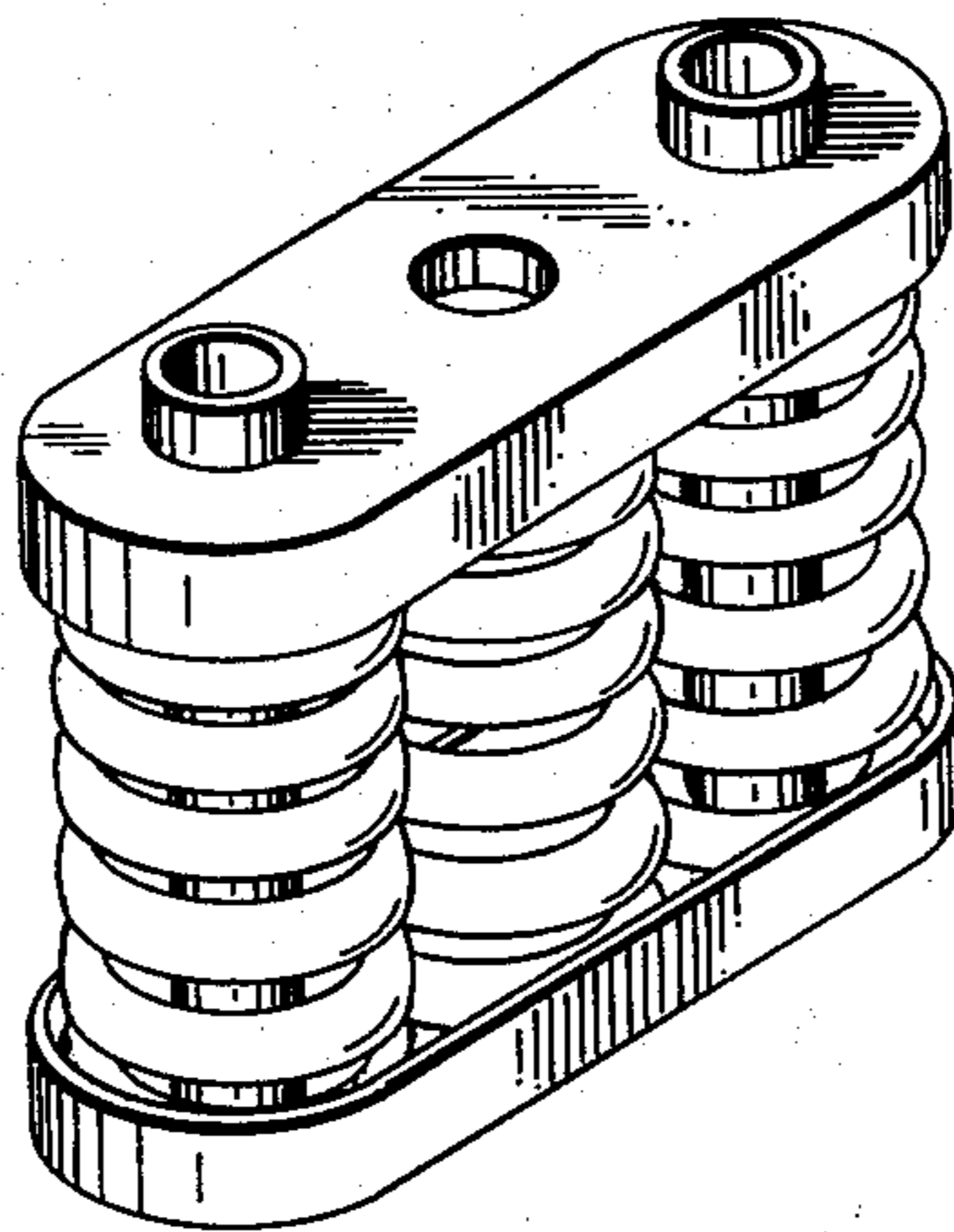

FIG. 5 is a side elevation view thereof.



