The ornamental design for a miniaturized basketball backboard, as shown and described.

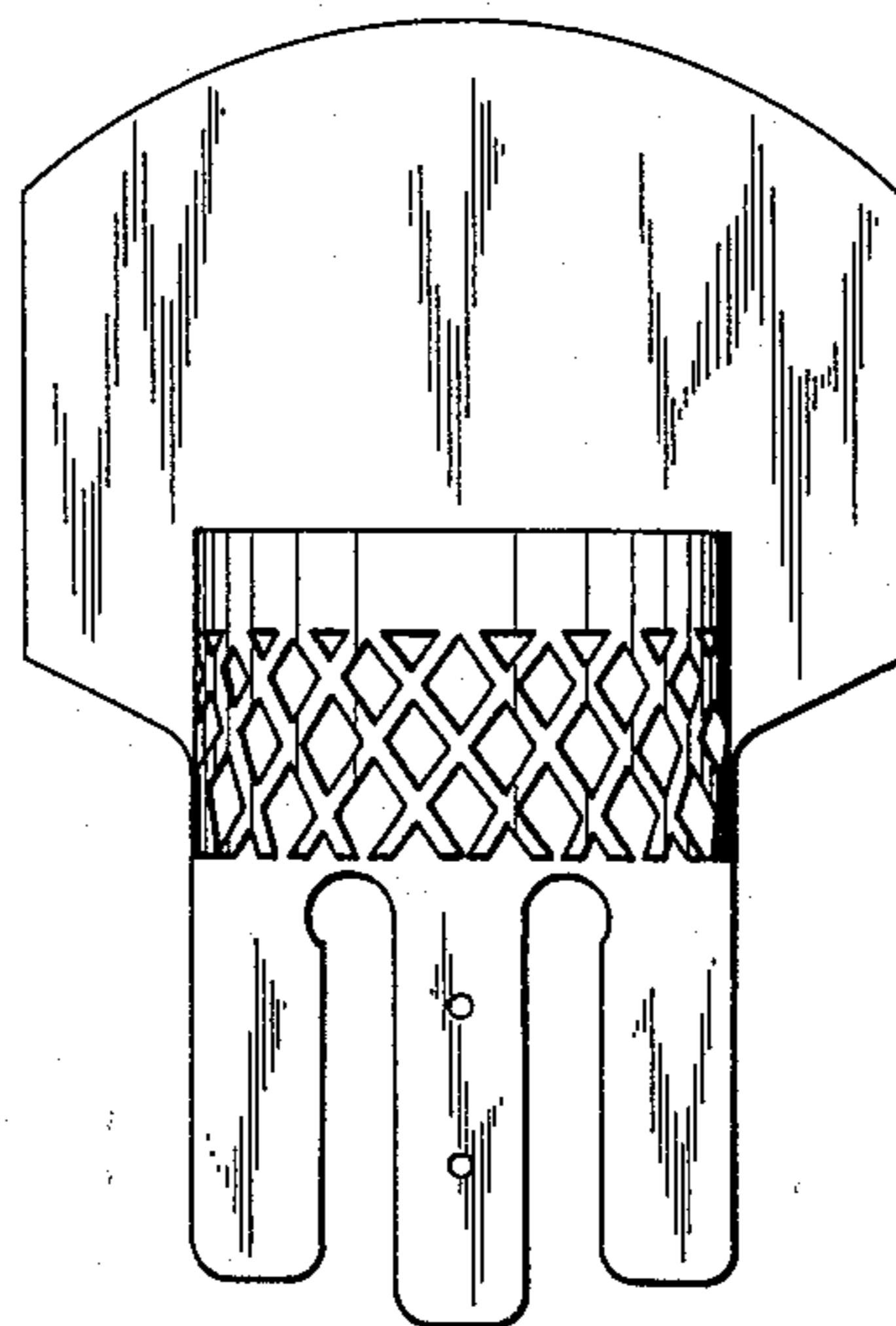
DESCRIPTION

