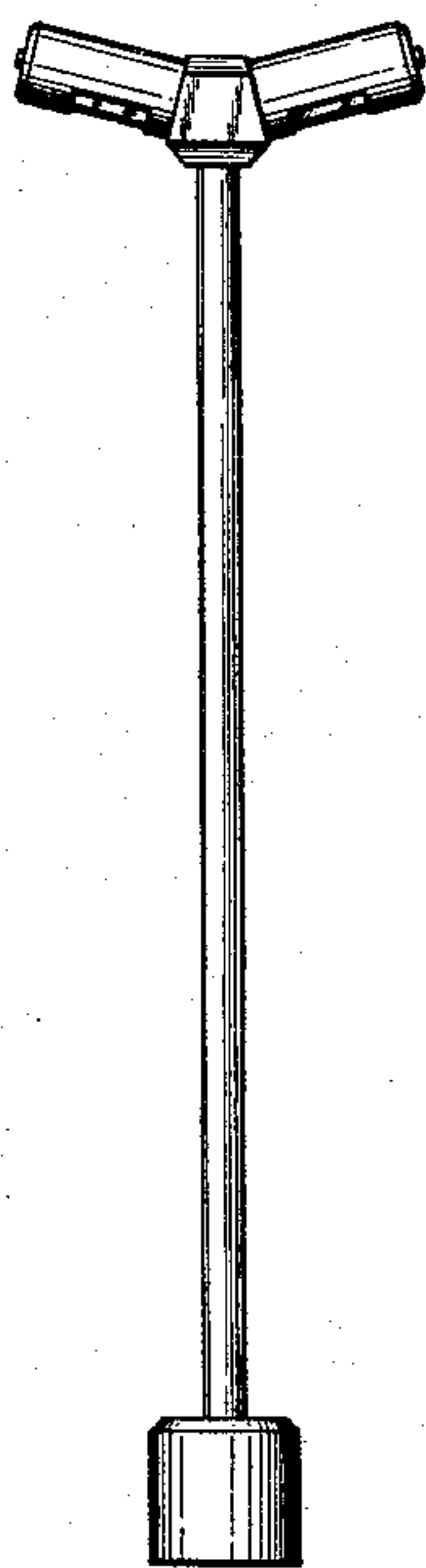

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a garden lighting fixture, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a garden lighting fixture showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevation thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevation thereof;
FIG. 4 is a fragmentary elevation of the side opposite that shown in FIG. 3, the lighting fixture being fragmentarily shown for convenience of illustration;
FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof.



