DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a work stool showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

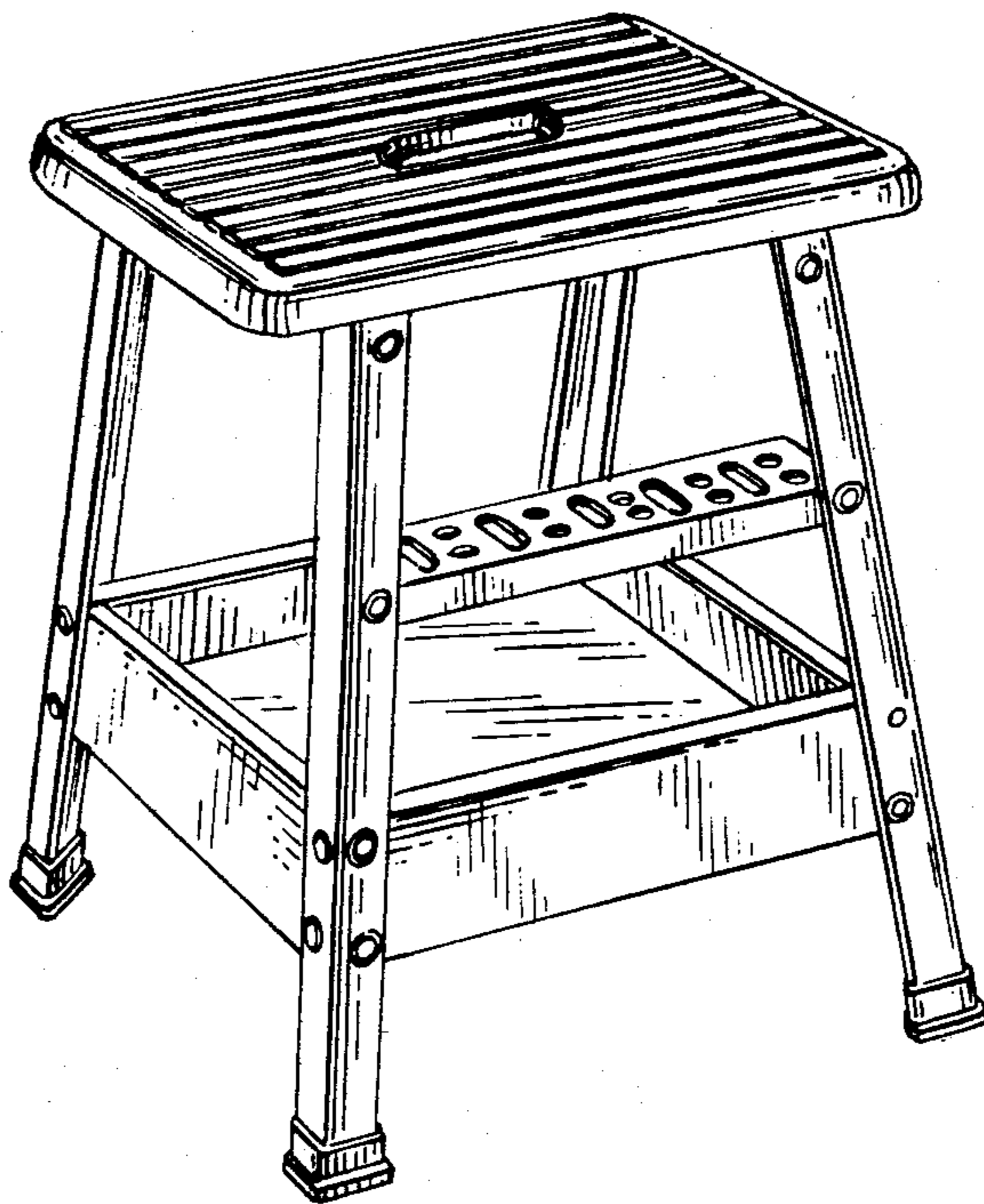

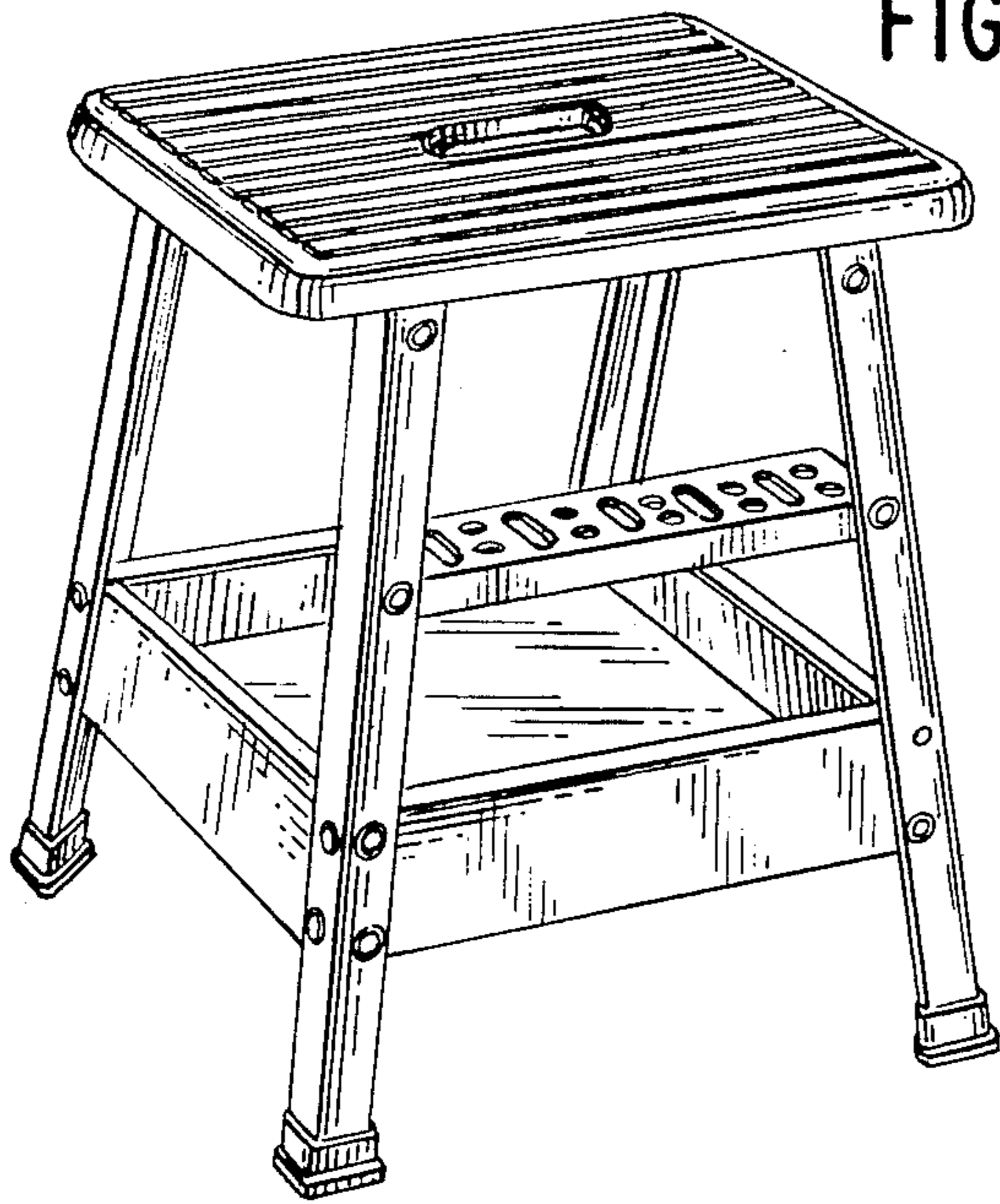

