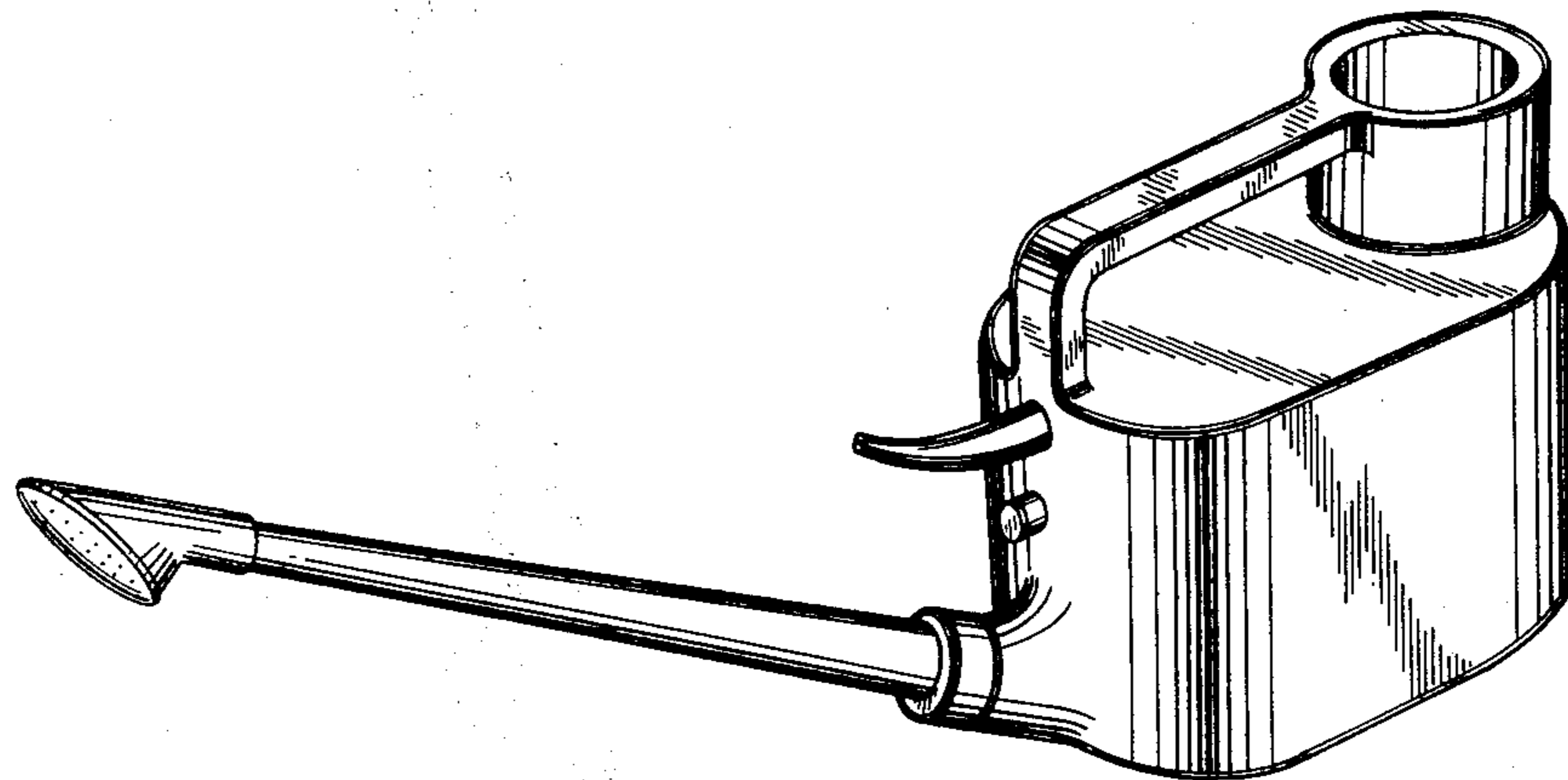

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a watering can, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and right side of a watering can showing my new design with the spray nozzle in an operative position; FIG. 2 is a perspective view taken from the bottom, rear and right side thereof, with the curved spout in an operative position; and FIG. 3 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and right side thereof, the left side being a mirror image of the right side shown.



