The ornamental design for a serving tray or the like, as shown and described.

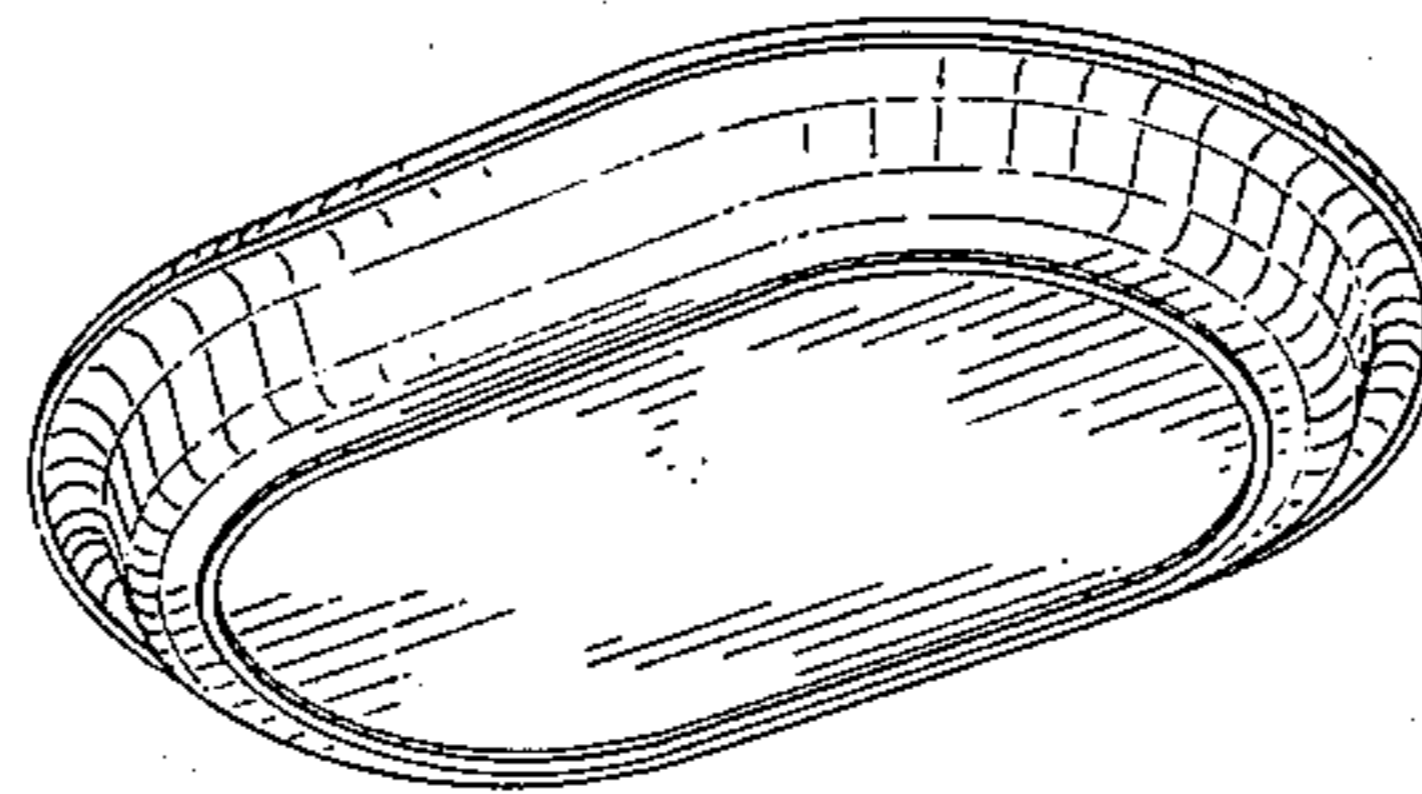
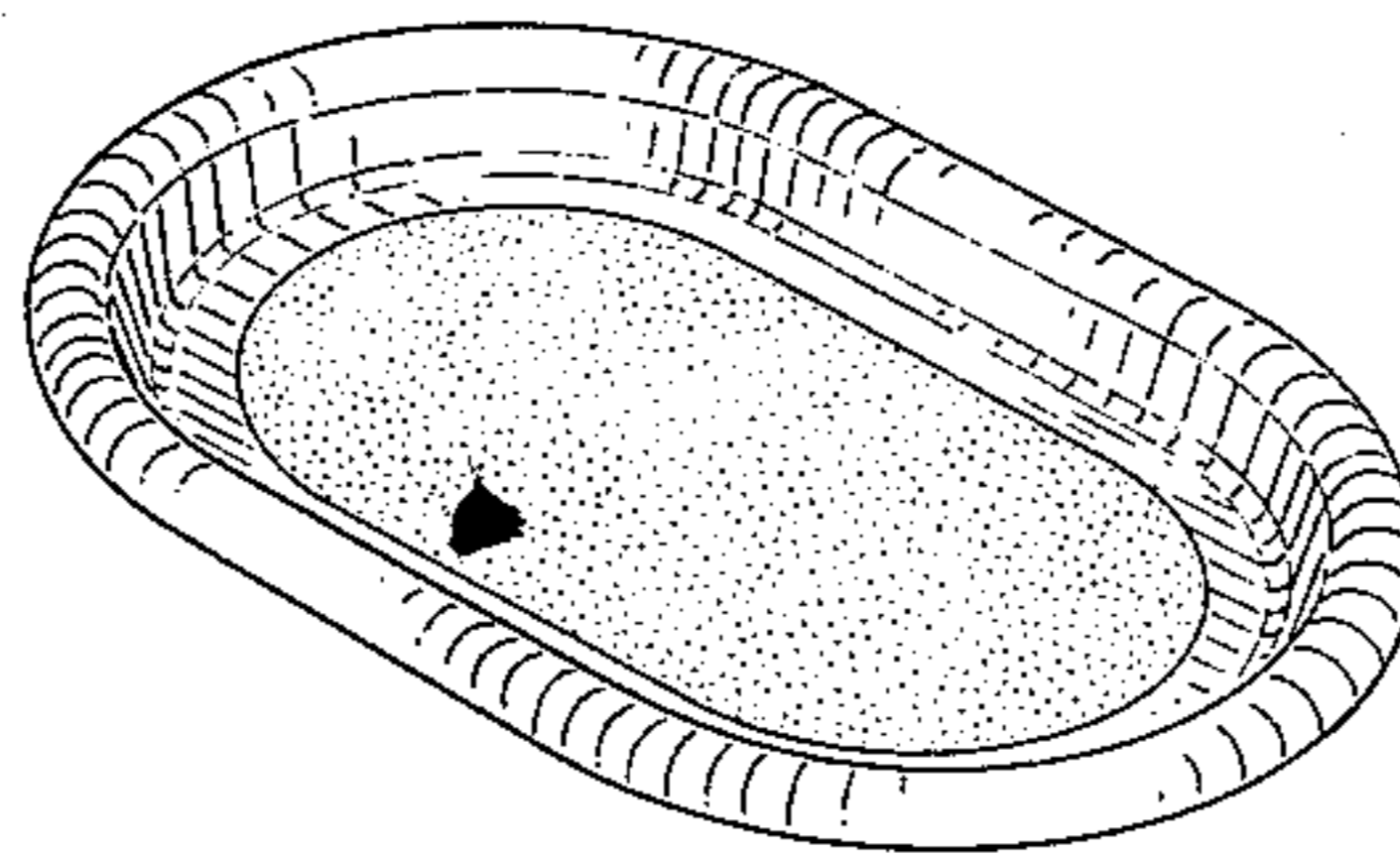
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and left side perspective view of a serving tray or the like showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view; and

FIG. 3 is a rear, bottom and right side perspective view.

The stippled shading in FIG. 1 represents a contrast in texture on the surface of the serving tray or the like.