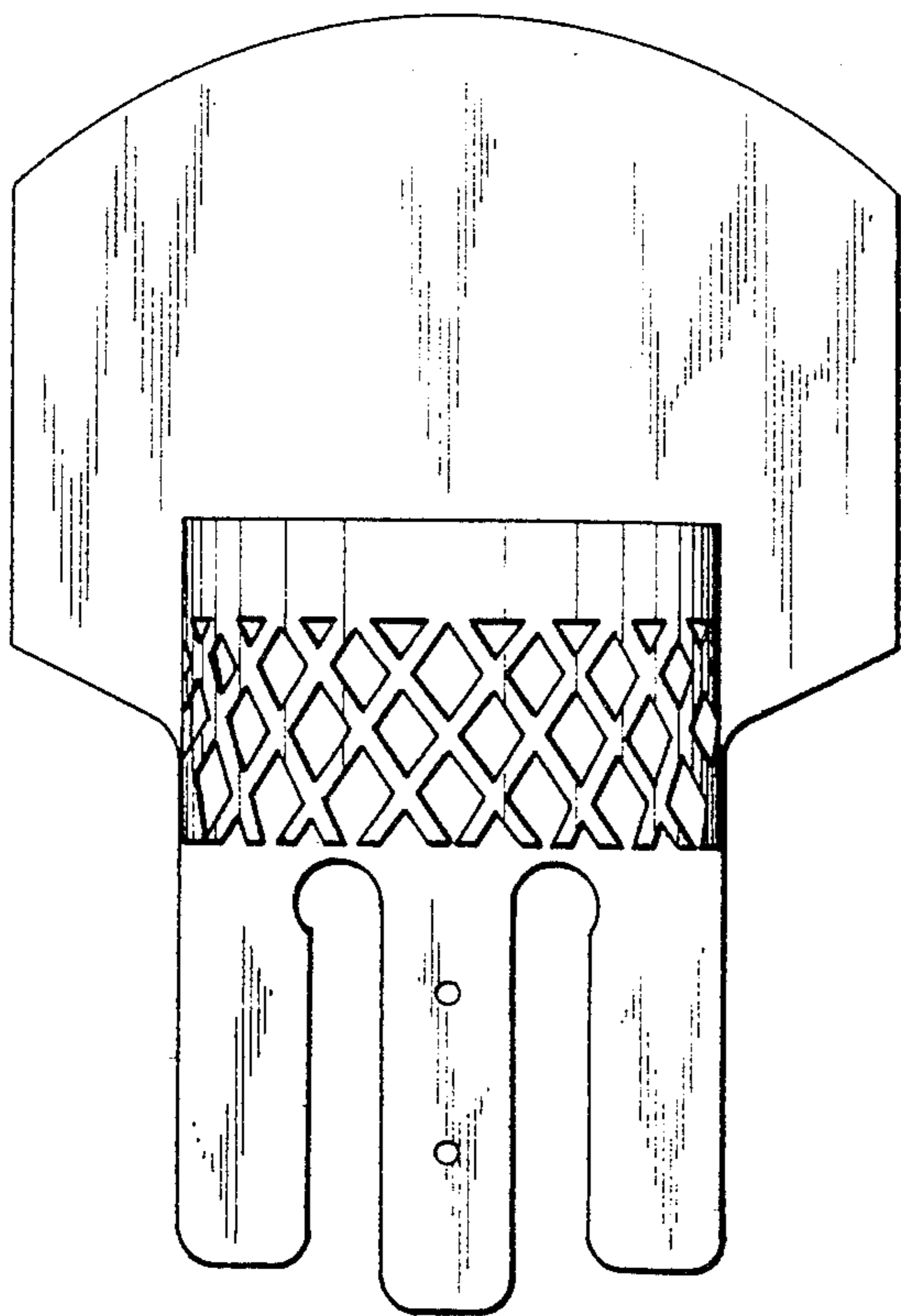

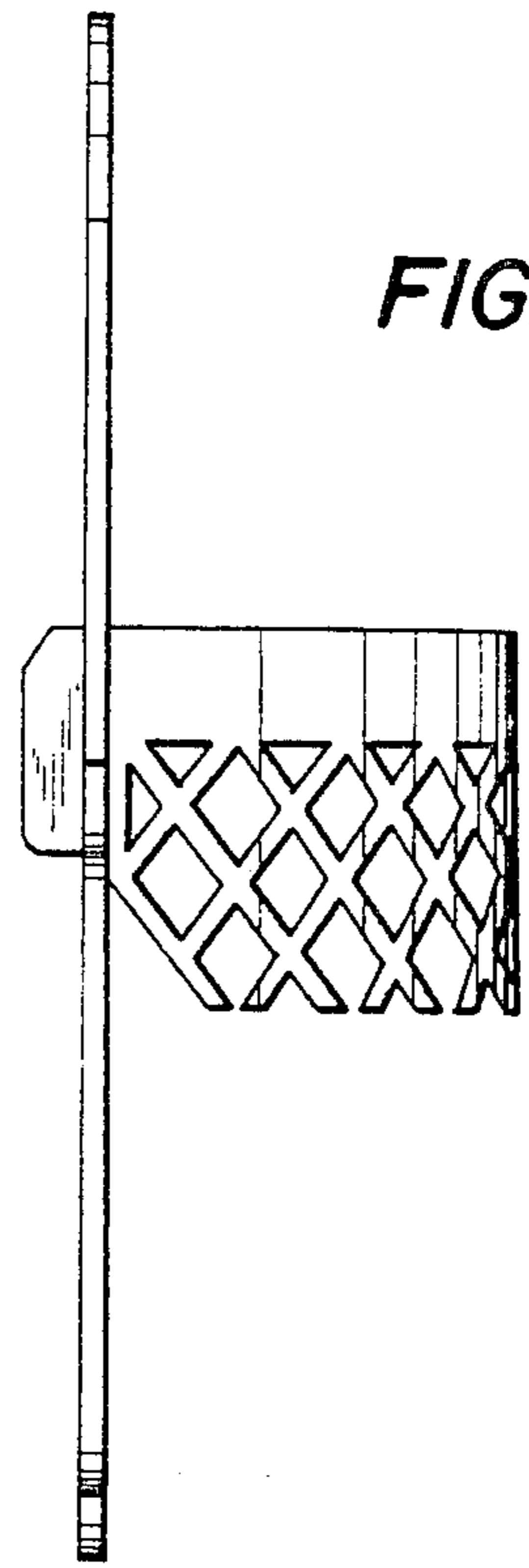

