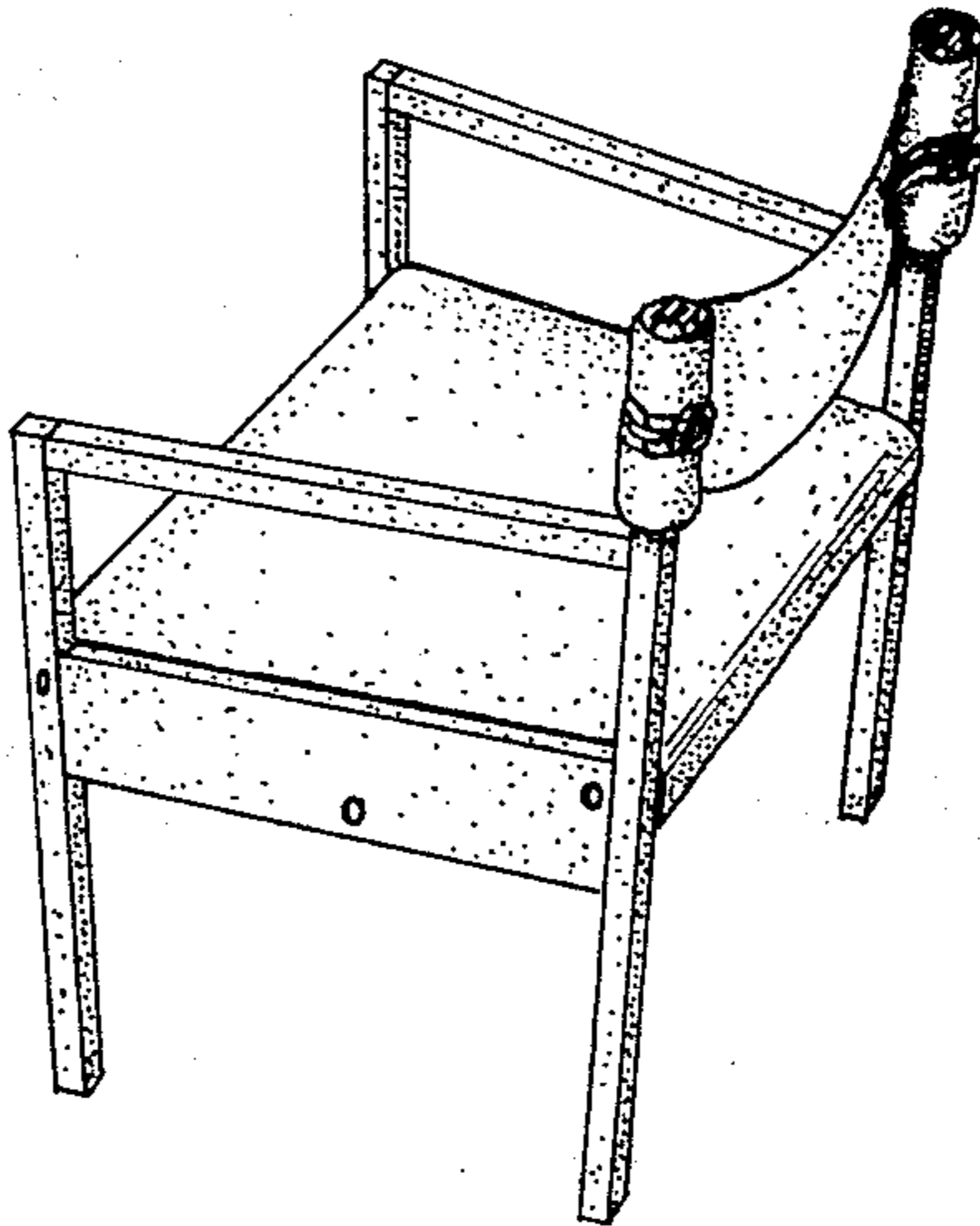

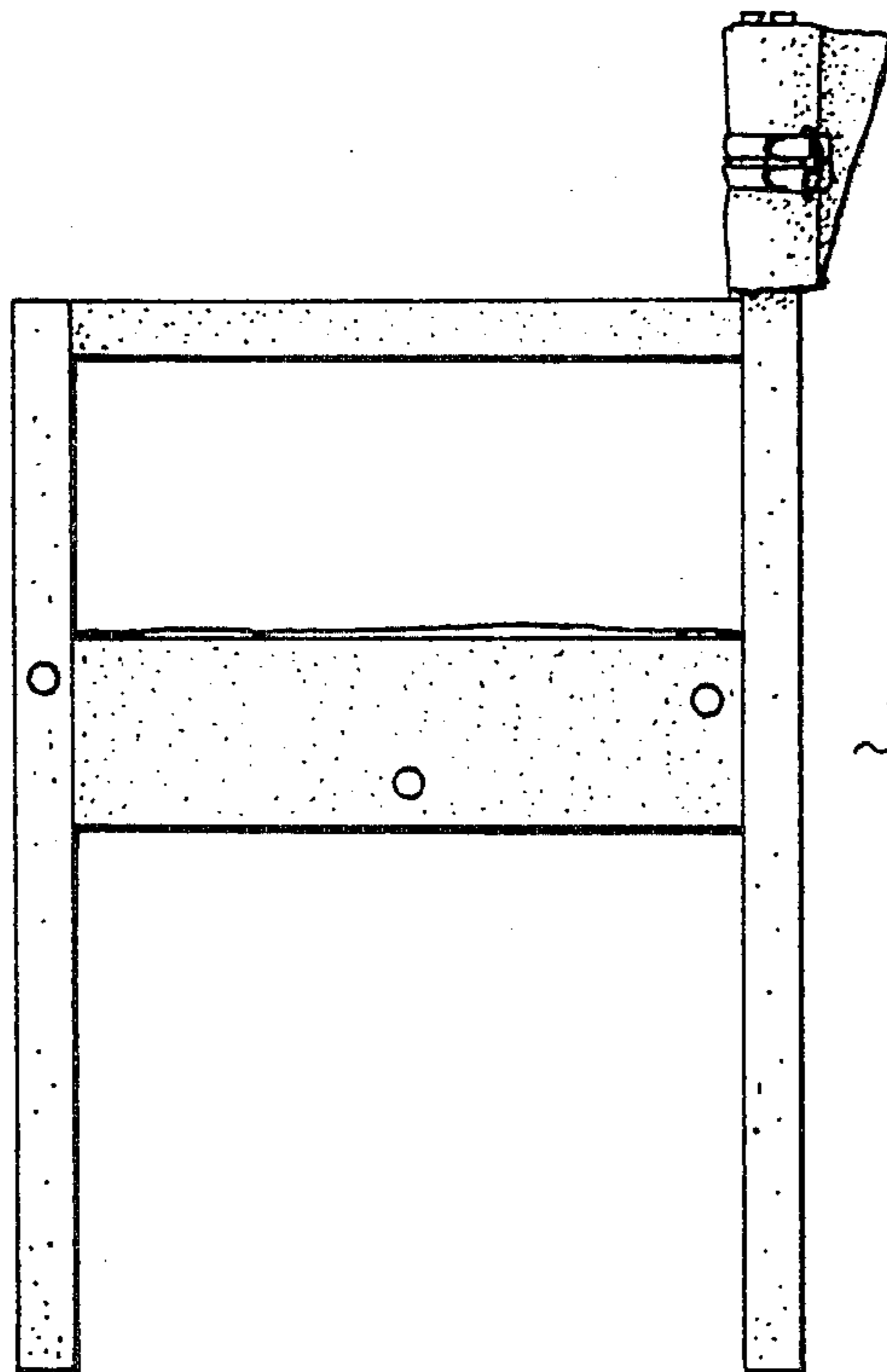
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a chair, as shown.