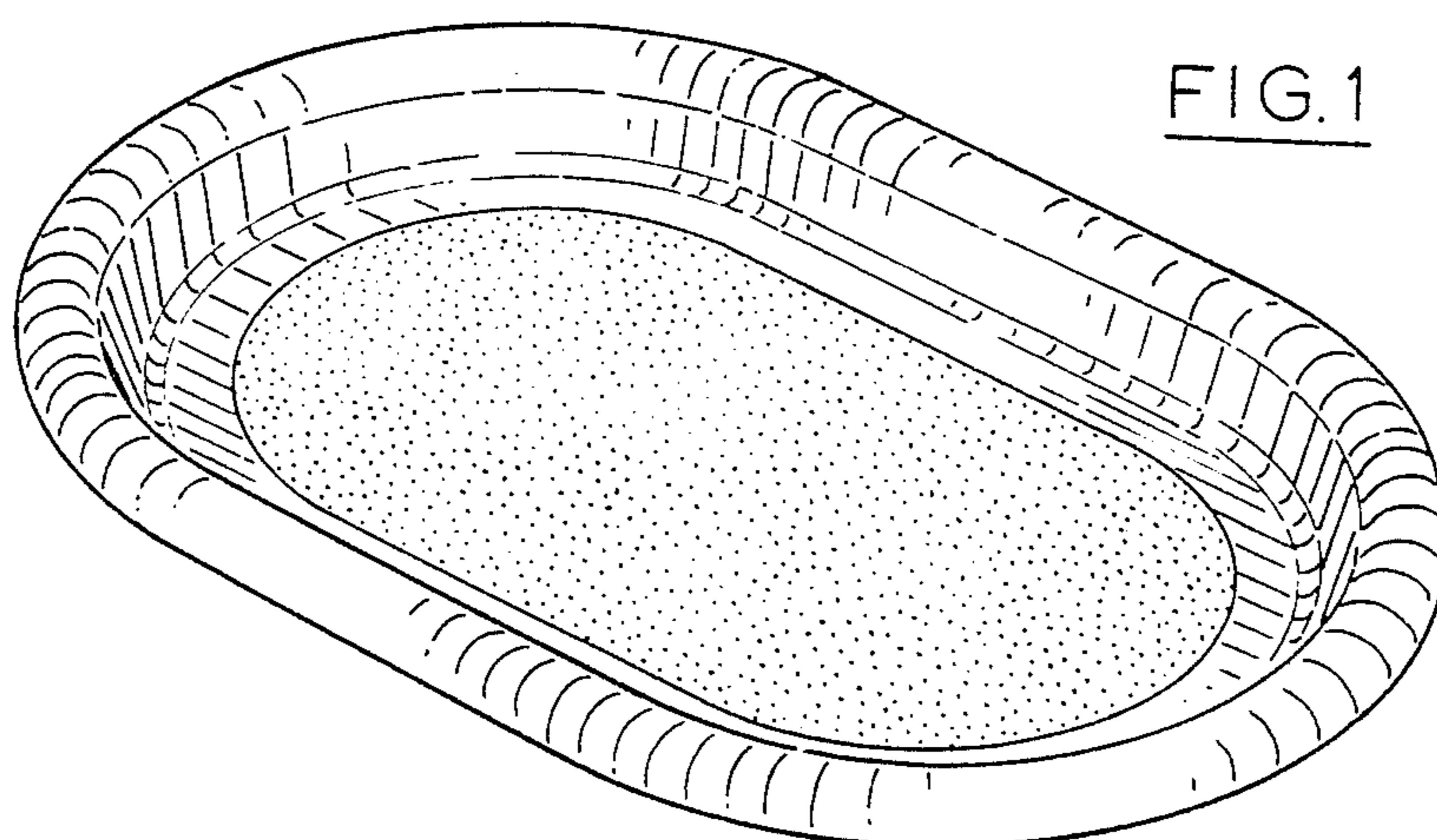

