[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a hanger bracket and hook therefor, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a hanger bracket and hook therefor illustrating my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof; FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along lines 7—7 of FIG. 2.

The characteristic feature of my design resides in the flanged configuration of the hanger bracket structure and the configuration of the lower arm and the rounded projections thereon.

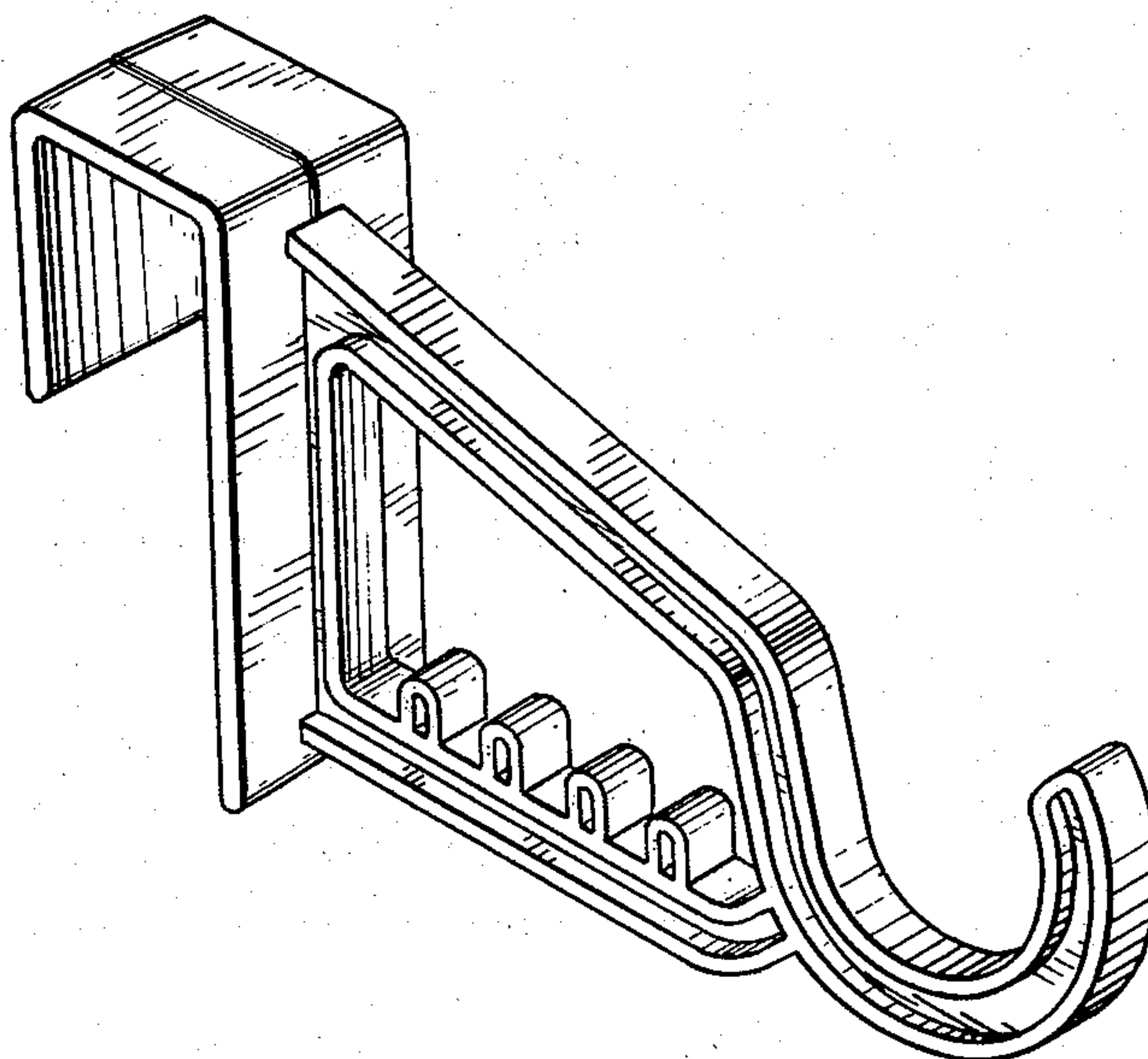