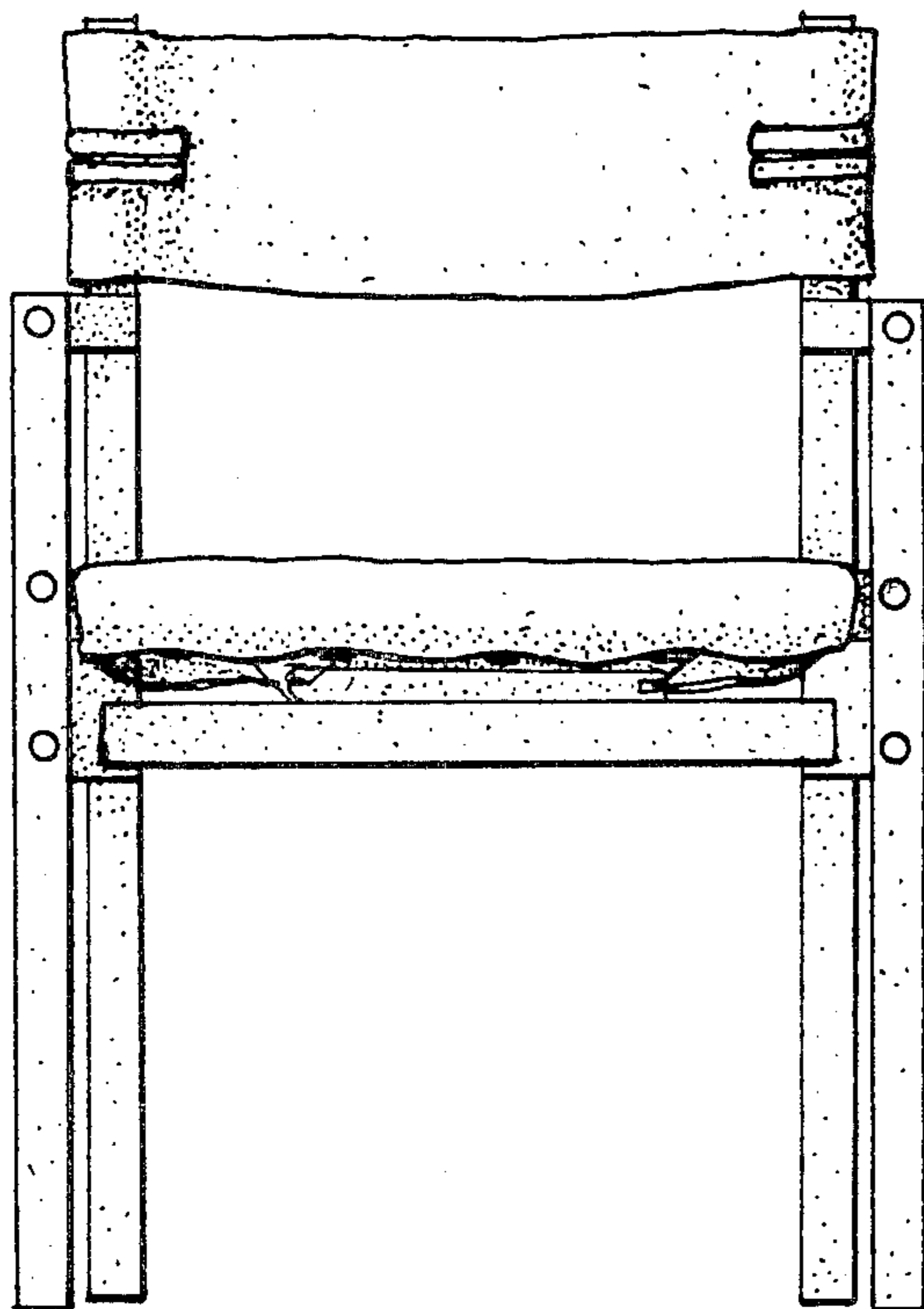
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 6 is a perspective view.