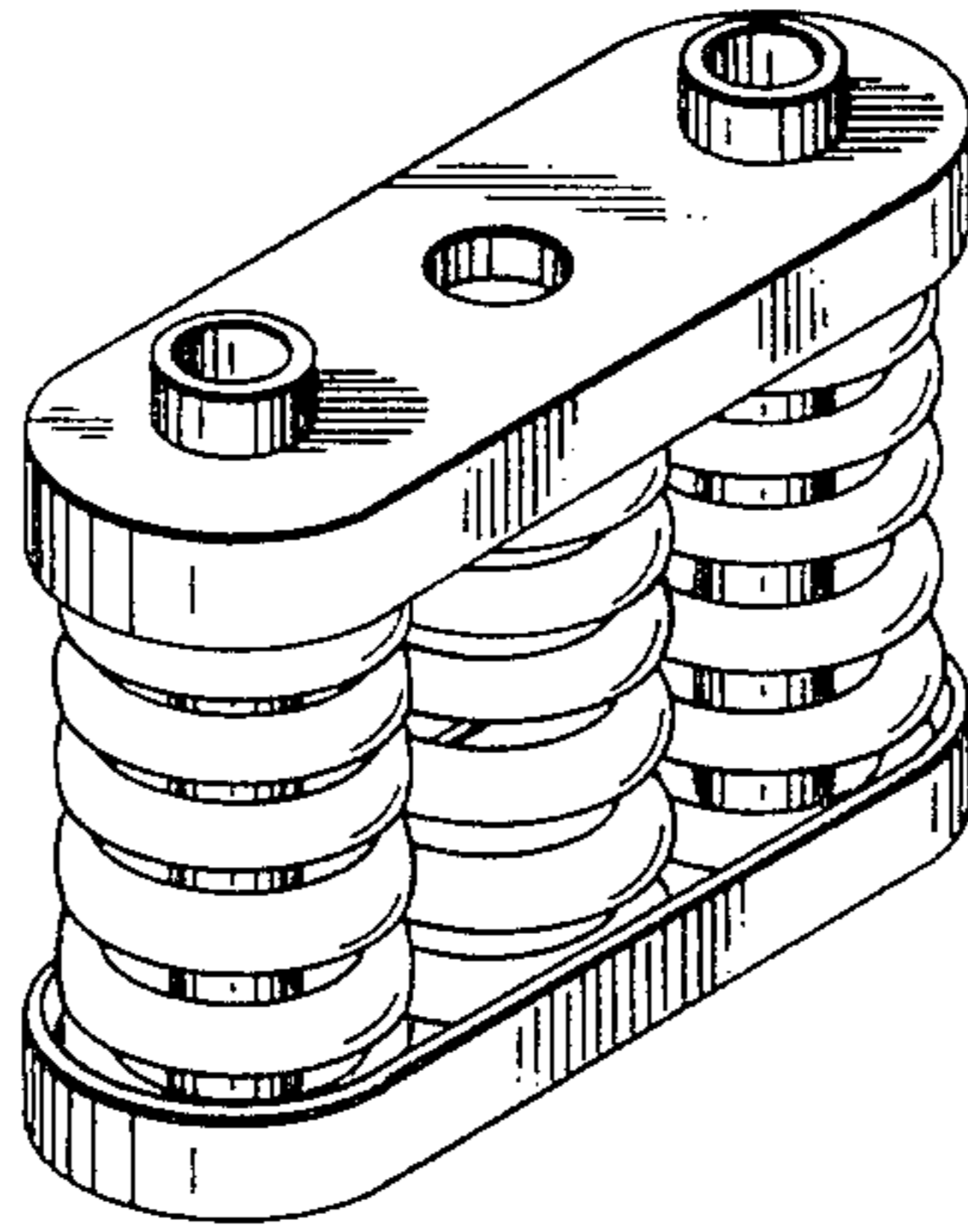

