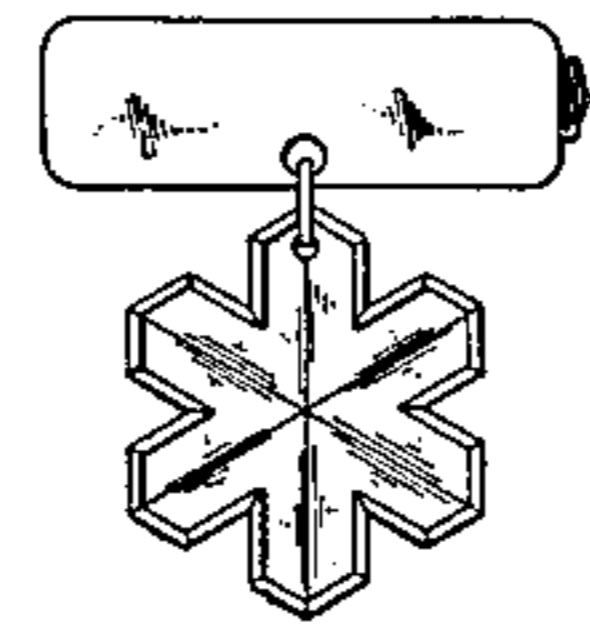
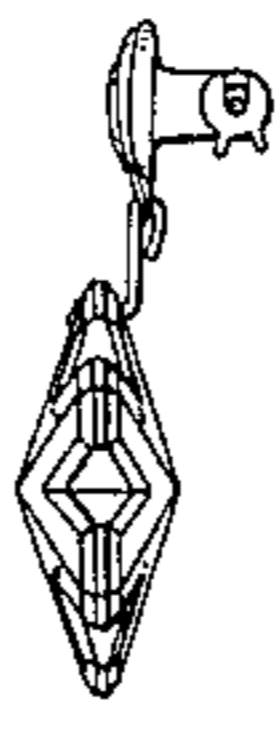
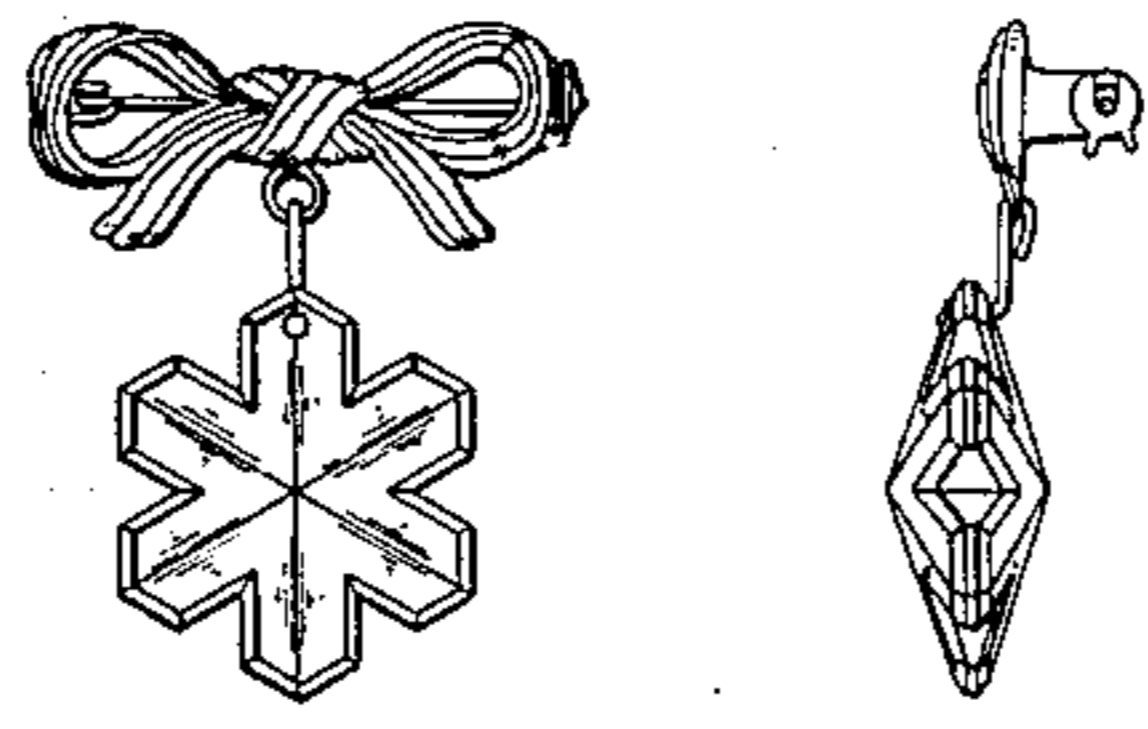