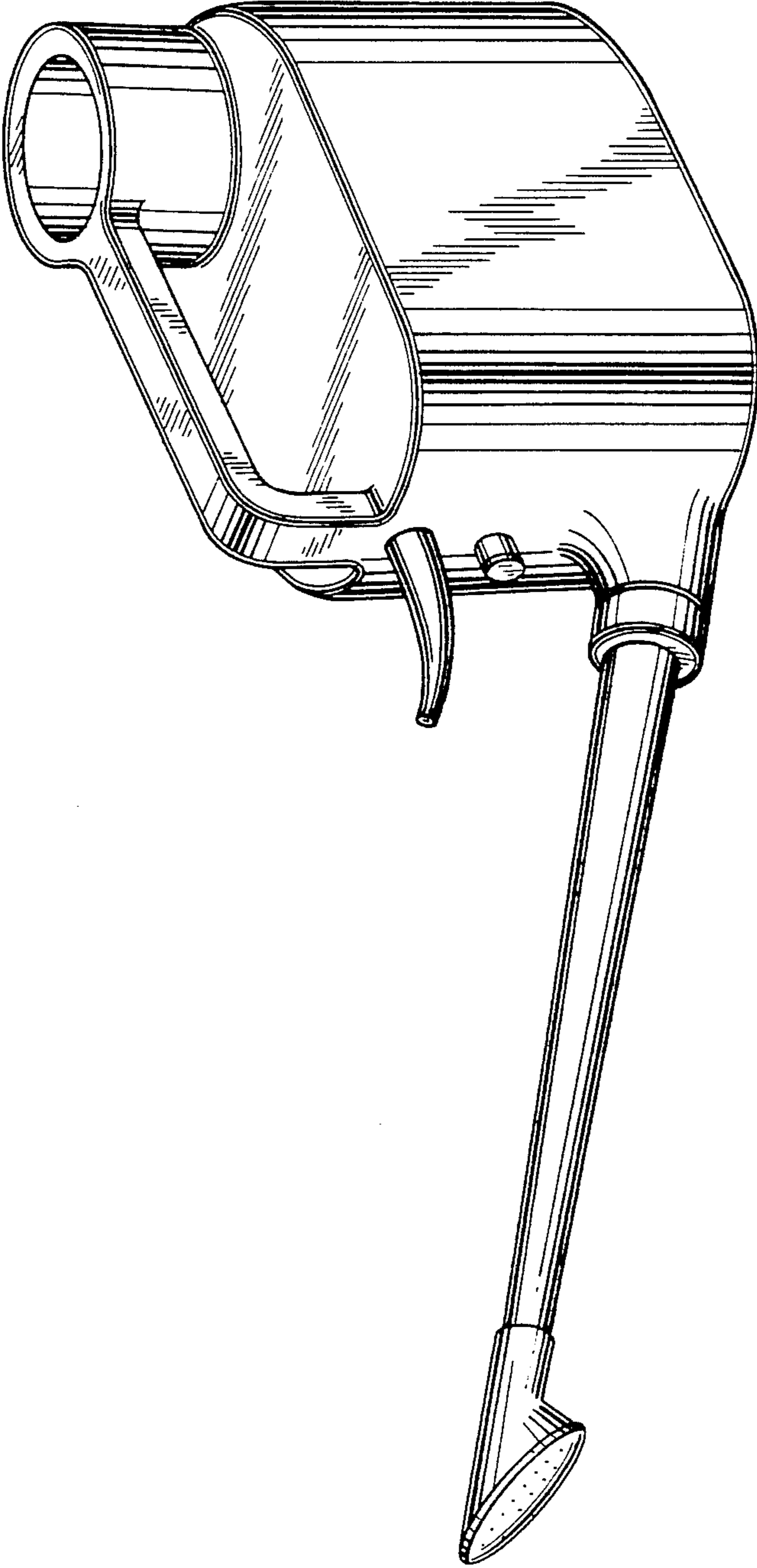

