[57] CLAIM

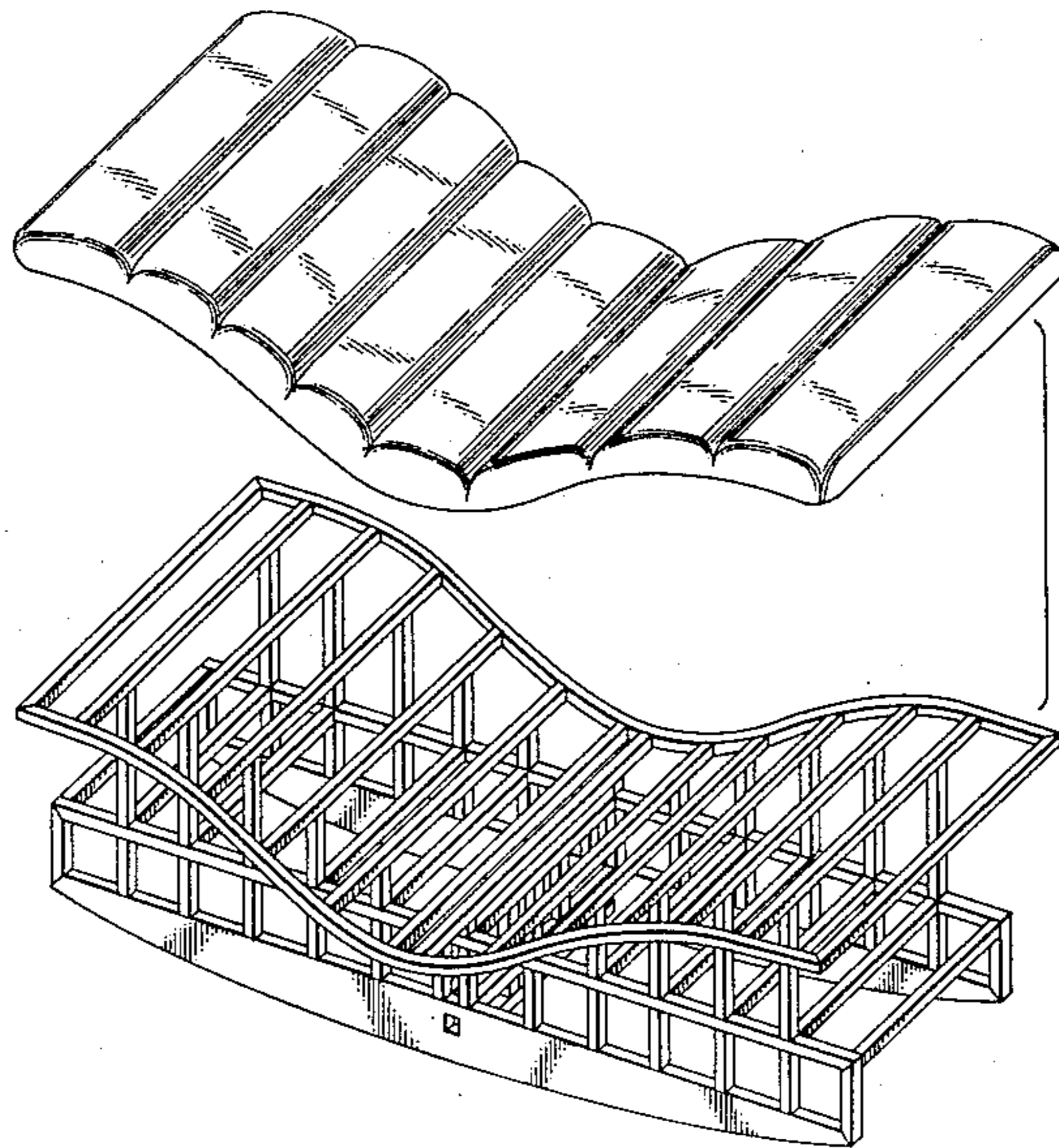
The ornamental design for a chaise longue, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a chaise longue showing my design in exploded condition in the interest of clarity of illustration.

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the chaise longue of FIG. 1, with the cushion shown in place.

The side of the chaise longue not shown is a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 2.



