FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a chair showing my design;

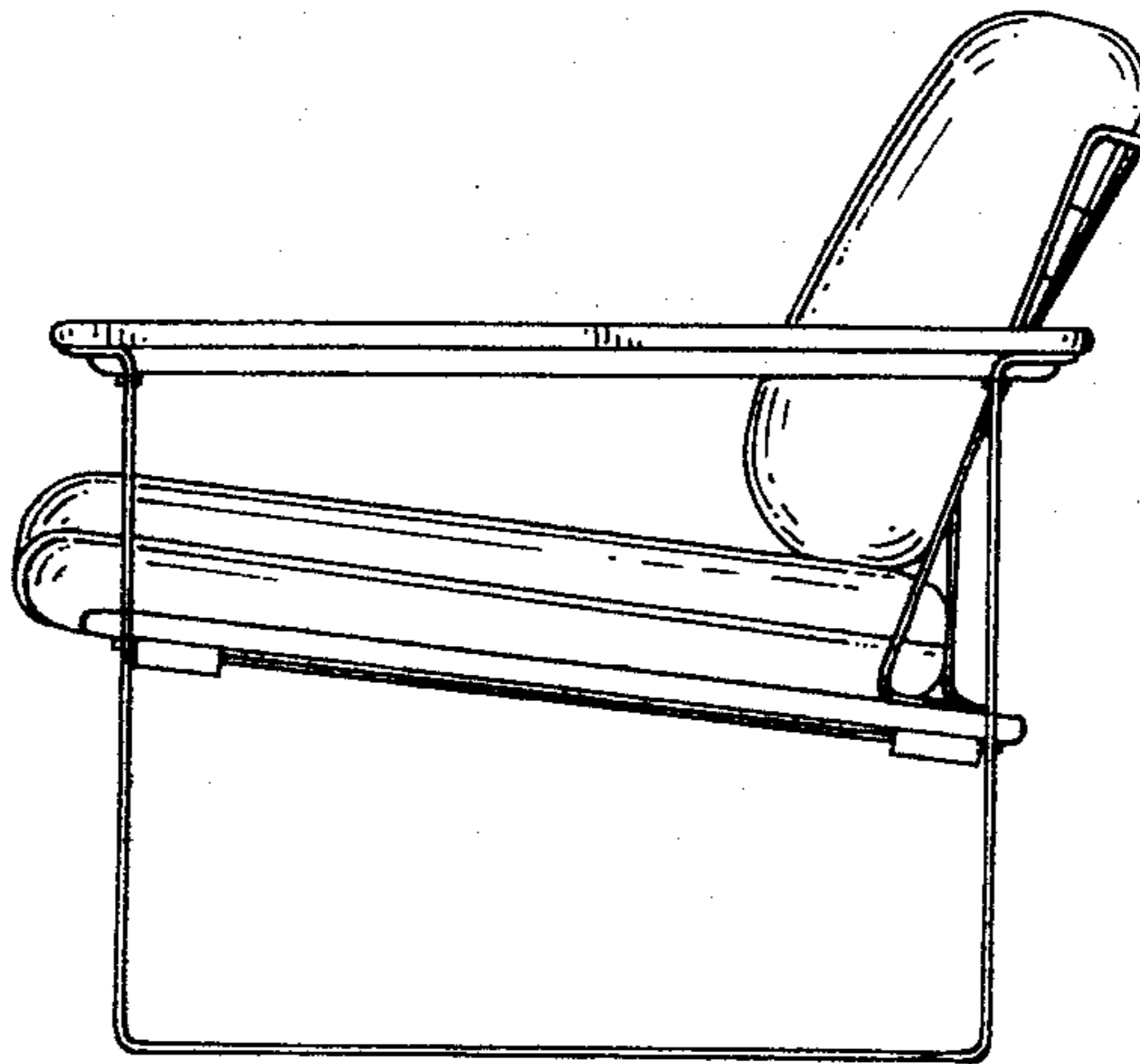
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view;

The side of the chair not shown is a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 5.