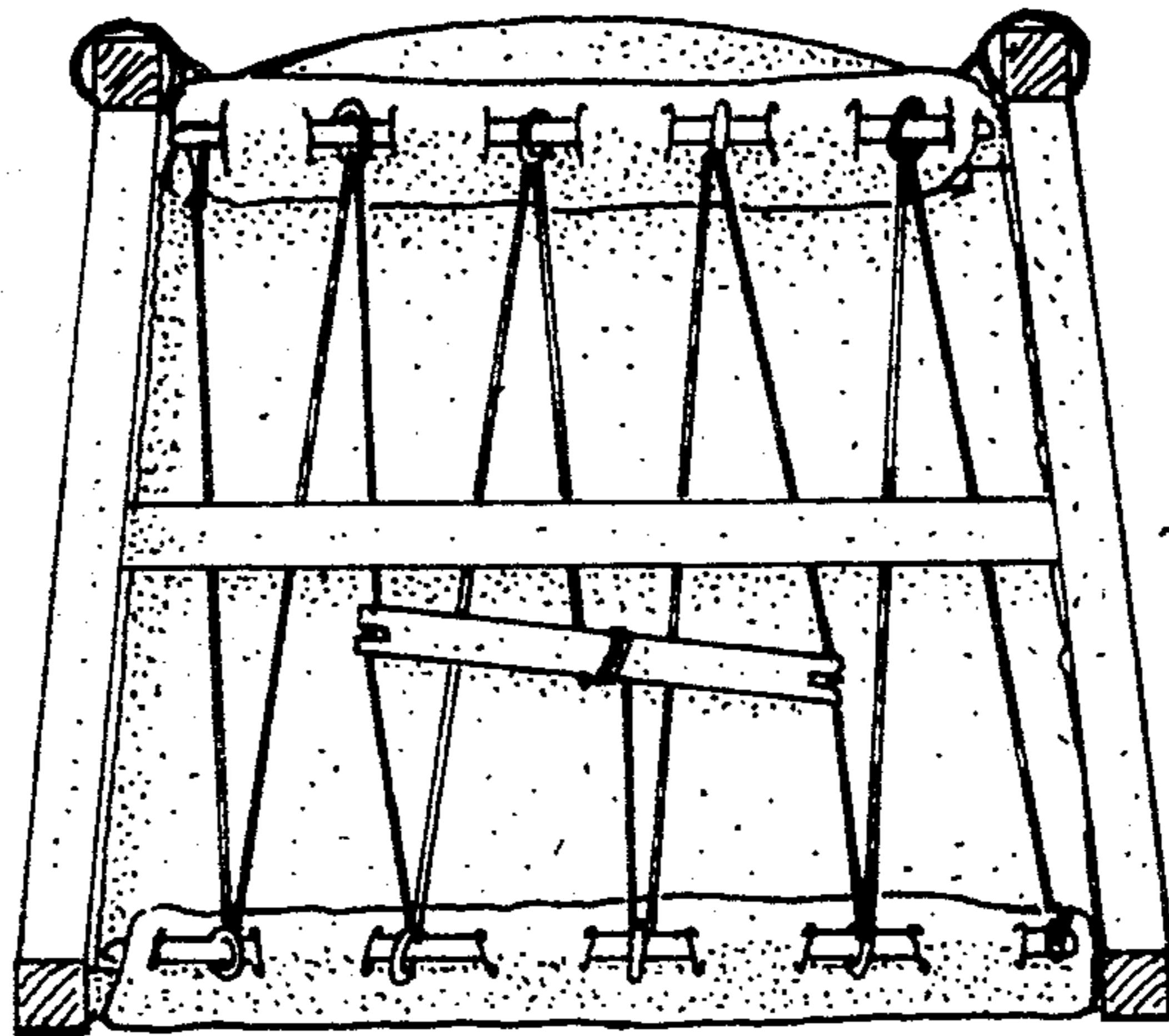