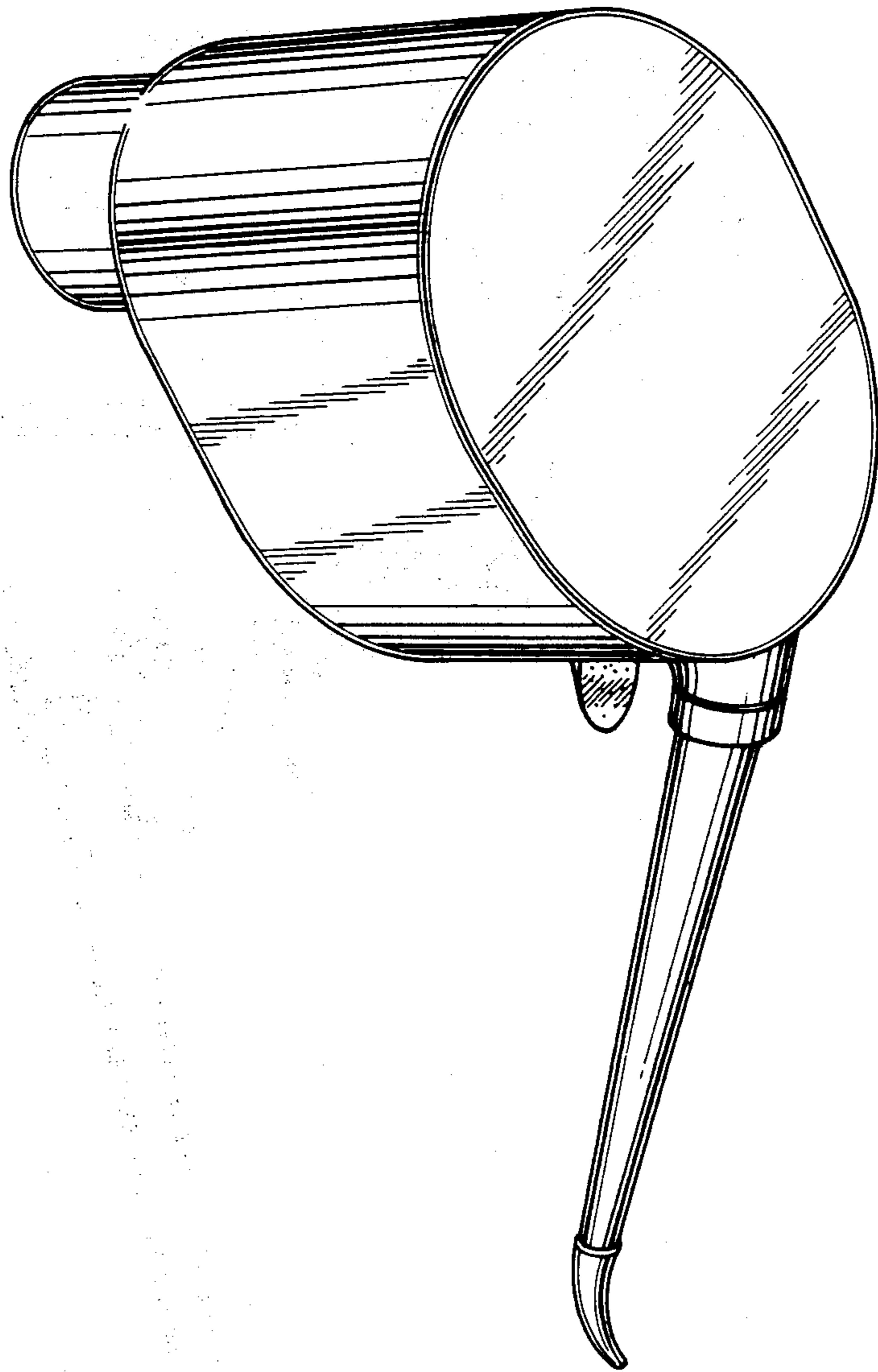

