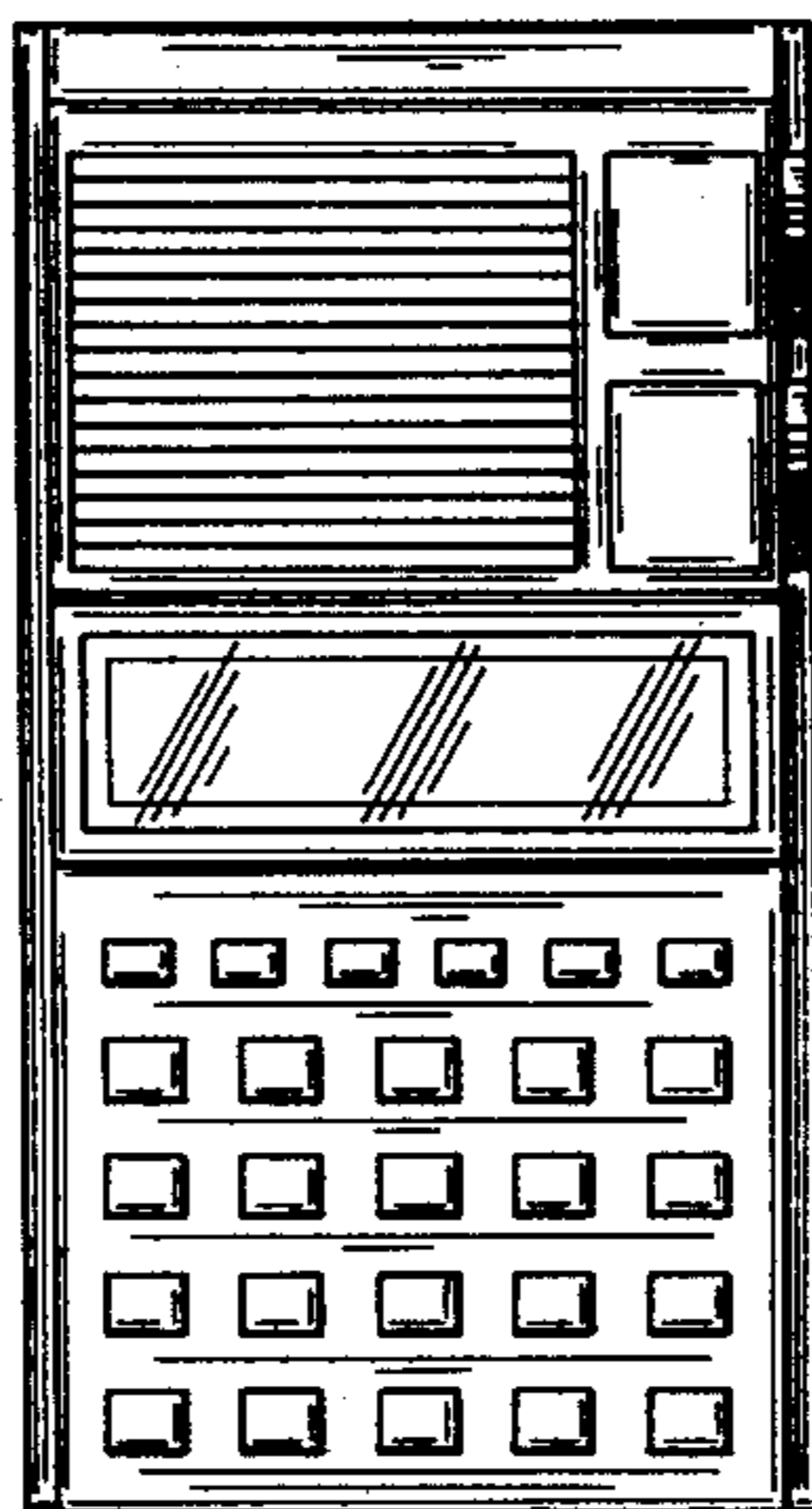

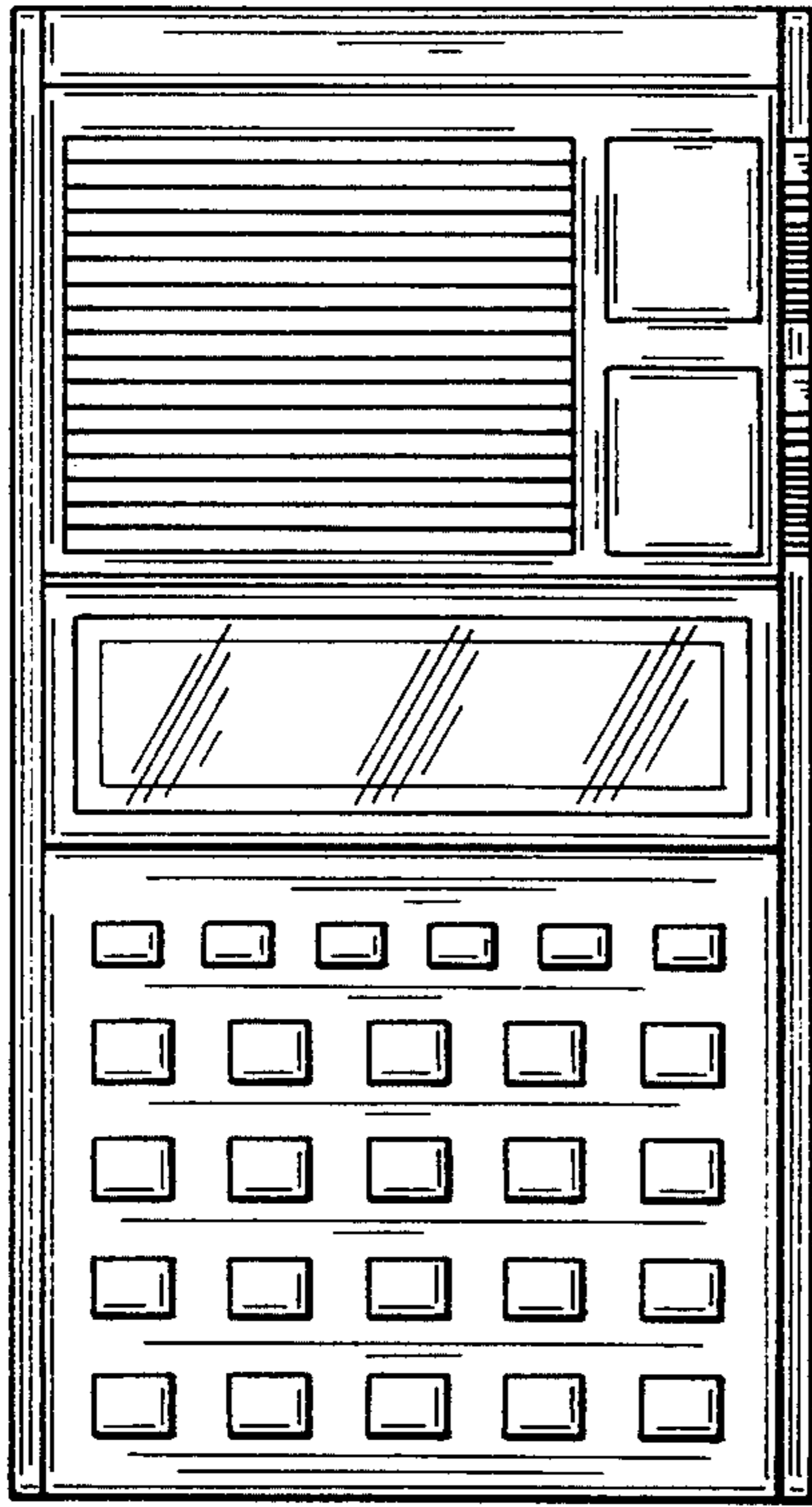
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an electronic calculator with watch, as shown and described.