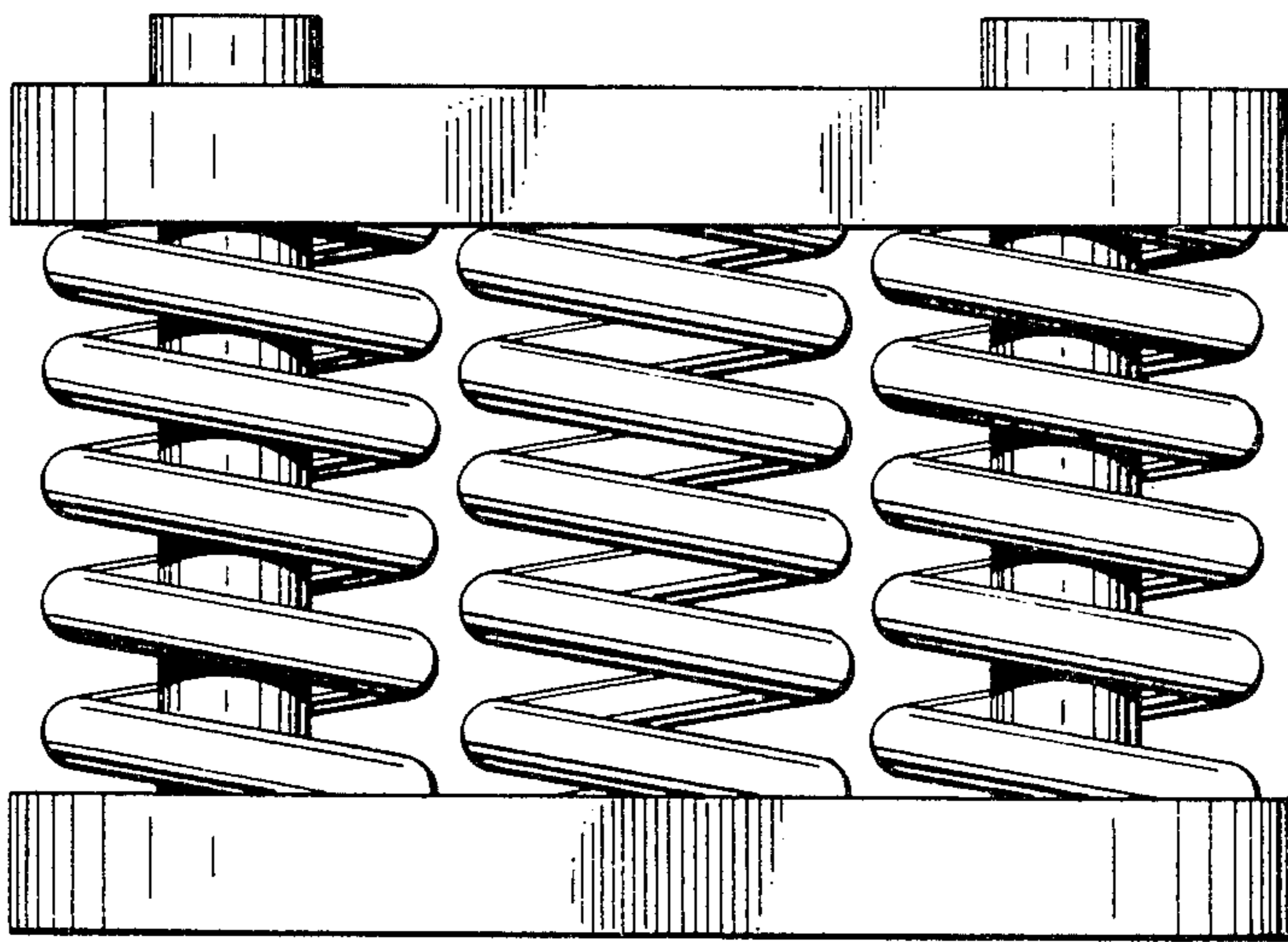