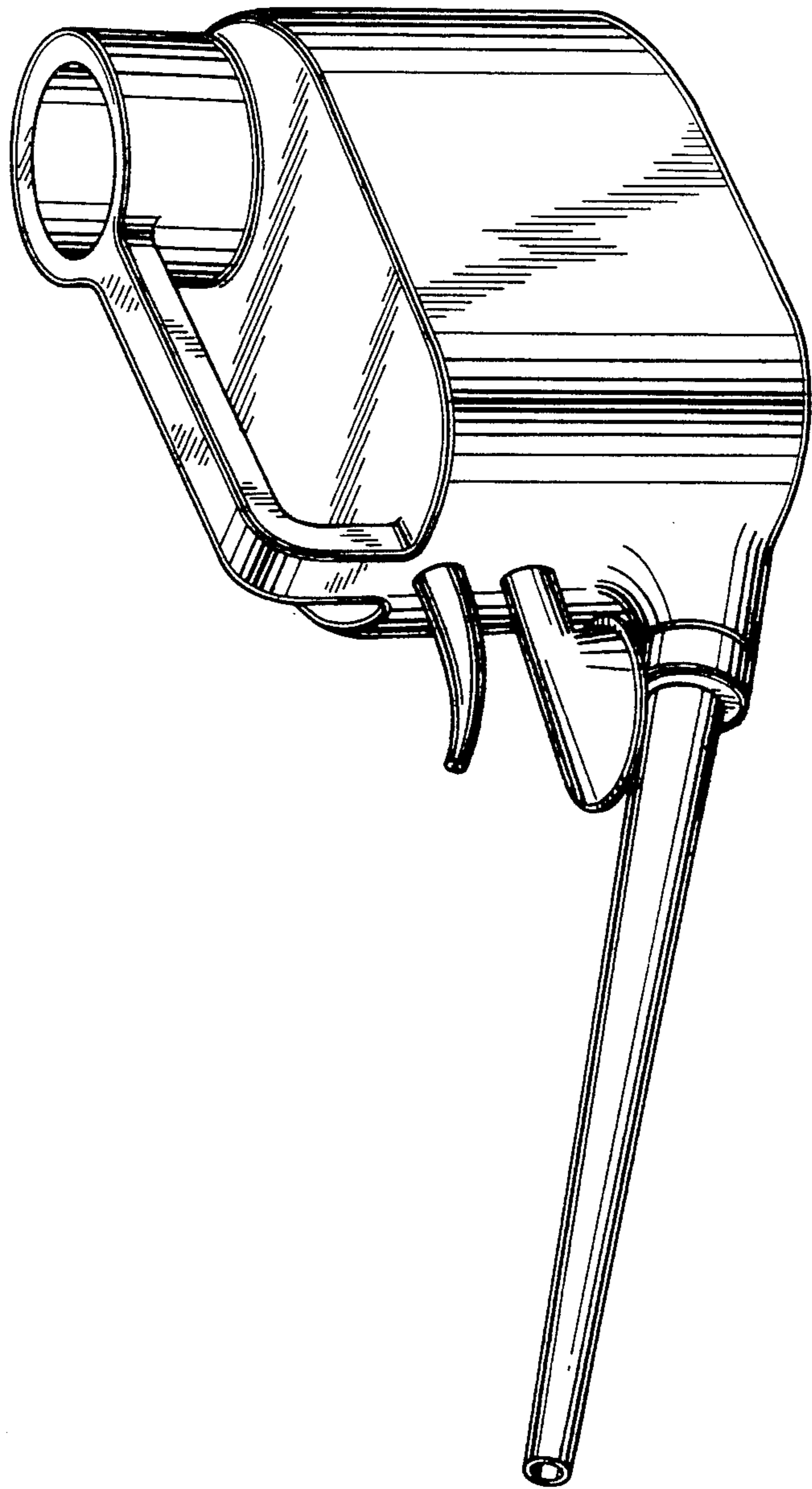
