DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a toy kitchen cart showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the opposite side shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a left end elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a side elevational view of the side opposite that shown in FIG. 5; and,
 FIG. 8 is a right end elevational view thereof.
