[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a costume, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a costume showing my new design with the hand and head partially shown in broken lines for purposes of illustration;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.

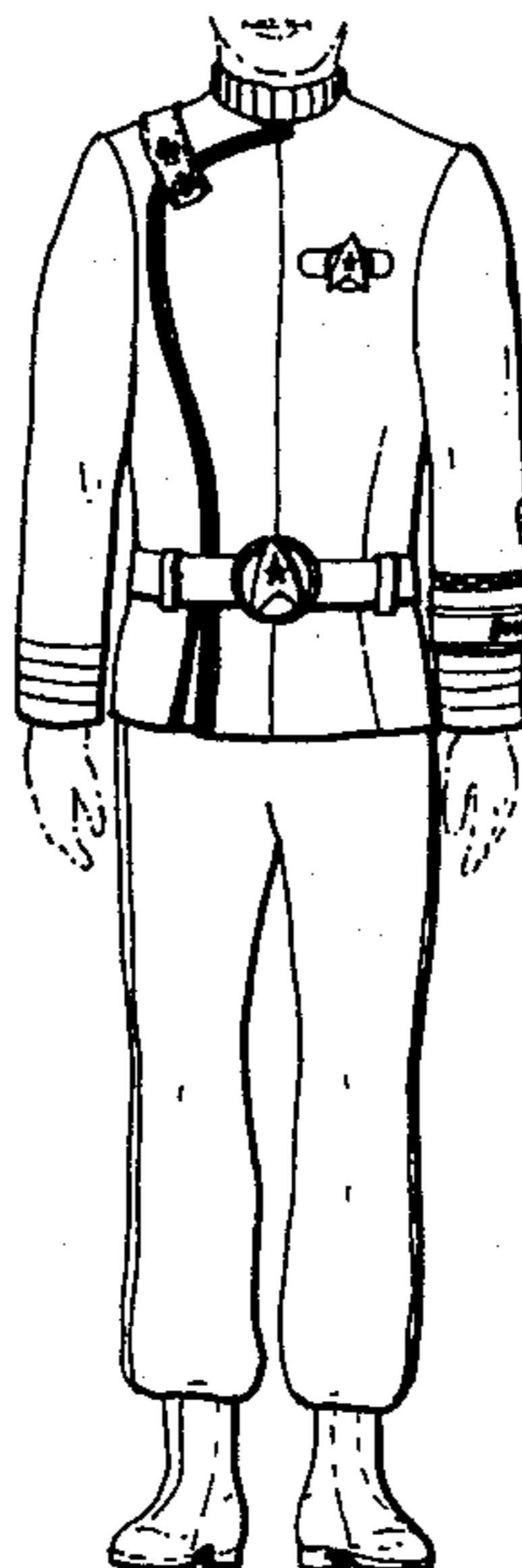

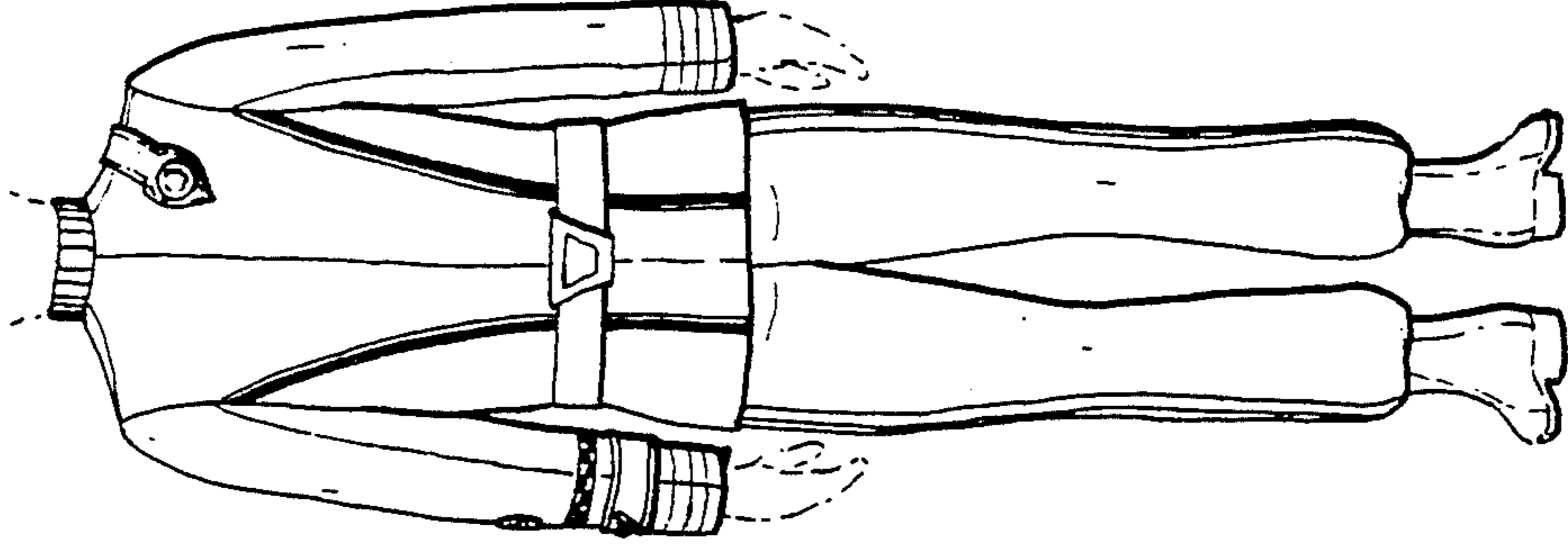

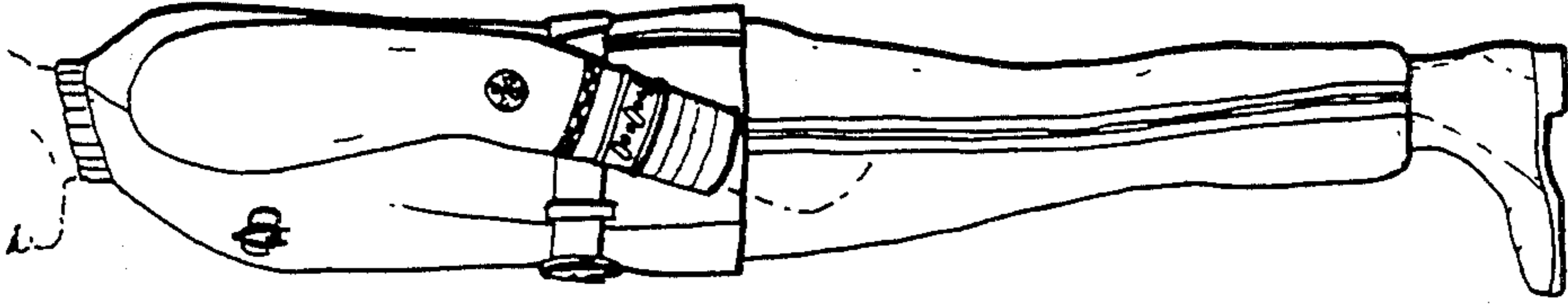

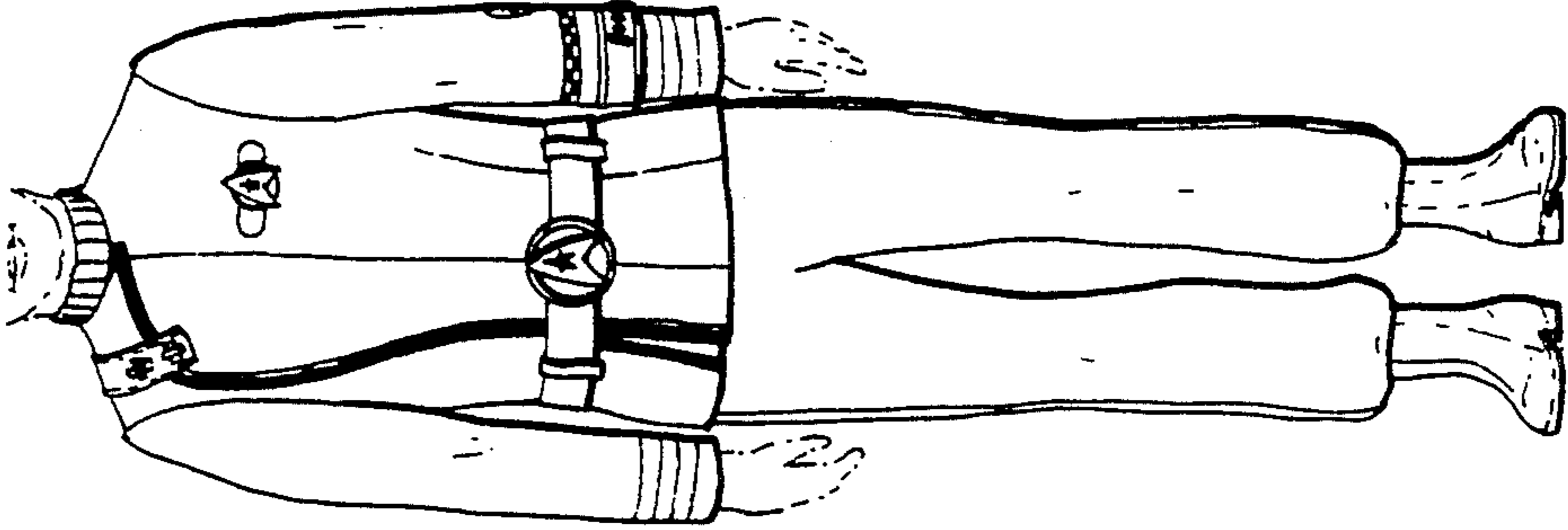