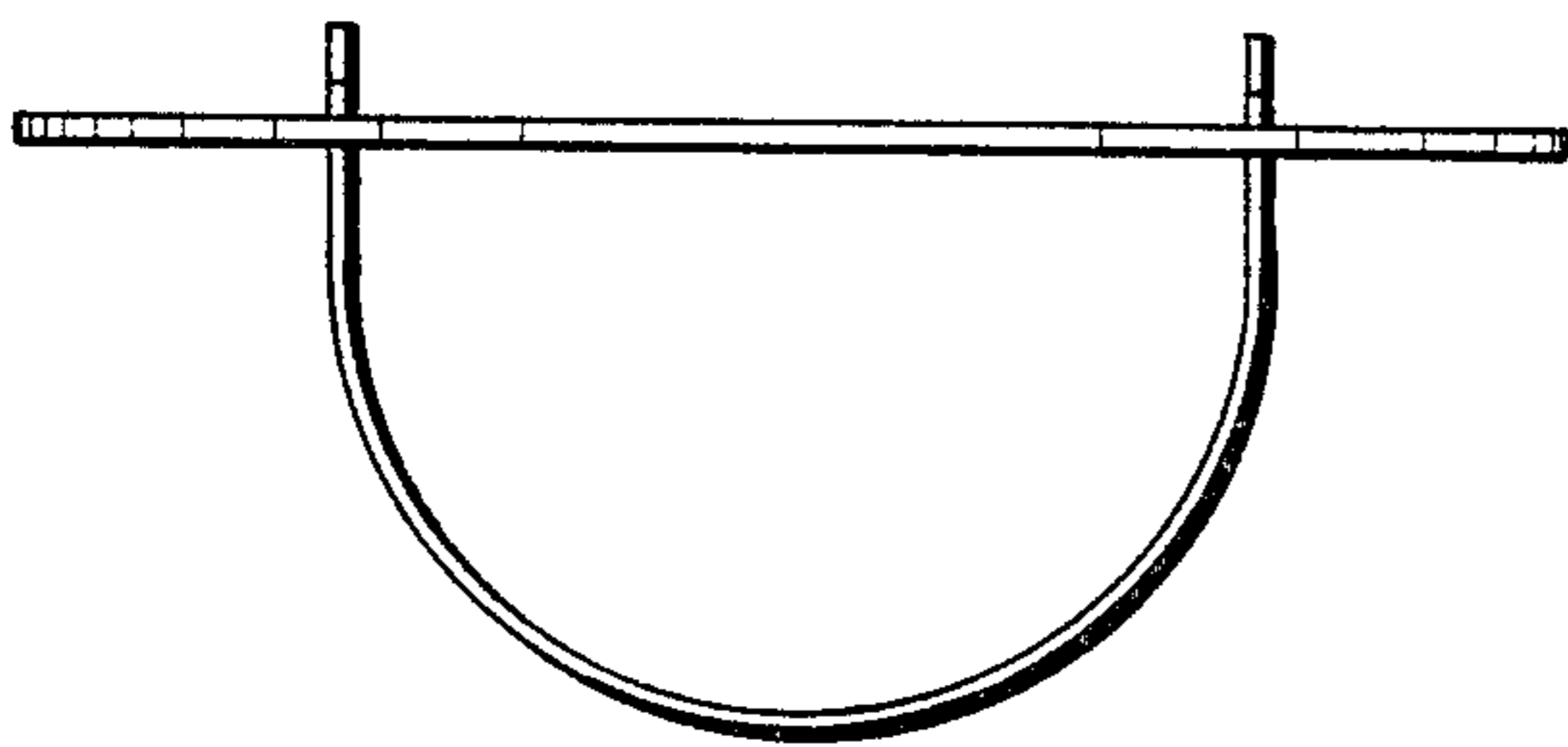

