CLAIM

The ornamental design for the athletic shoe, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of an athletic shoe showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, it being un-

derstood that the sole portions not shown are a continuation of that shown herein;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view of another embodiment of my new design of FIGS. 1-4;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of FIG. 5;

FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 5, the front being identical to FIG. 3;

FIG. 8 is a left side elevational view of yet another embodiment of my new design of FIGS. 1-4;

FIG. 9 is a top plan view of FIG. 8;

FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 8, the front being identical to FIG. 3.

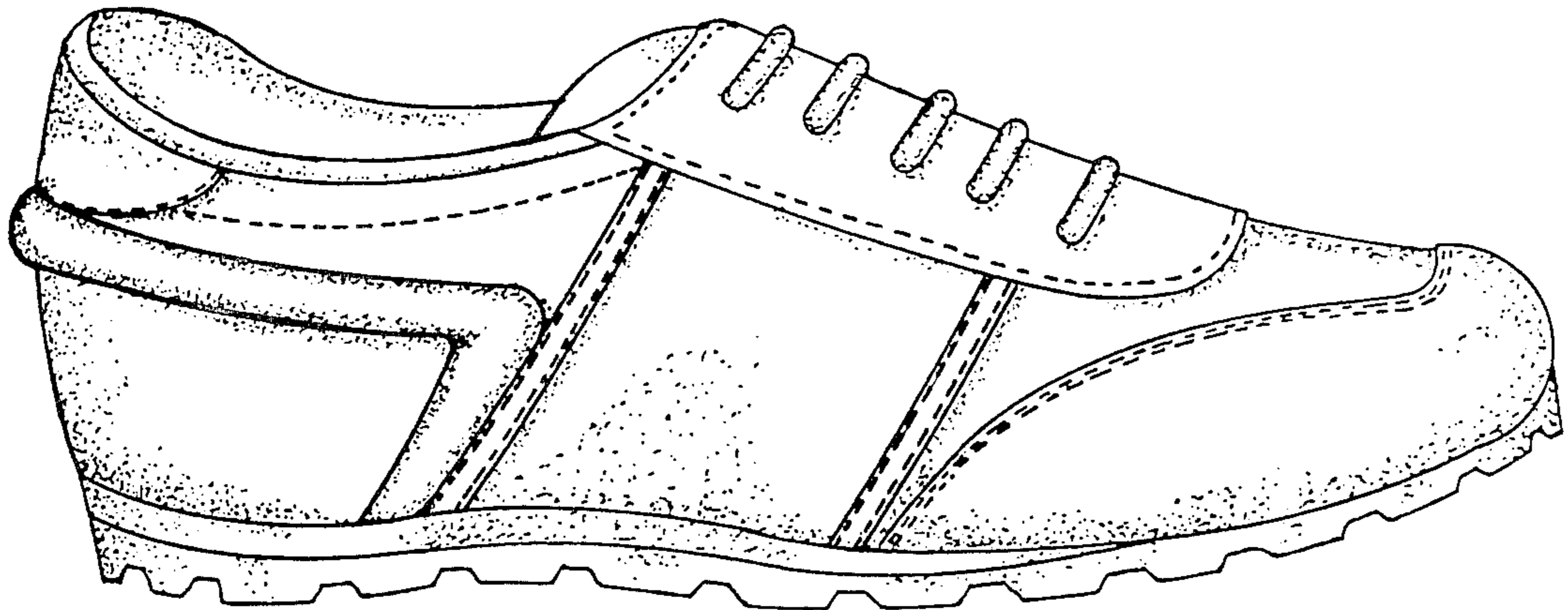

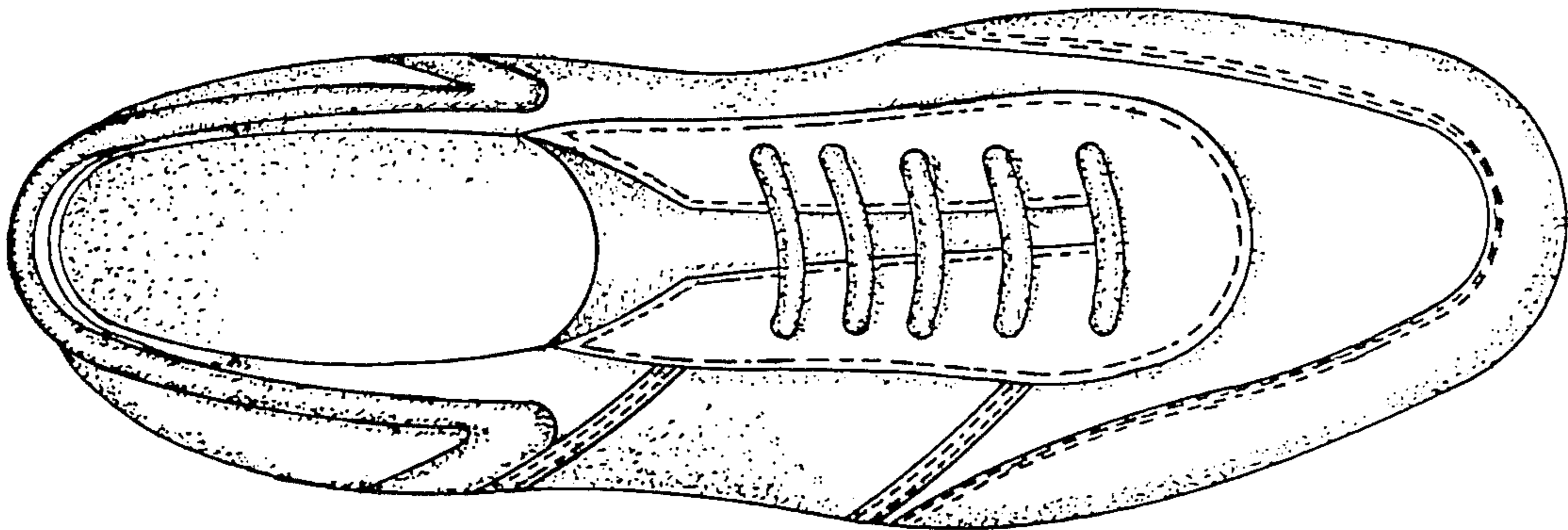

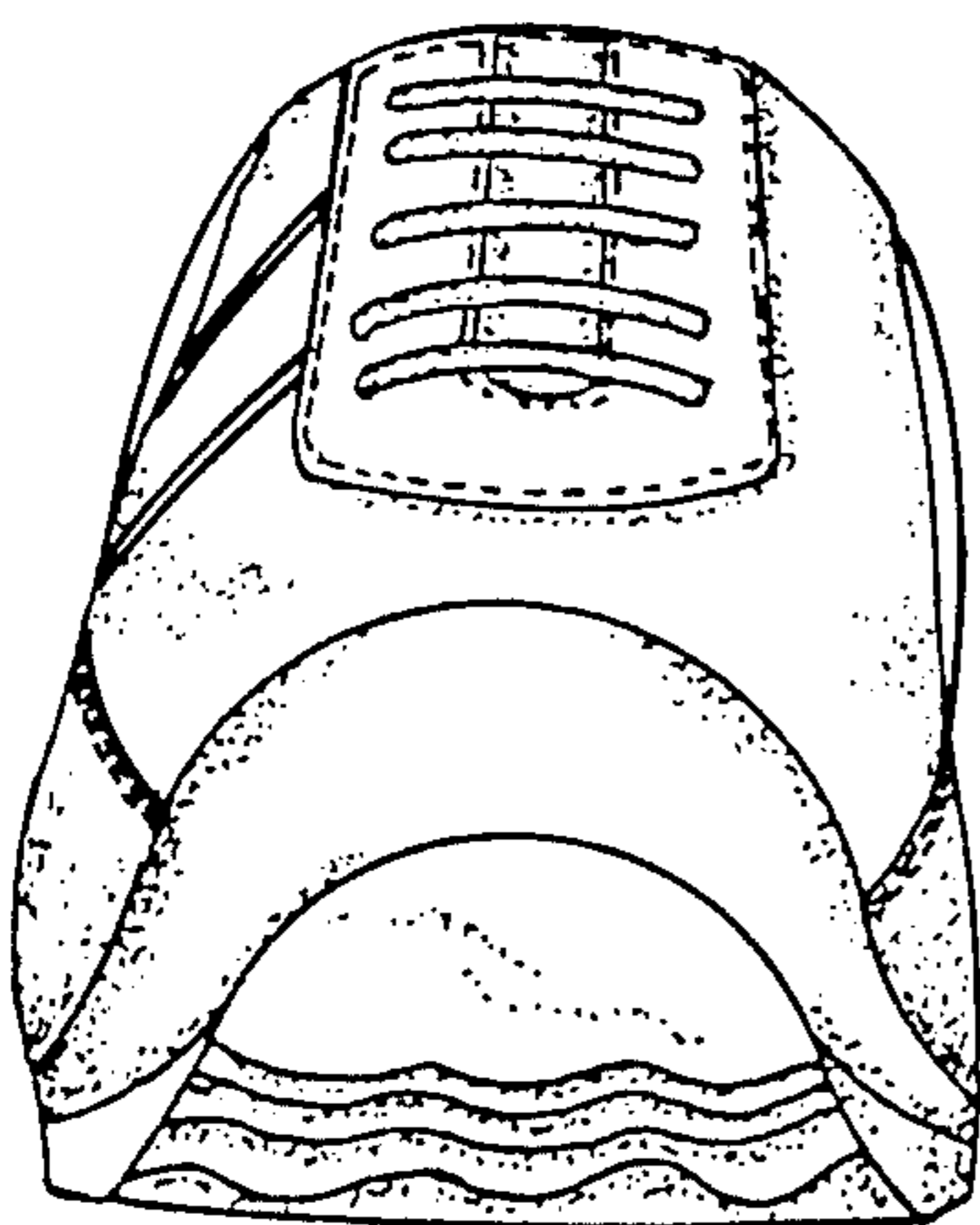

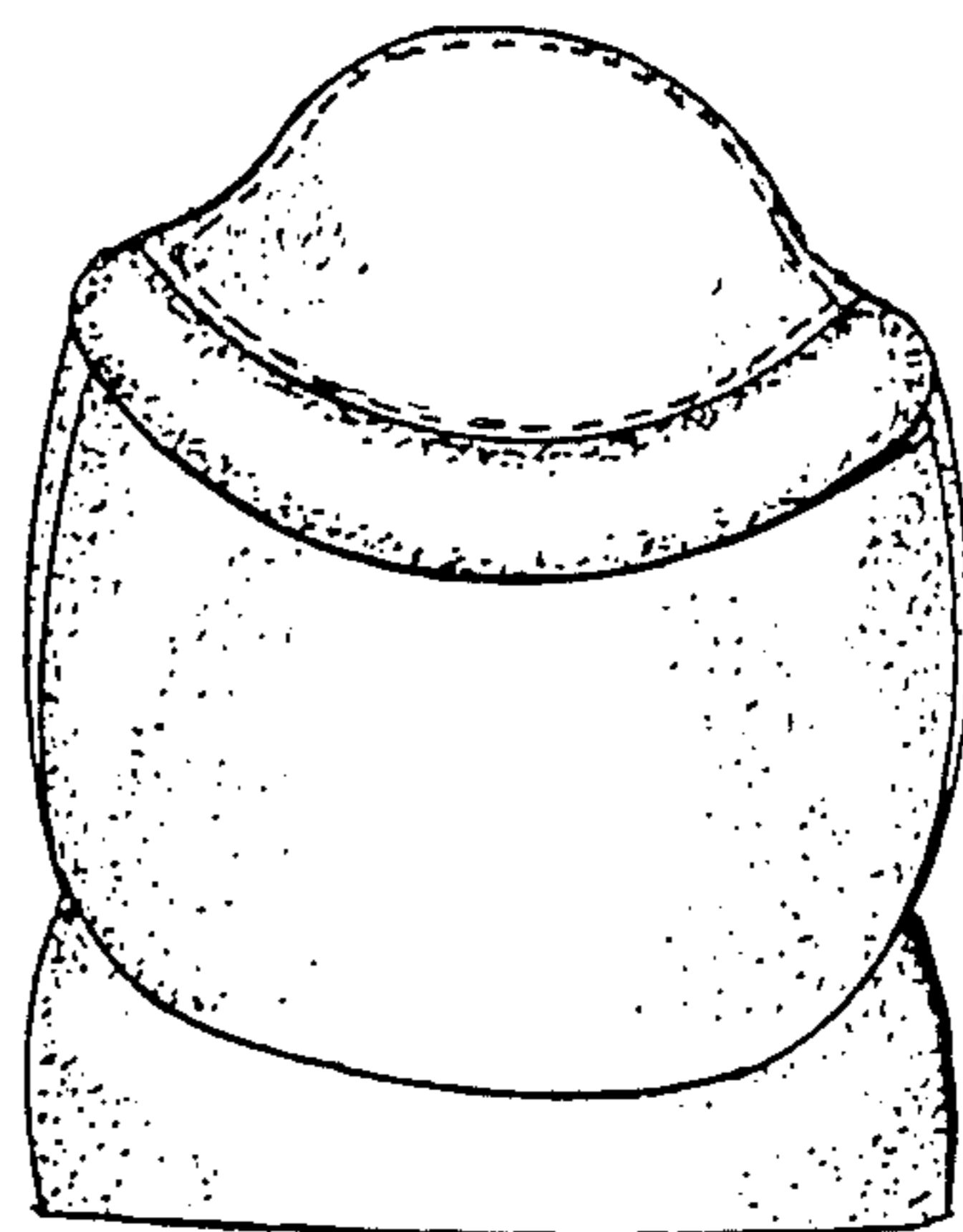