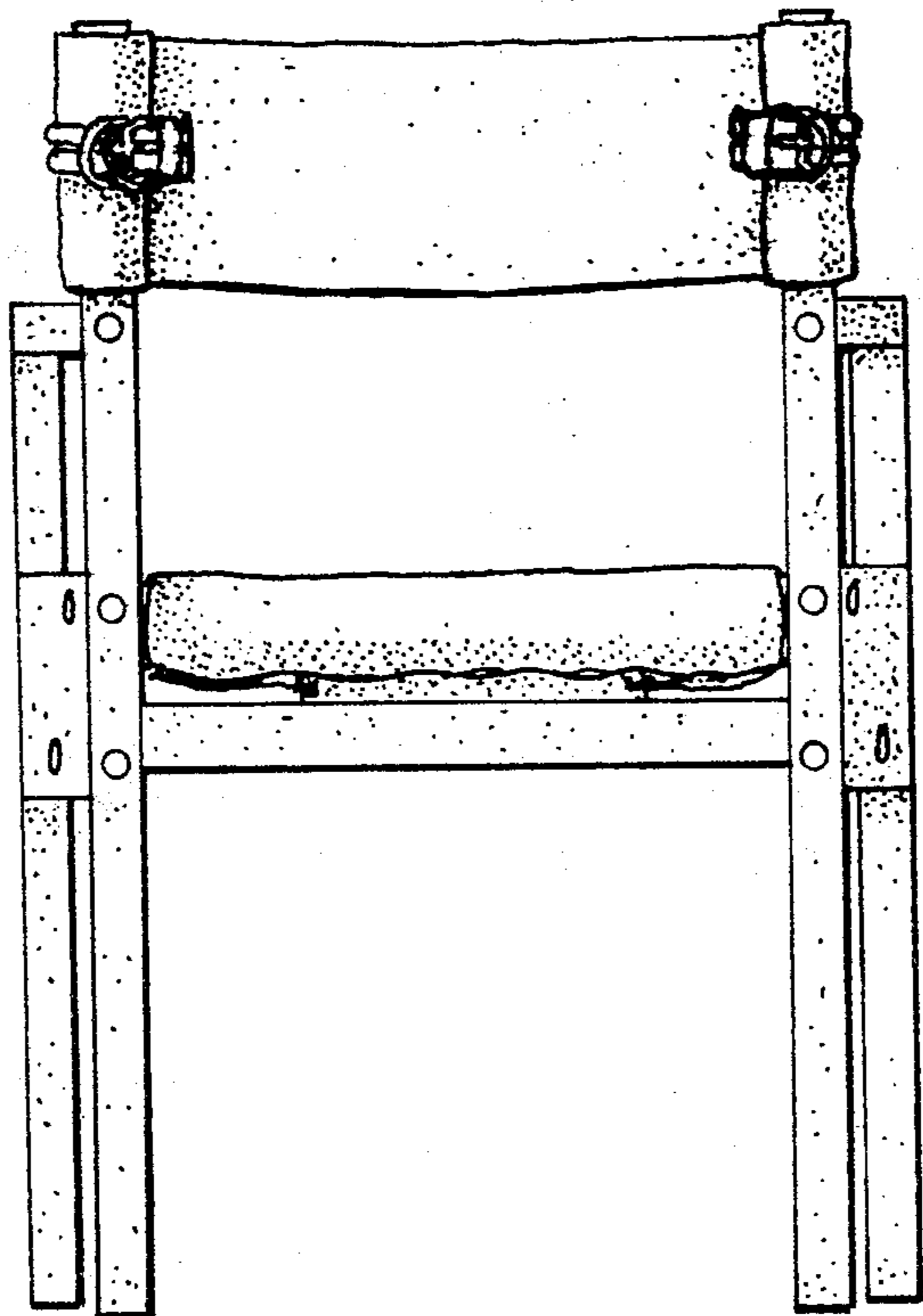


