The ornamental design for a vehicular two-way radio or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

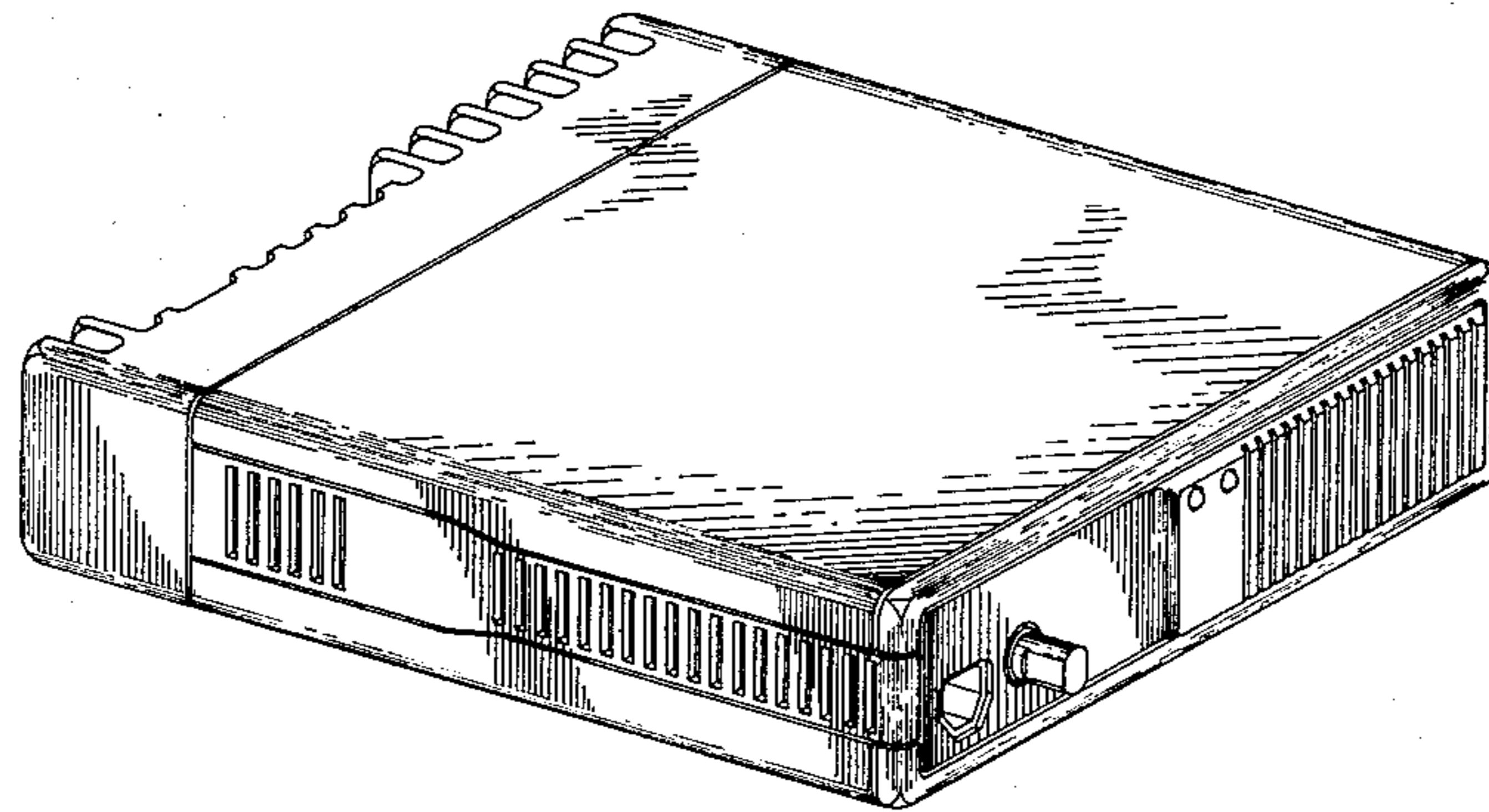
DESCRIPTION

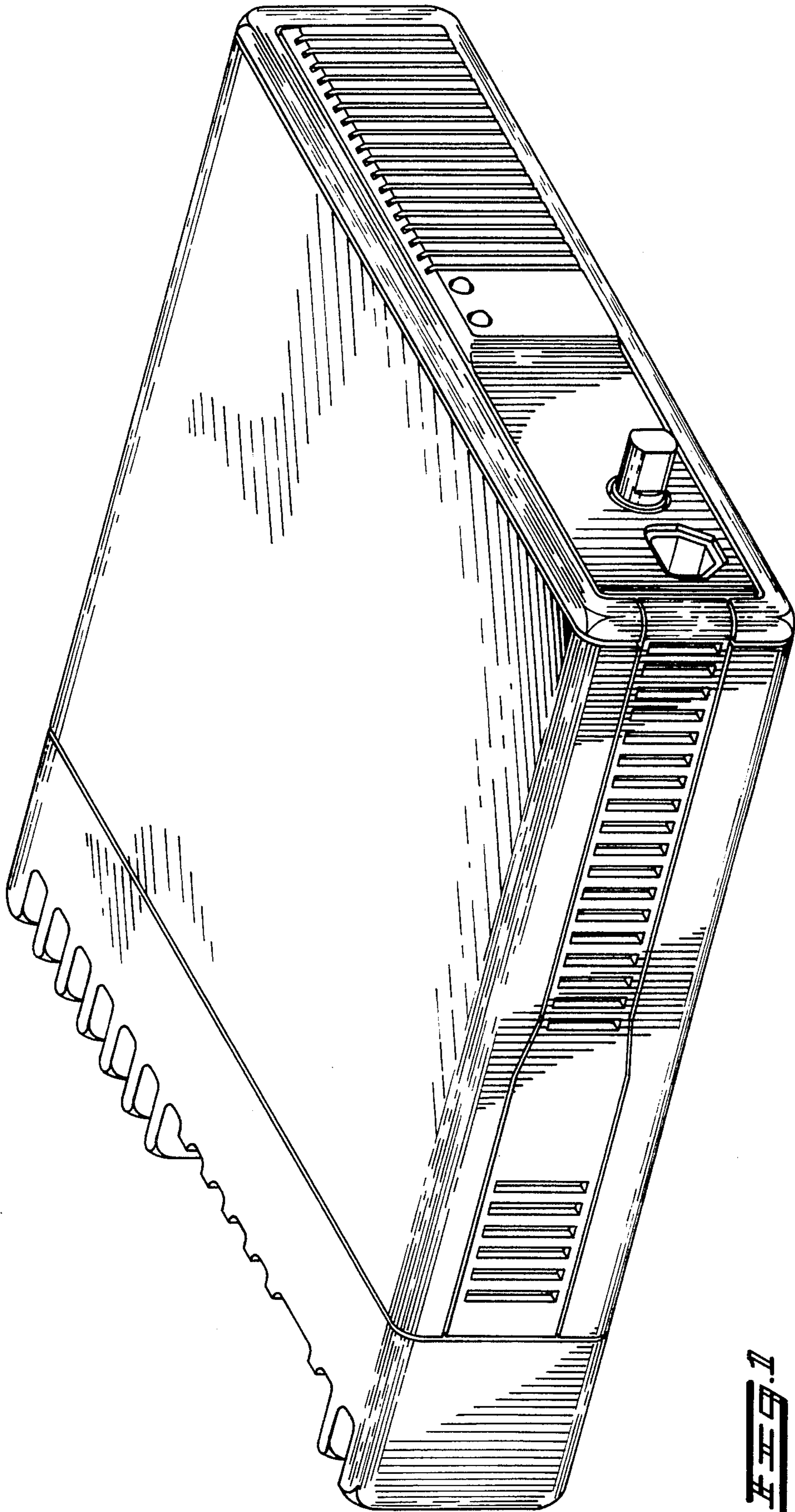
FIG. 1 is a front, top