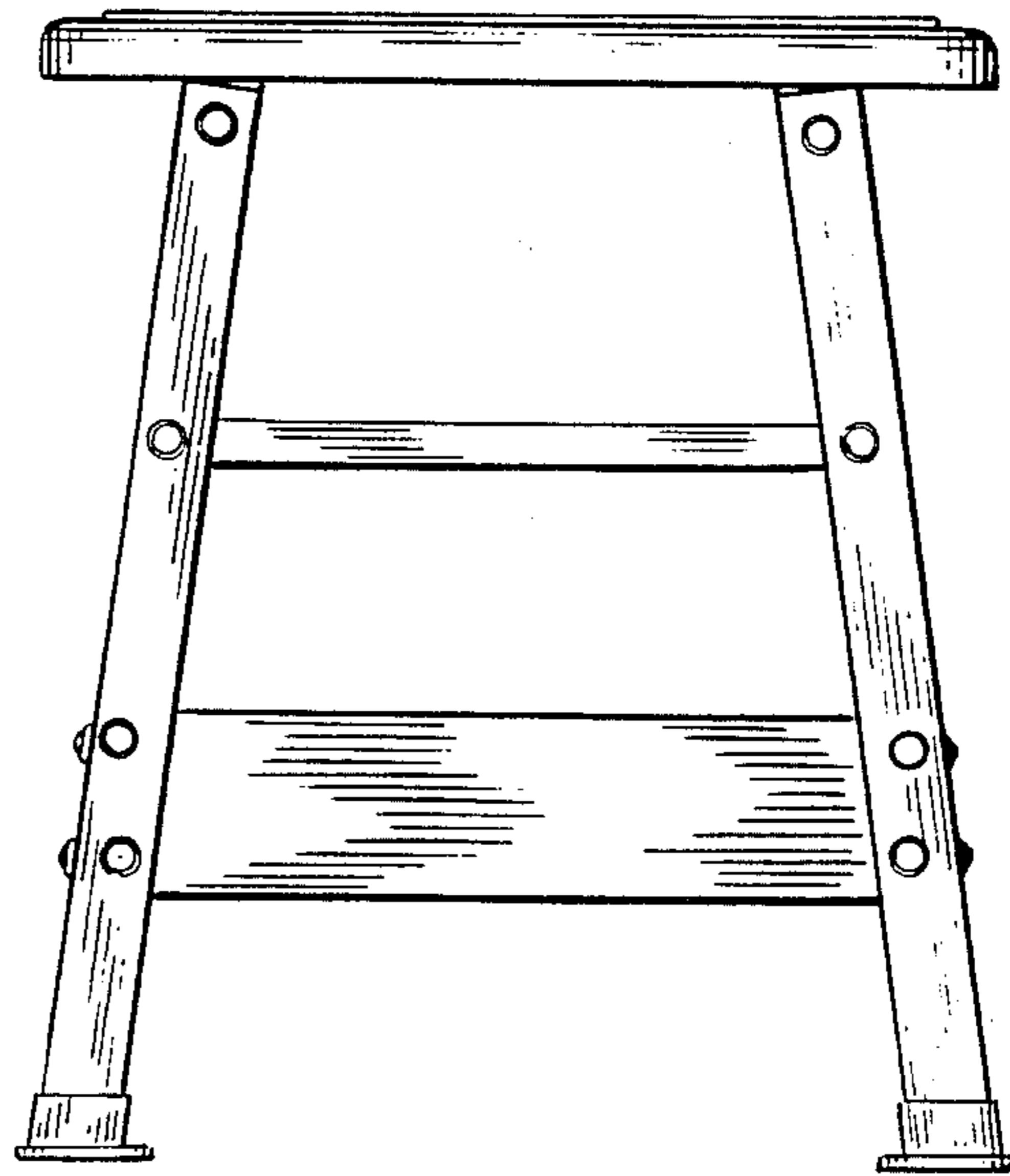