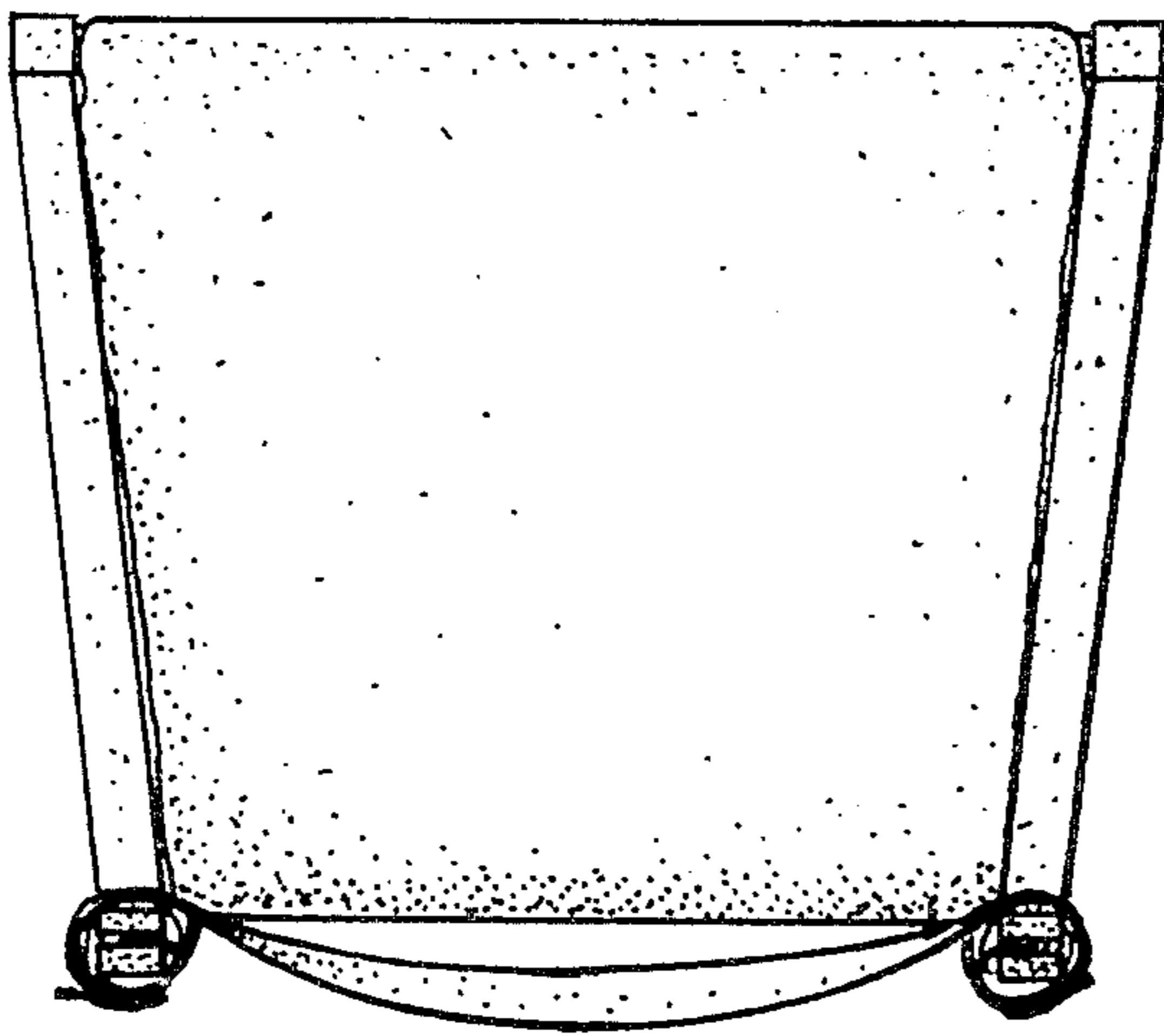