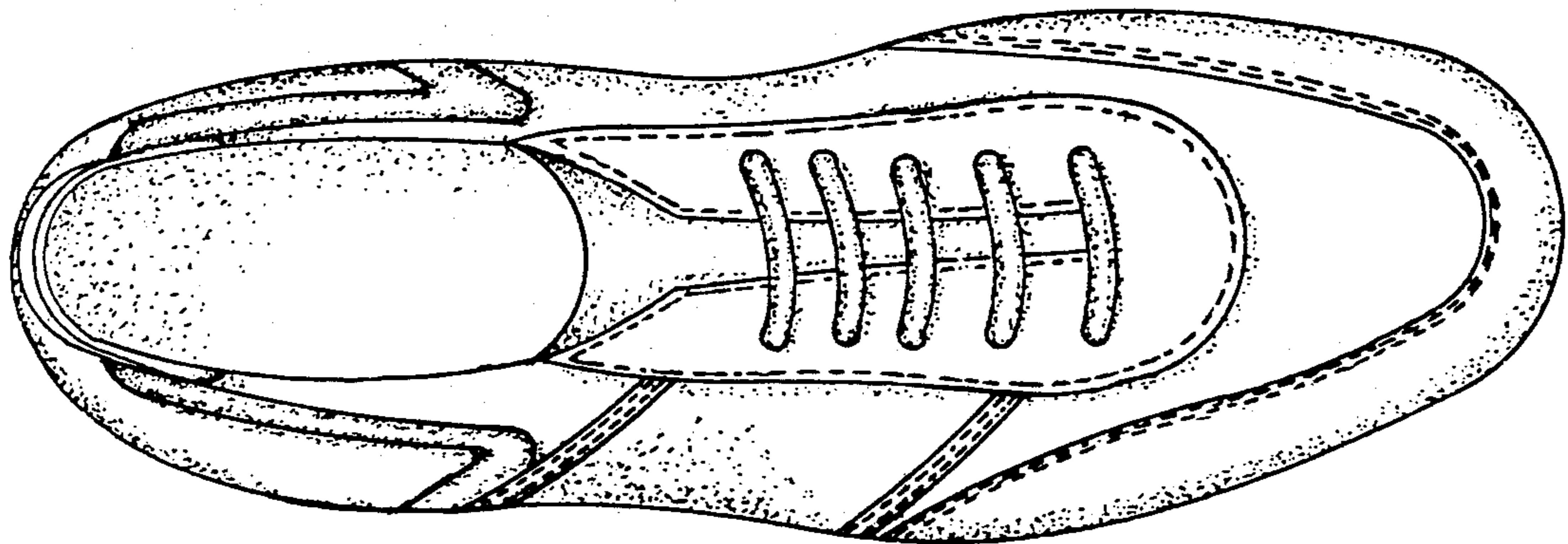

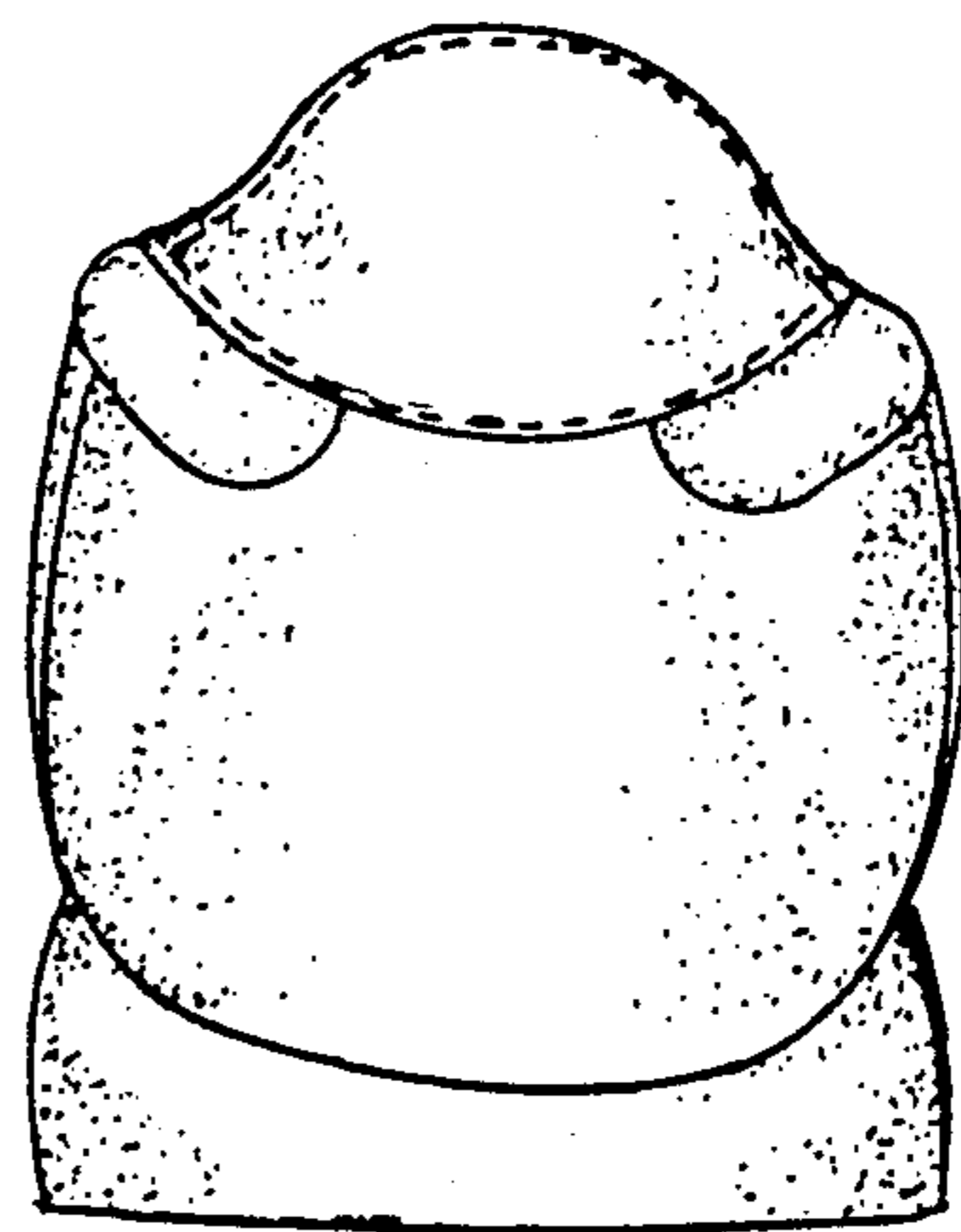

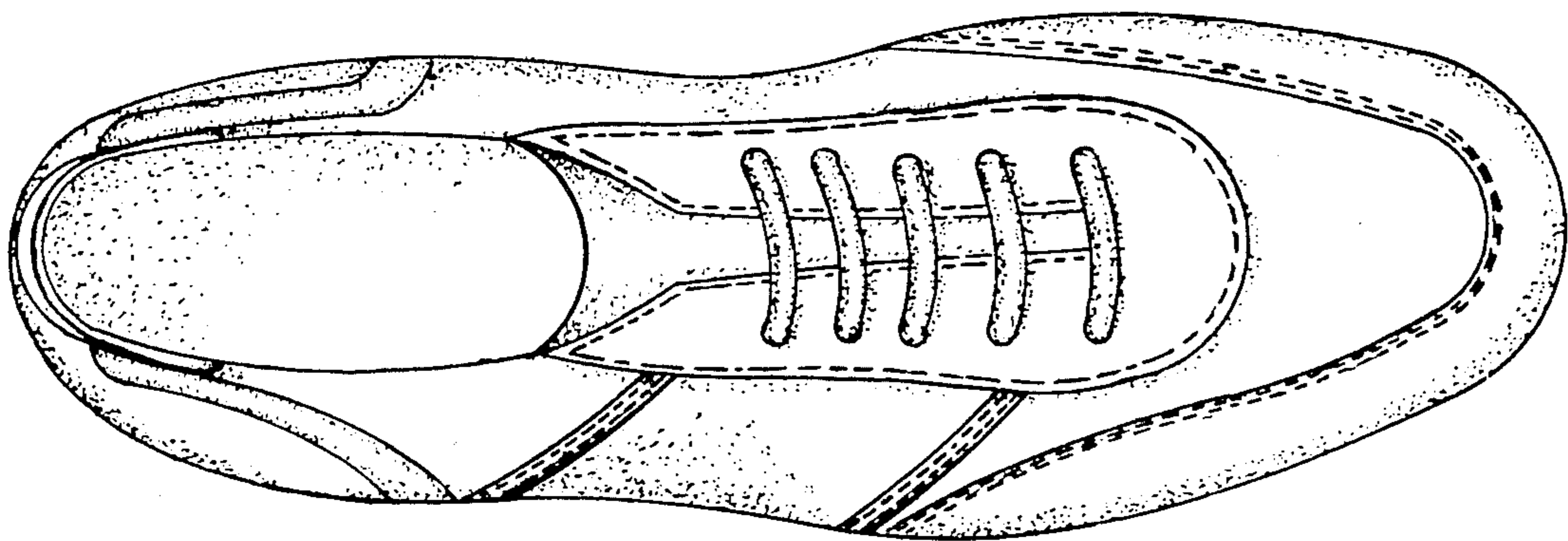

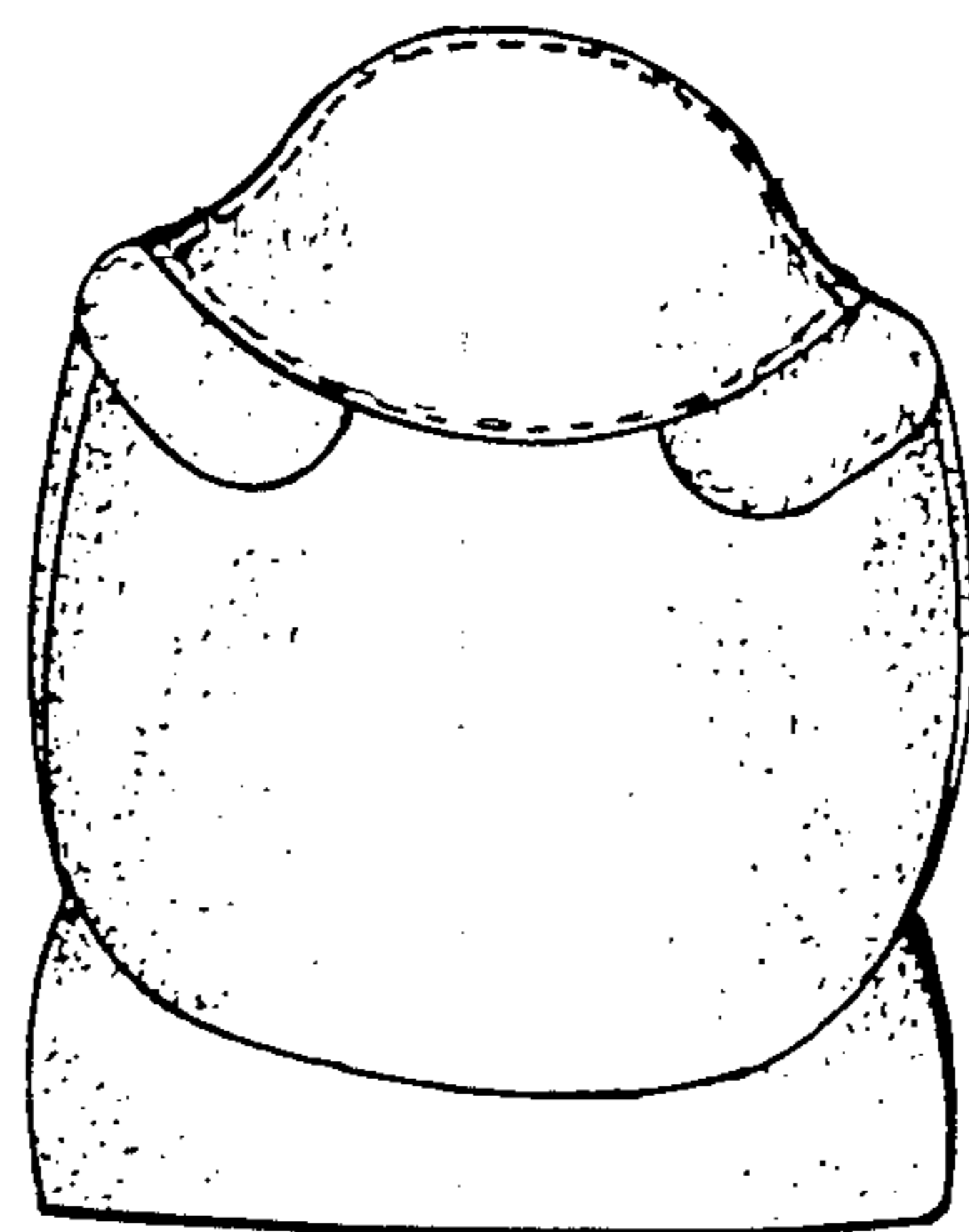