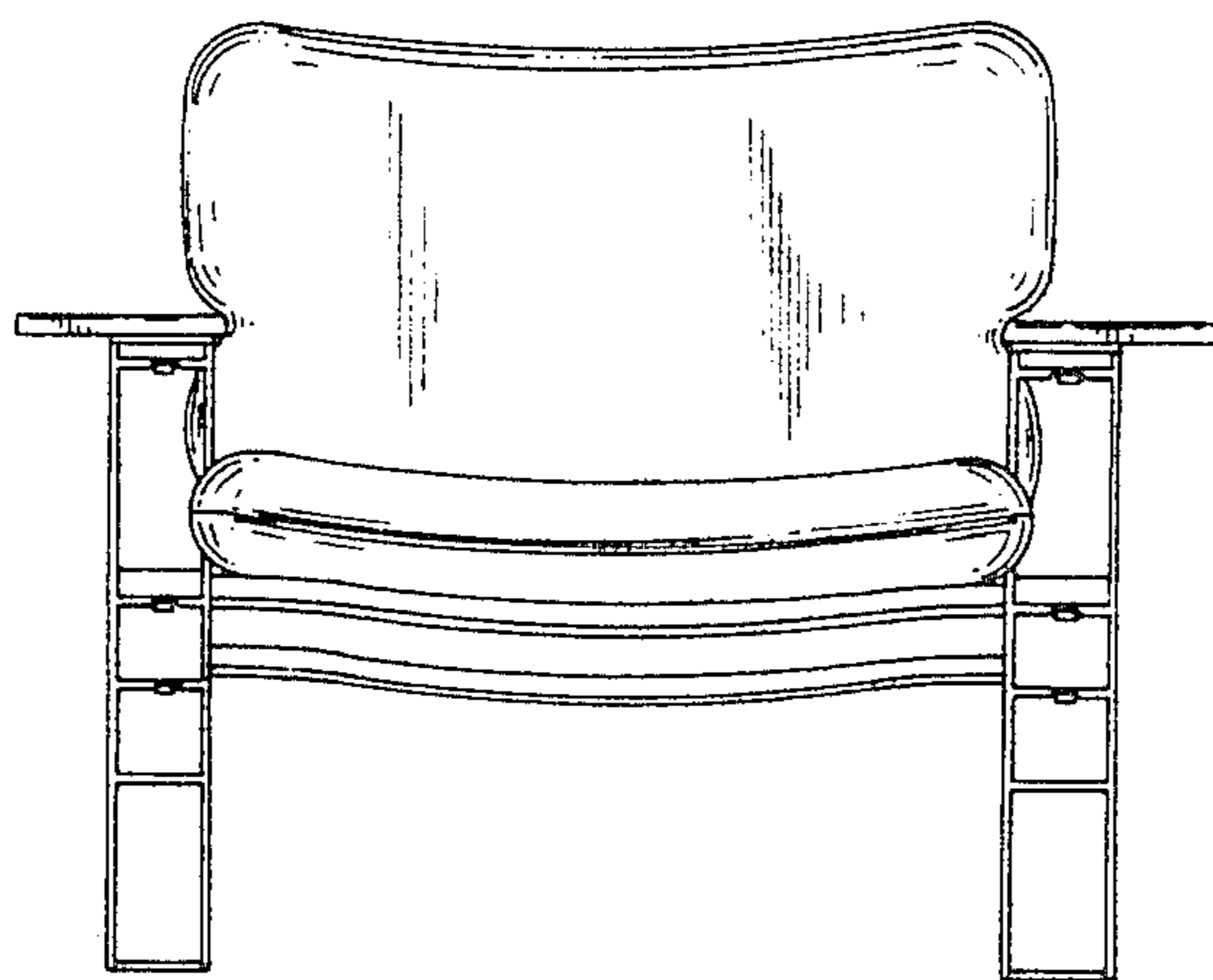

