The ornamental design for an armrest, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an armrest embodying our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

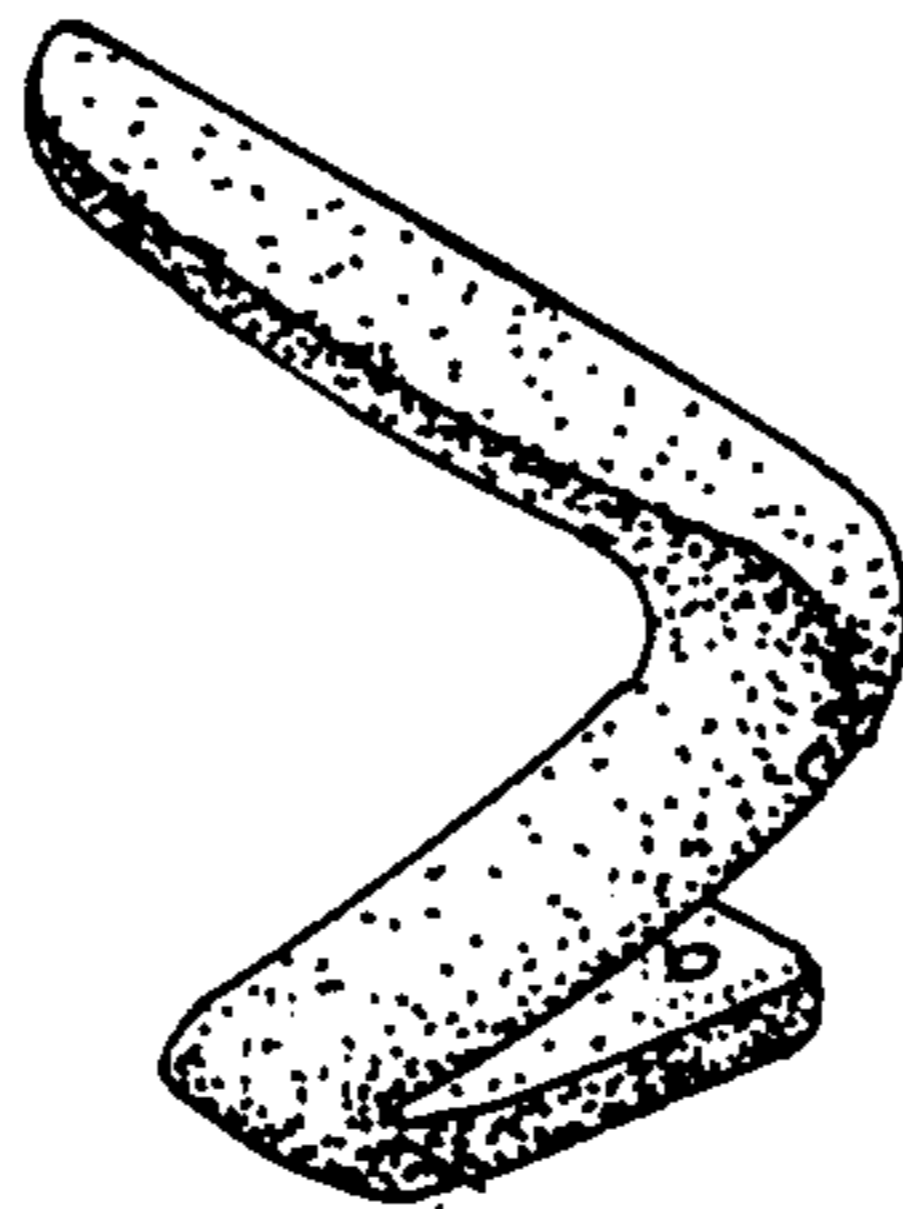
FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof, shown rotated about a horizontal axis 90° relative to the view in FIG. 4; and

FIG. 7 is a side elevation view thereof, as seen from the side opposite that shown in FIGS. 1 and 4, the view in FIG. 7 shown rotated about a horizontal axis 180° relative to the view in FIG. 4.