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a snowflake pin, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a snowflake pin showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of a snowflake pin showing a modified form of my new design;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



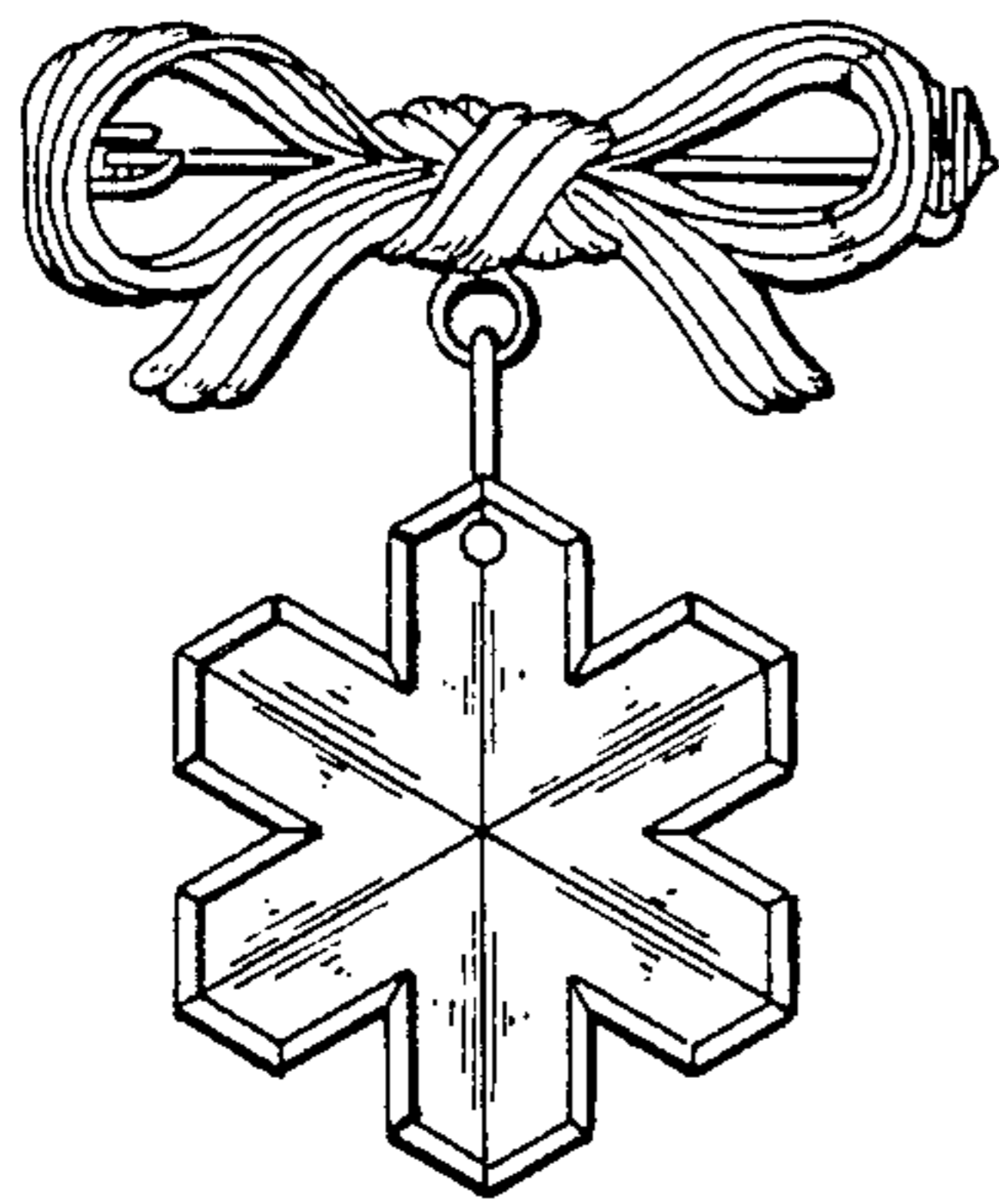