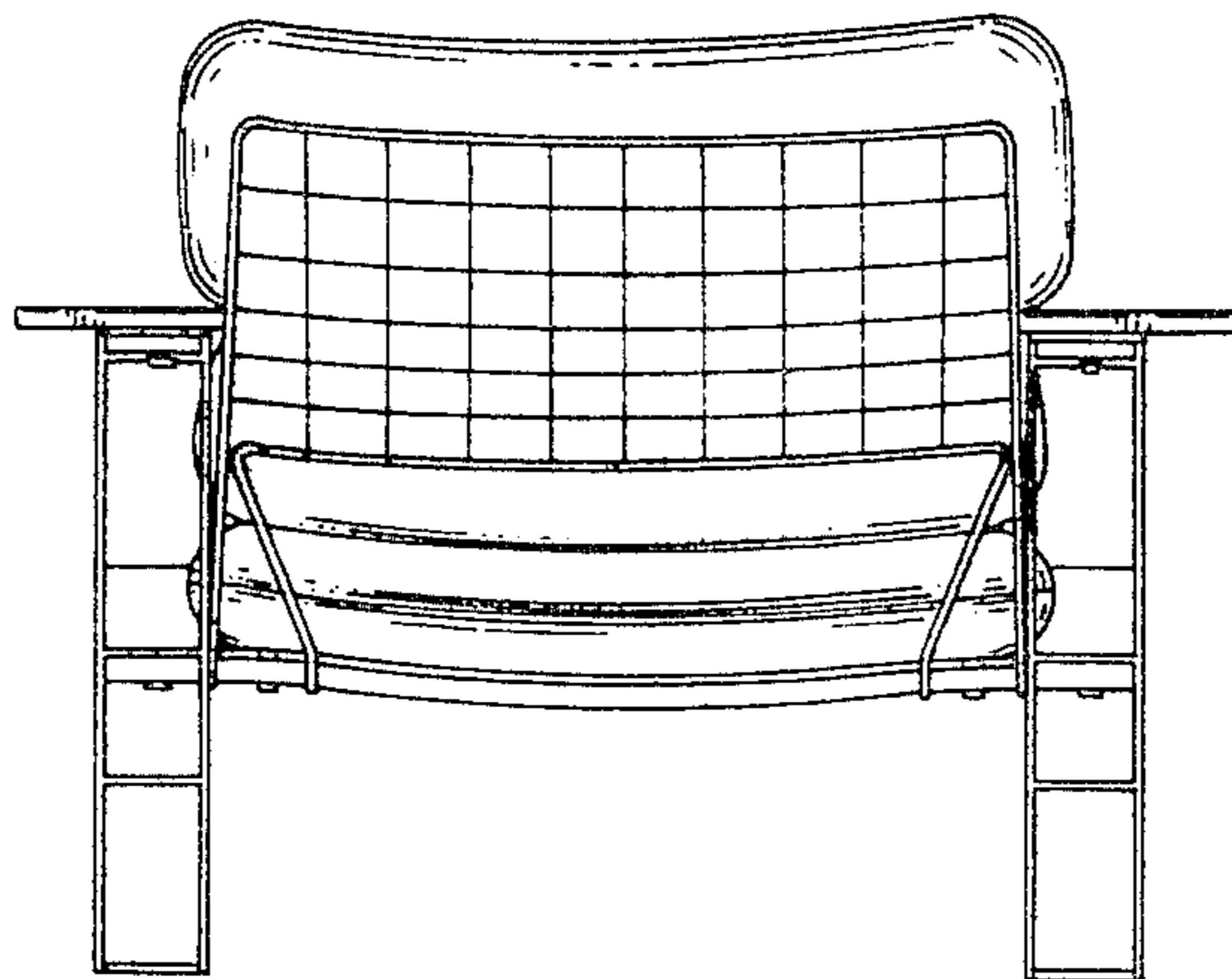