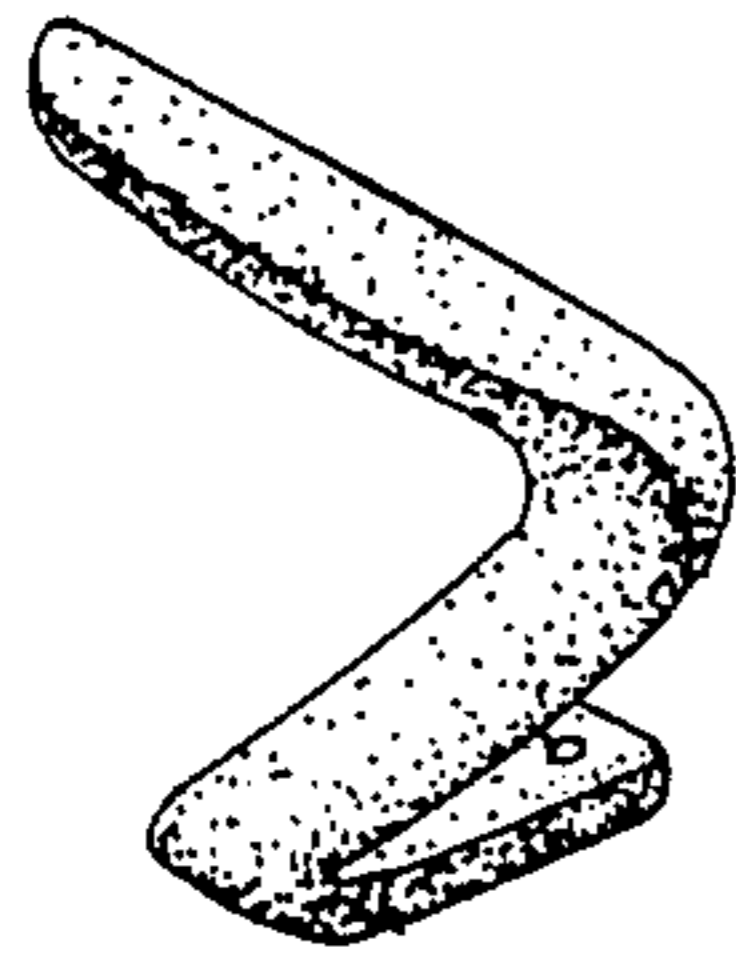

