DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a portable electronic musical chord instrument showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevation thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevation thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom edge elevation thereof; and

FIG. 7 is a top edge elevation thereof.

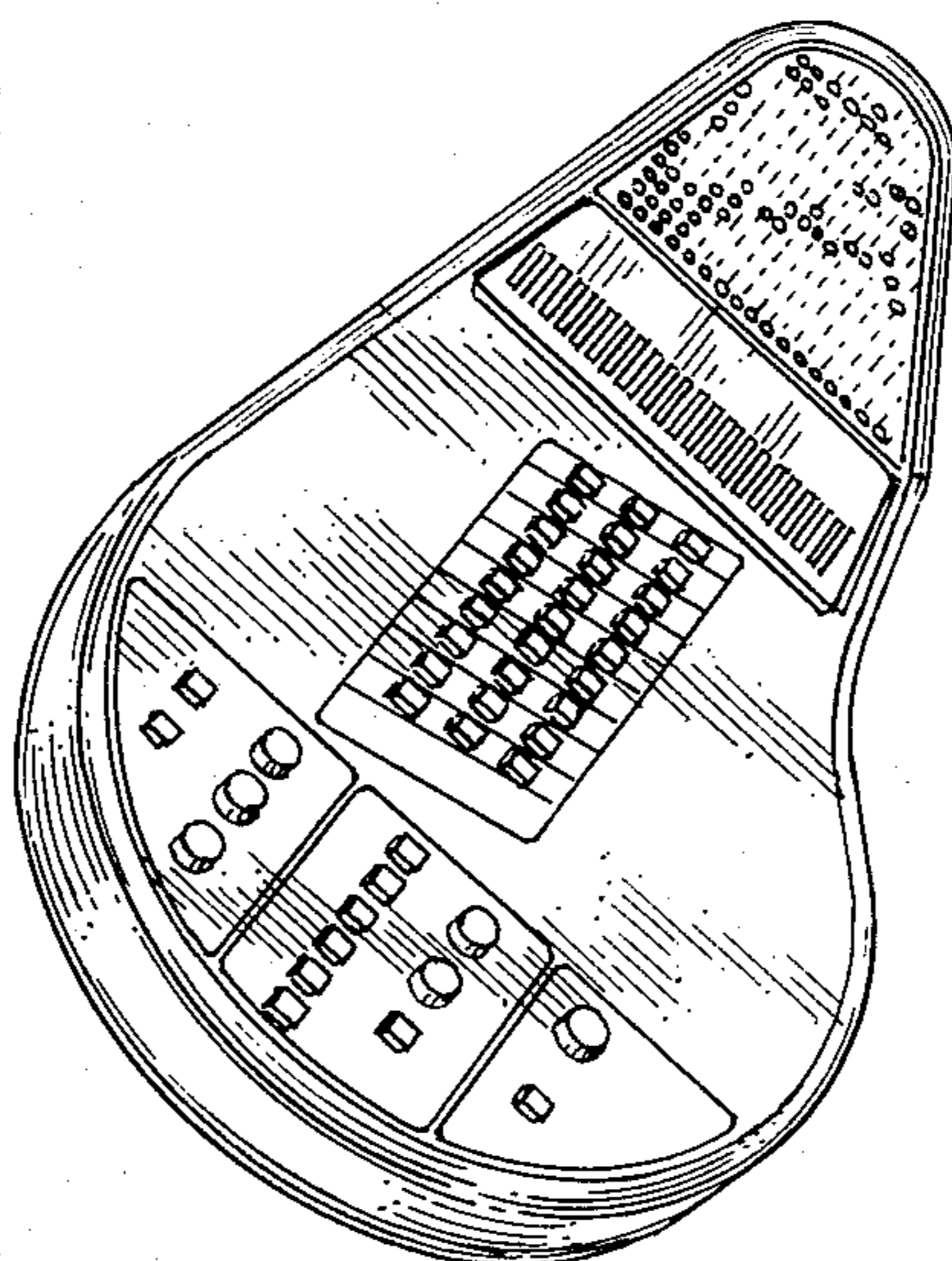

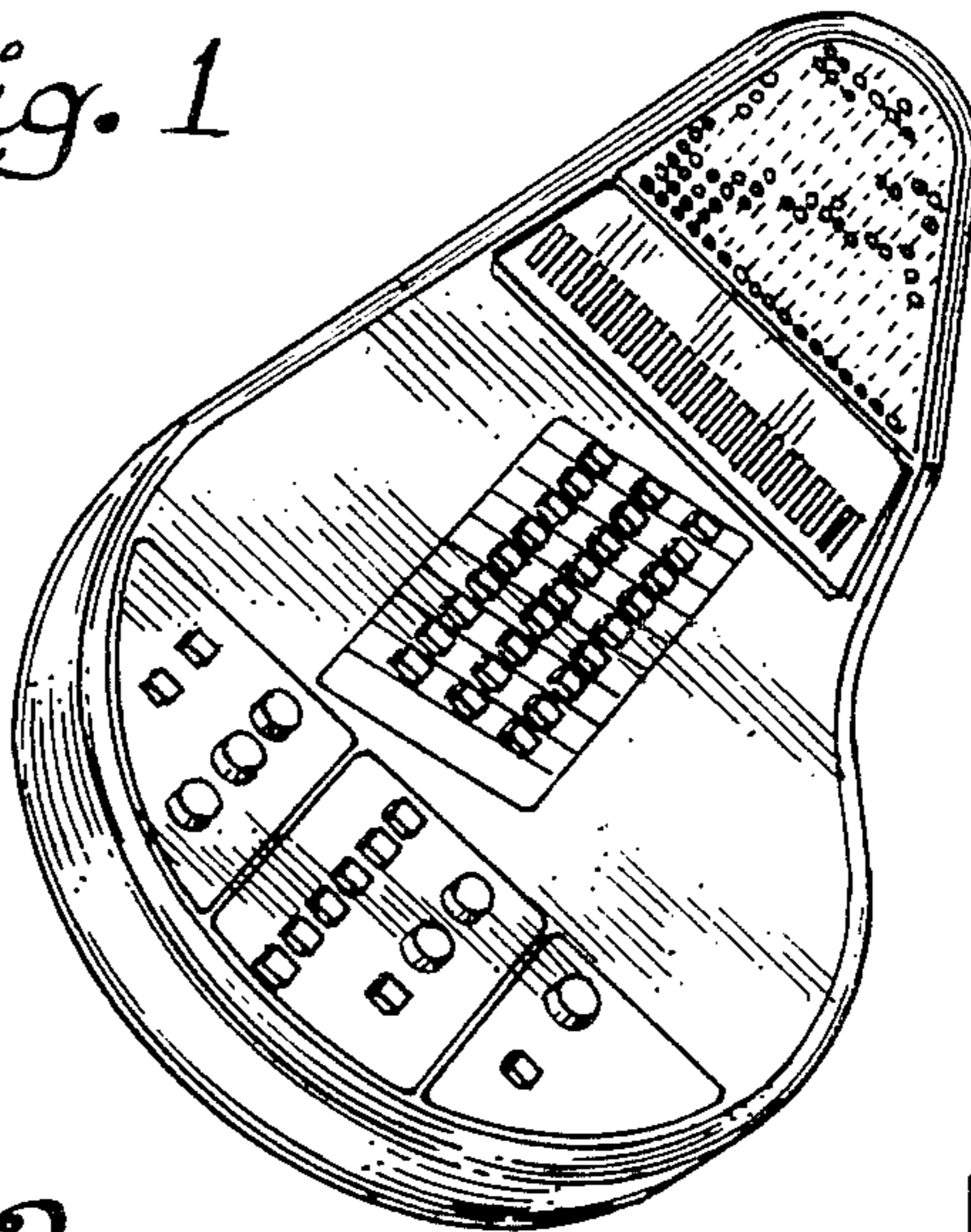

