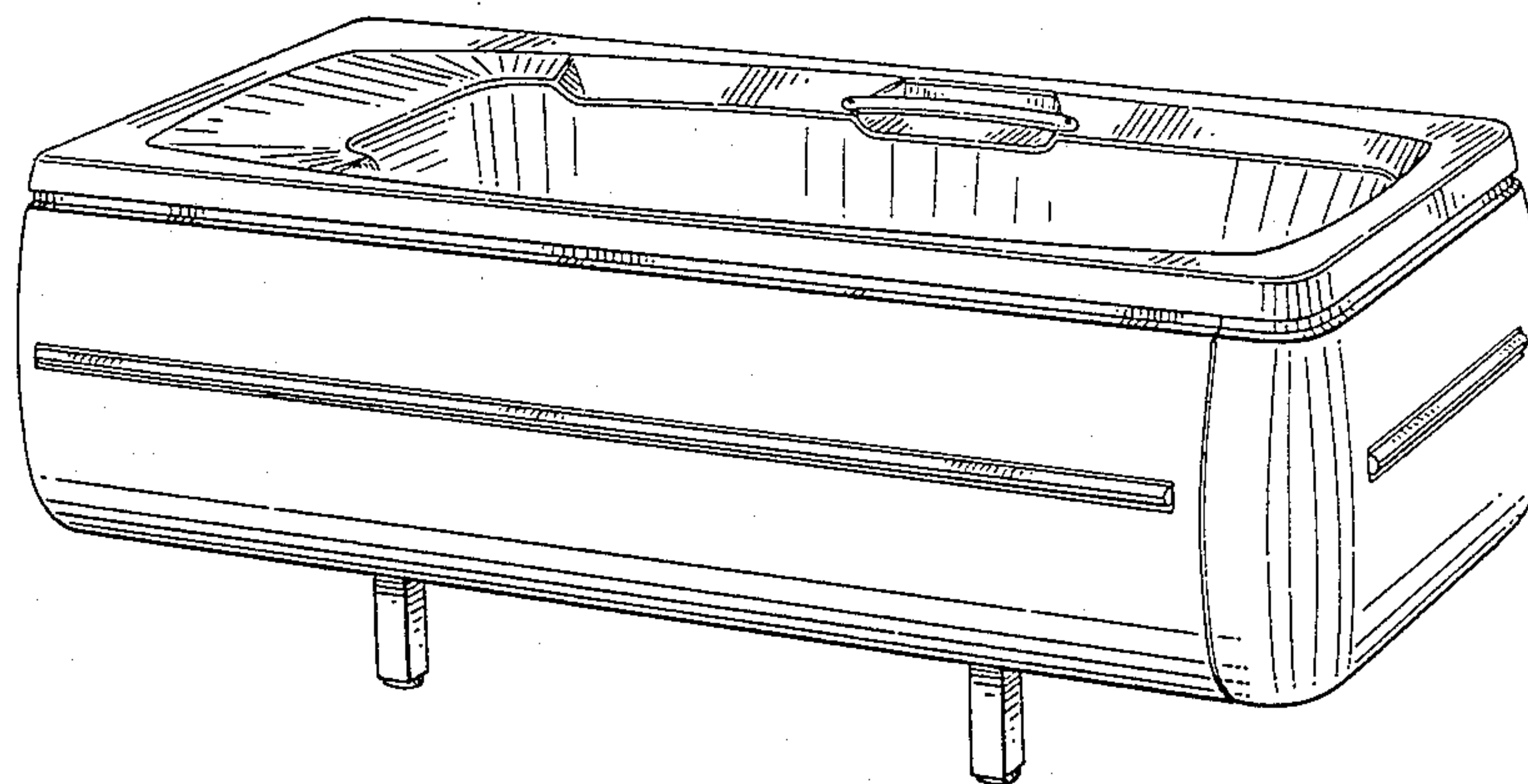

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bathtub, substantially as shown and described.

### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and left side of a bathtub showing our new design, the right side being a mirror image of the left side shown; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.



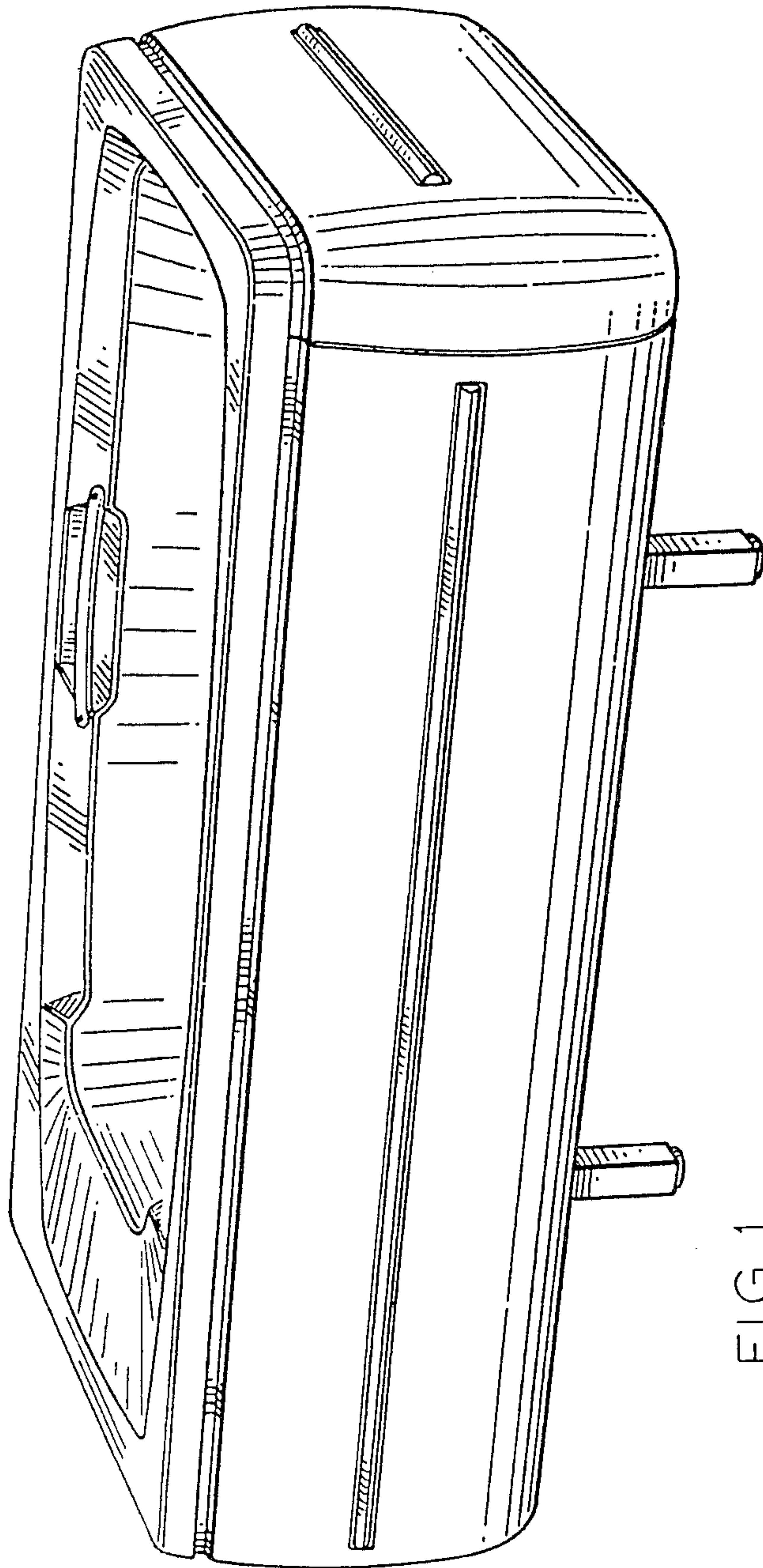

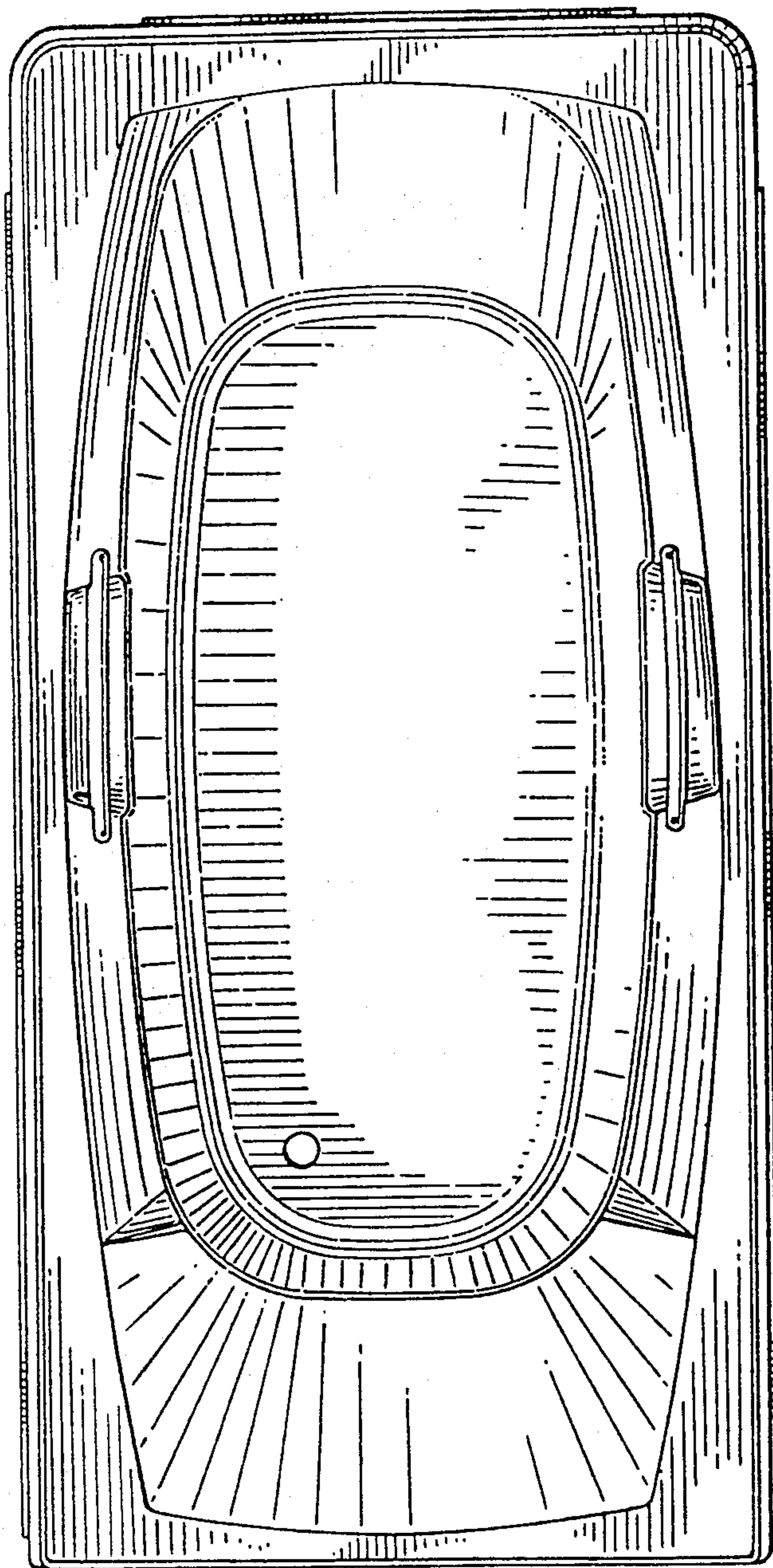