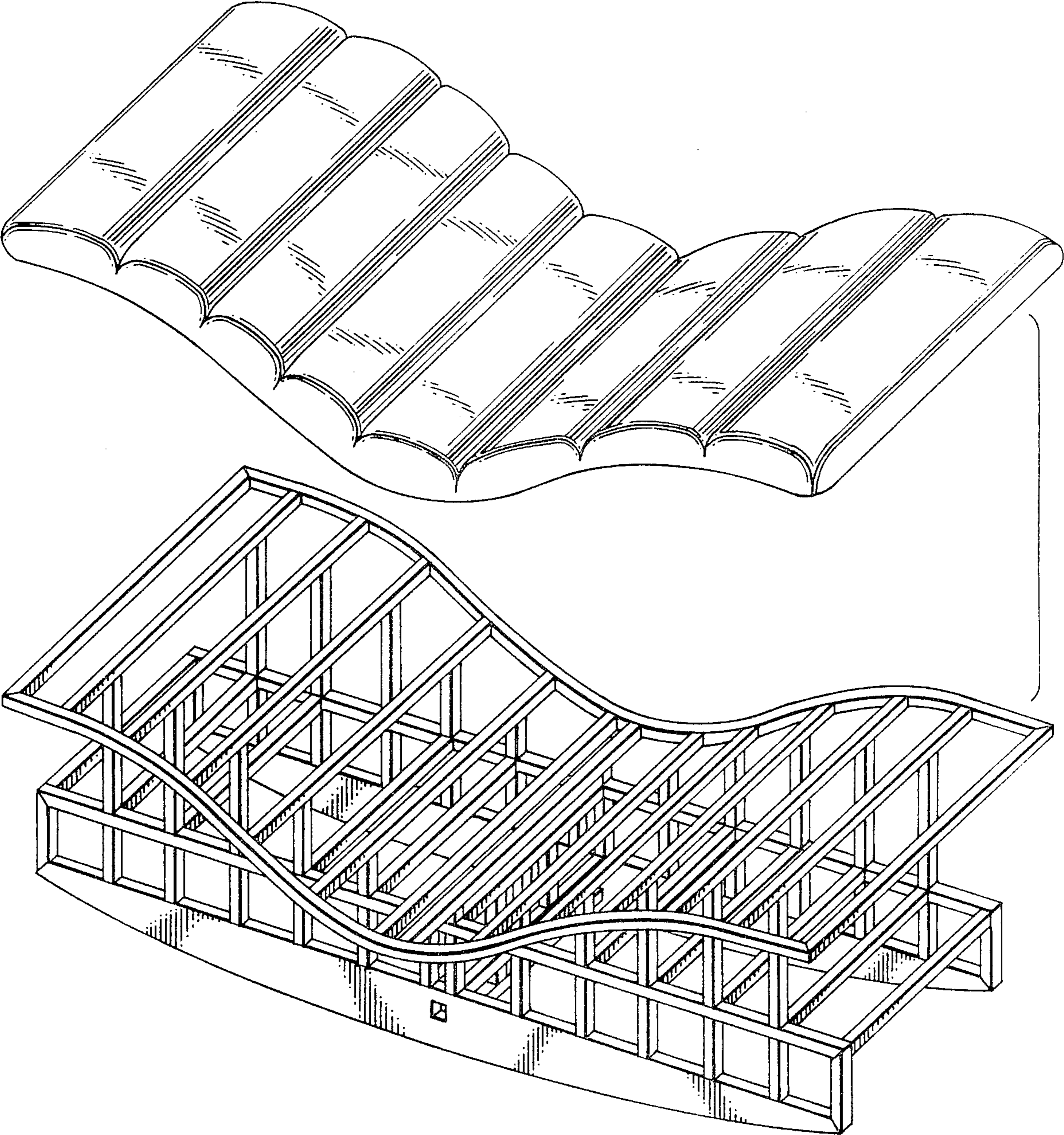

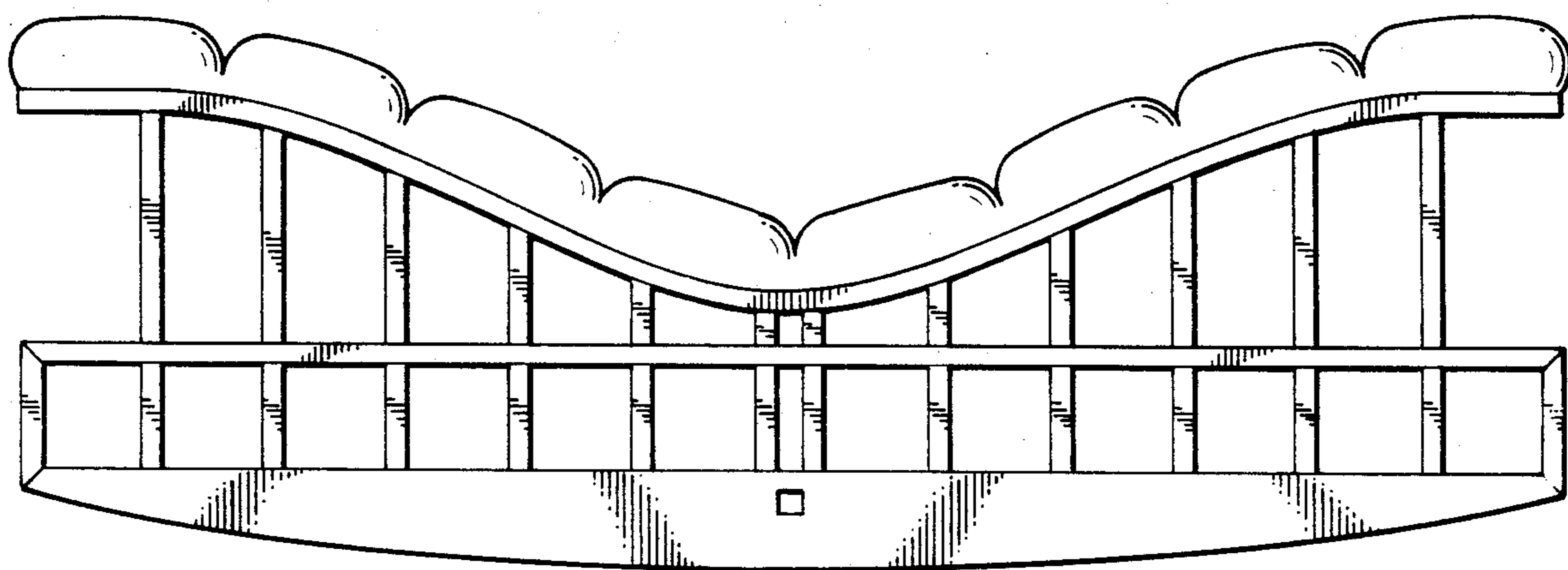