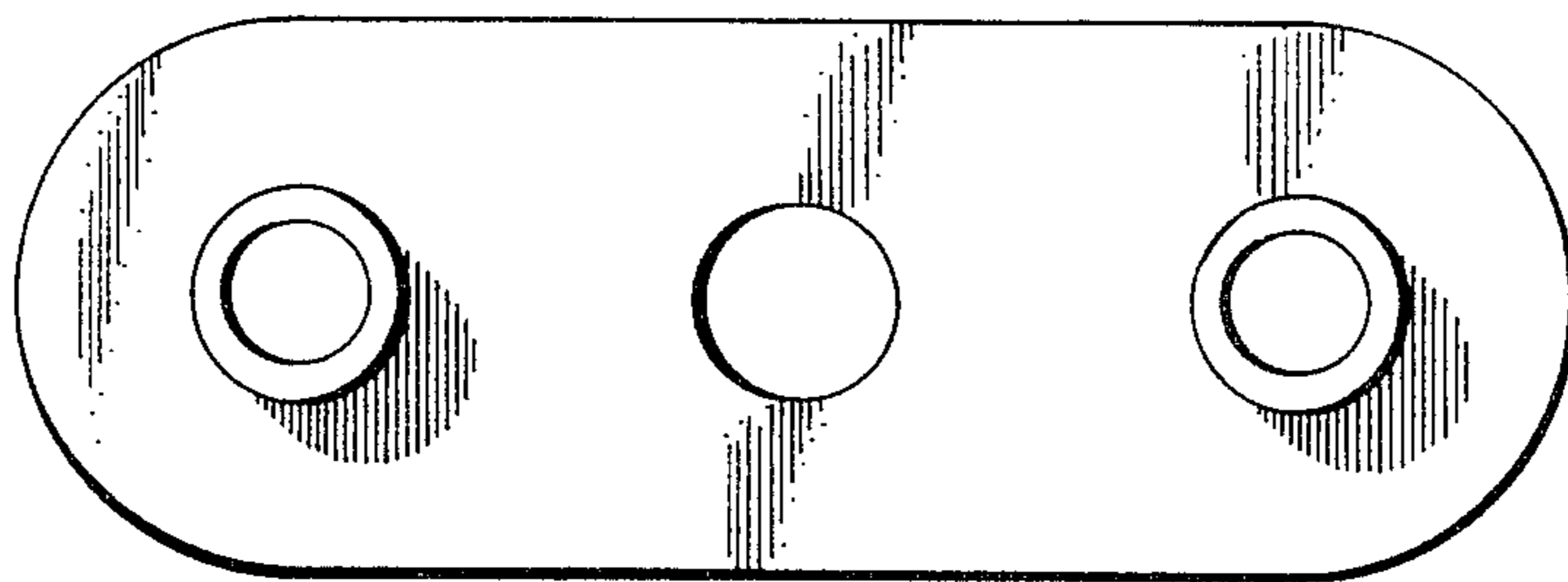

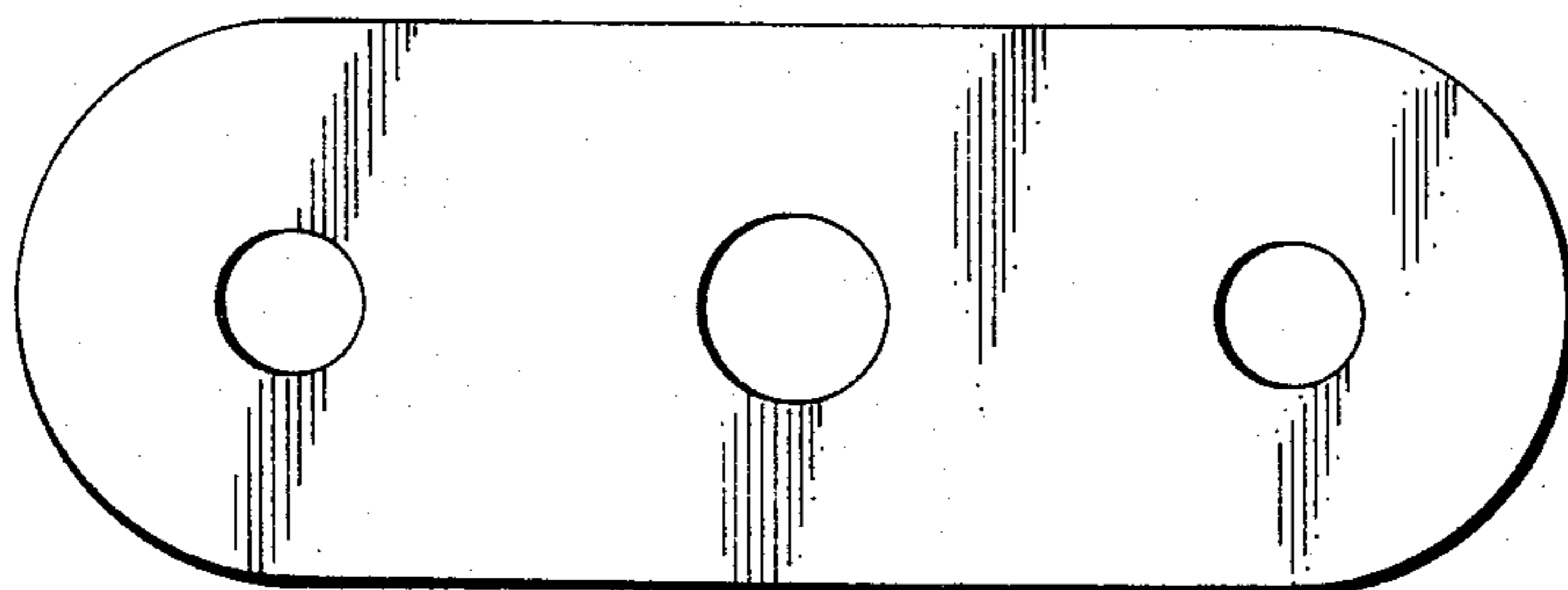