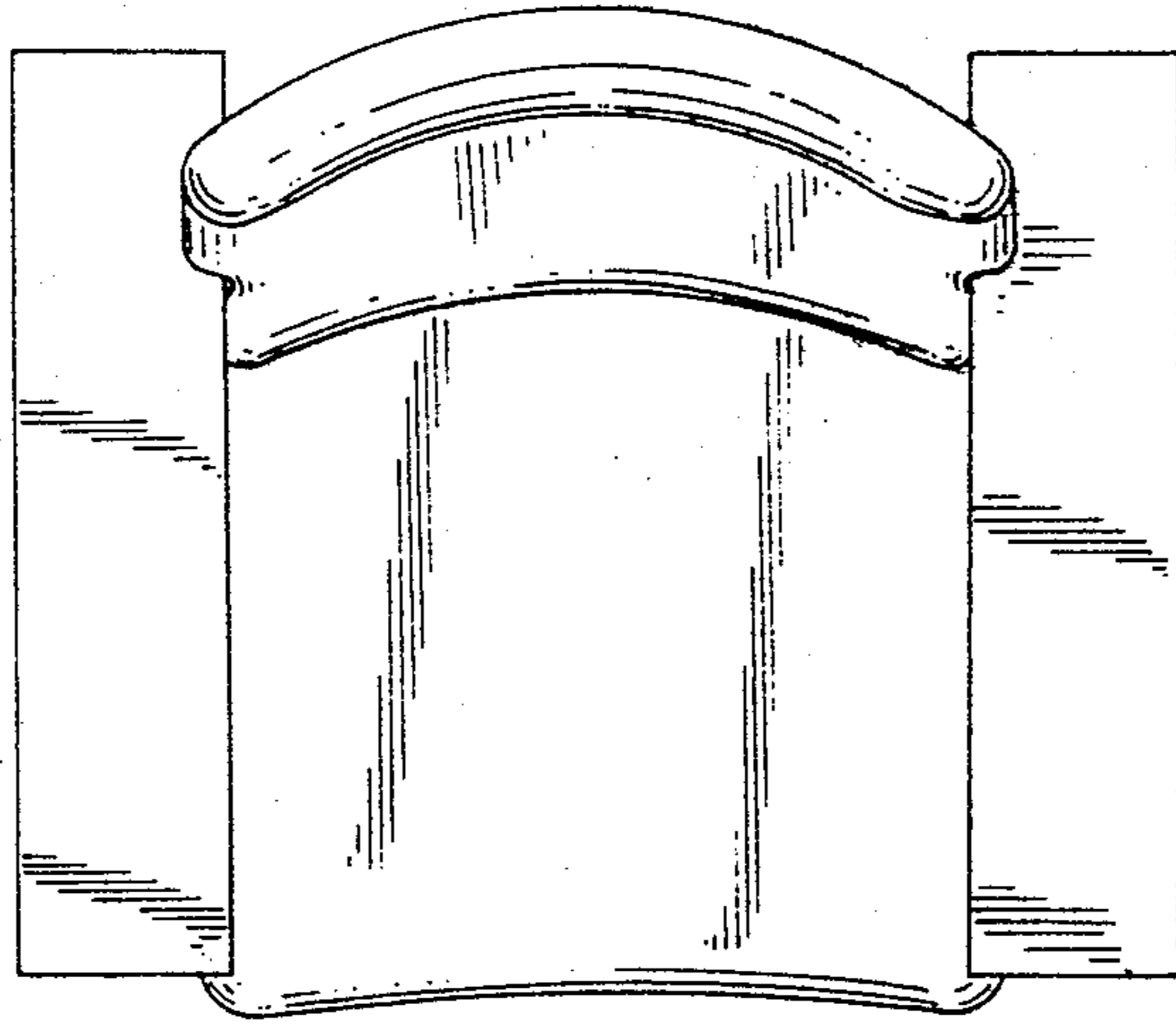