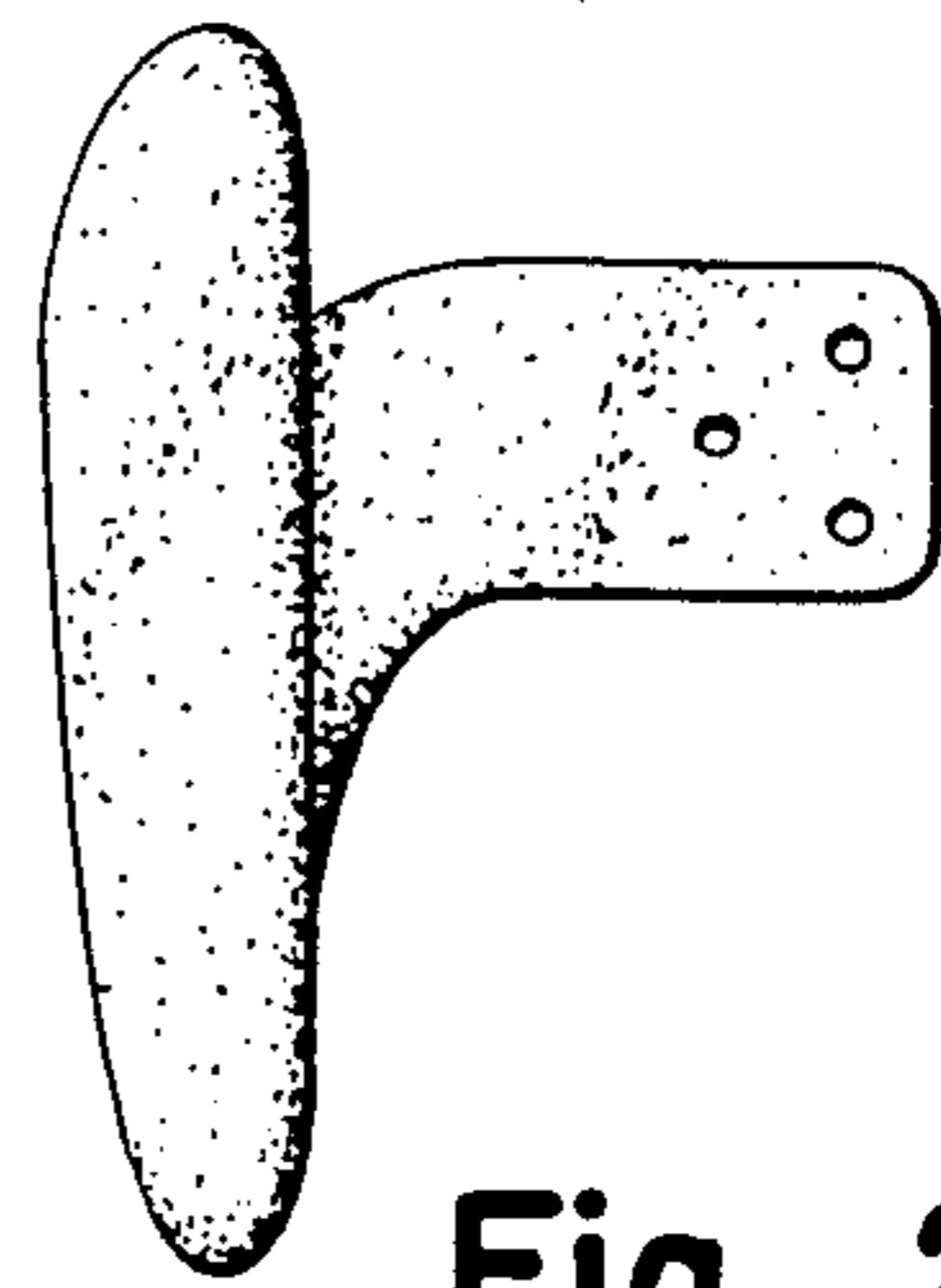

