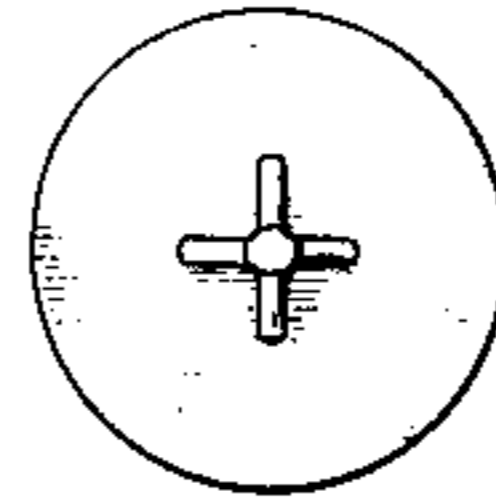
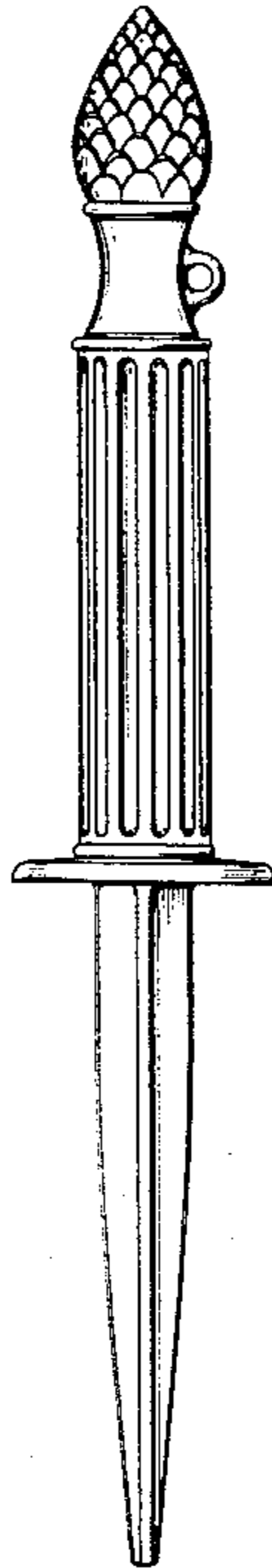
Garden marker-lawn stanchion design, as shown.

FIG. 1 is a front view of a garden marker or lawn stanchion;

FIG. 2 is a side view of the garden marker or lawn stanchion shown in FIG. 1; and

FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the garden marker or lawn stanchion shown in FIGS. 1 and 2.



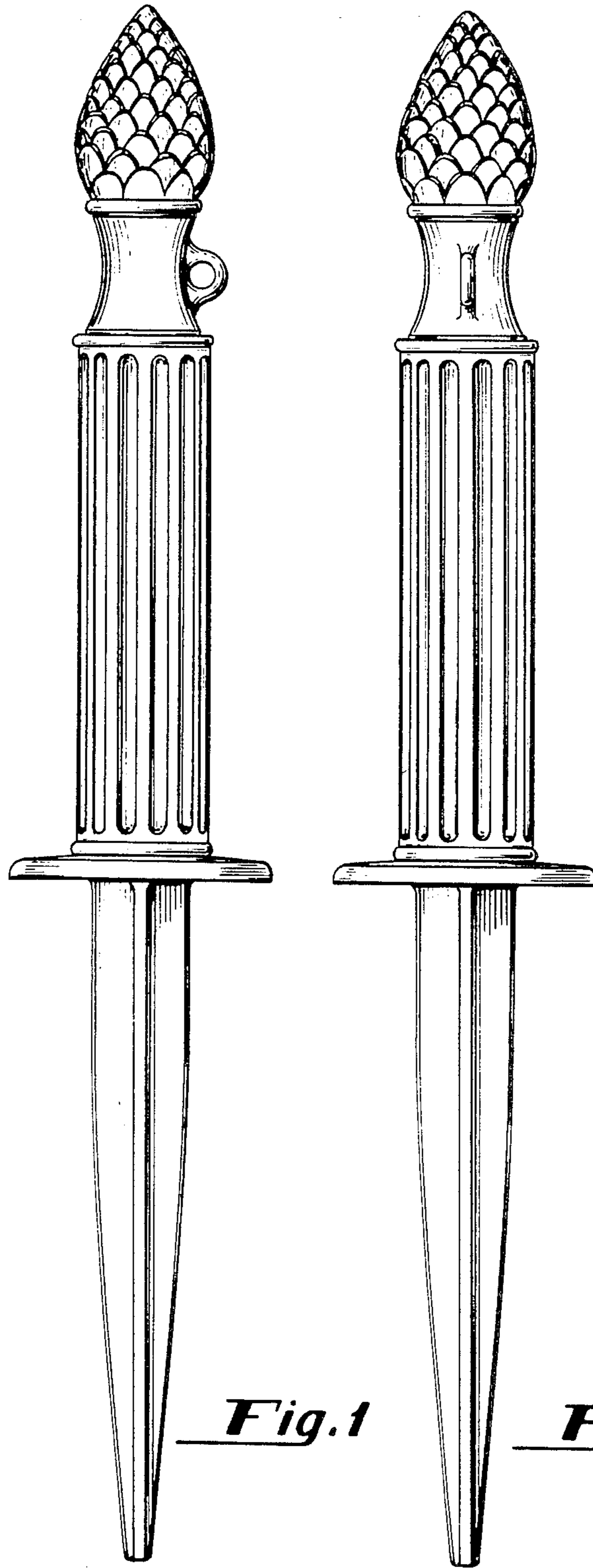
