FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an end closure for a container showing our original design; FIG. 2 is a sectional view taken along the line 2—2 of FIG. 1.

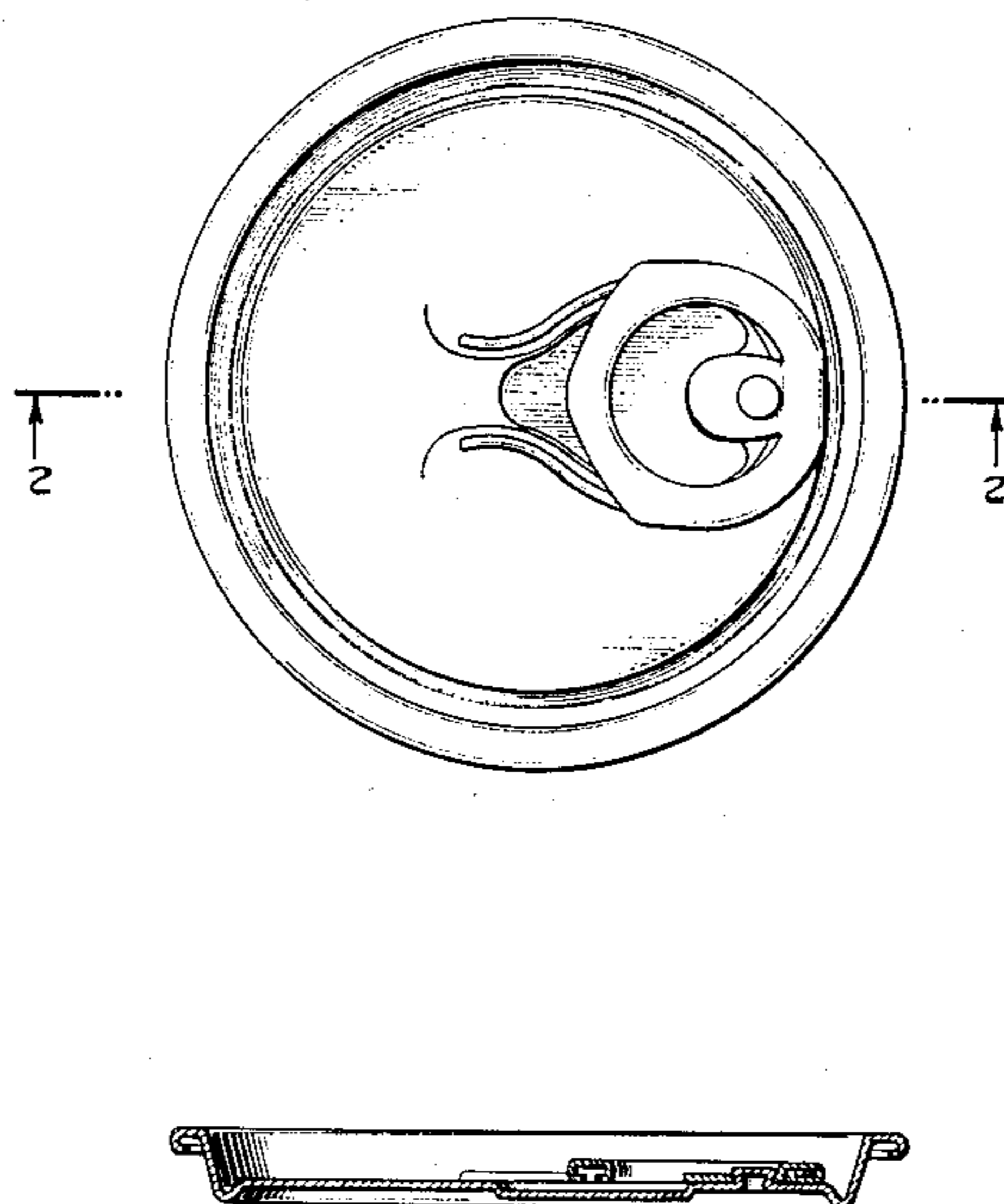

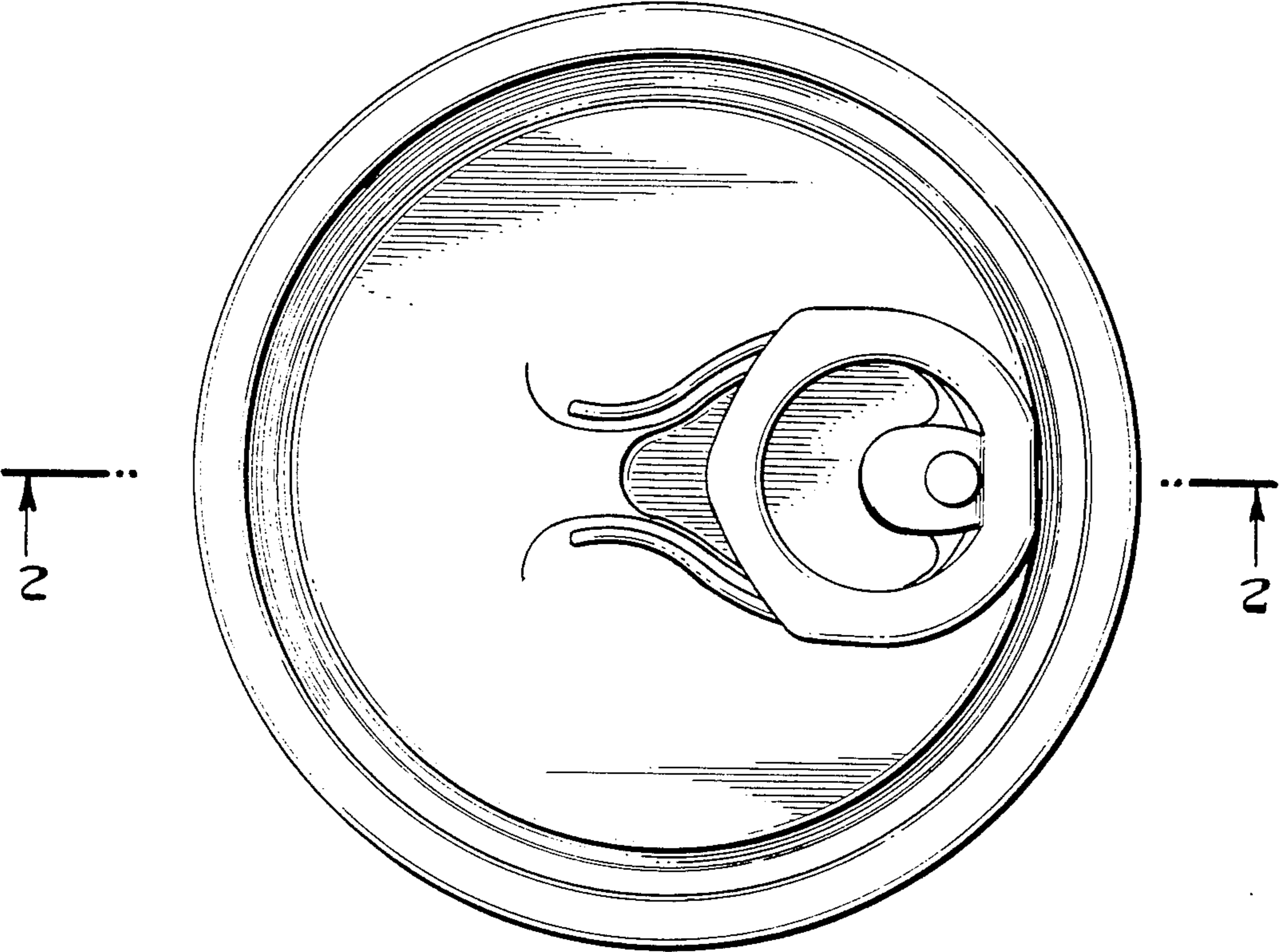
