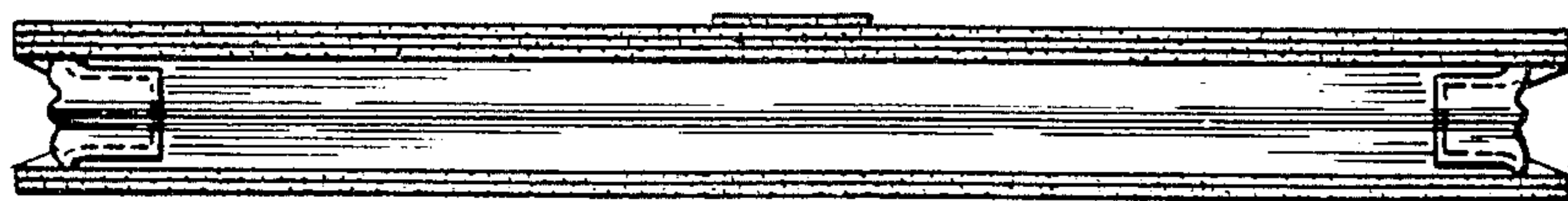