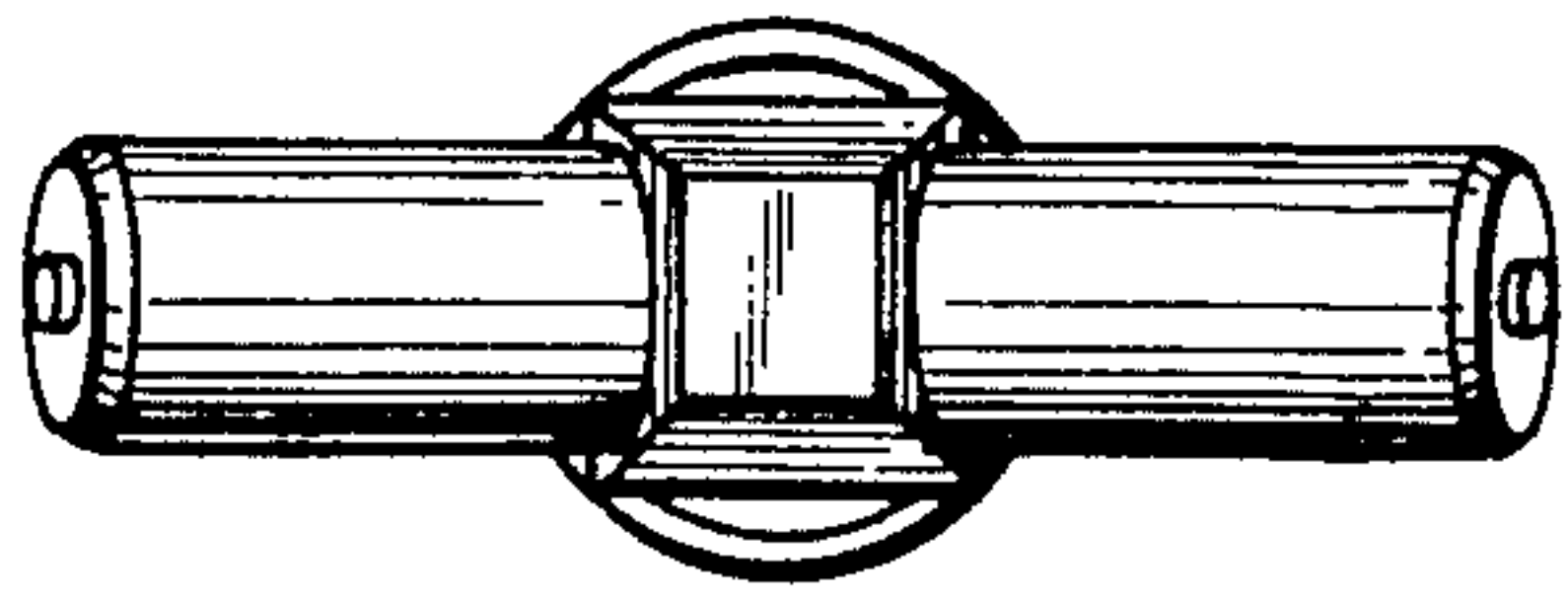

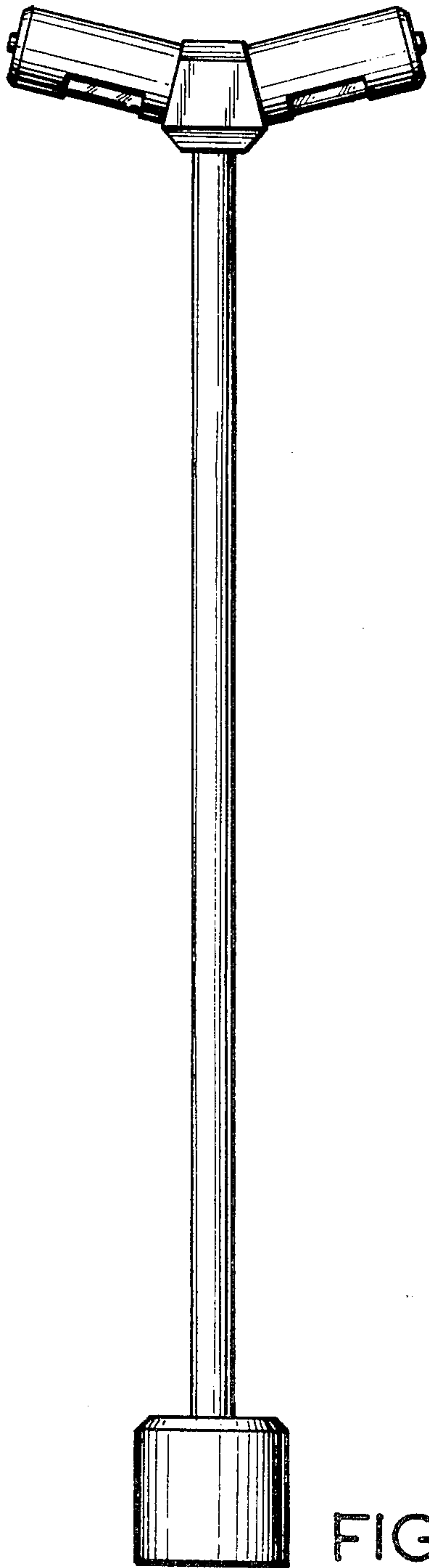