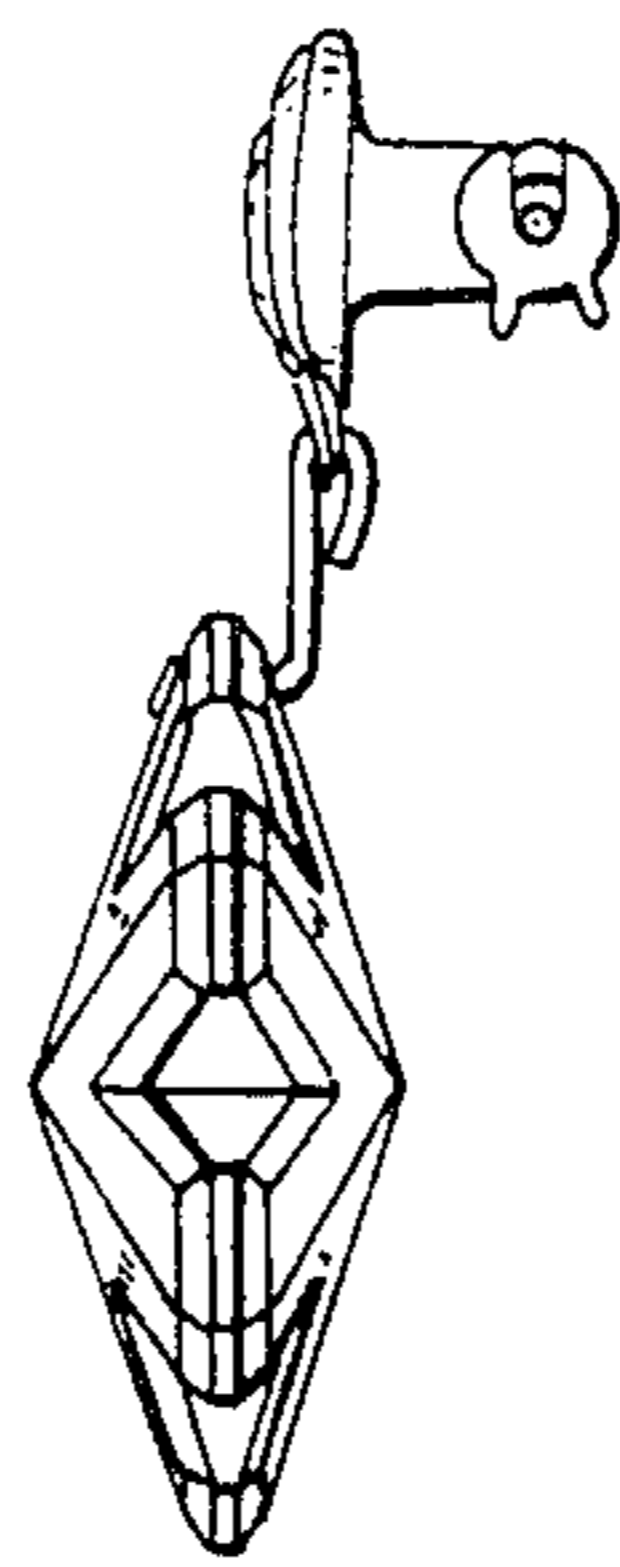

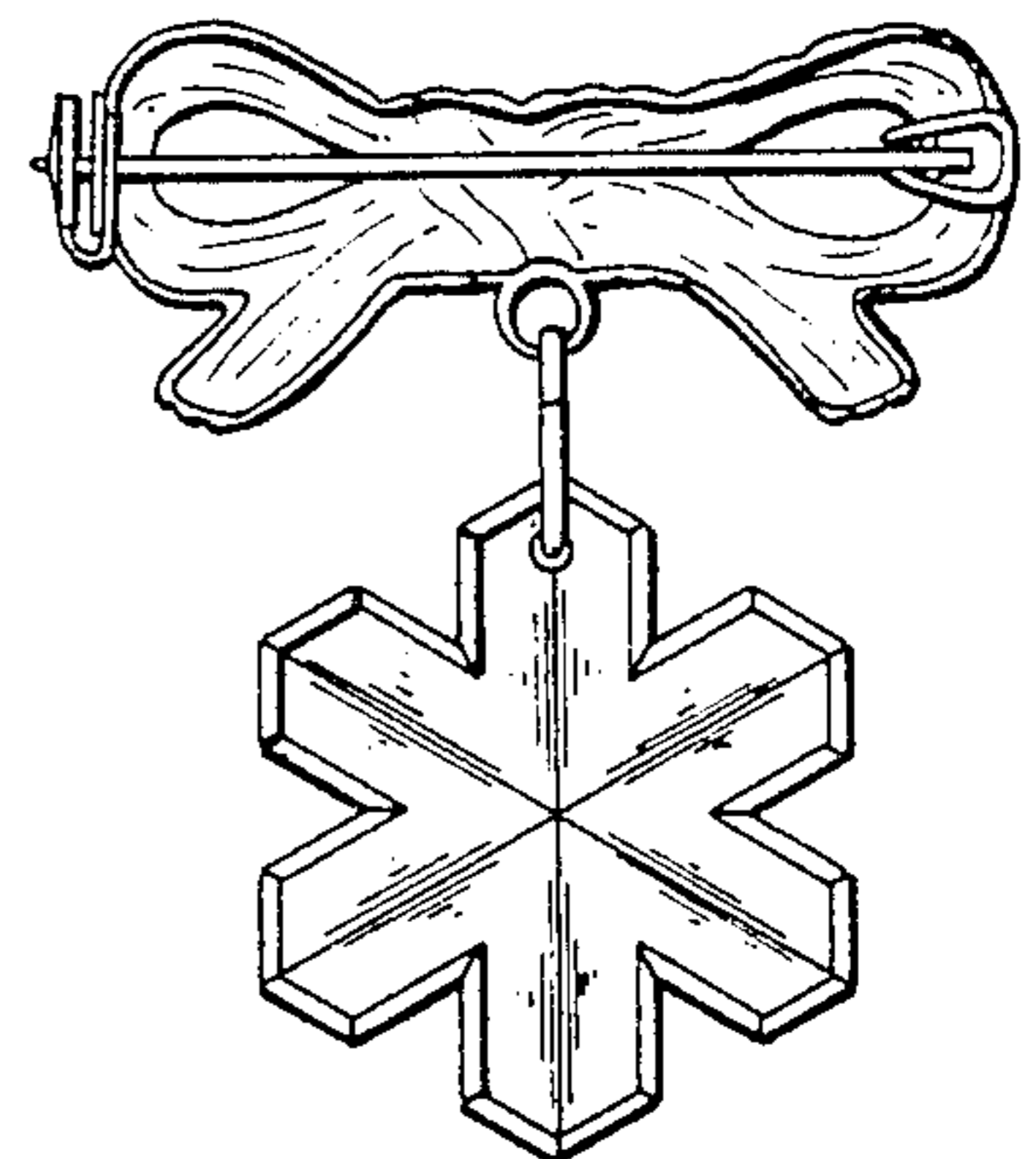