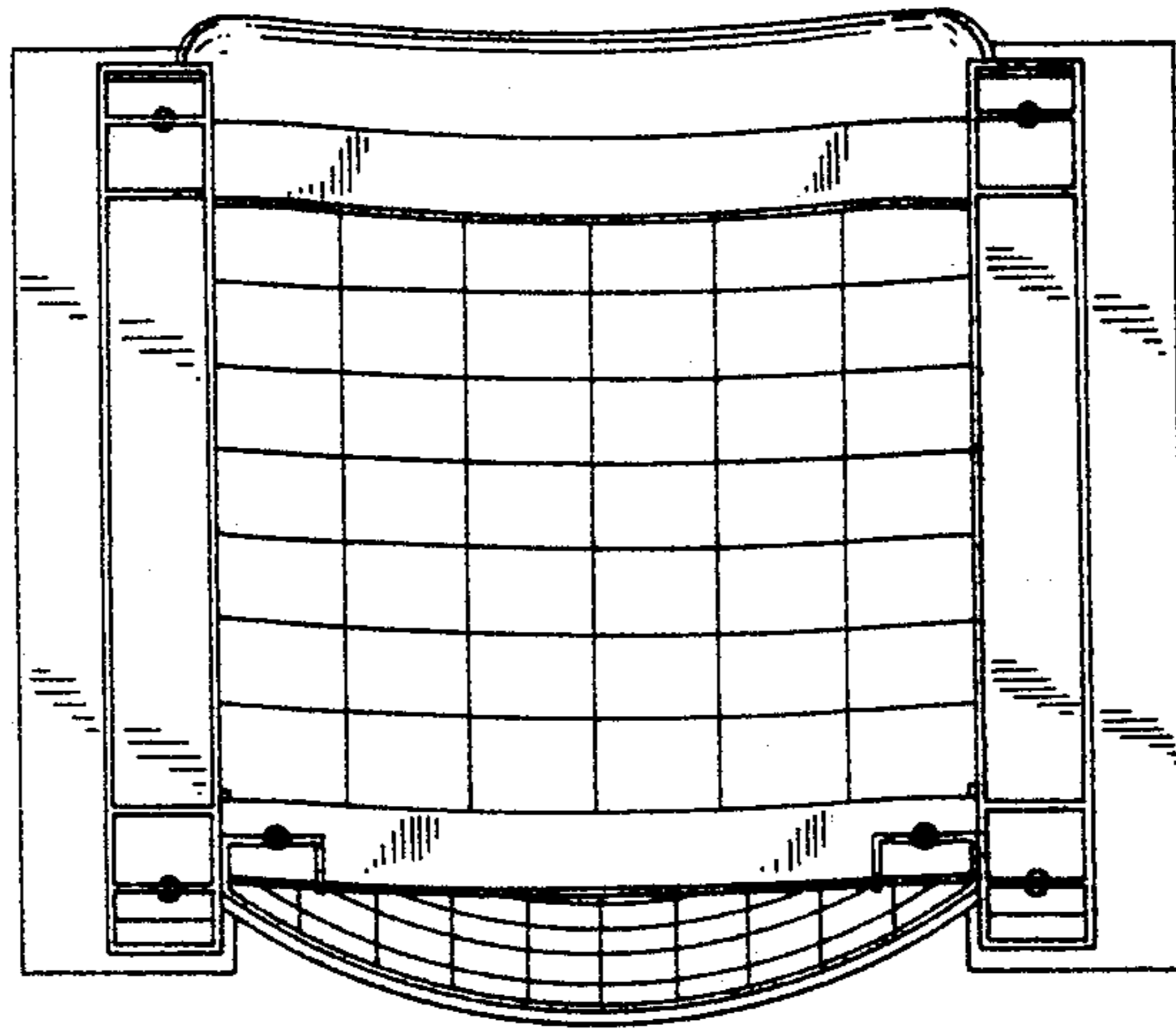

