The ornamental design for a bottle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a bottle embodying our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof looking from the left of FIG. 2;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof looking from the right of FIG. 2;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 2.
The rear elevational view of the bottle, not shown, is the mirror image of FIG. 2.

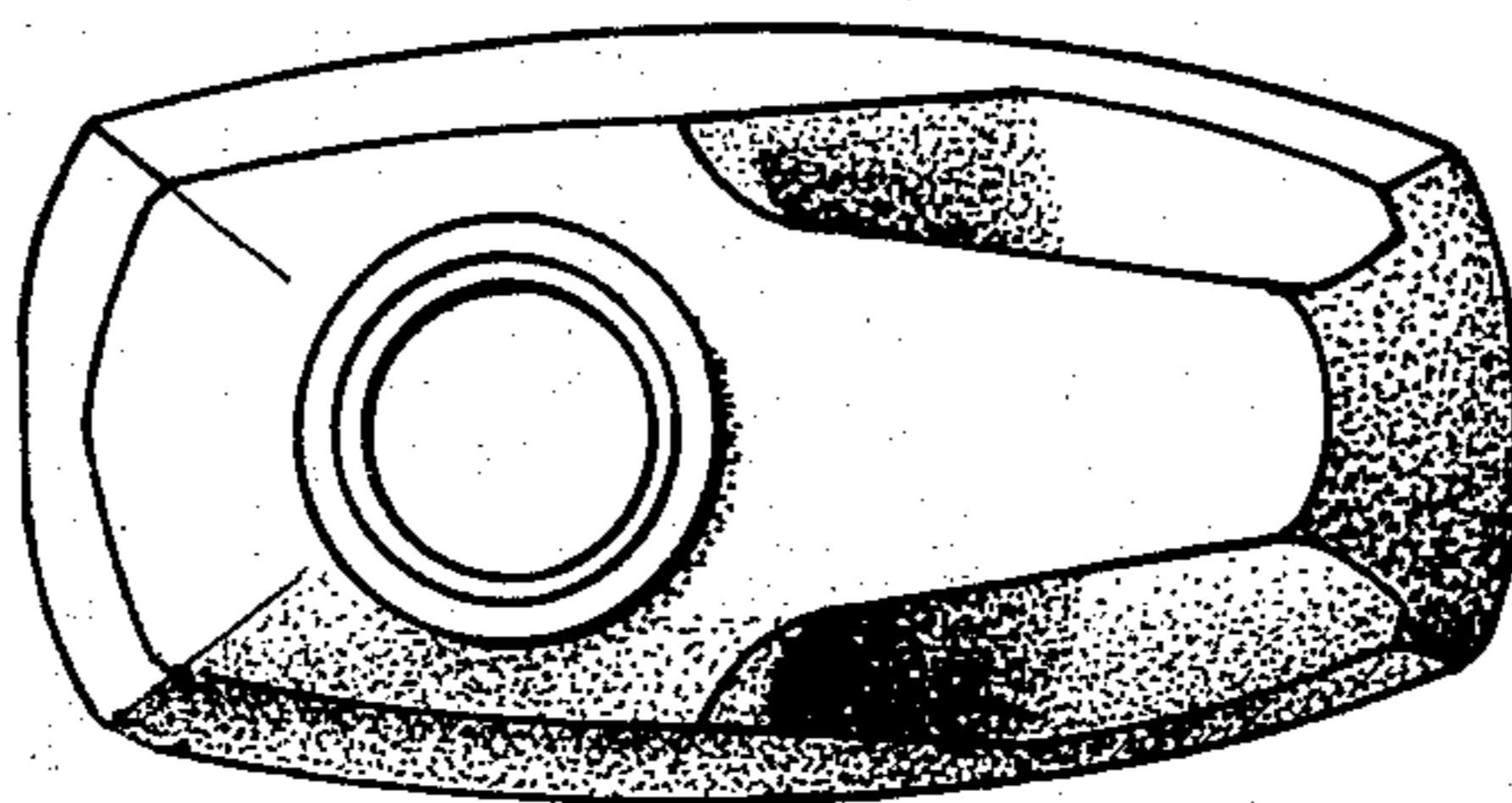