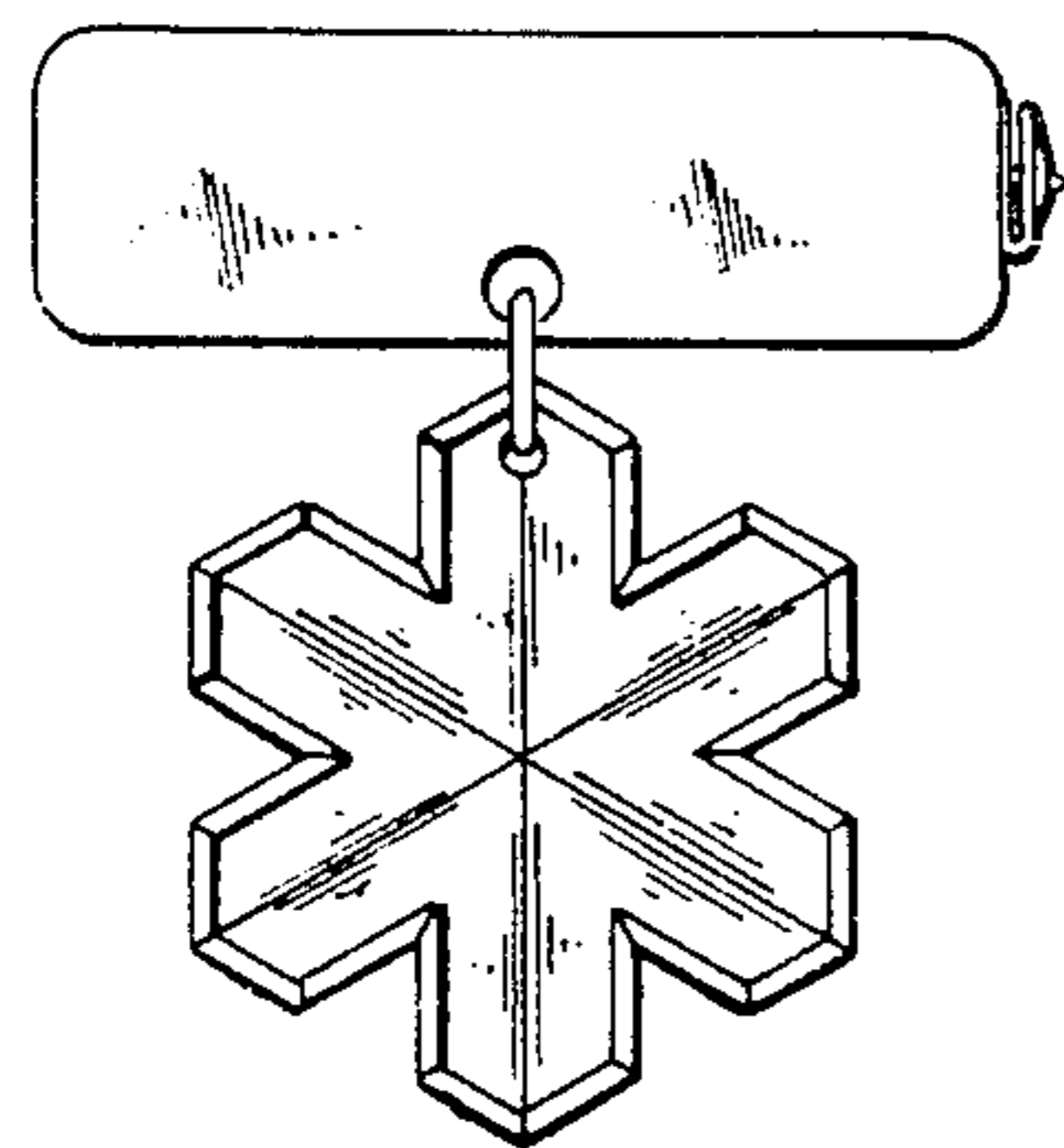

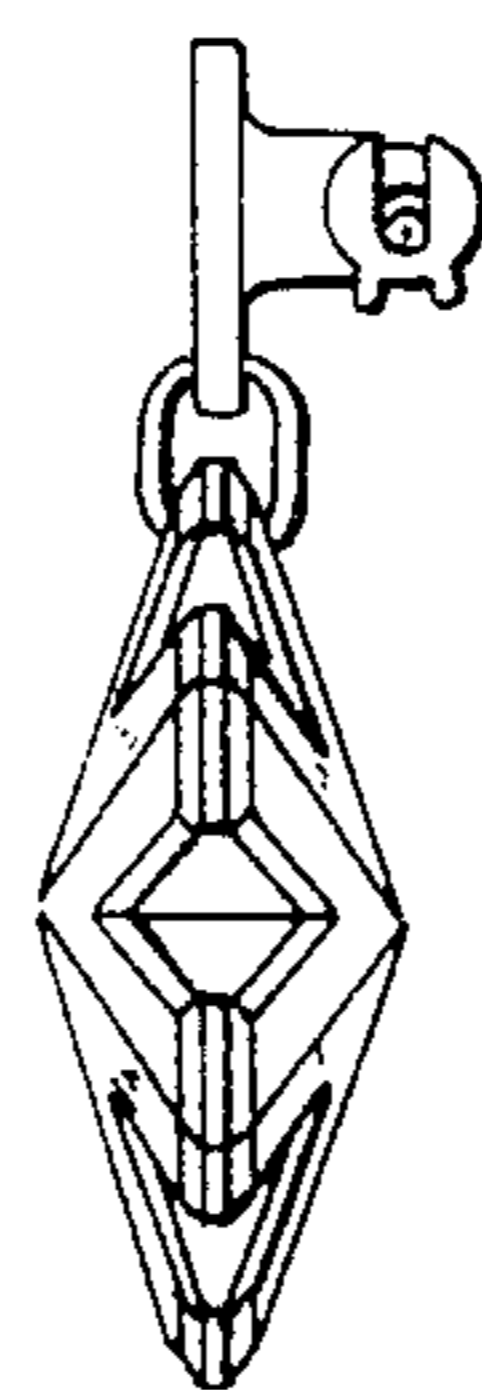

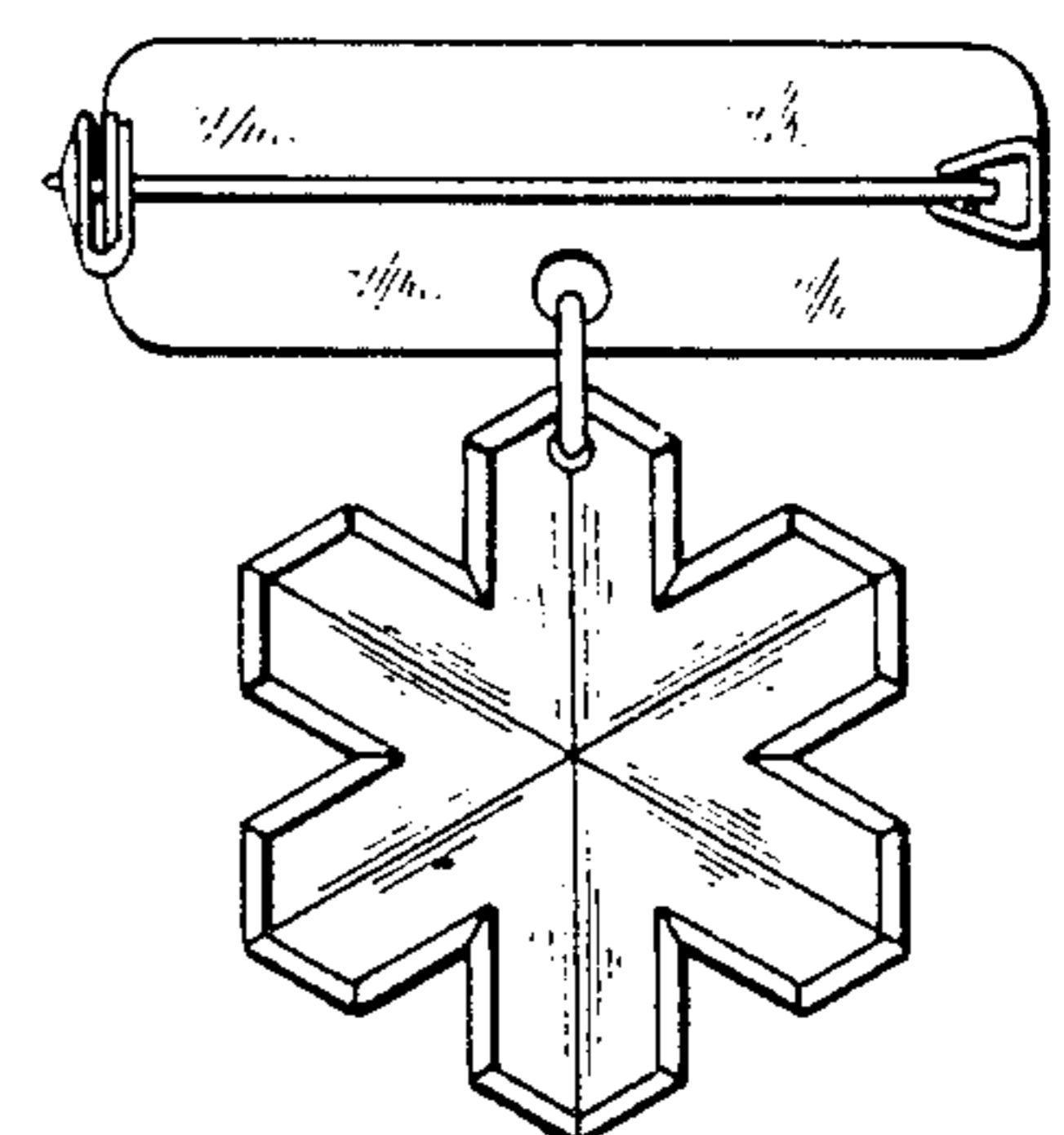