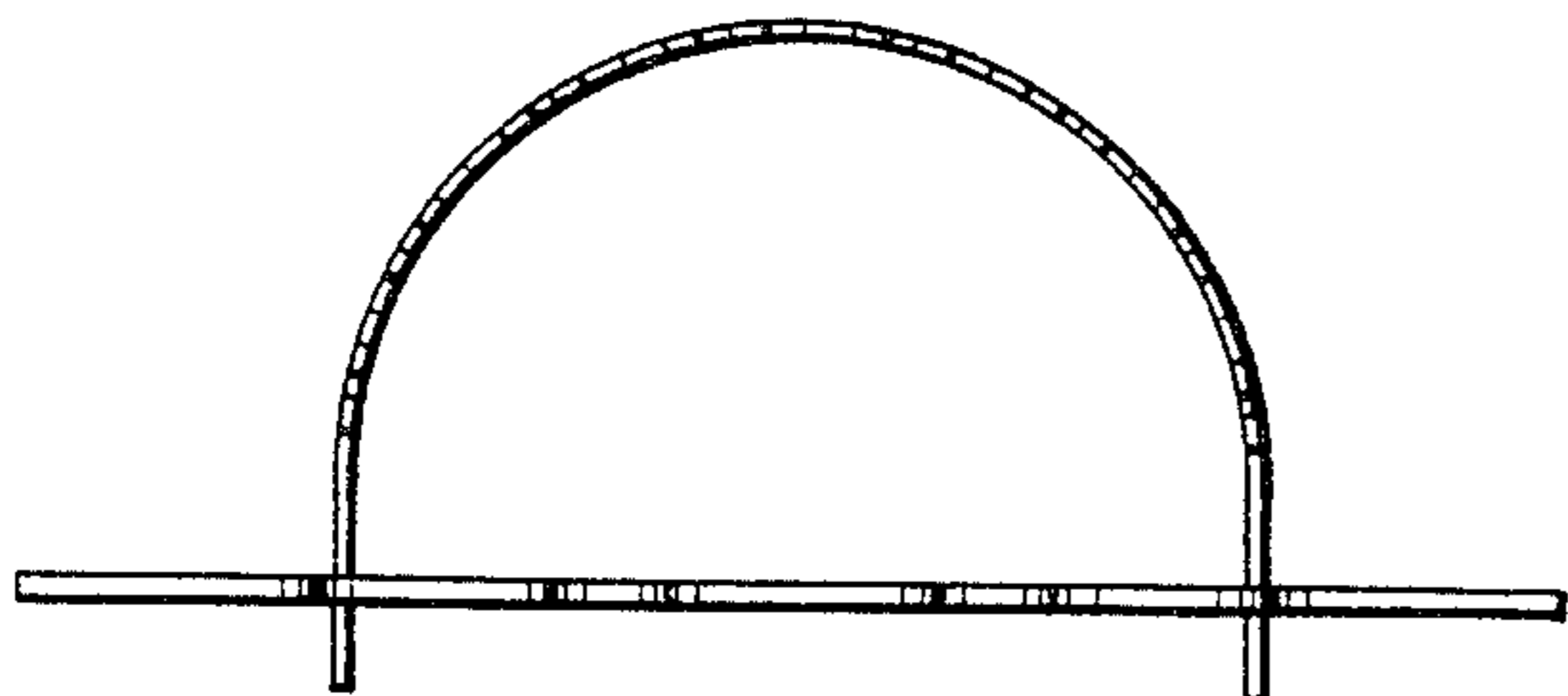

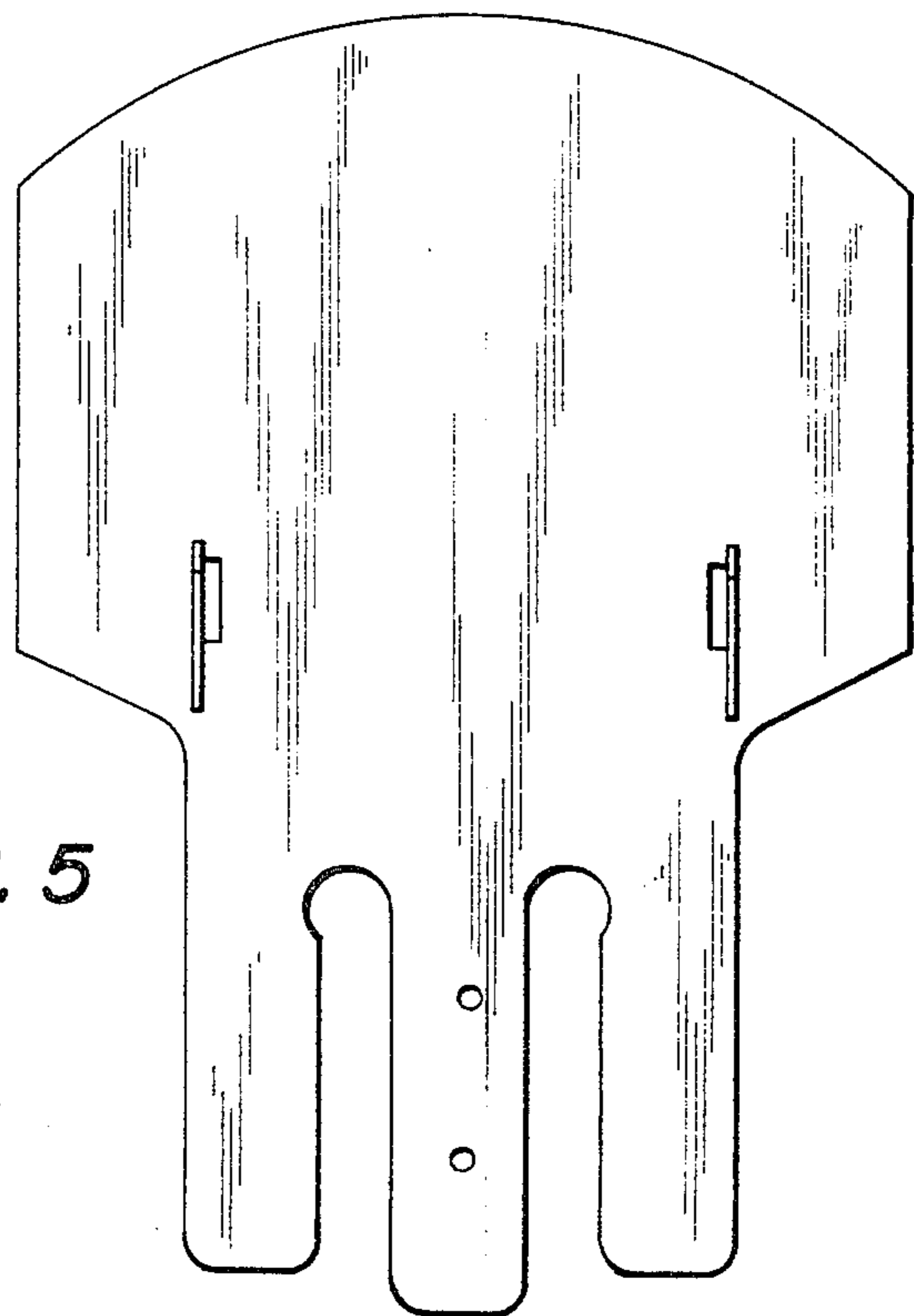
