The ornamental design for a stacking toy, substantially as shown and described.

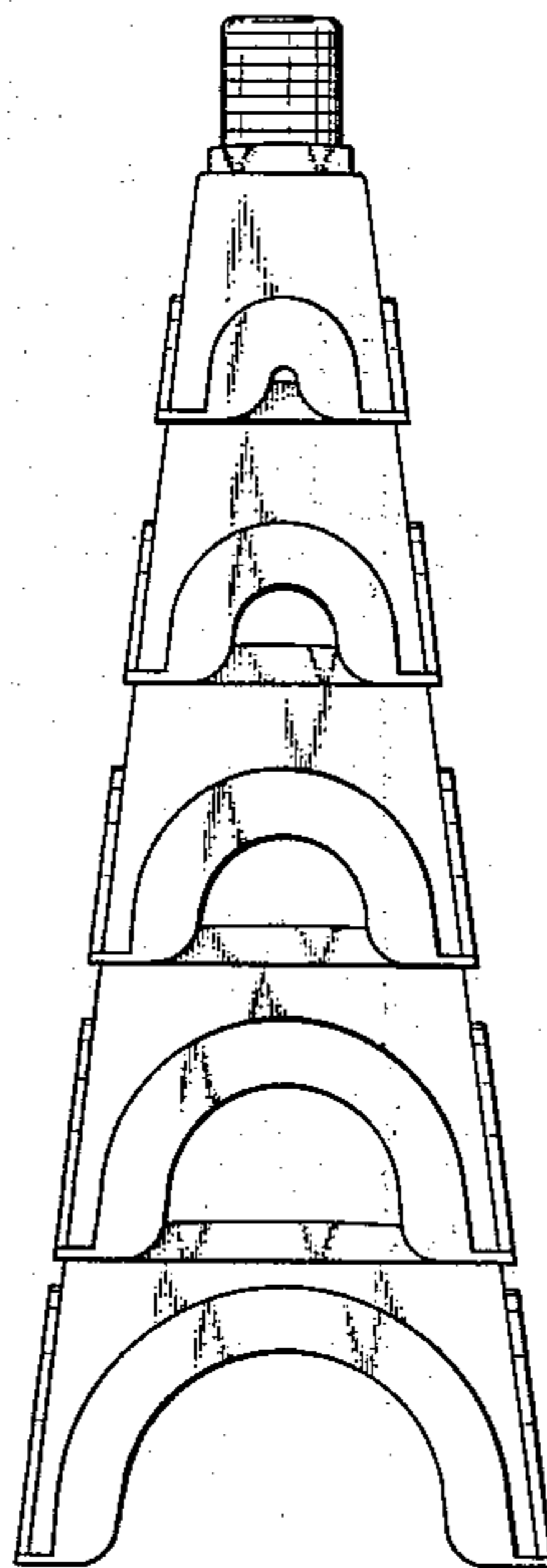
**DESCRIPTION**

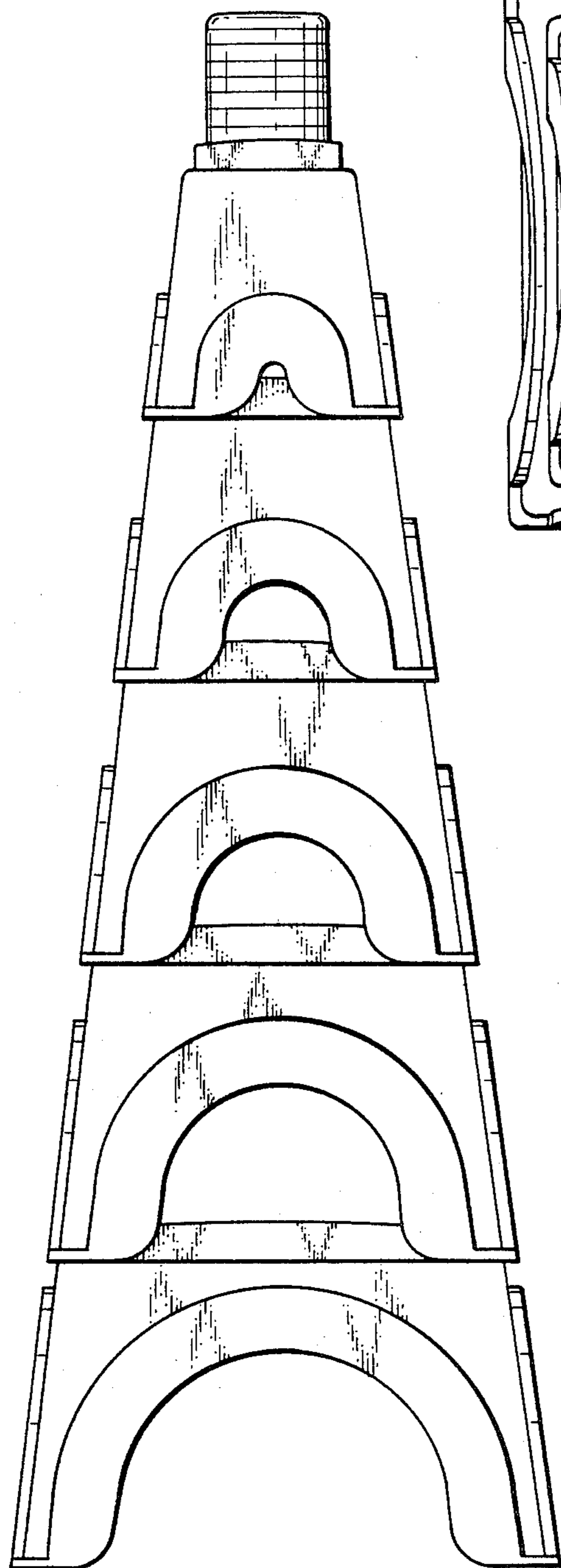