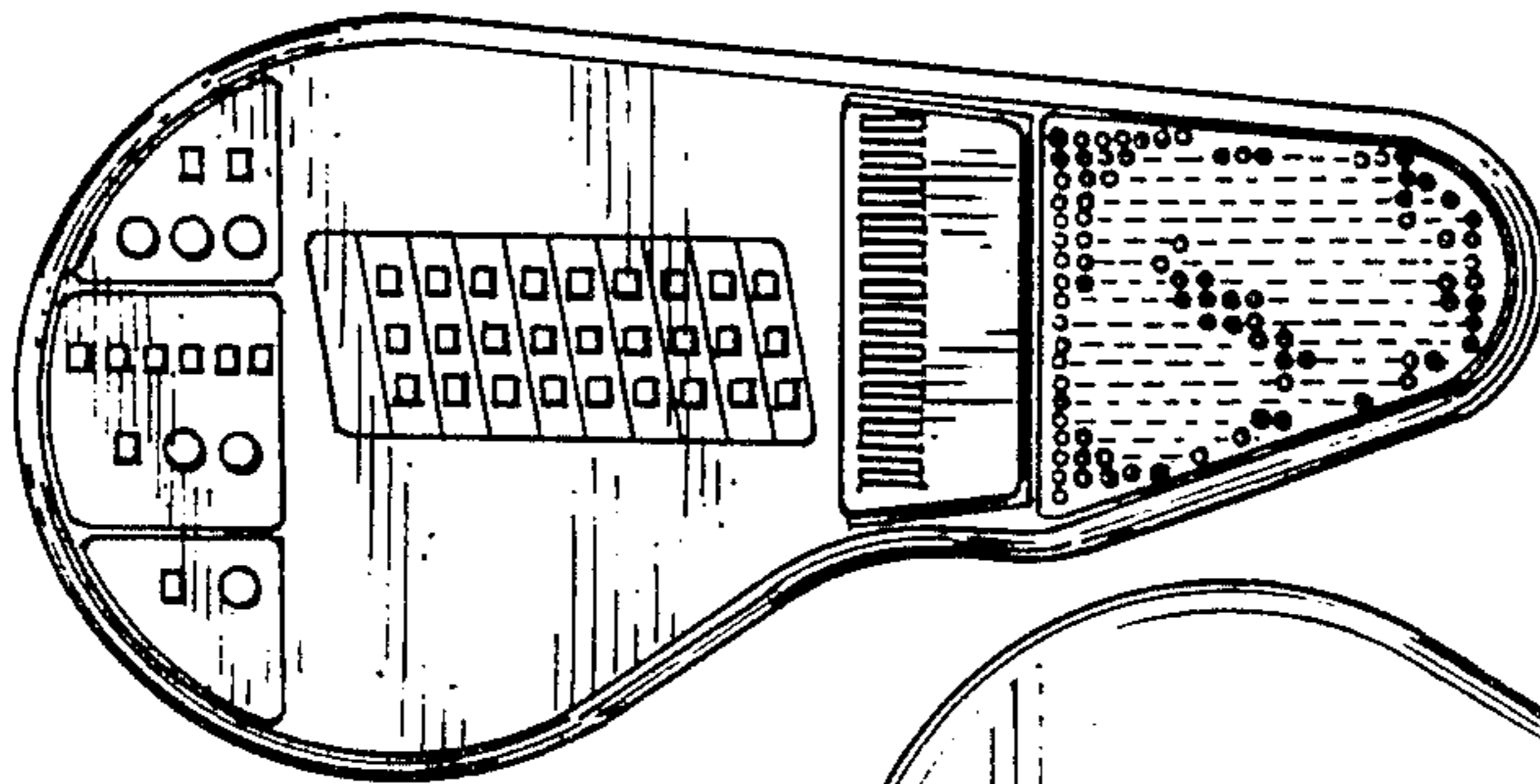

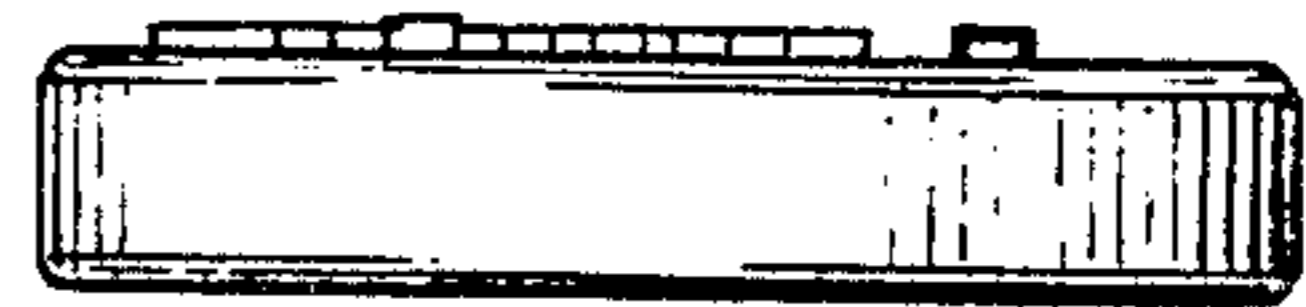

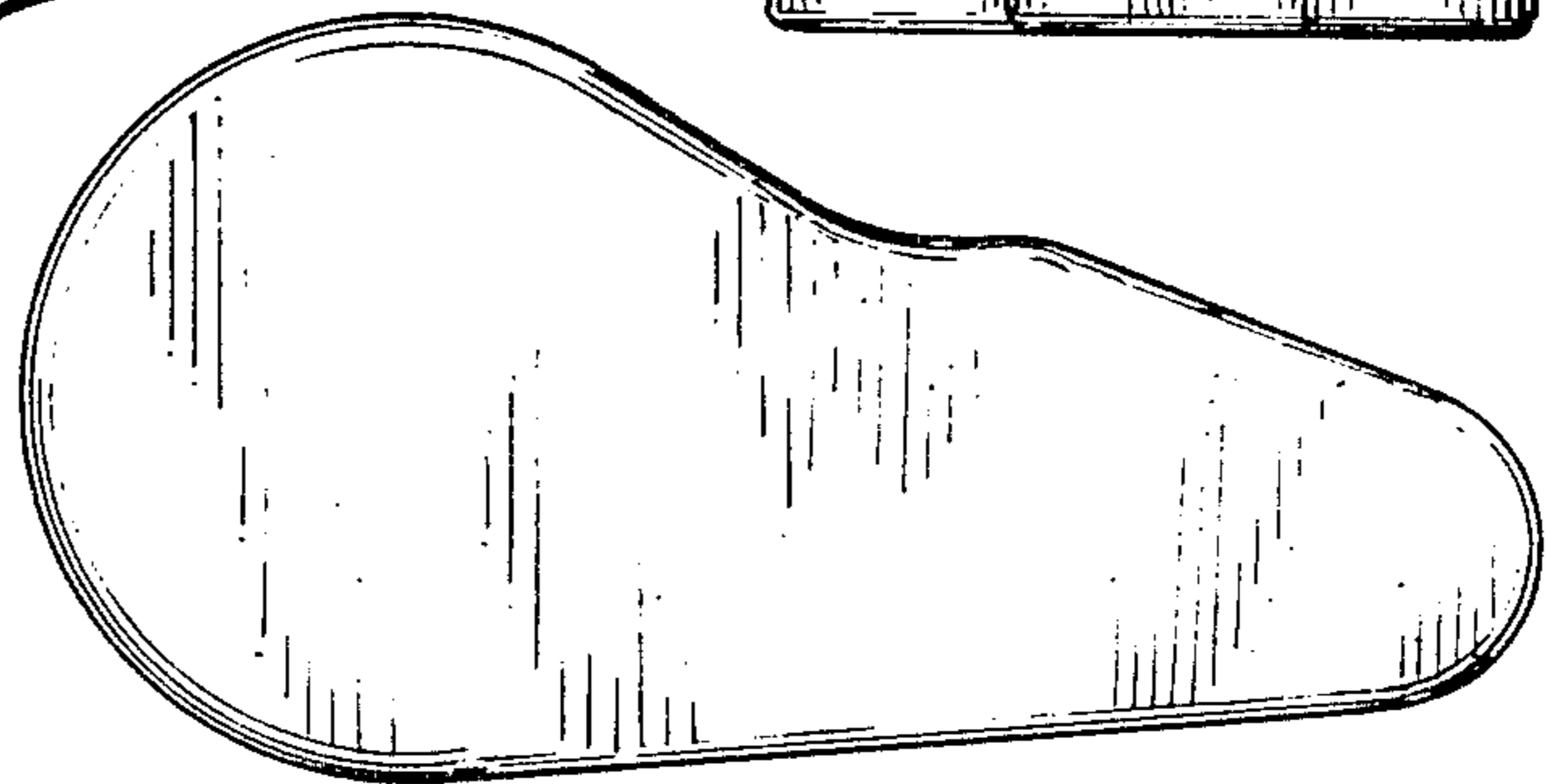