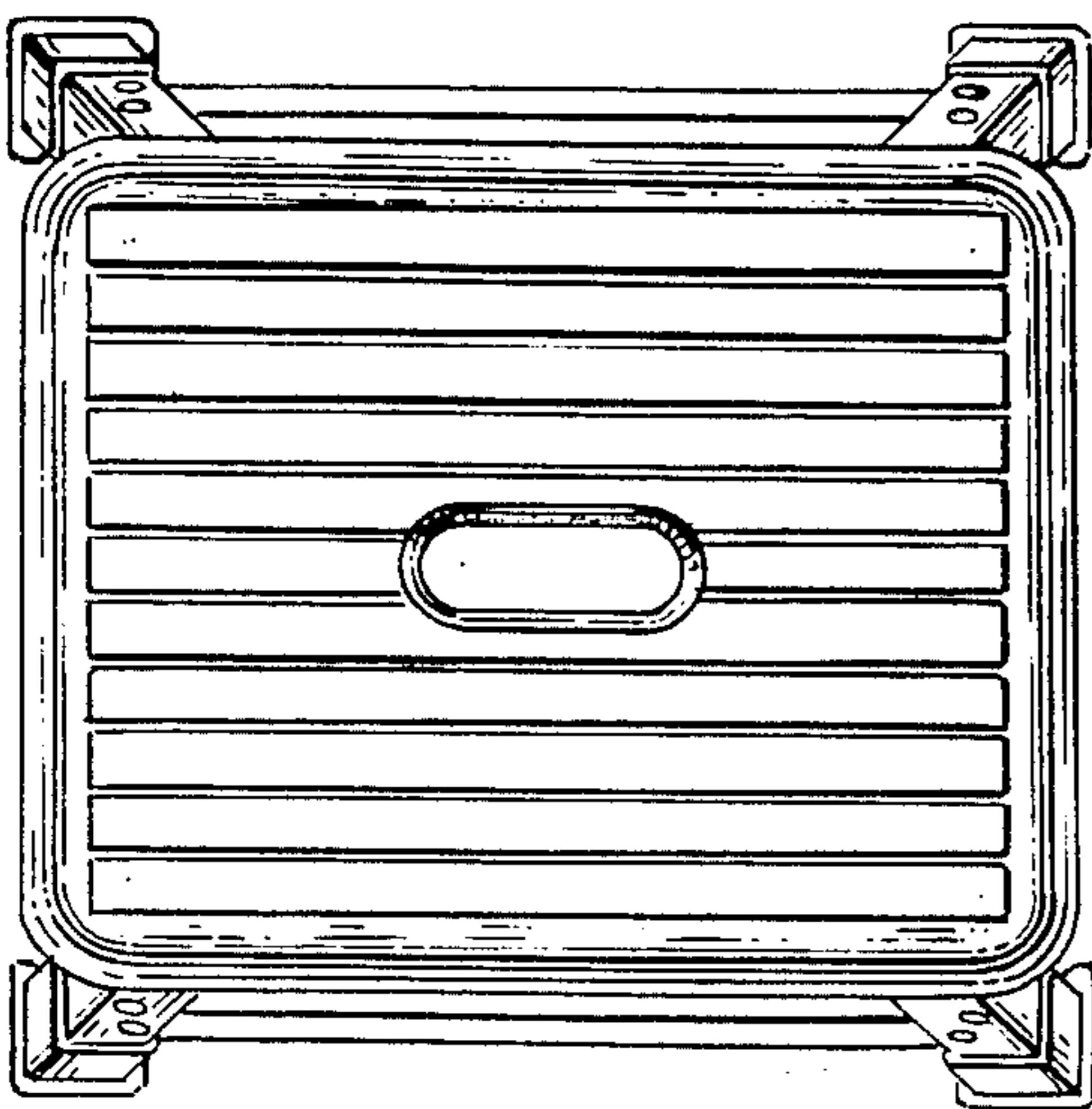

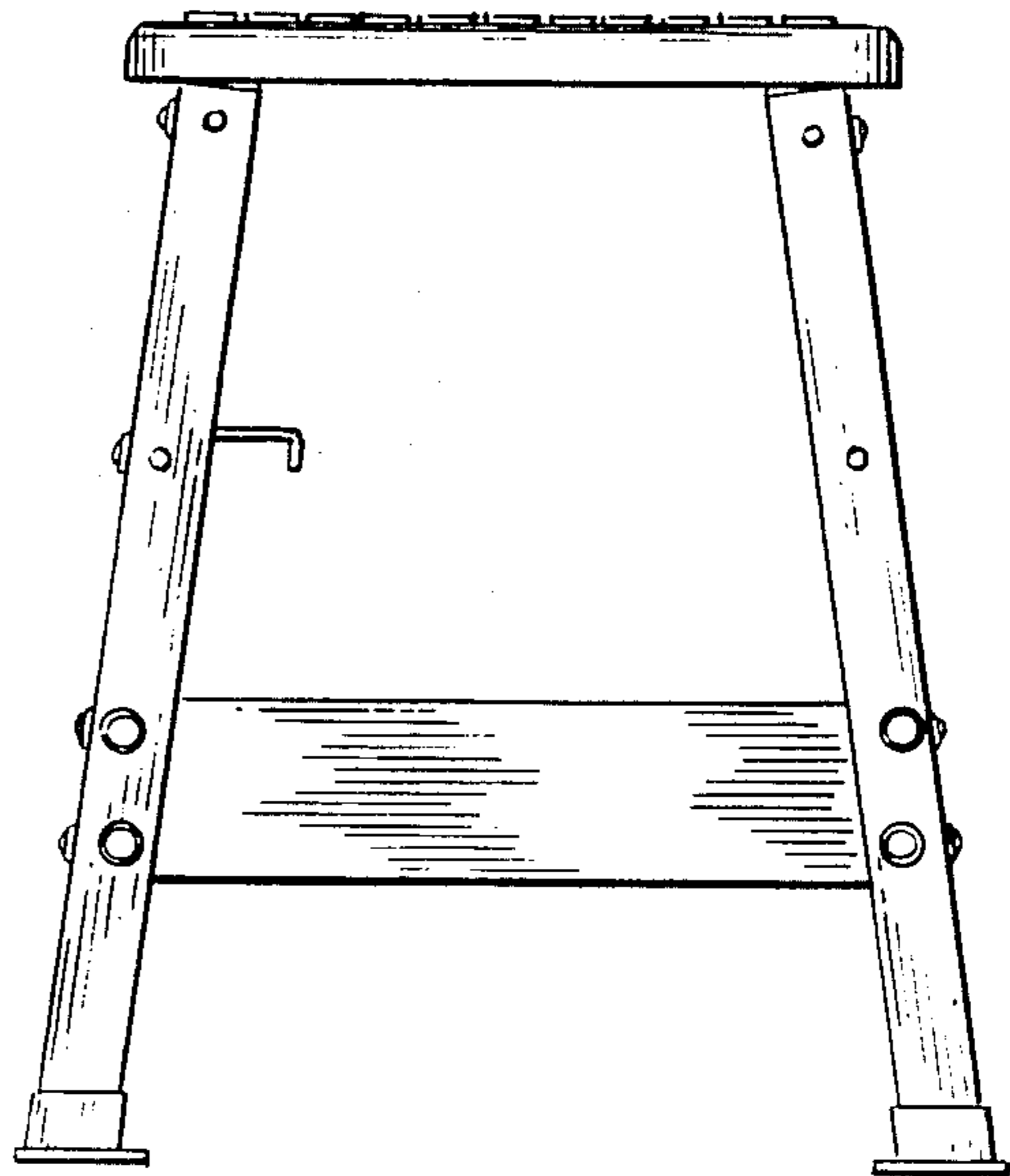