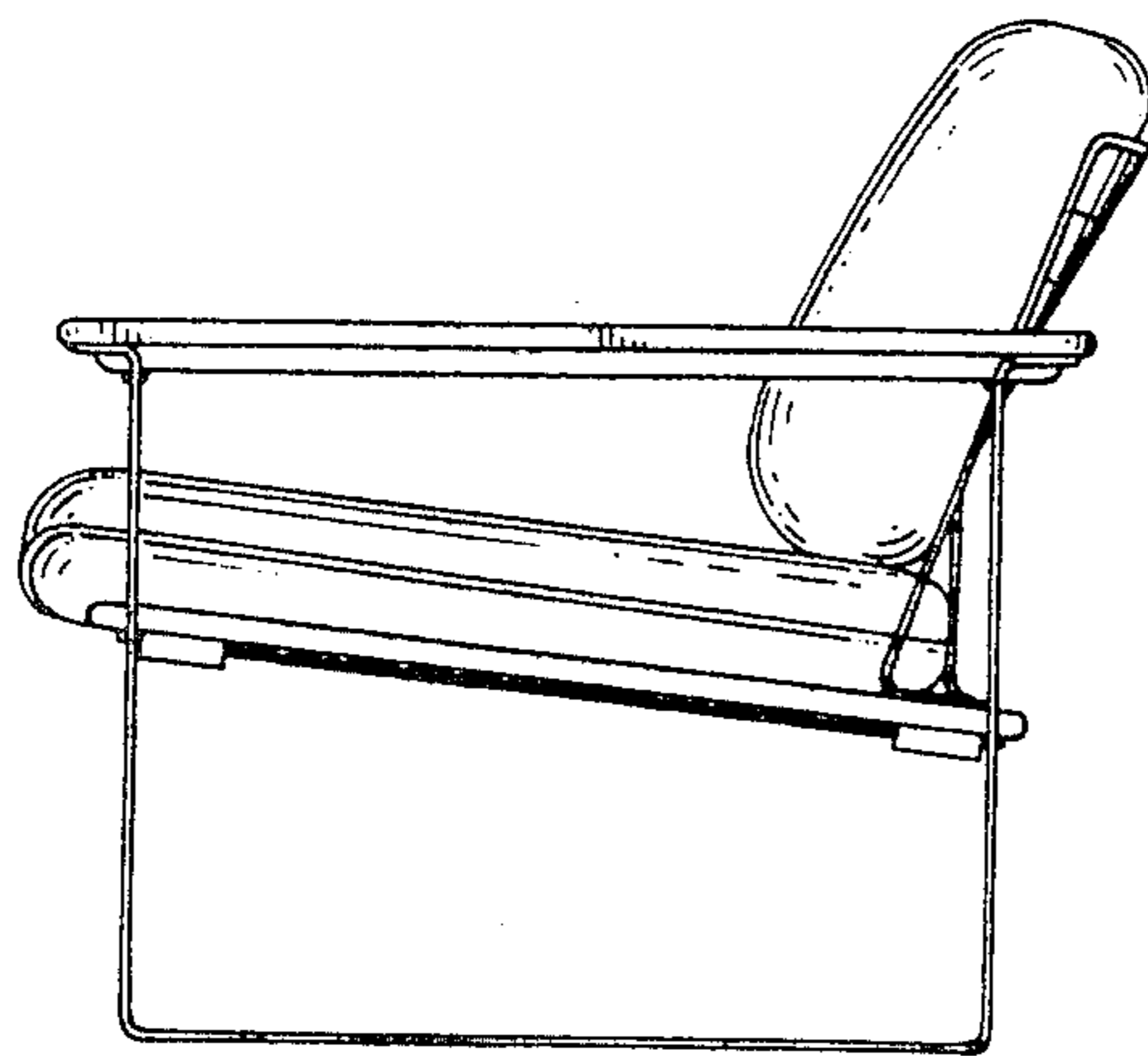