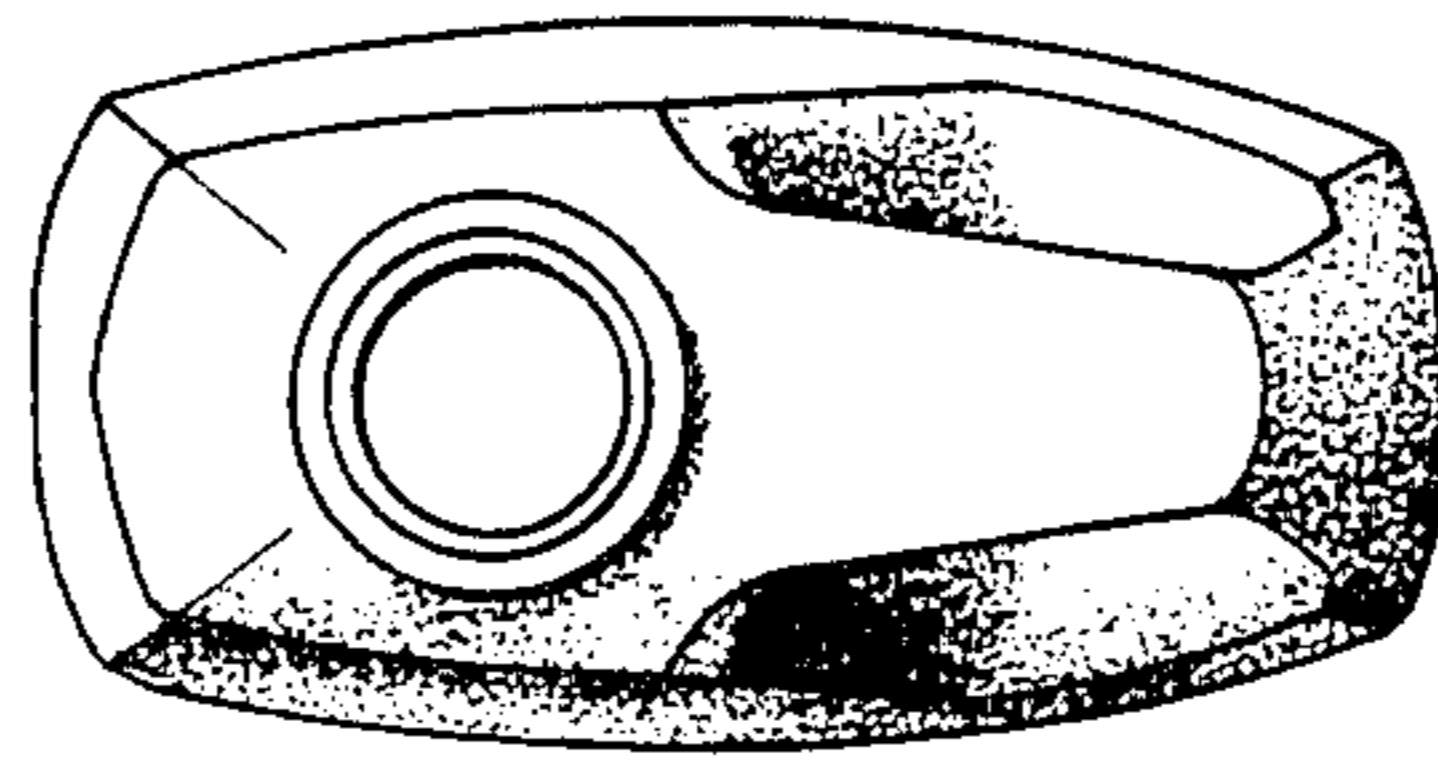

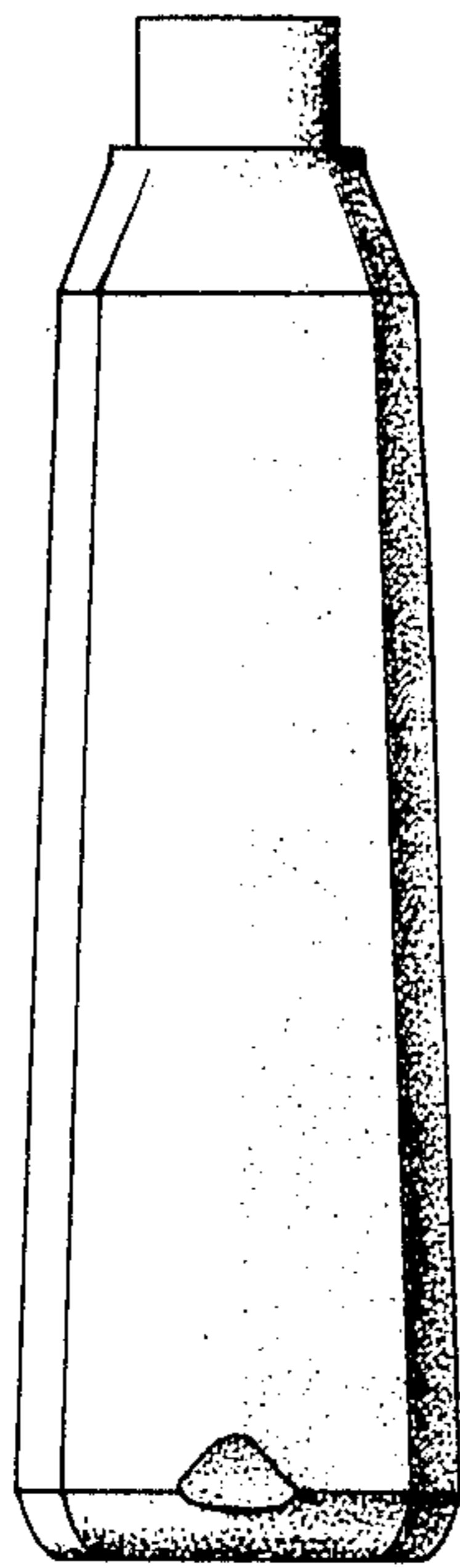

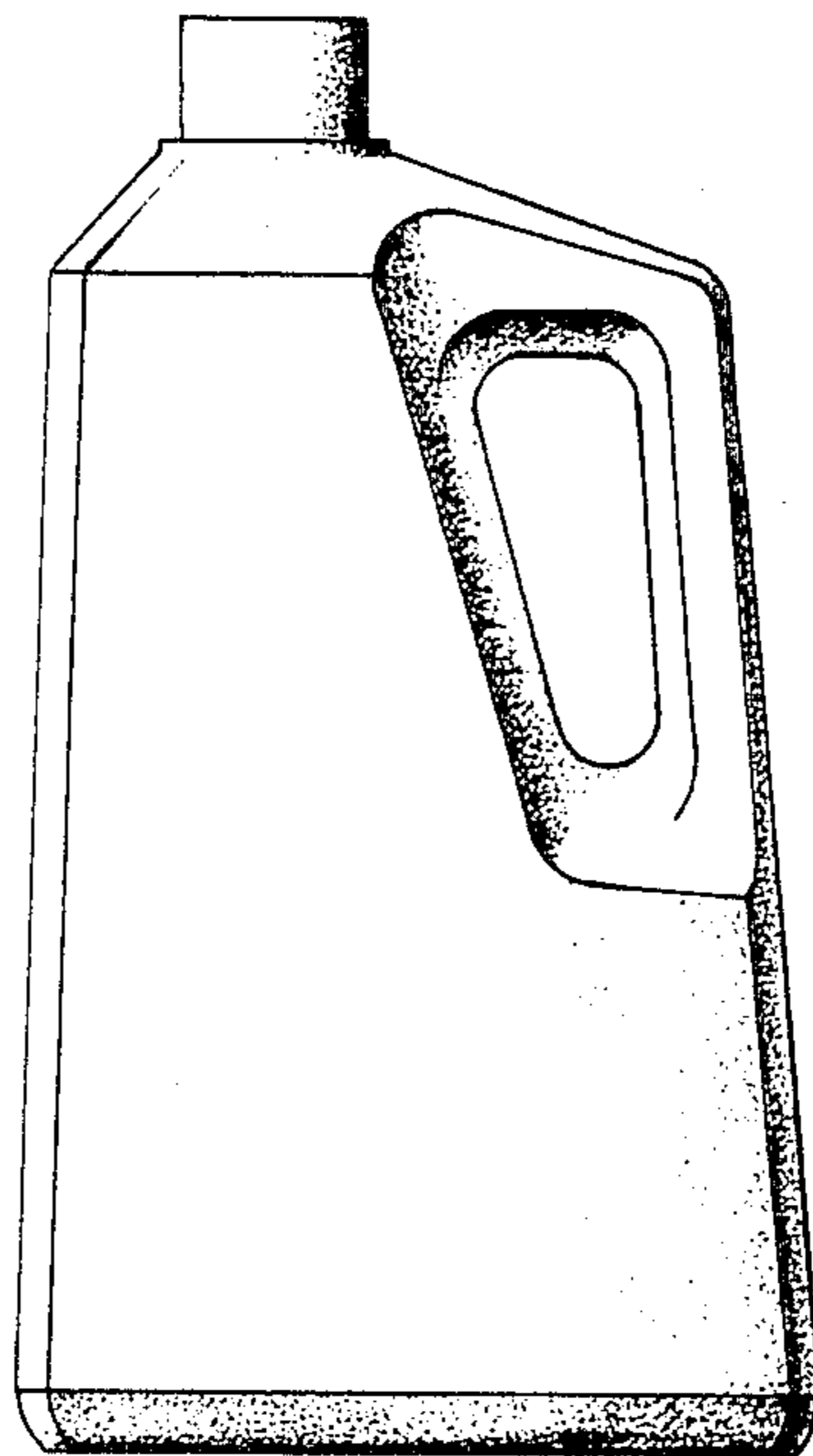

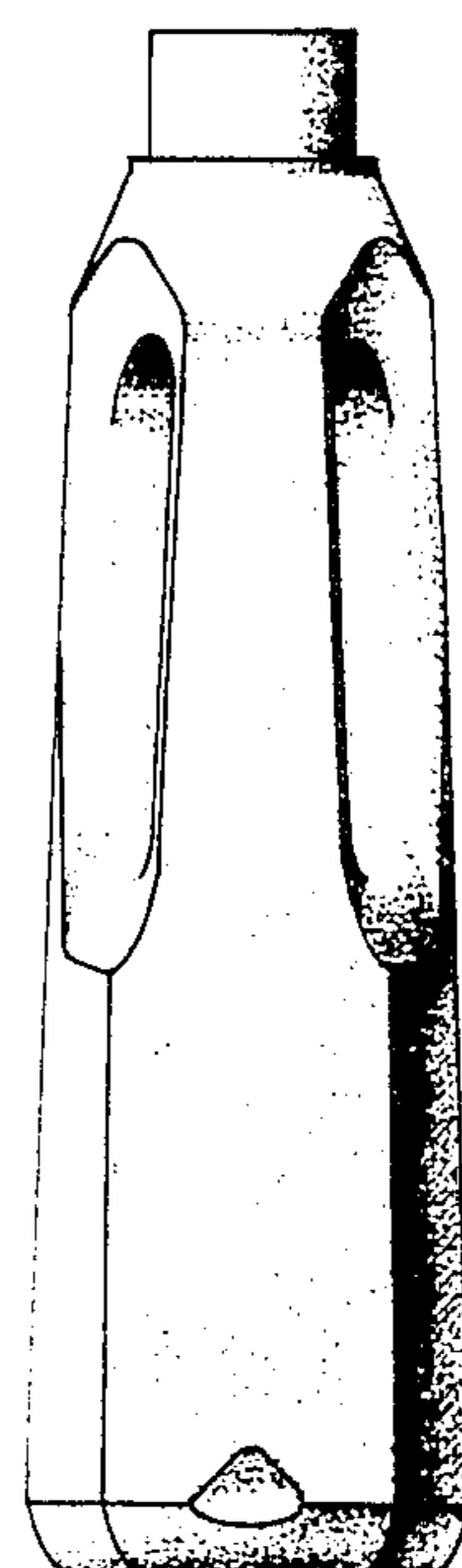
