DESCRIPTION

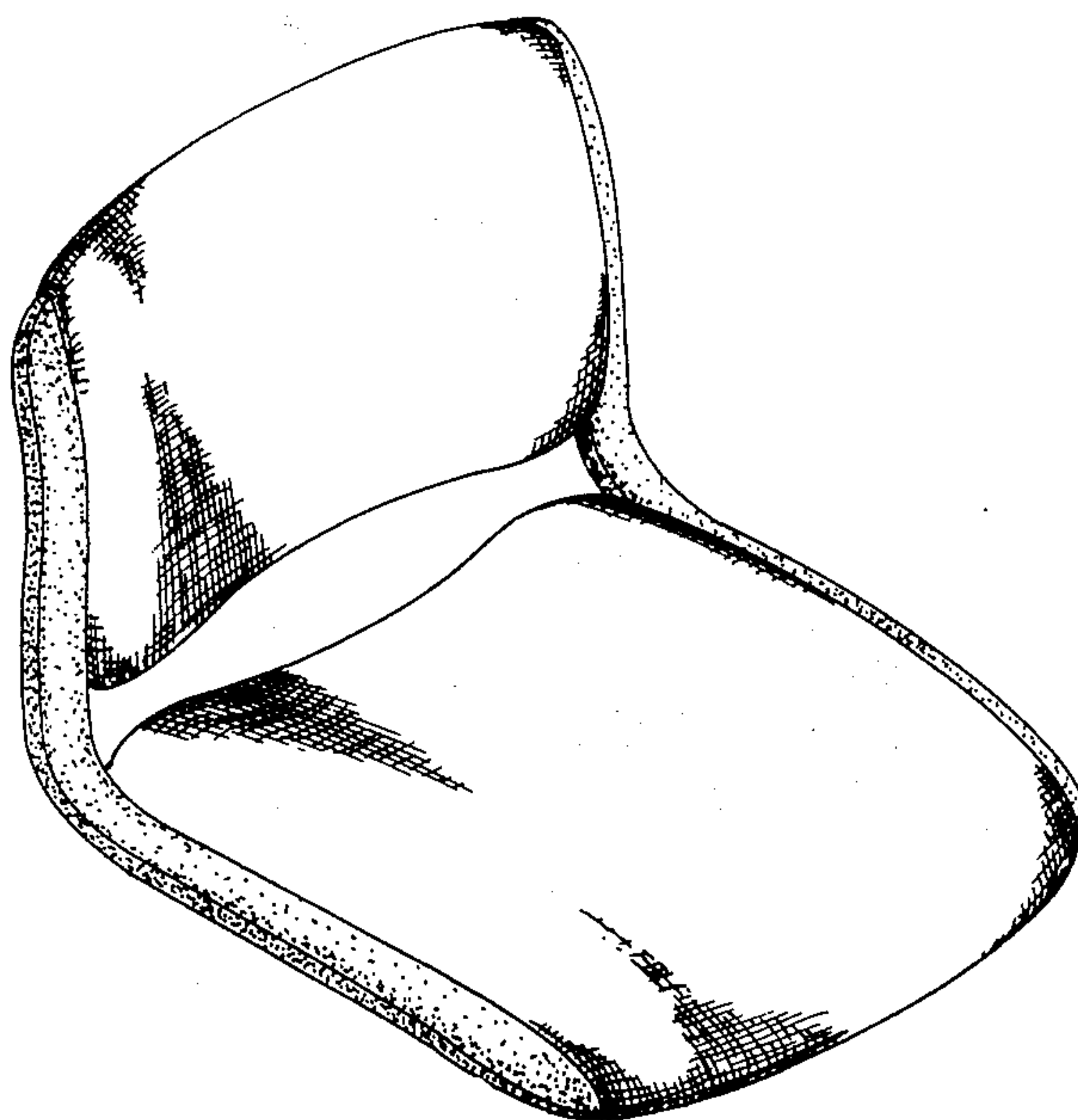
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined seat and backrest unit embodying my new design;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view thereof.



