The ornamental design for a watering can, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a watering can embodying my new design.
FIG. 2 is a front elevation thereof.
FIG. 3 is a rear elevation thereof.
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof.
FIG. 5 is a left side elevation thereof, the right side being a mirror image of the left side shown.
The bottom of the watering can is plain and unornamented.

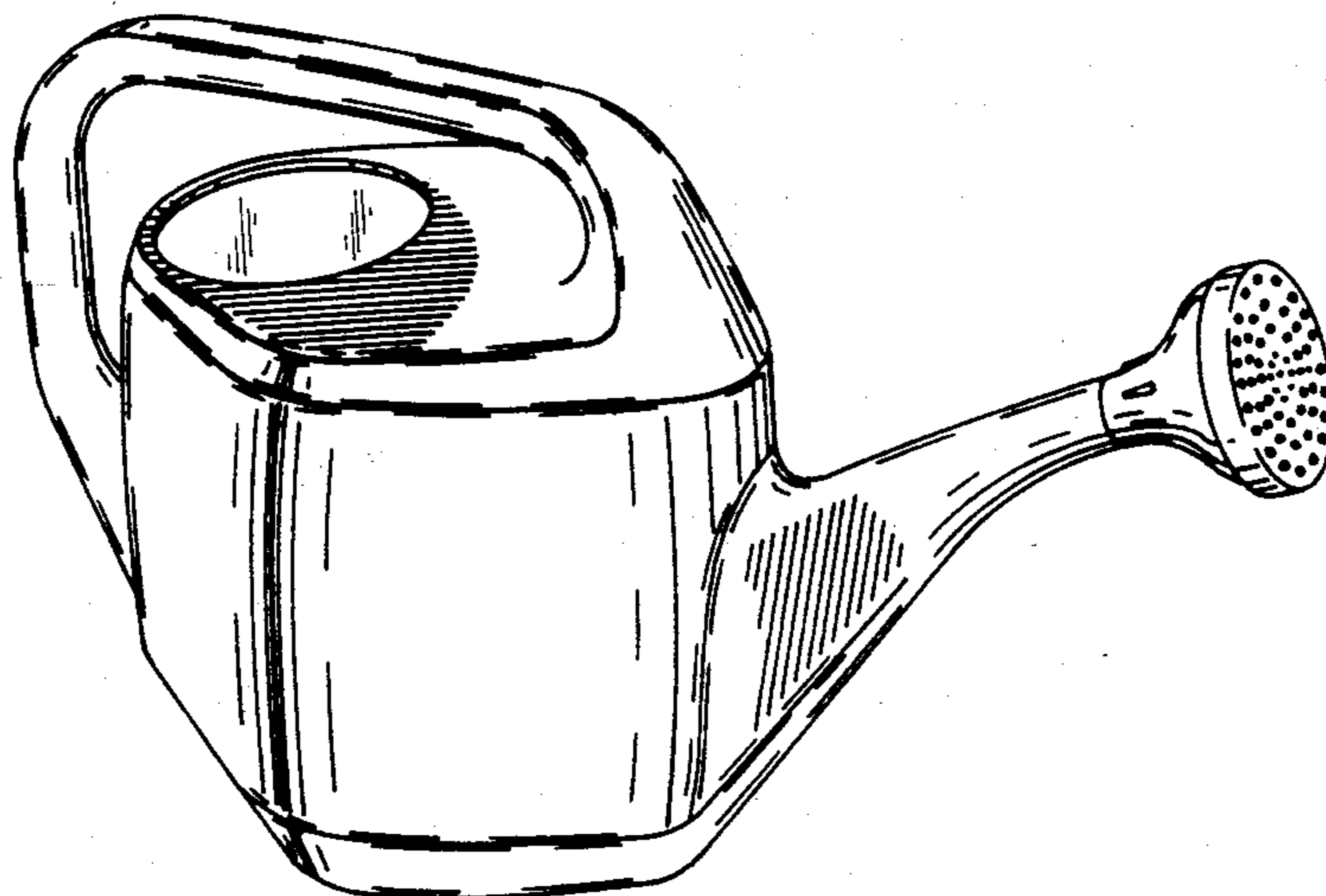