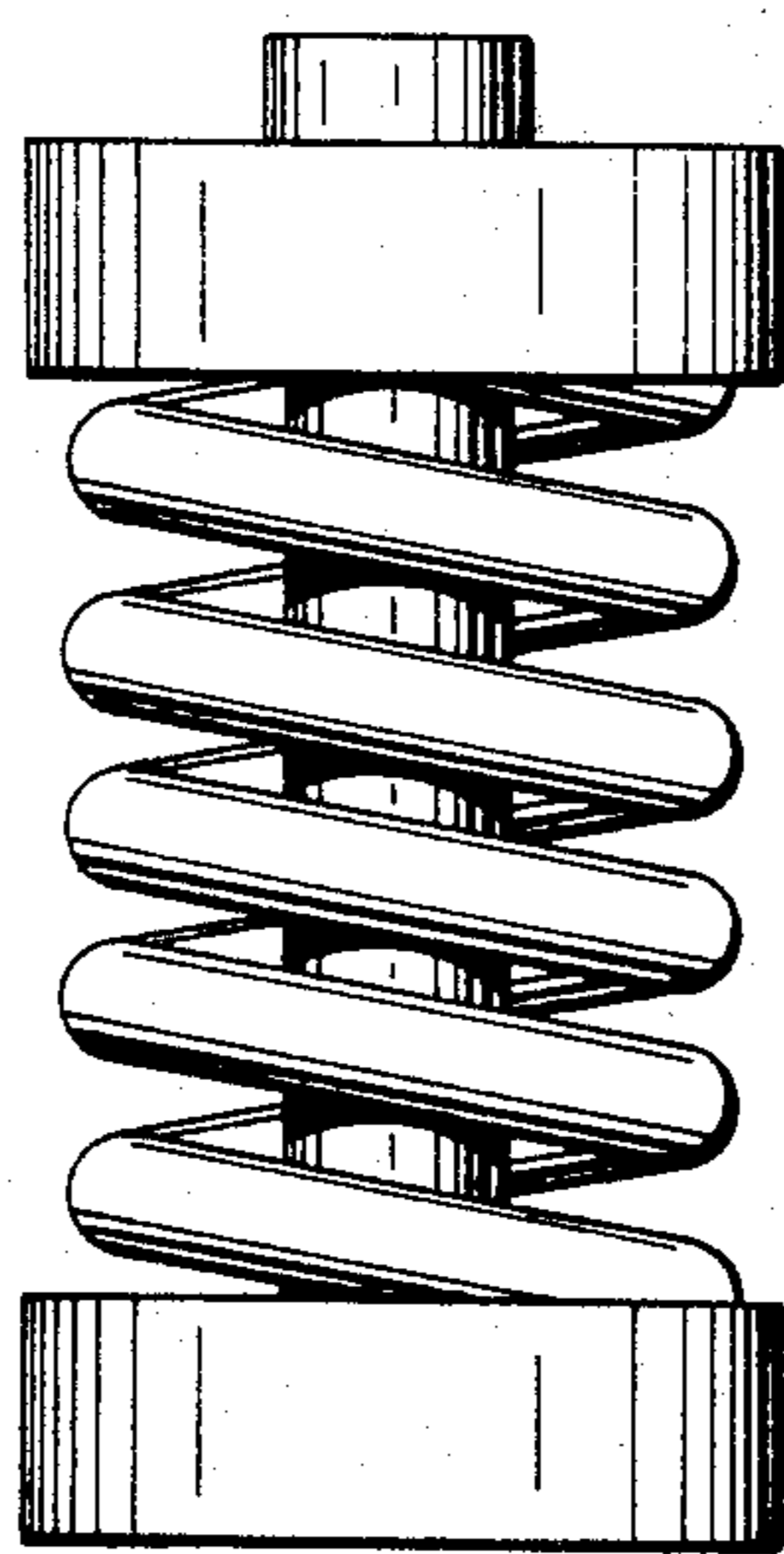