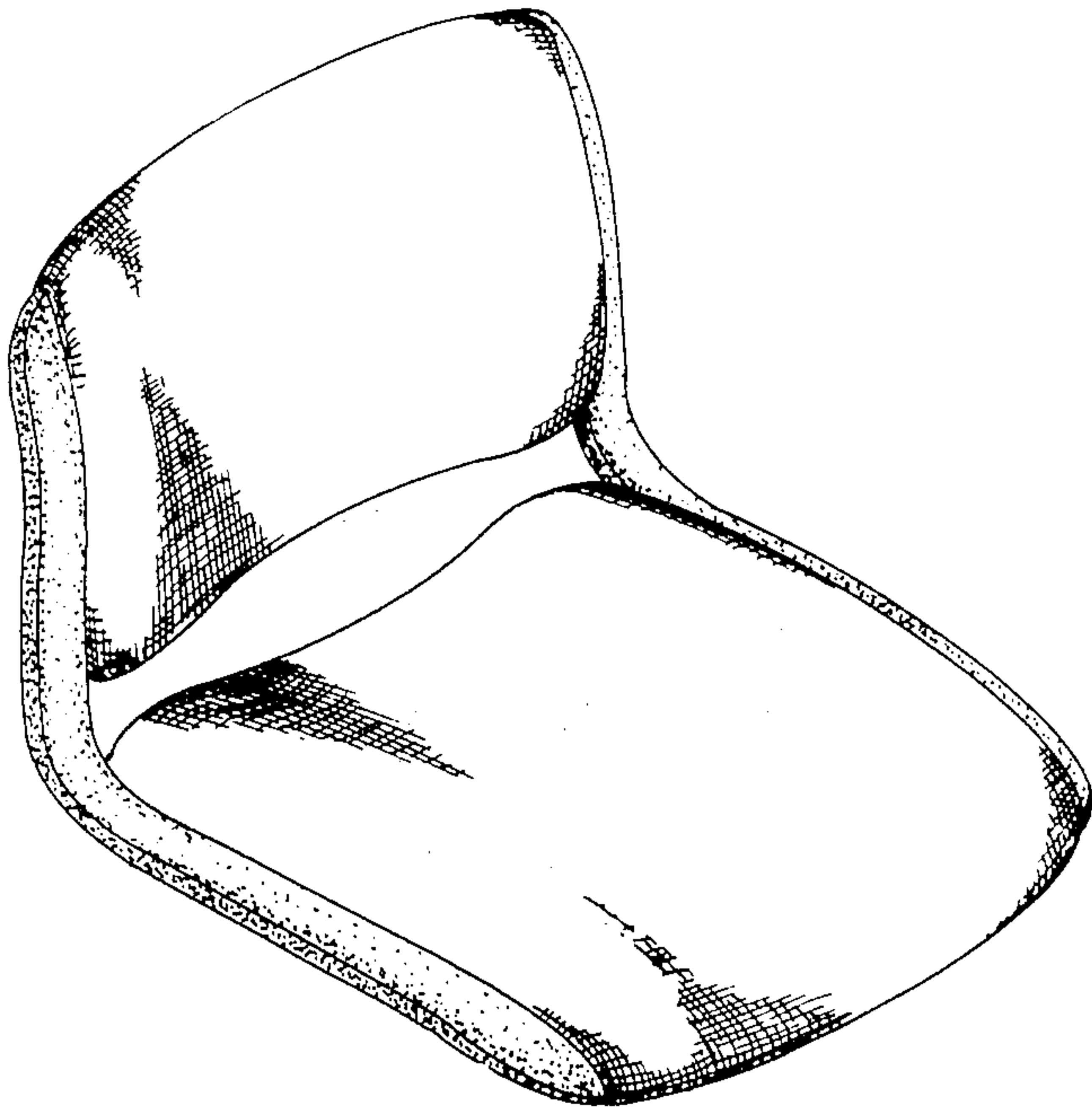

