[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a lavatory or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top and front of a lavatory or similar article embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image of the right side shown.

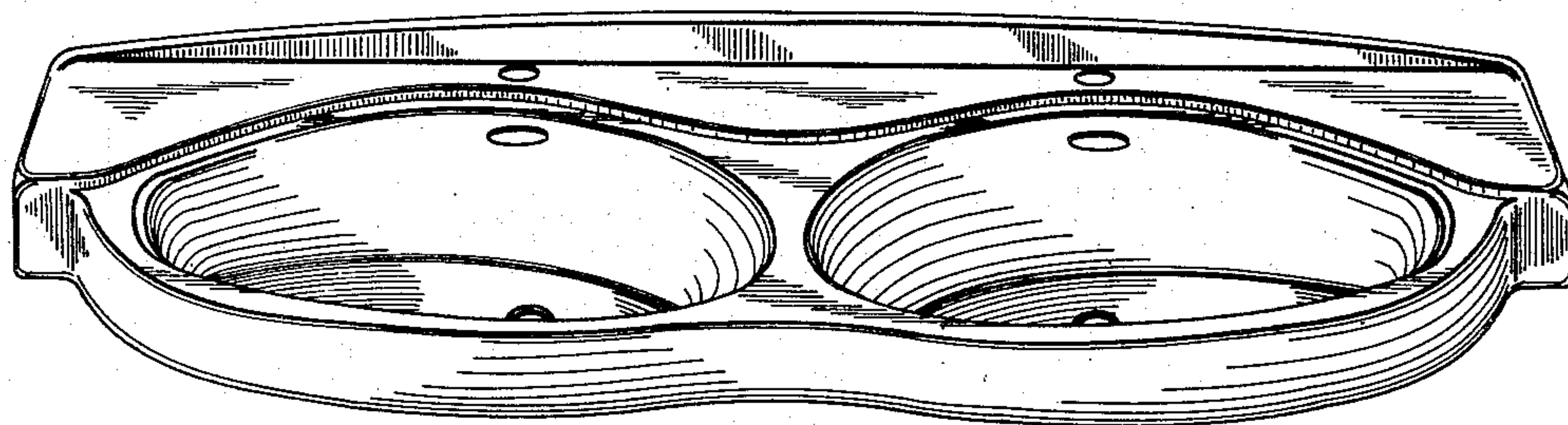

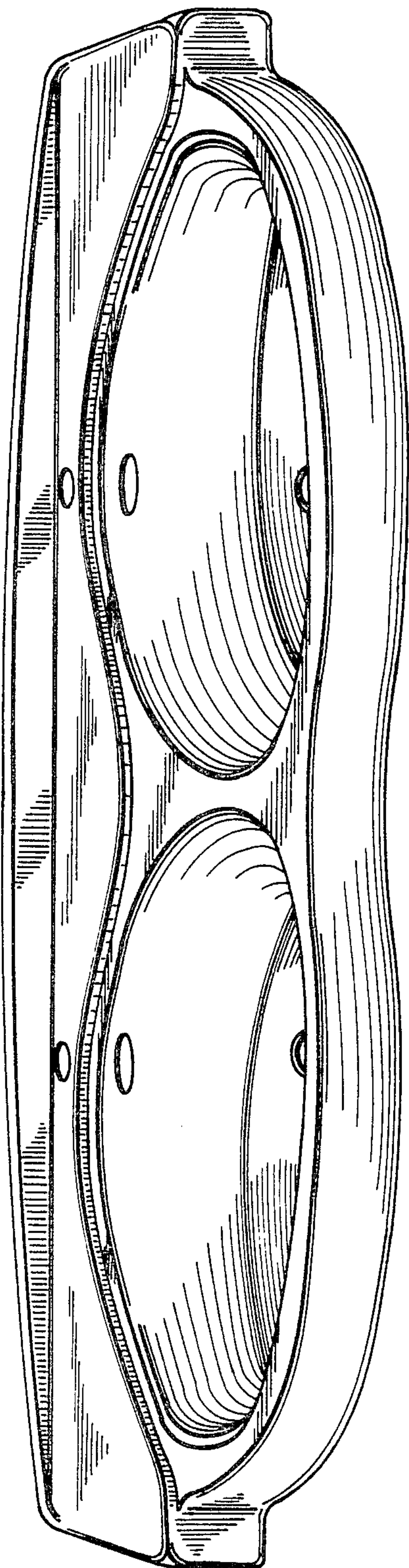

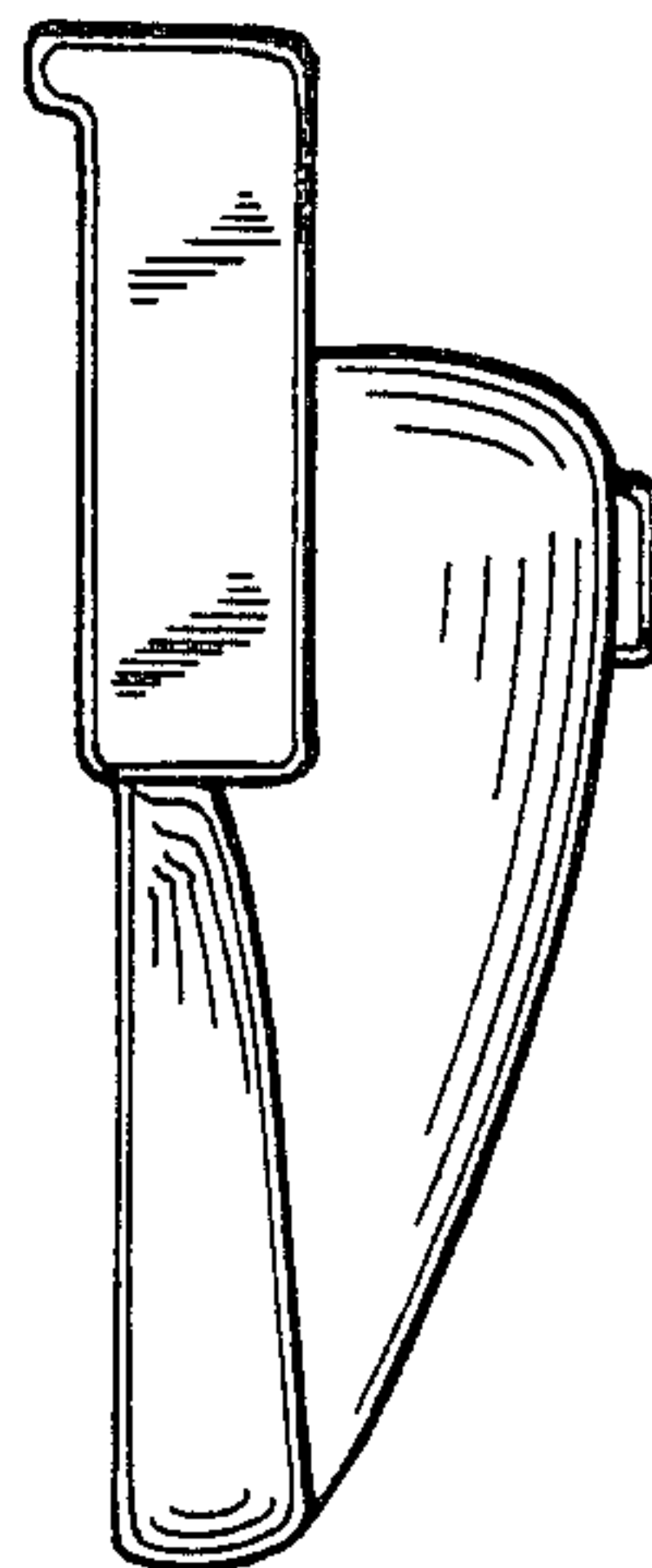

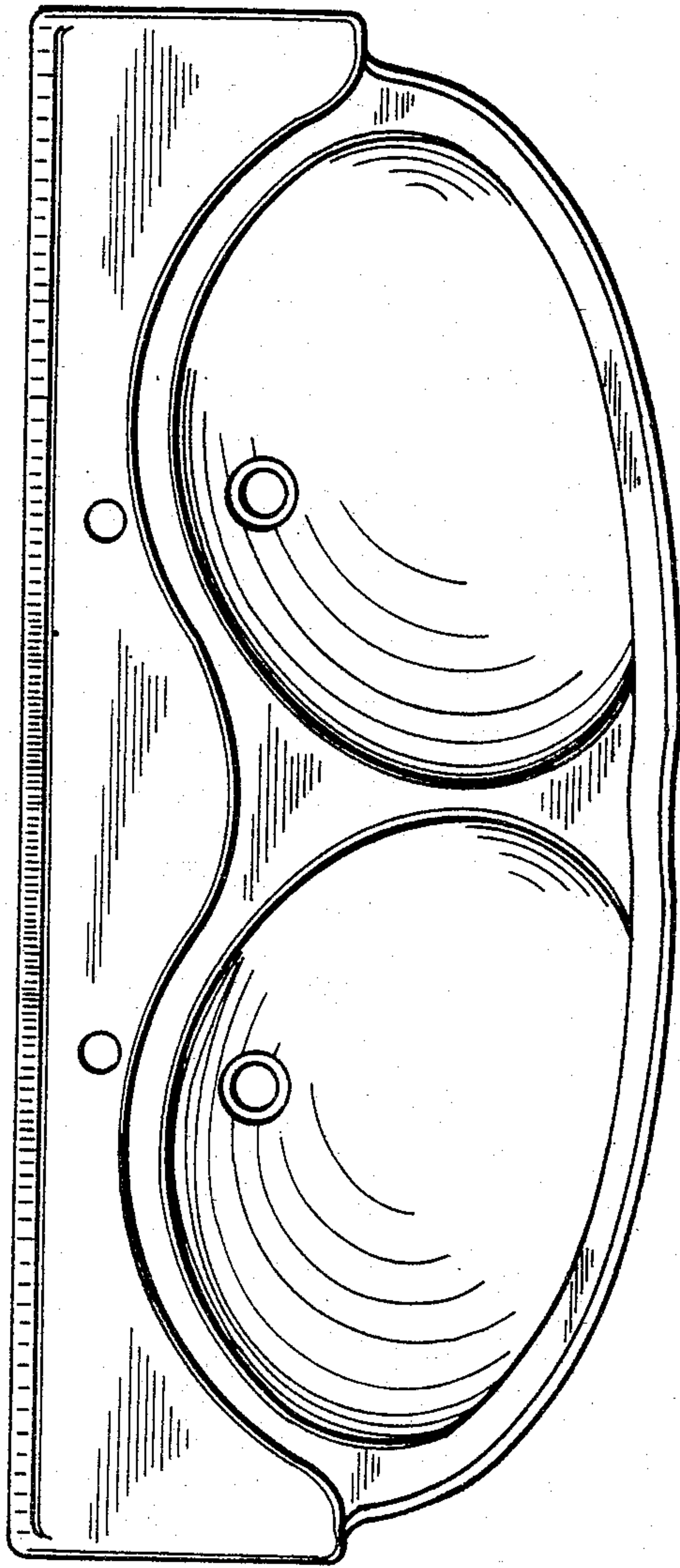