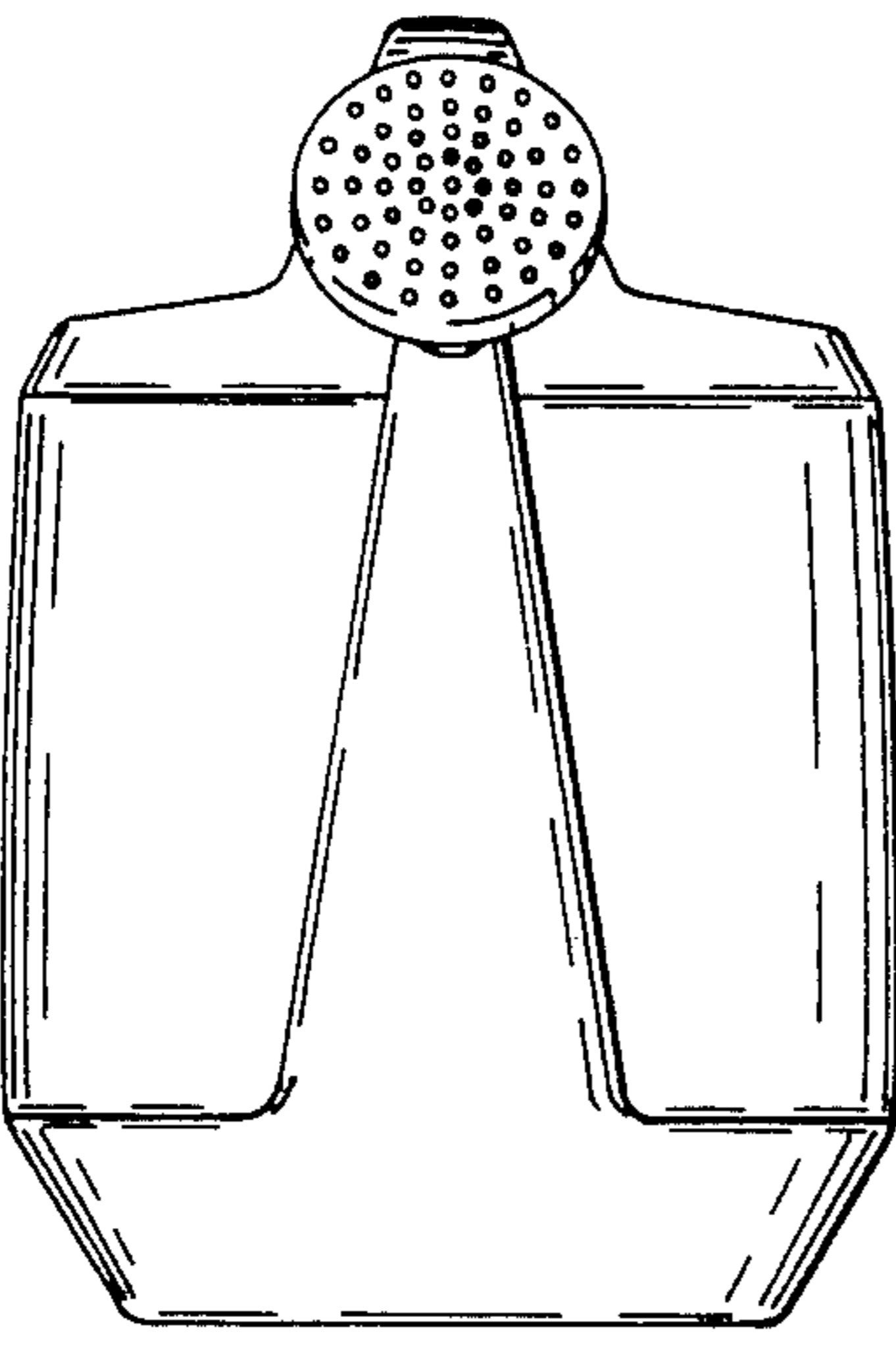
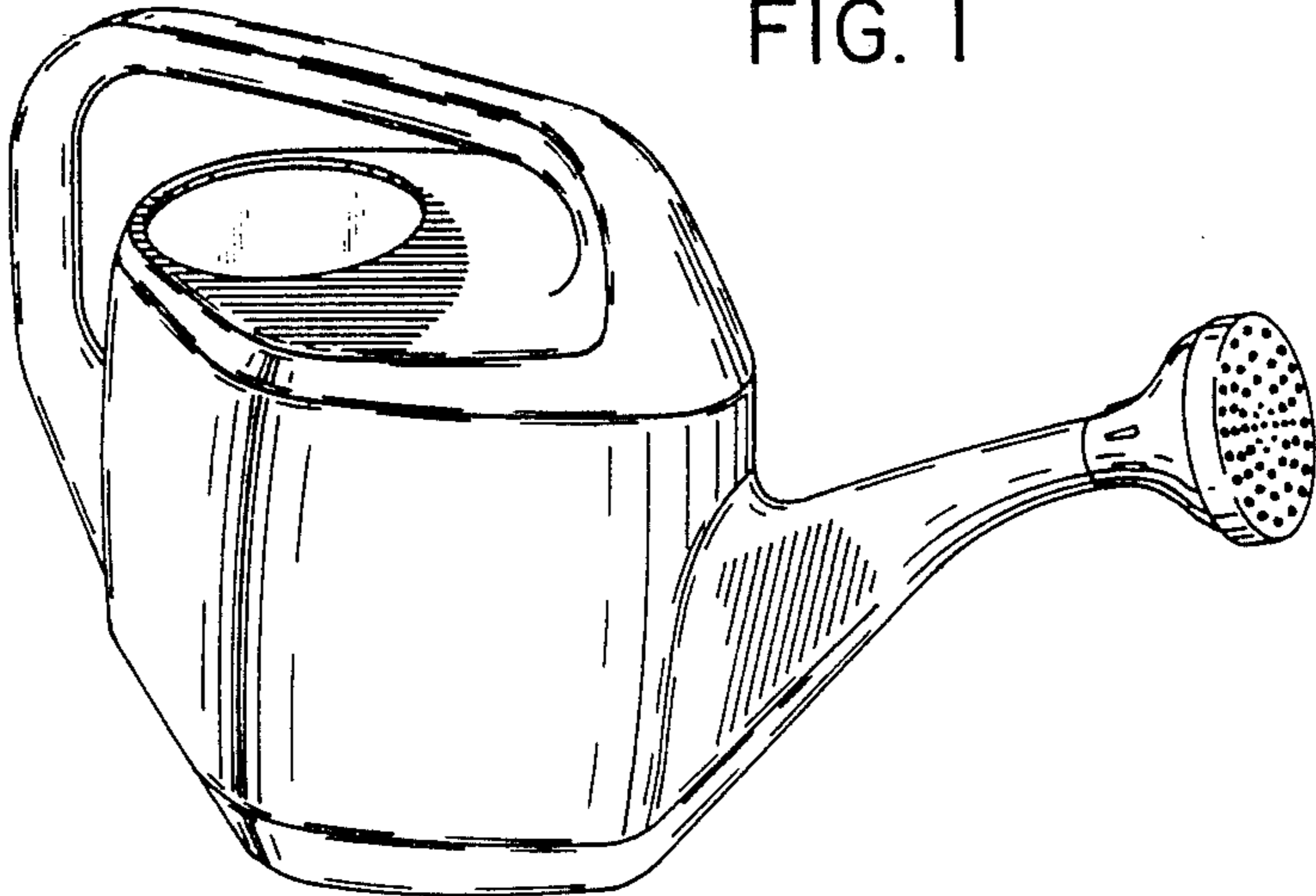

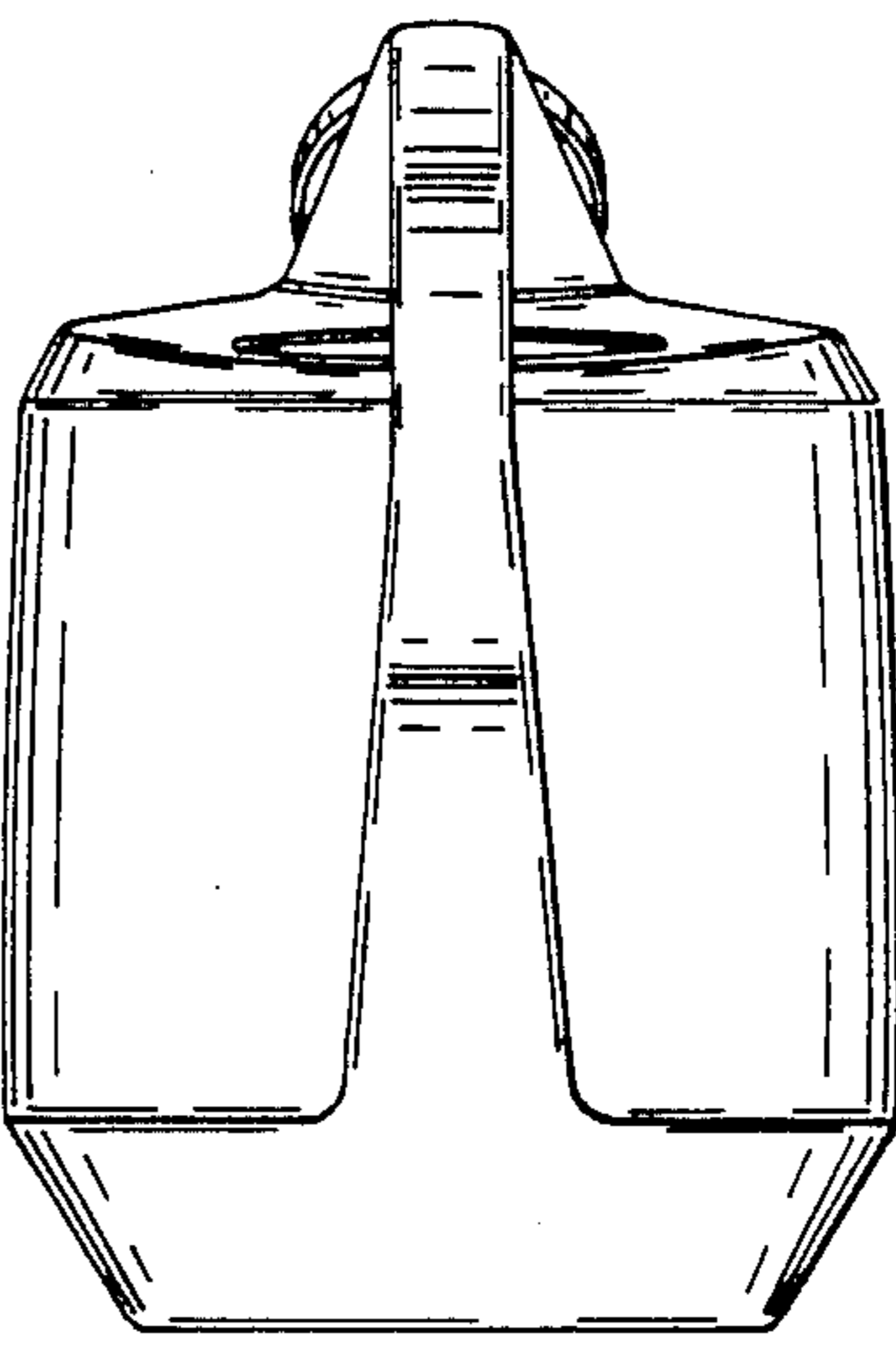

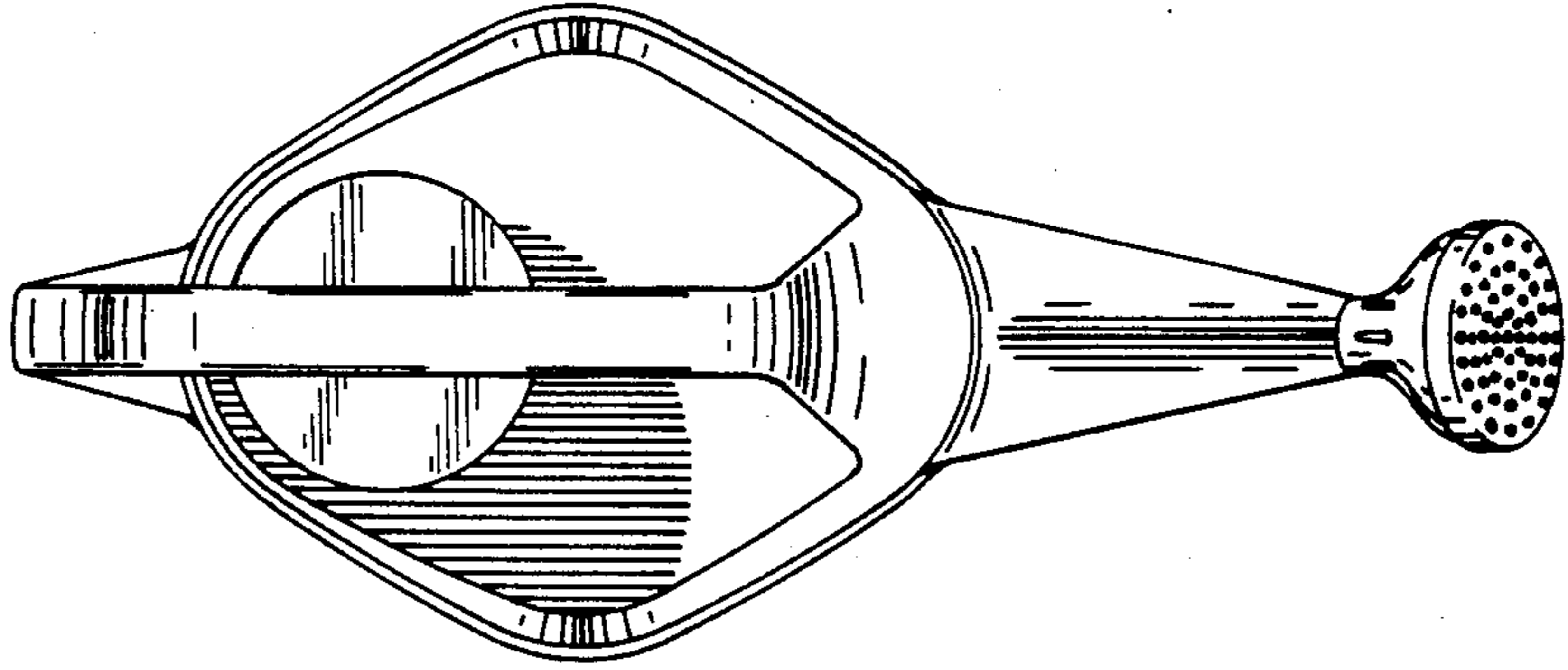