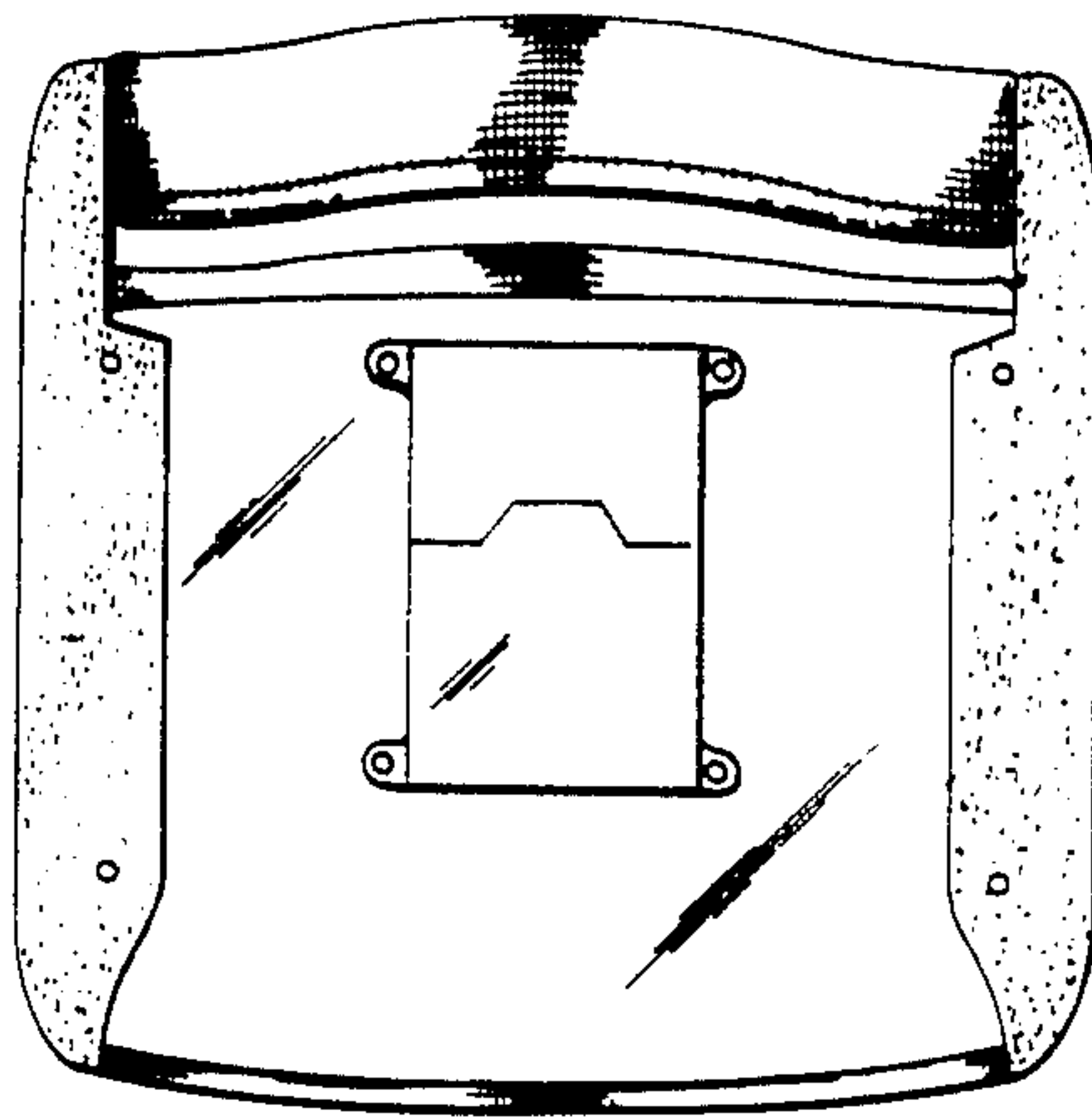