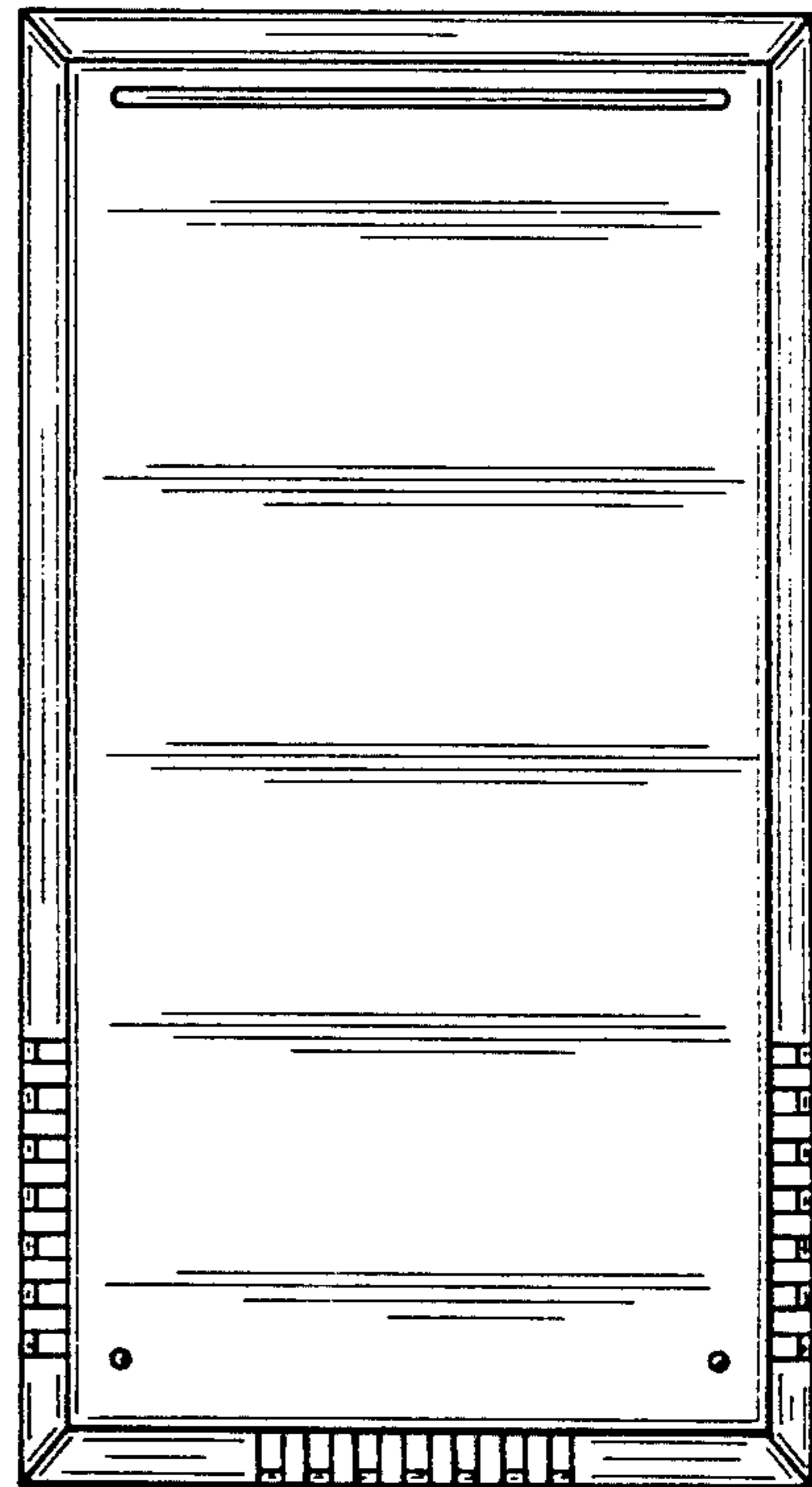
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view.

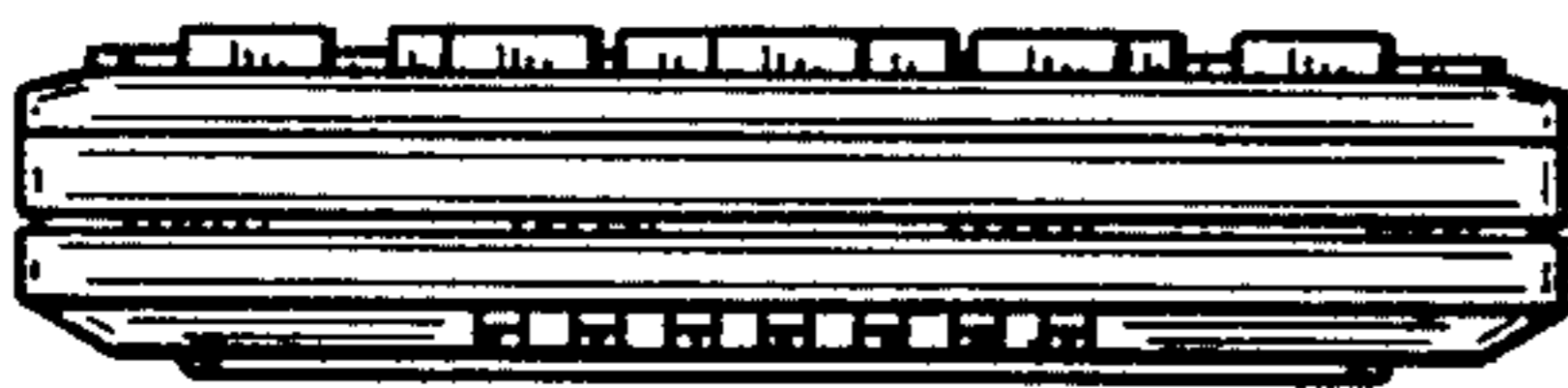