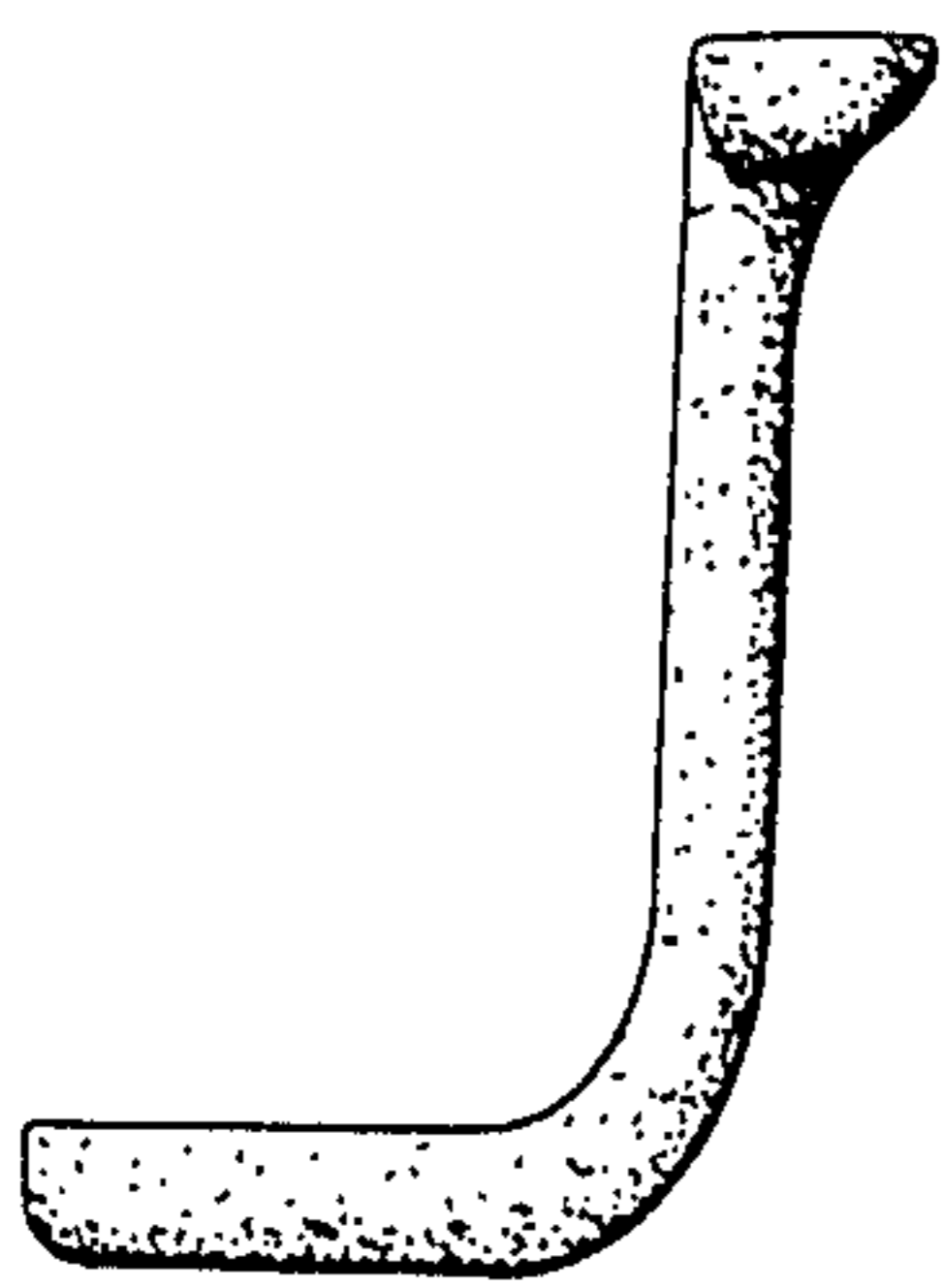

