[57] CLAIM

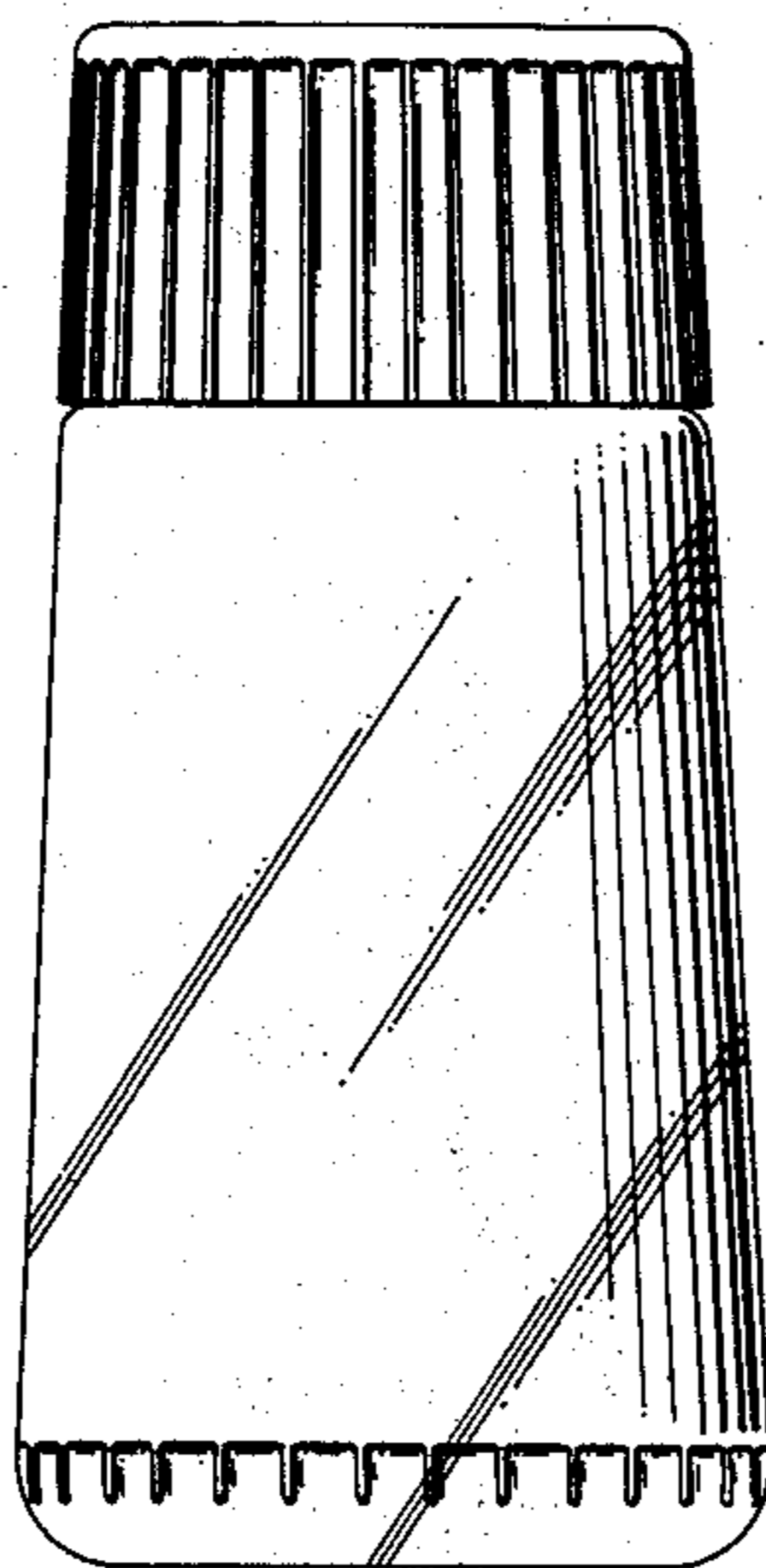
The ornamental design for a jar or the like, as shown and described.