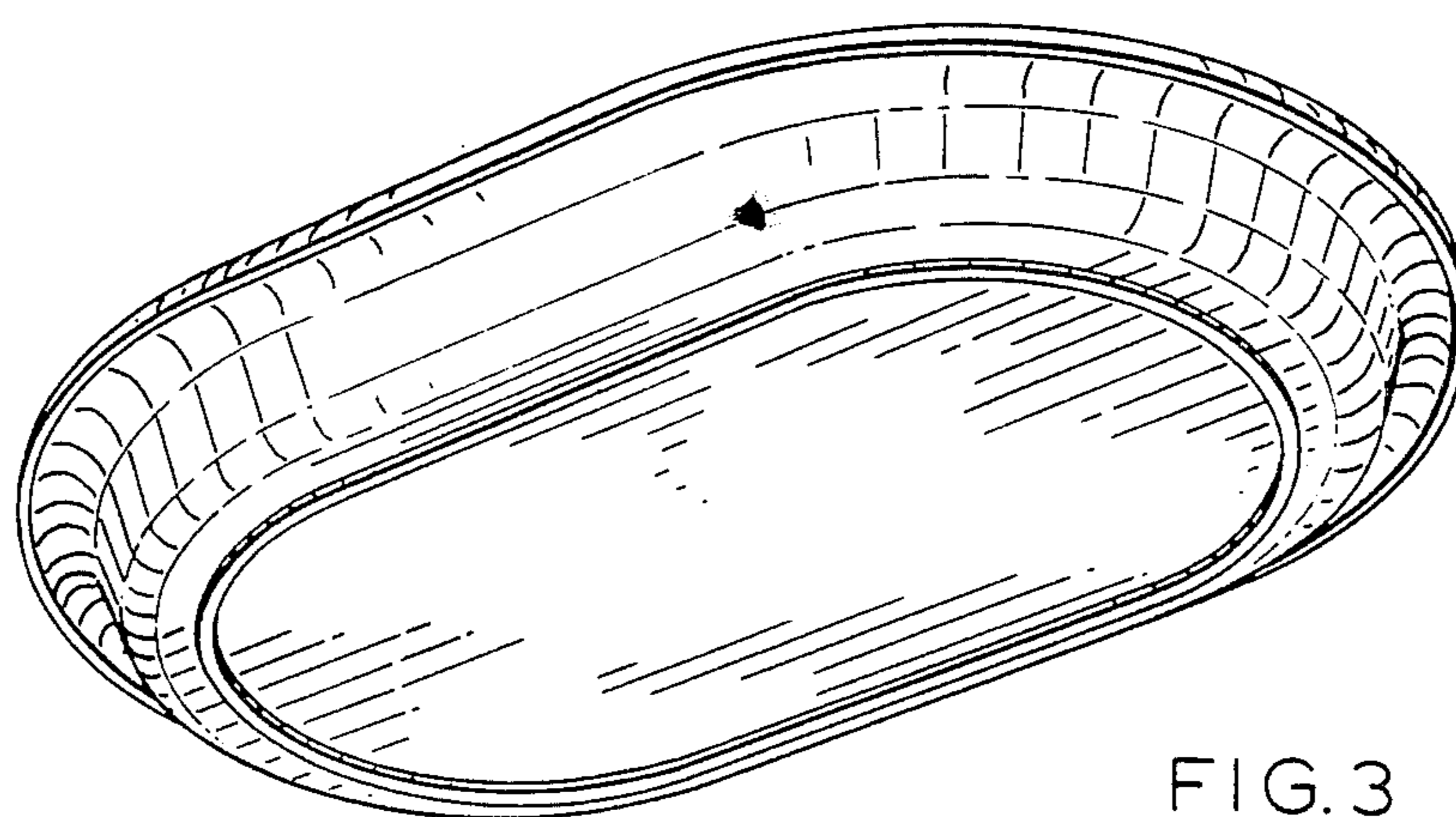