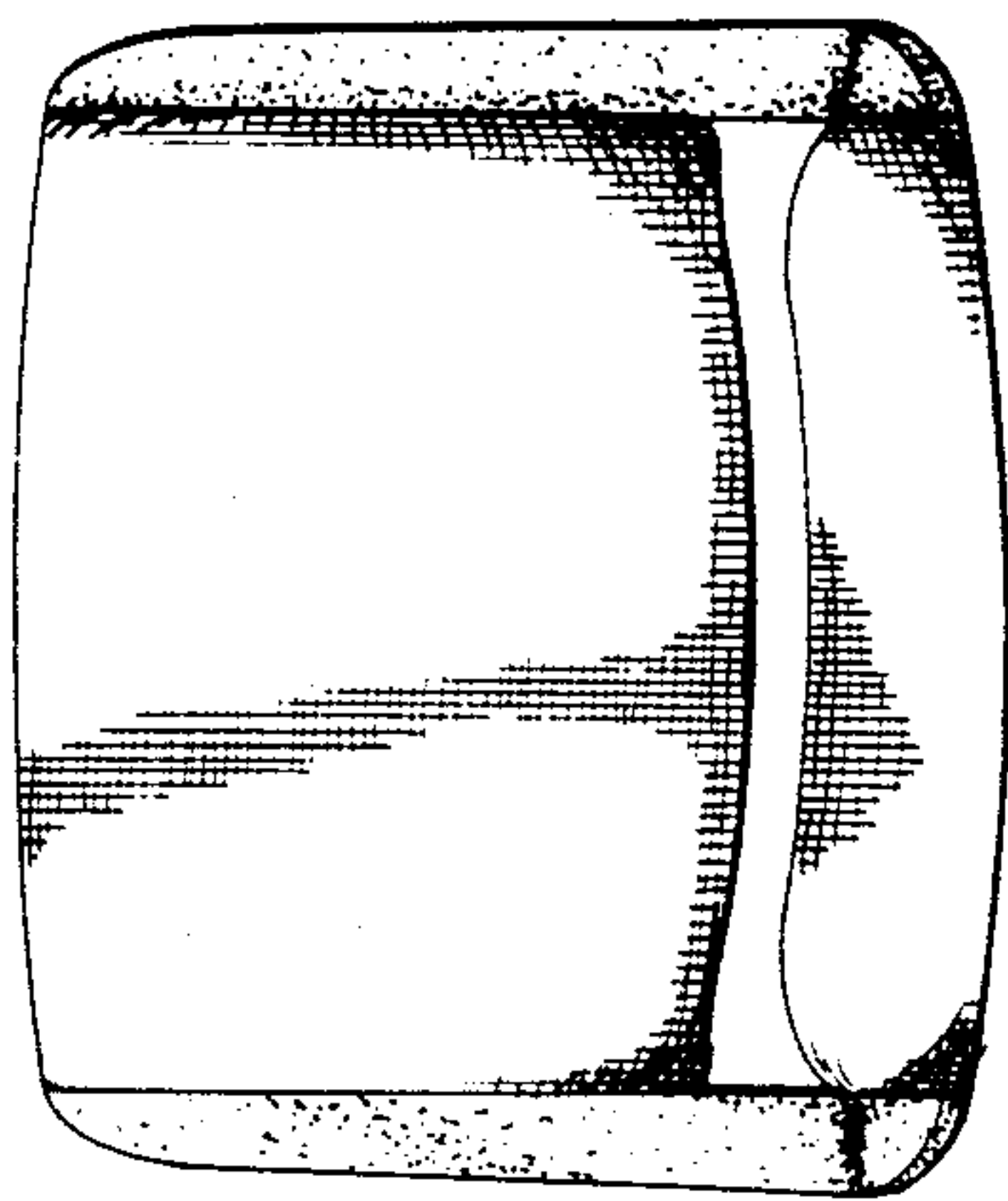