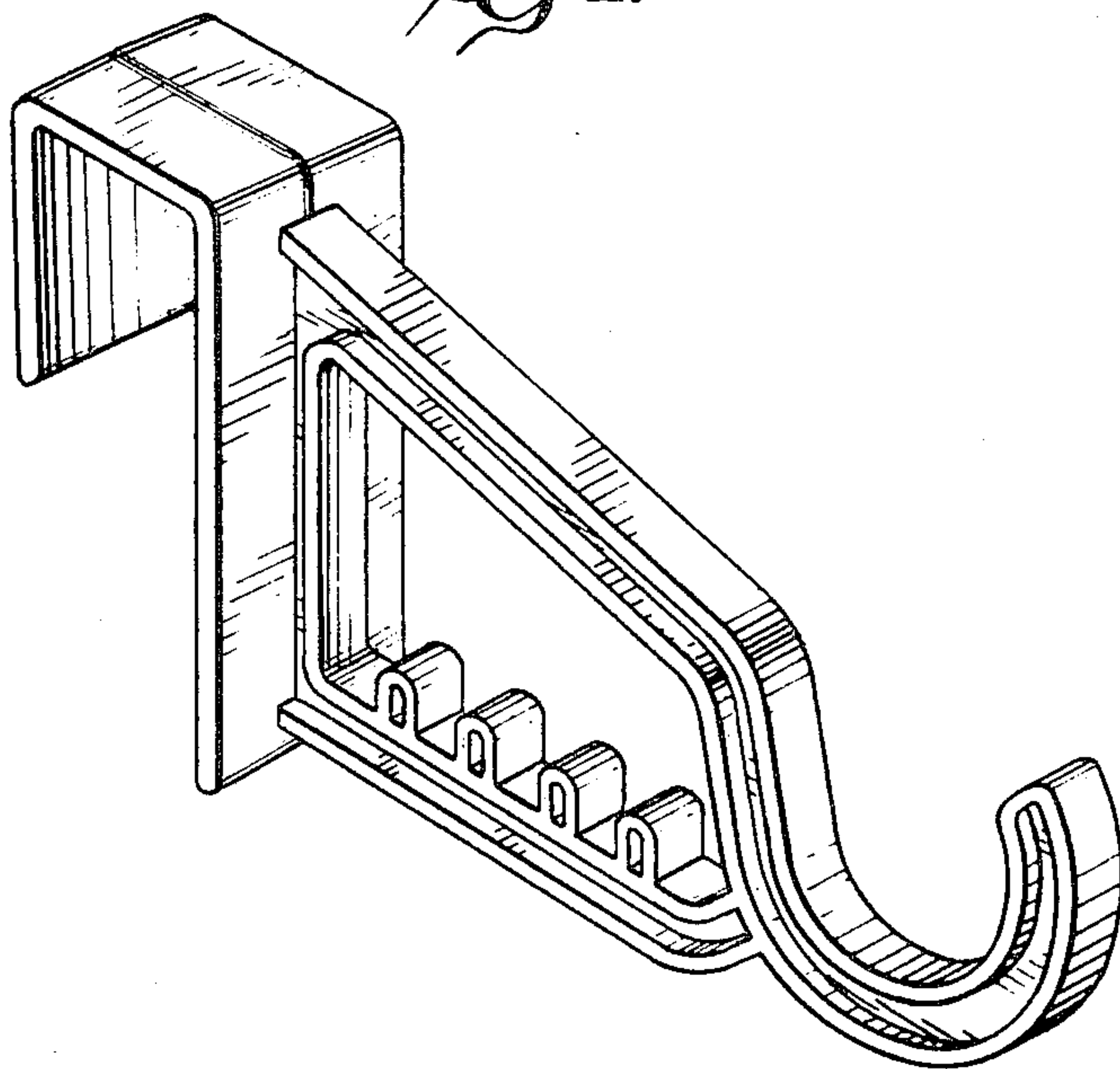

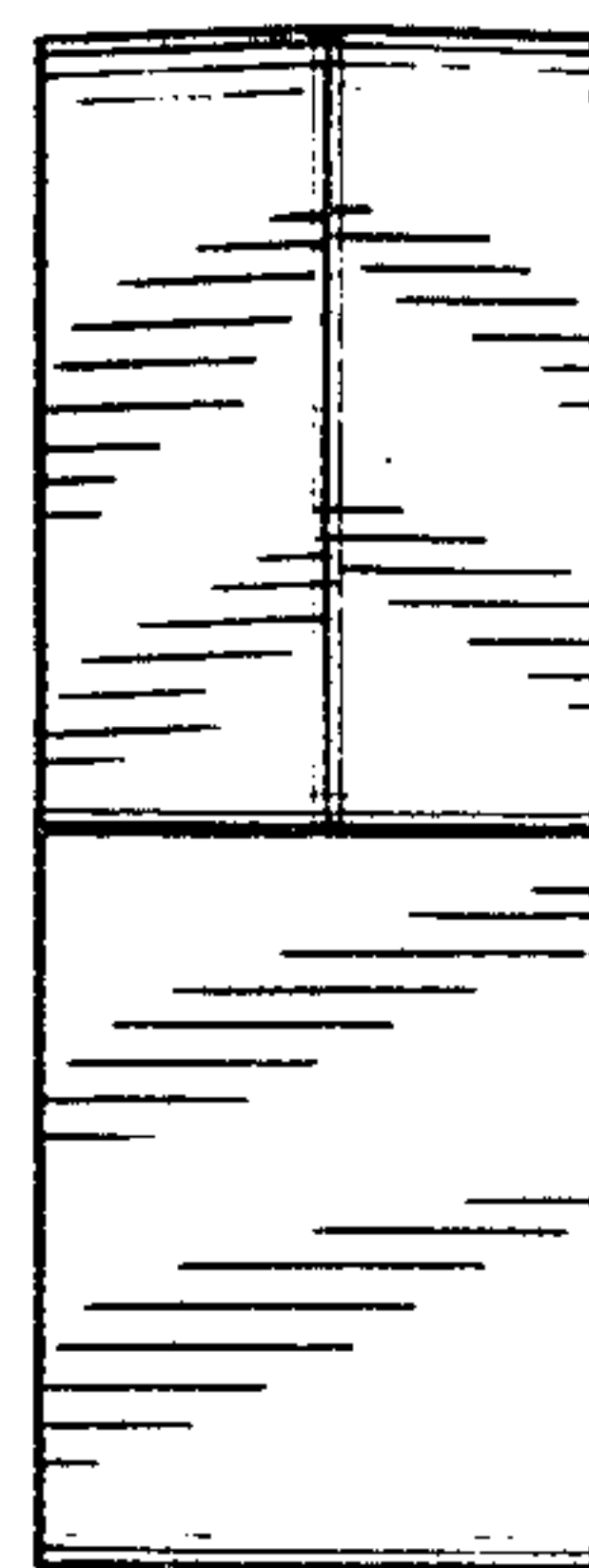

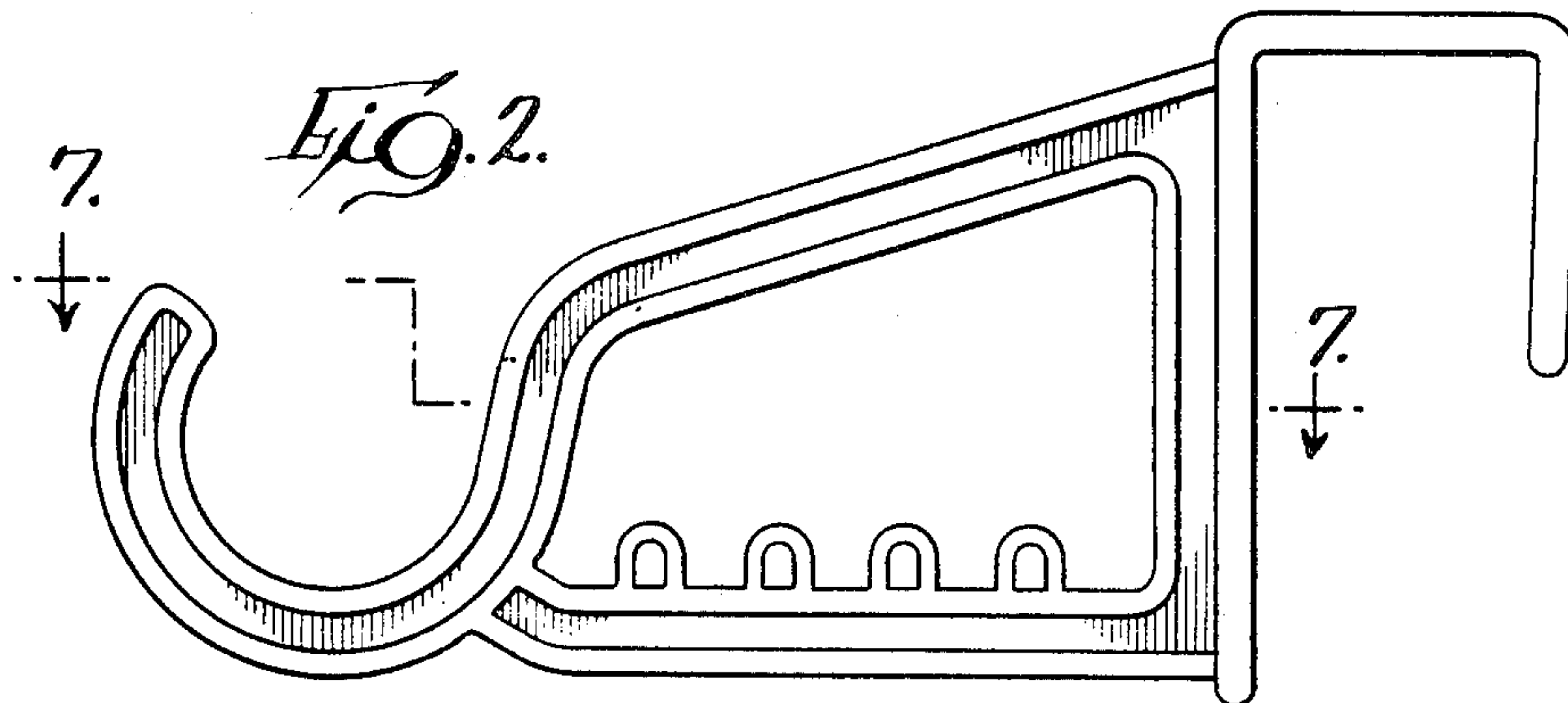

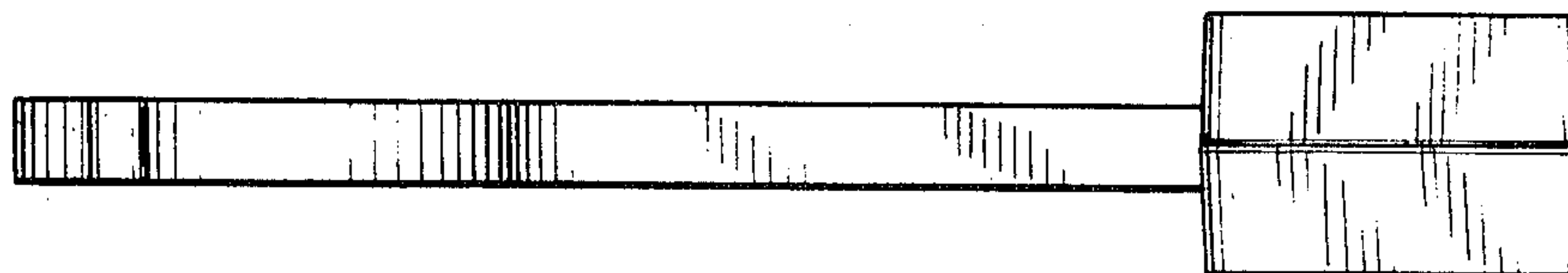

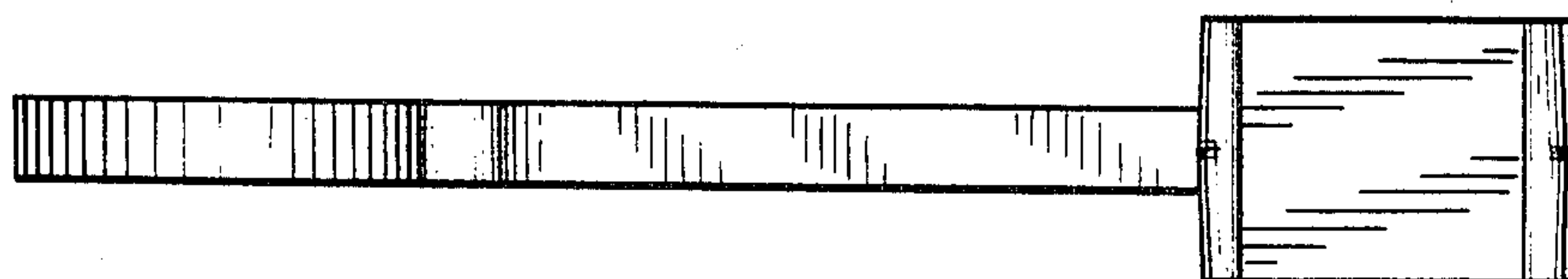