and left side isometric view of a vehicular two-way radio or similar article showing my new design;

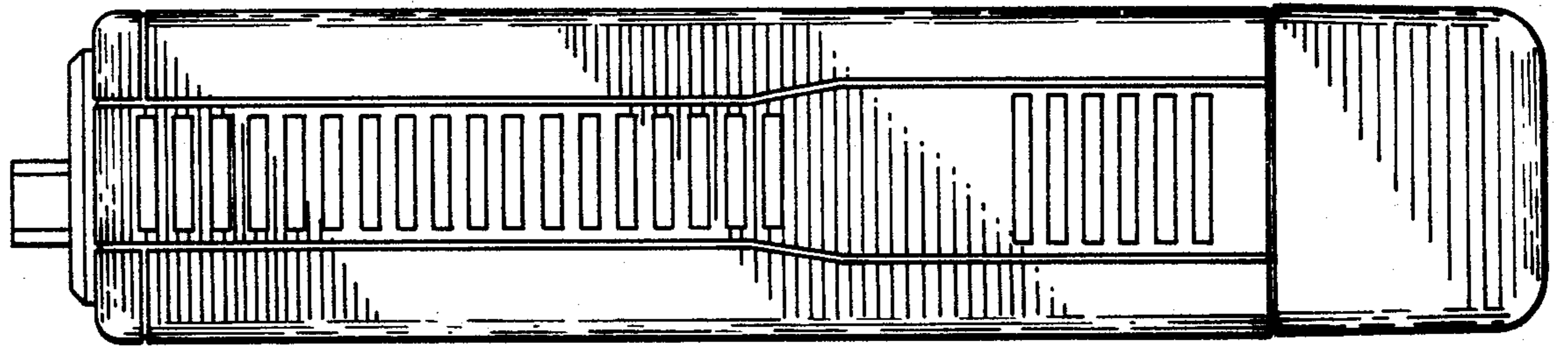

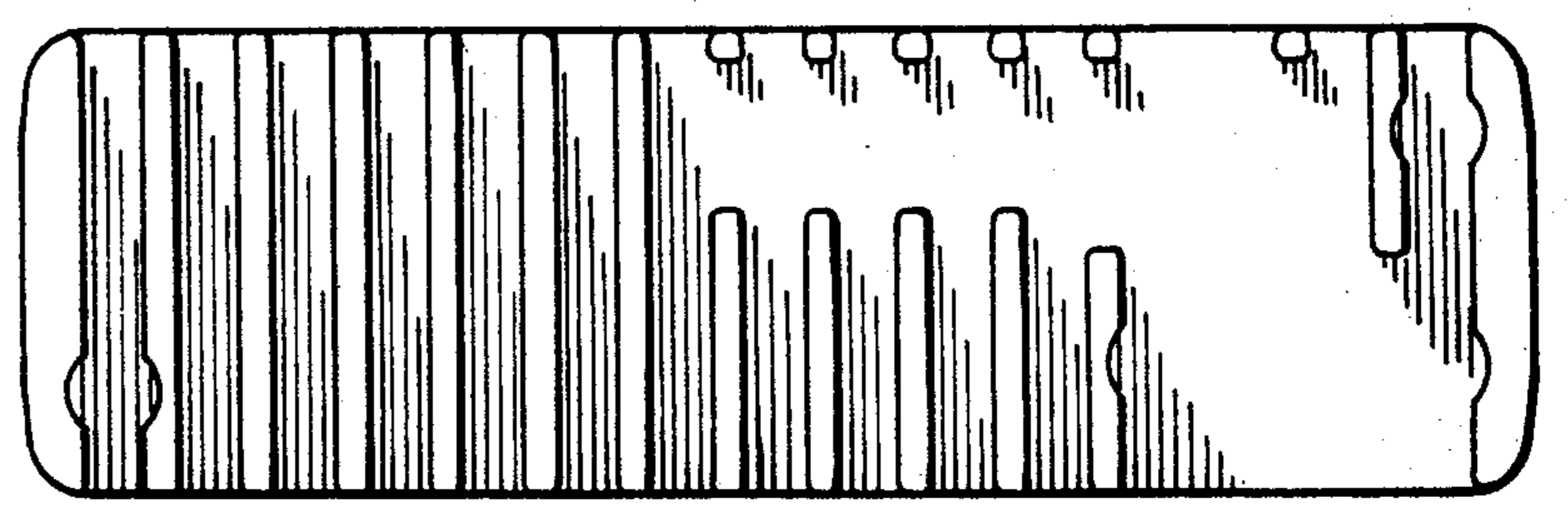

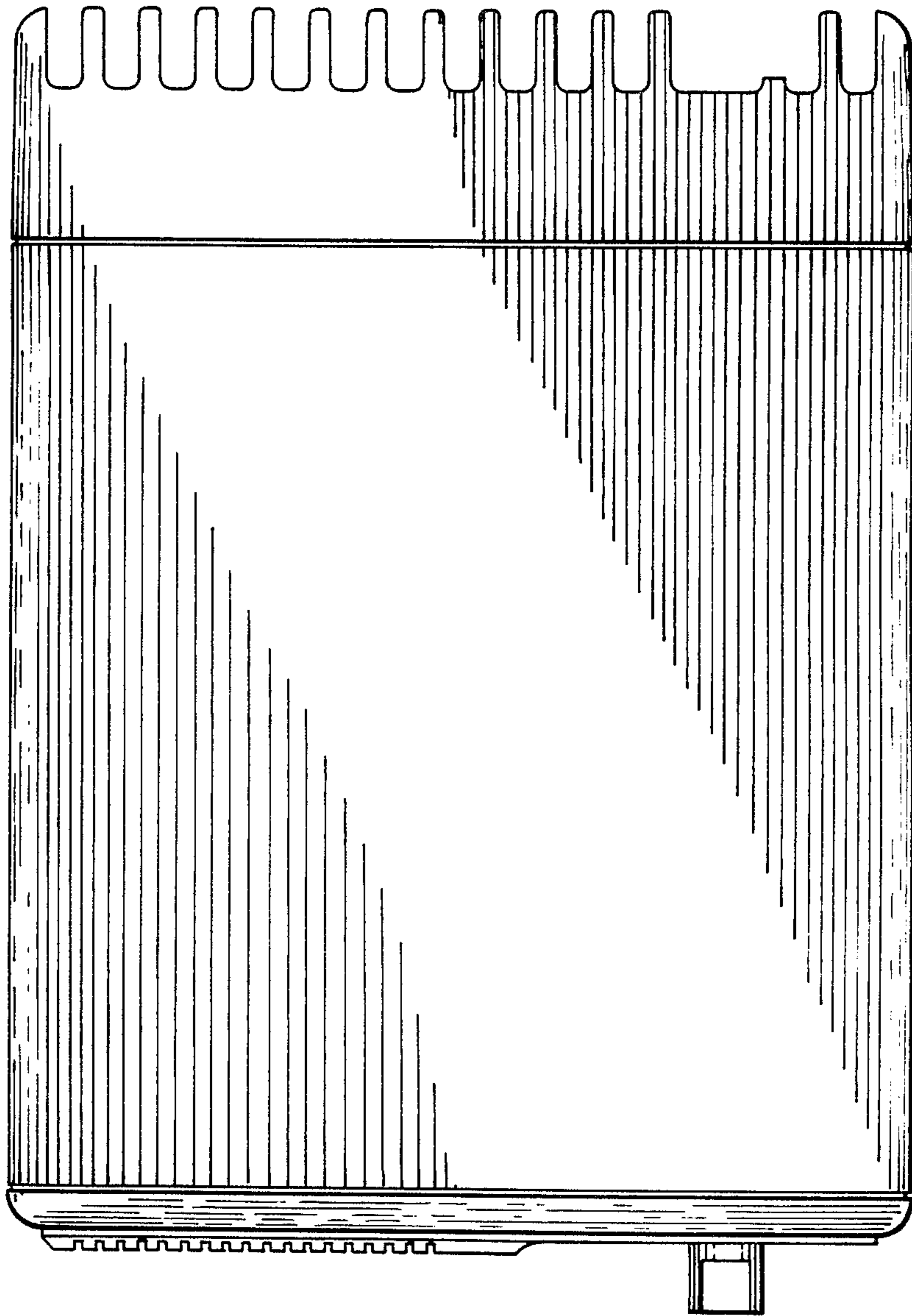