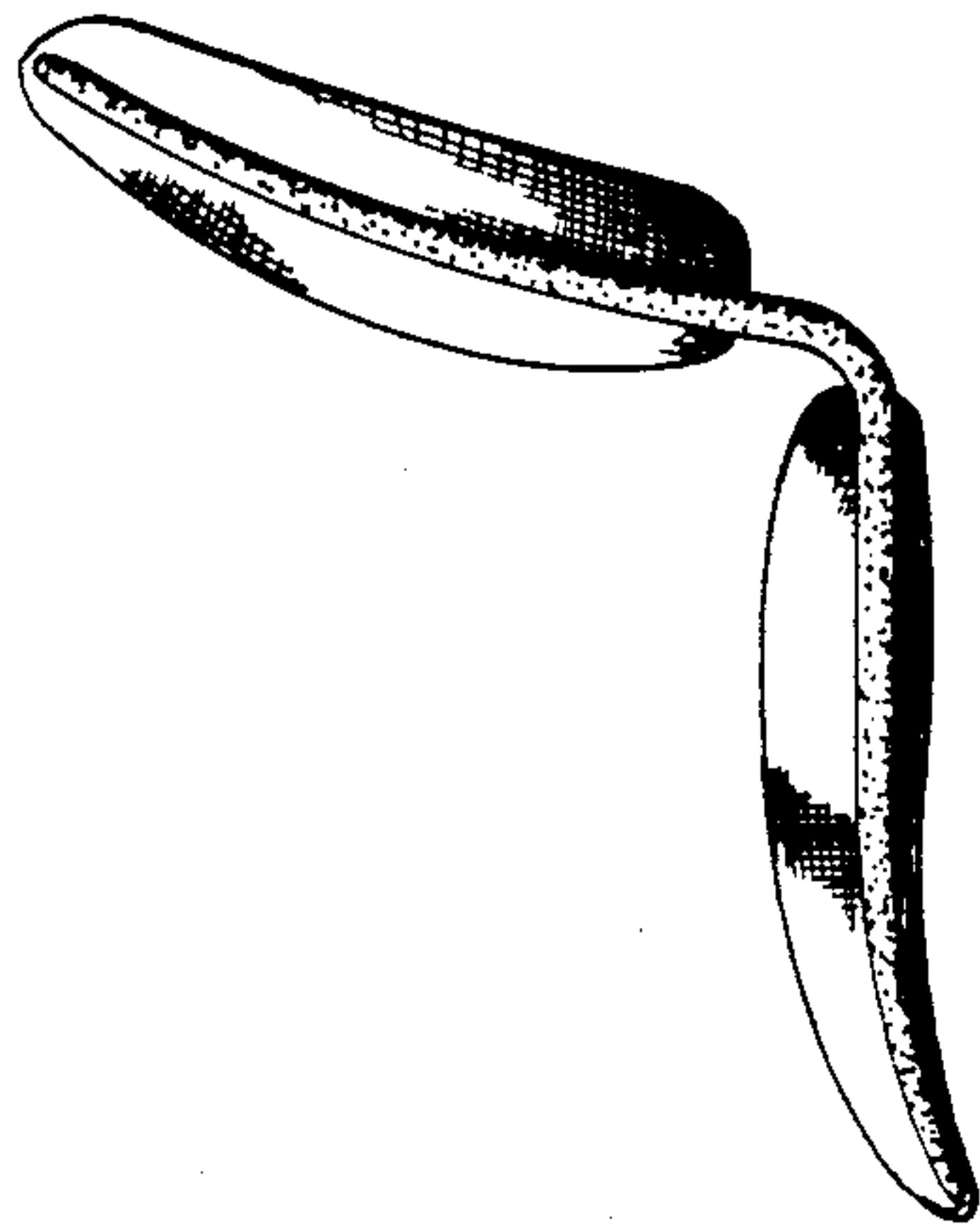

