FIG. 3 is a plan view.

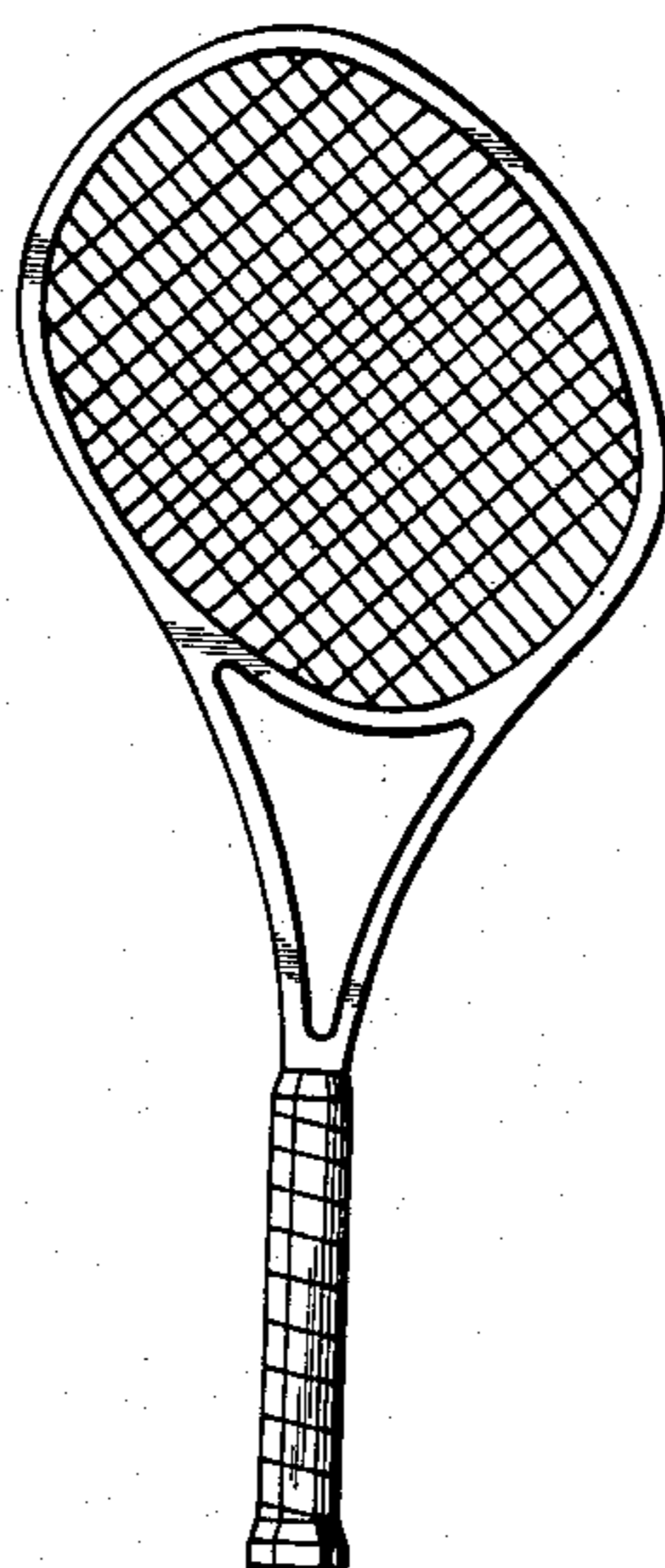

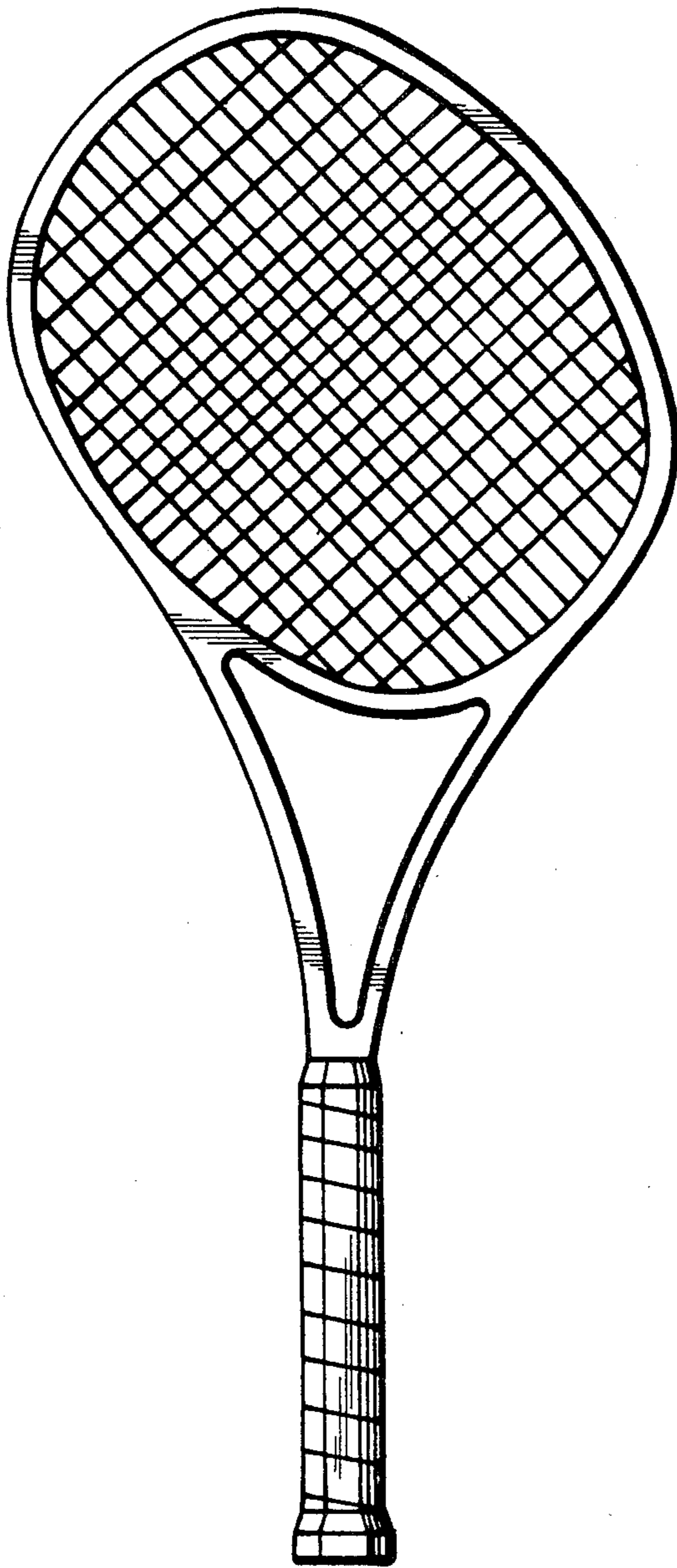

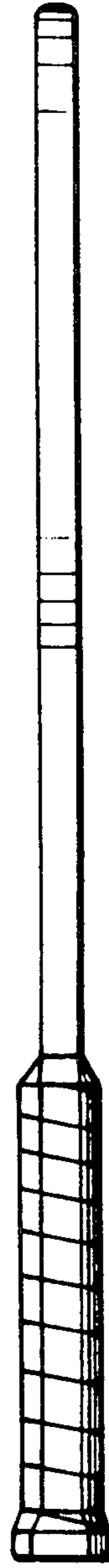