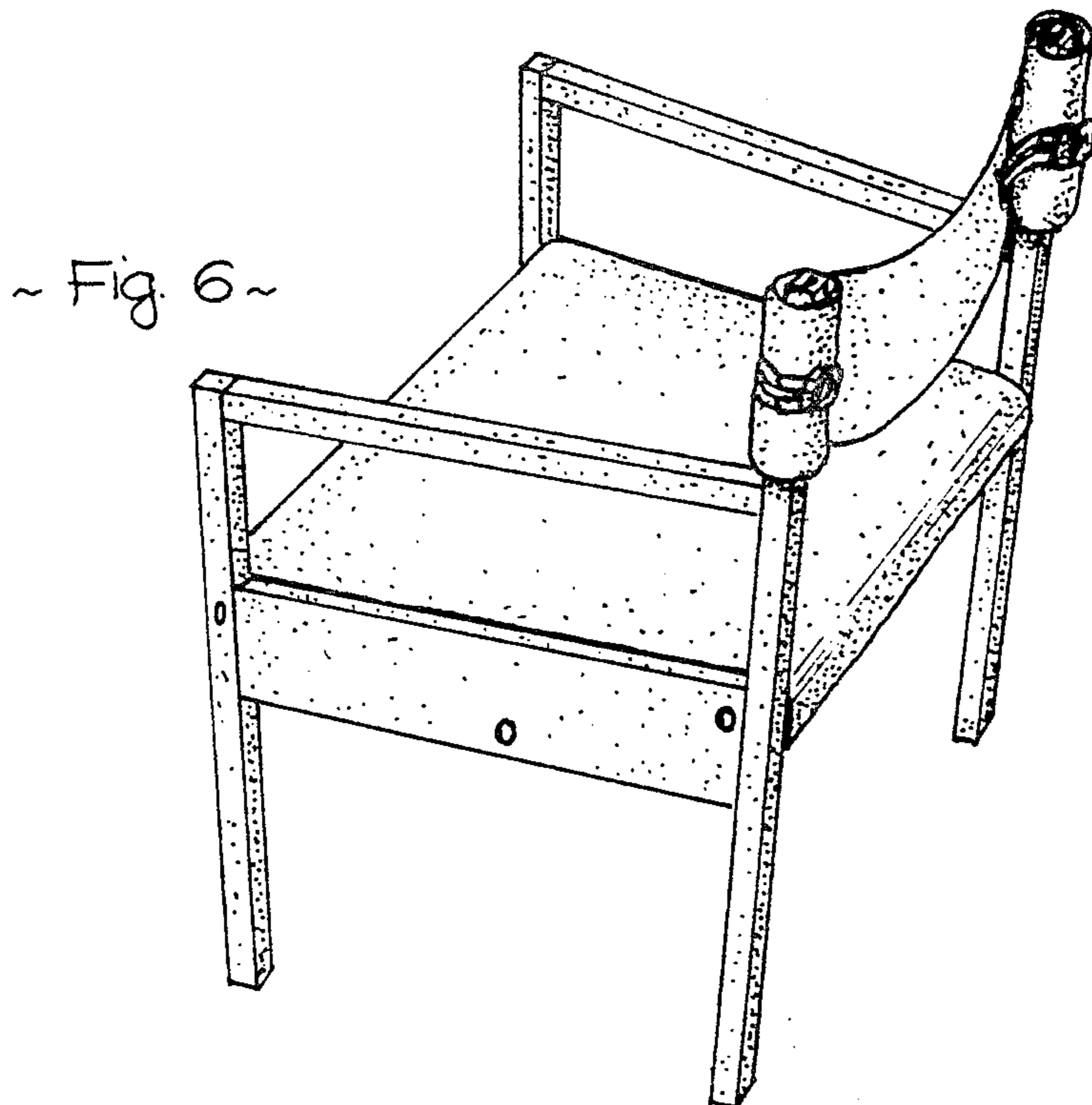