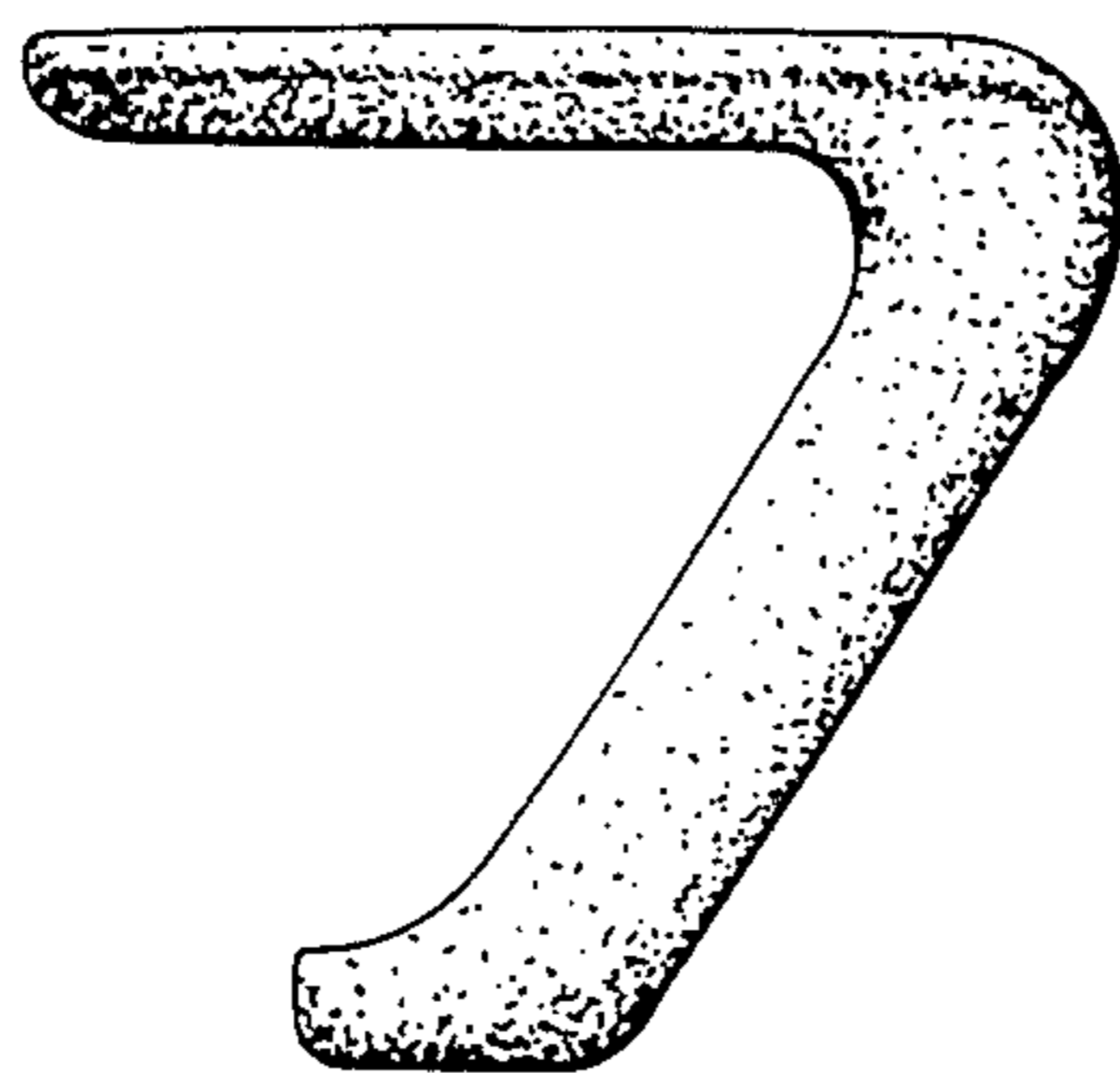

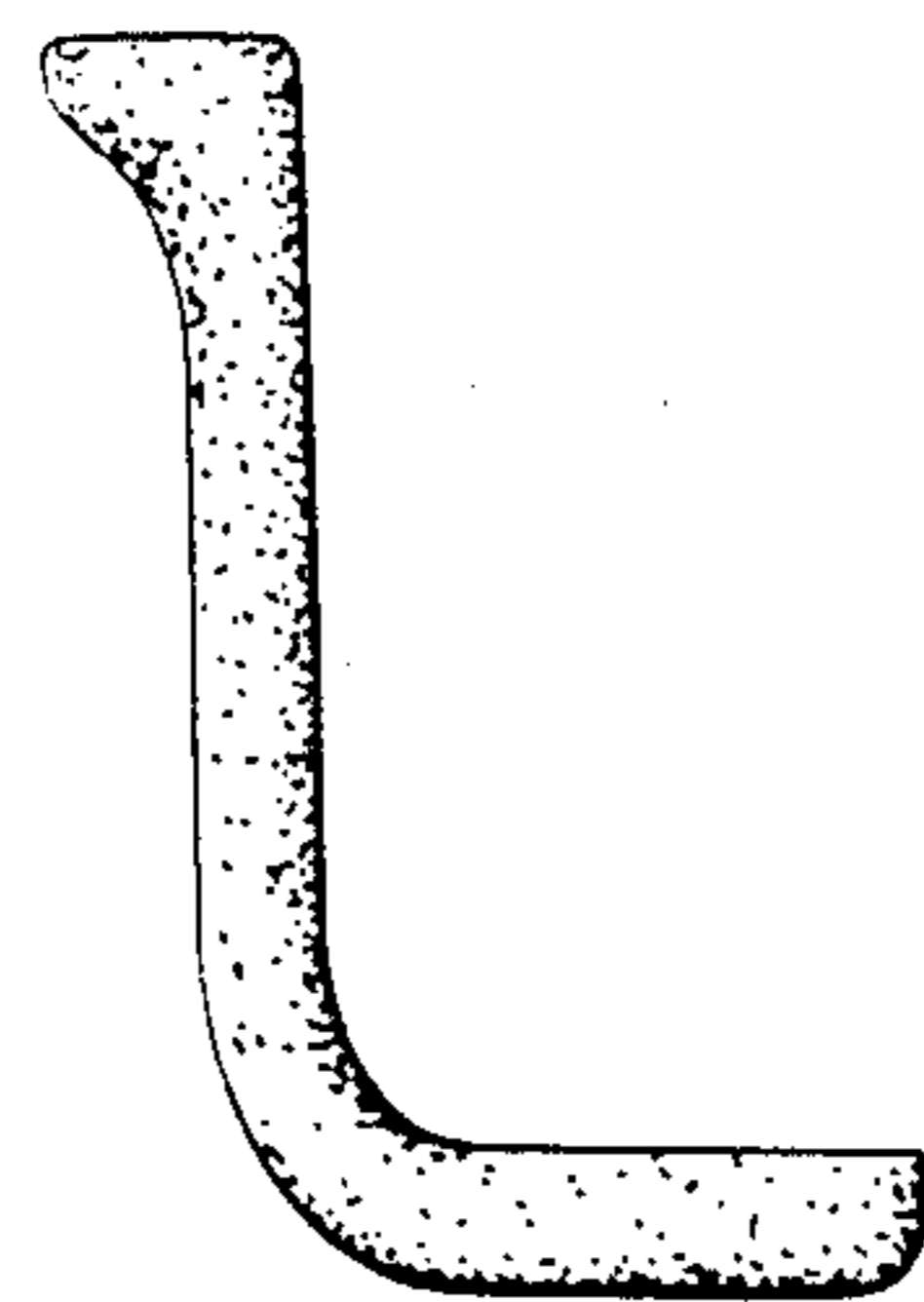