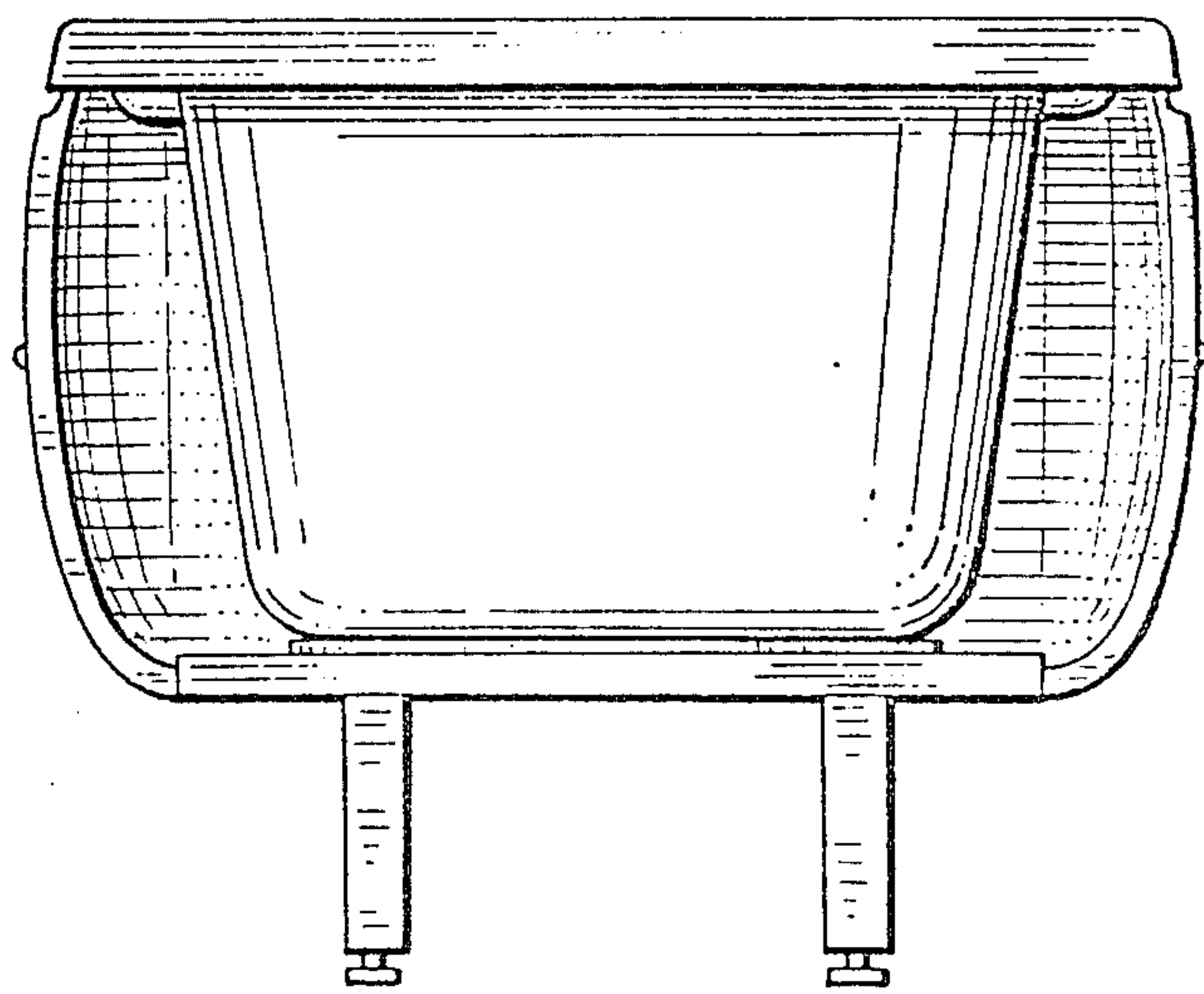
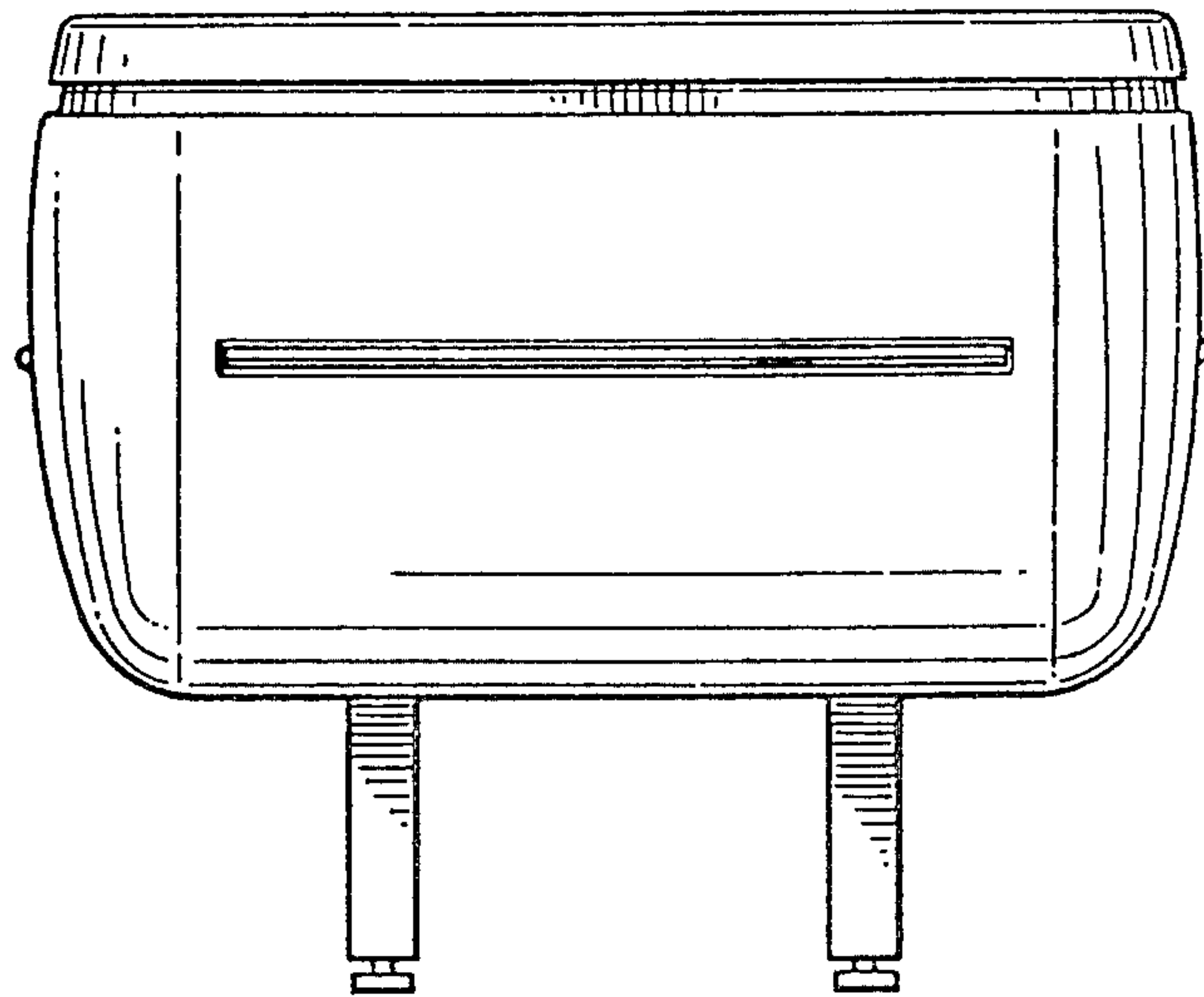