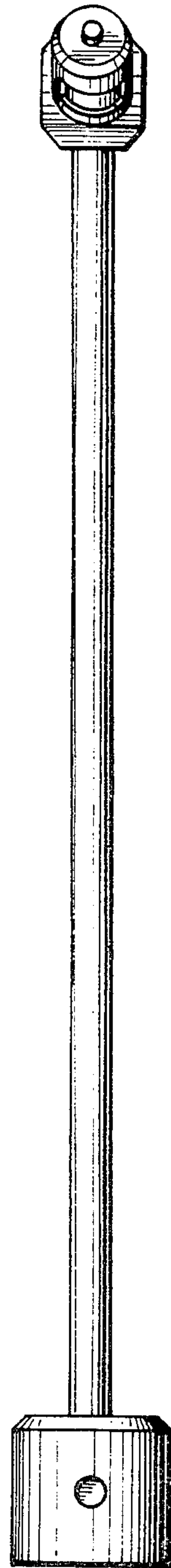

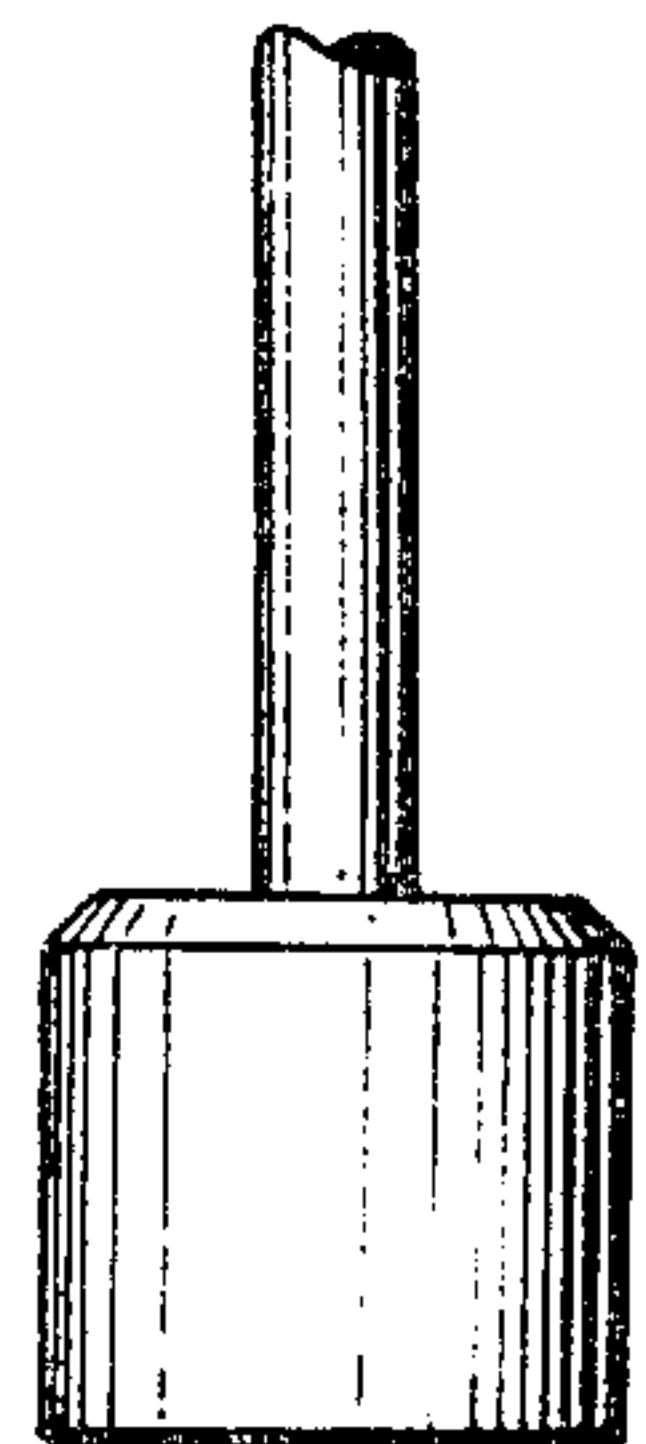

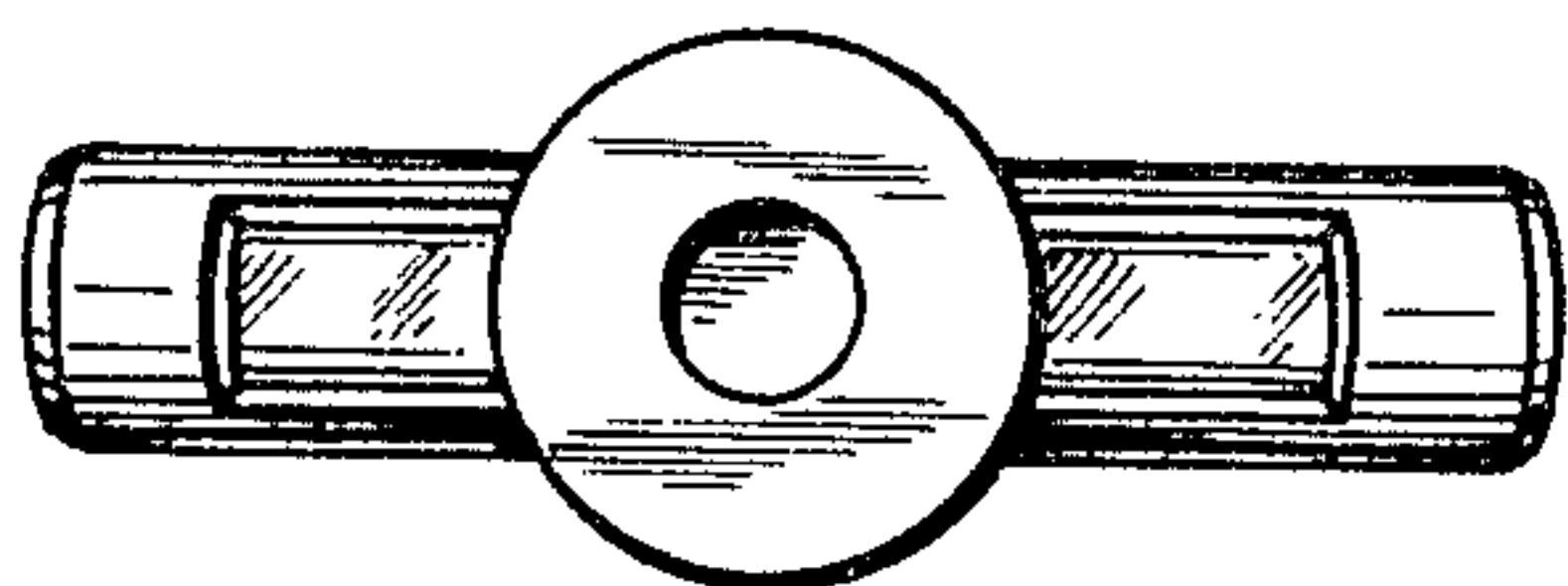