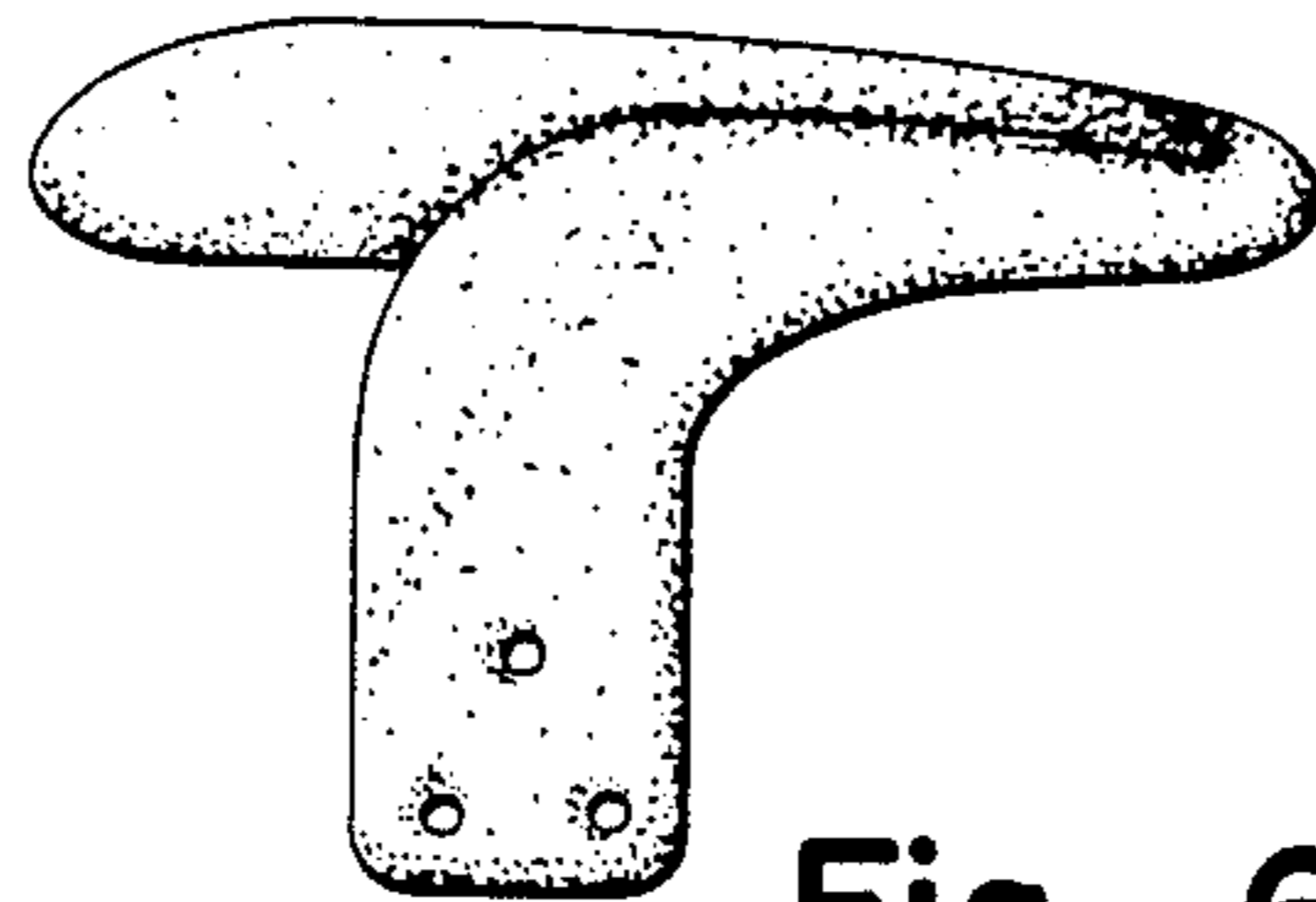