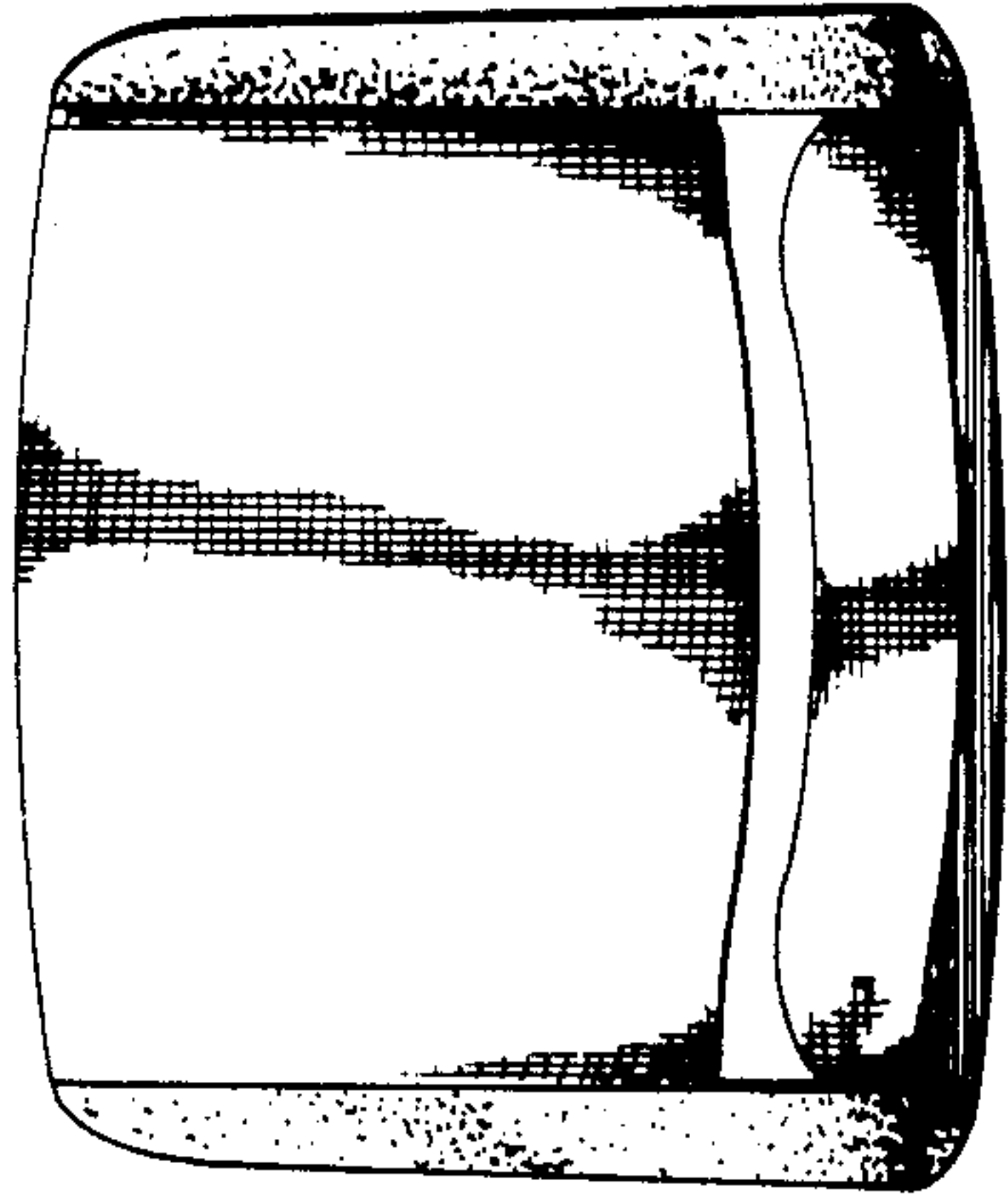