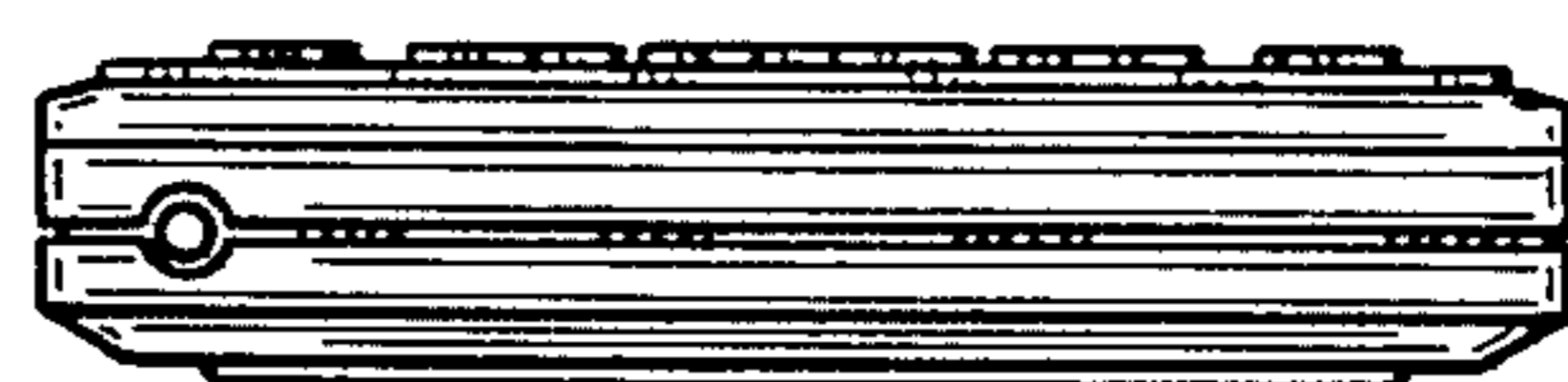

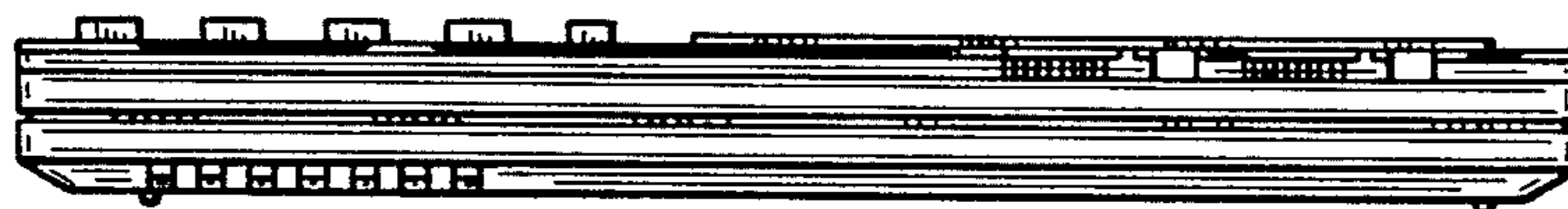

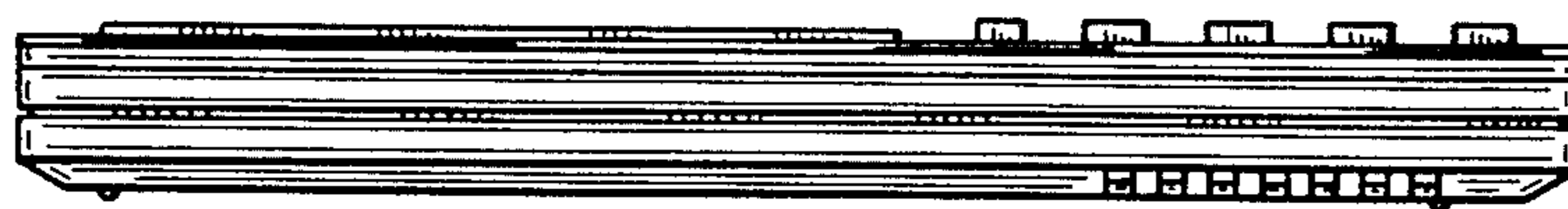