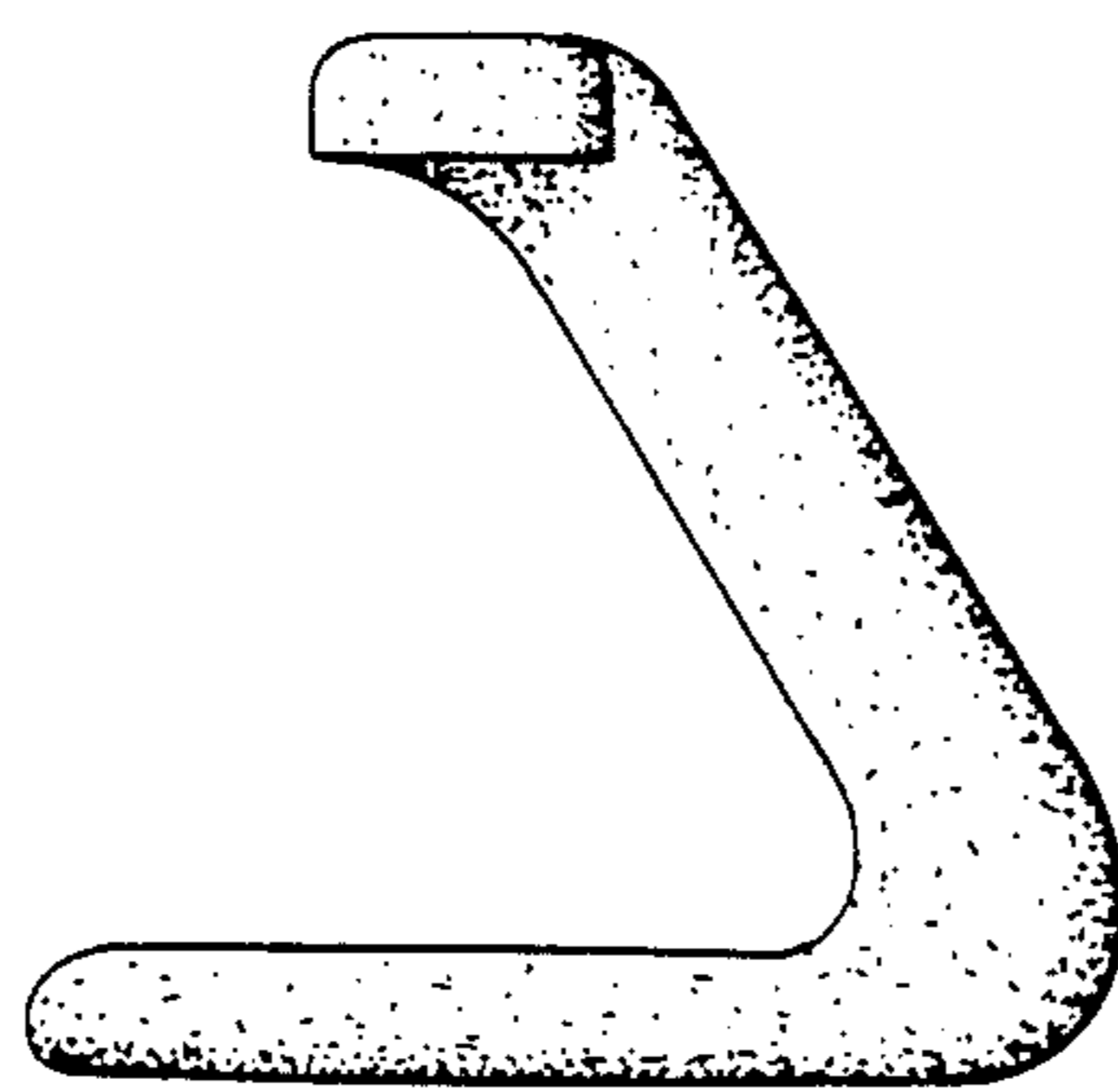