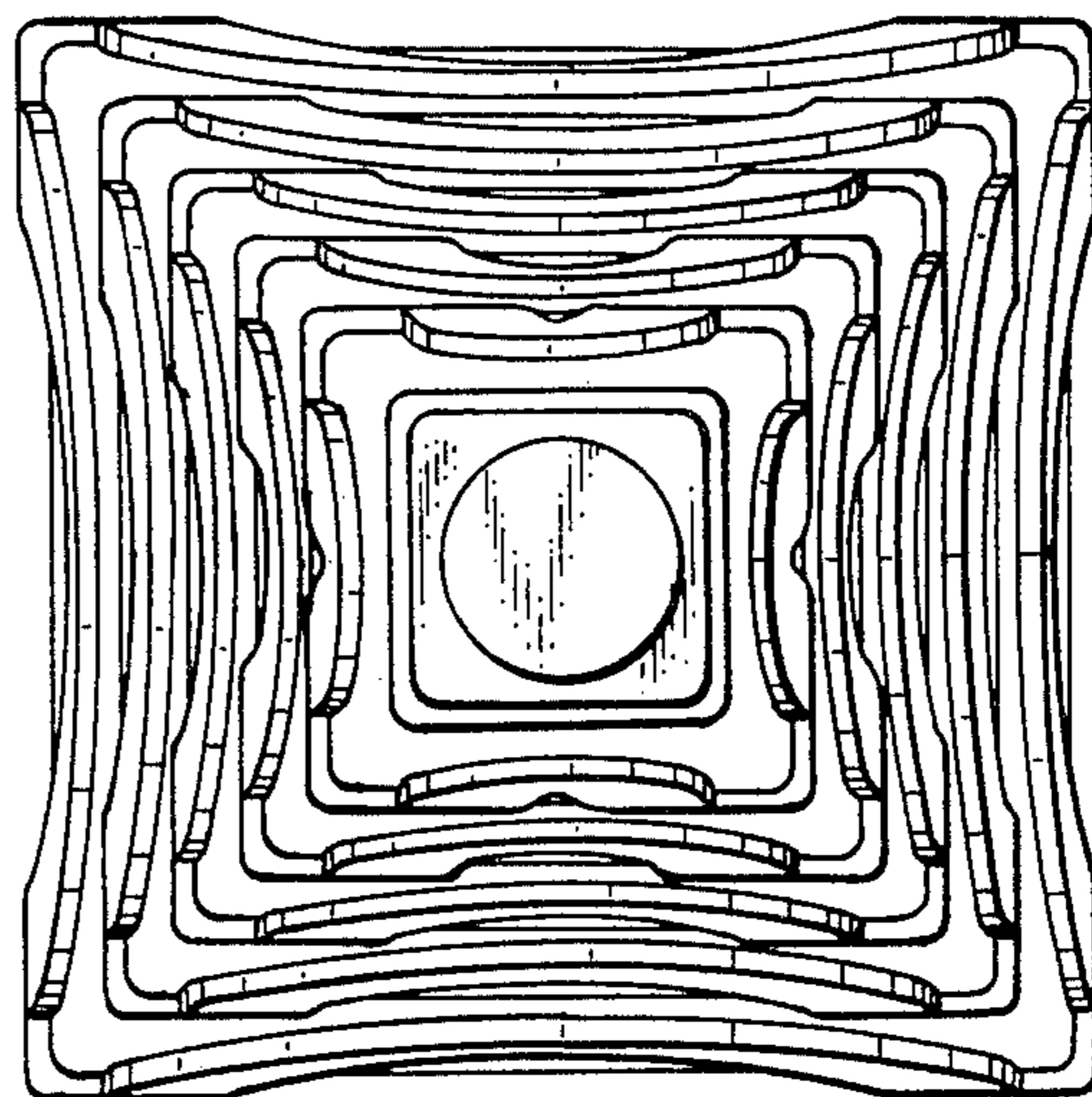

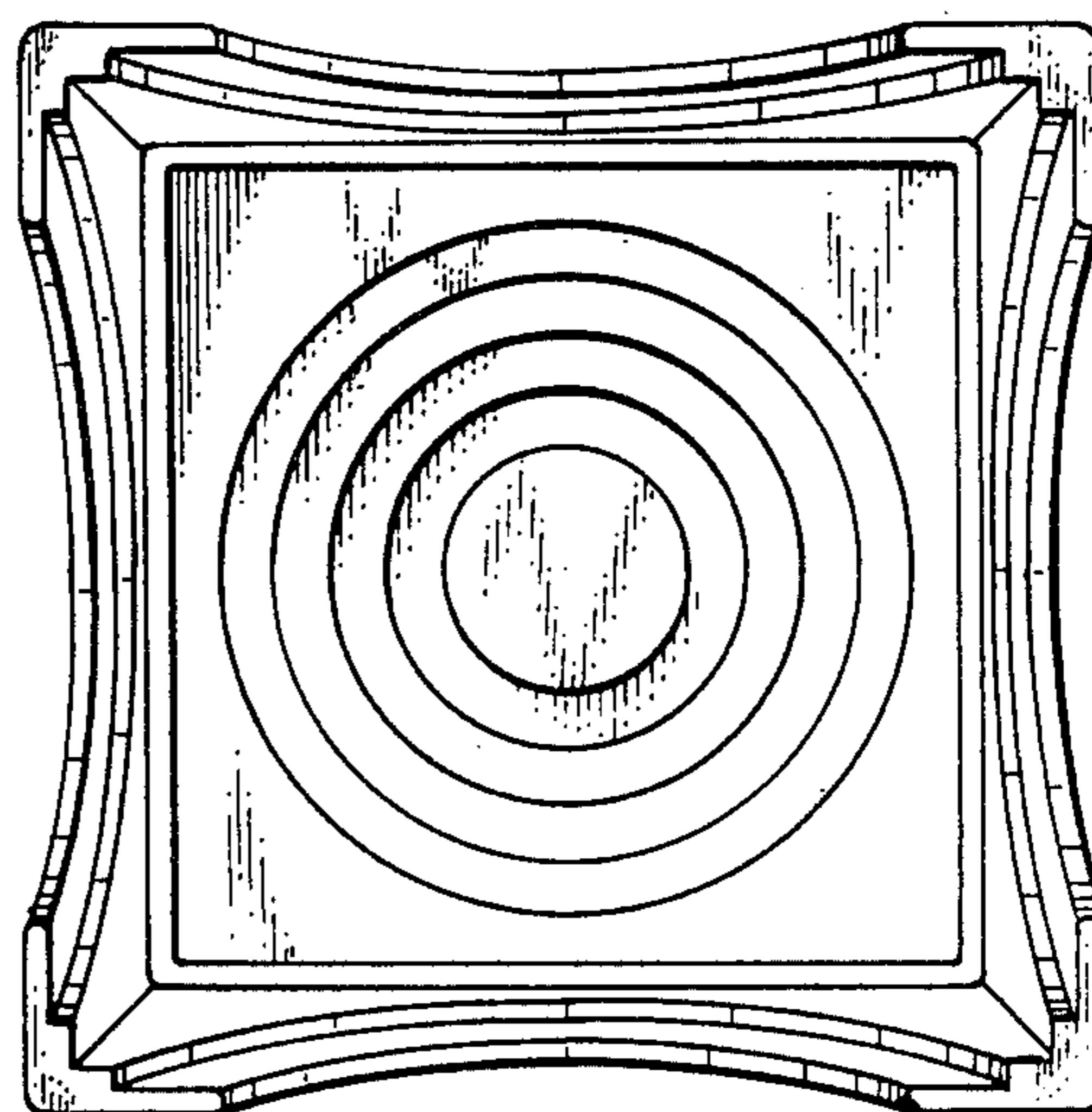