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof.



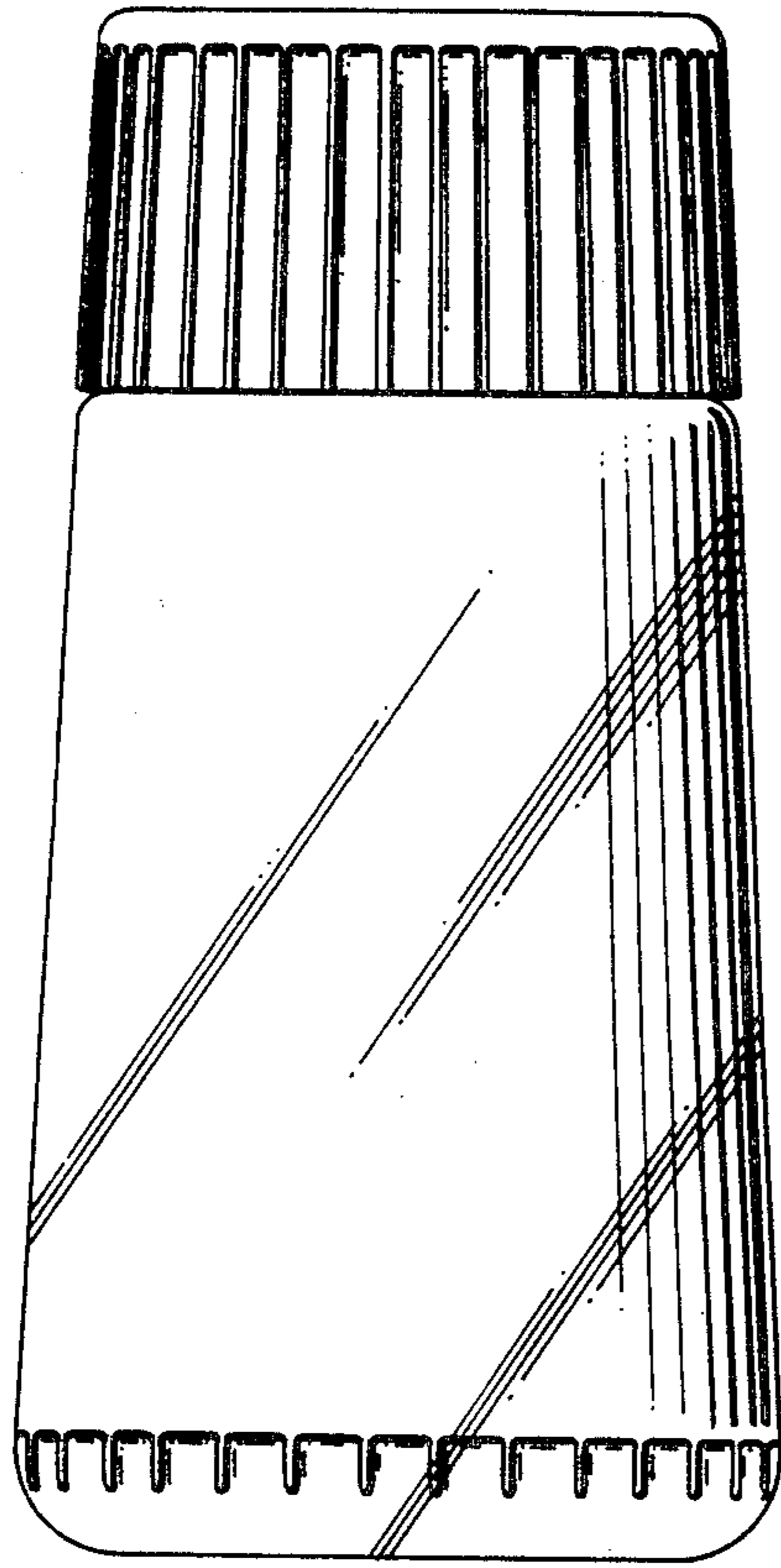

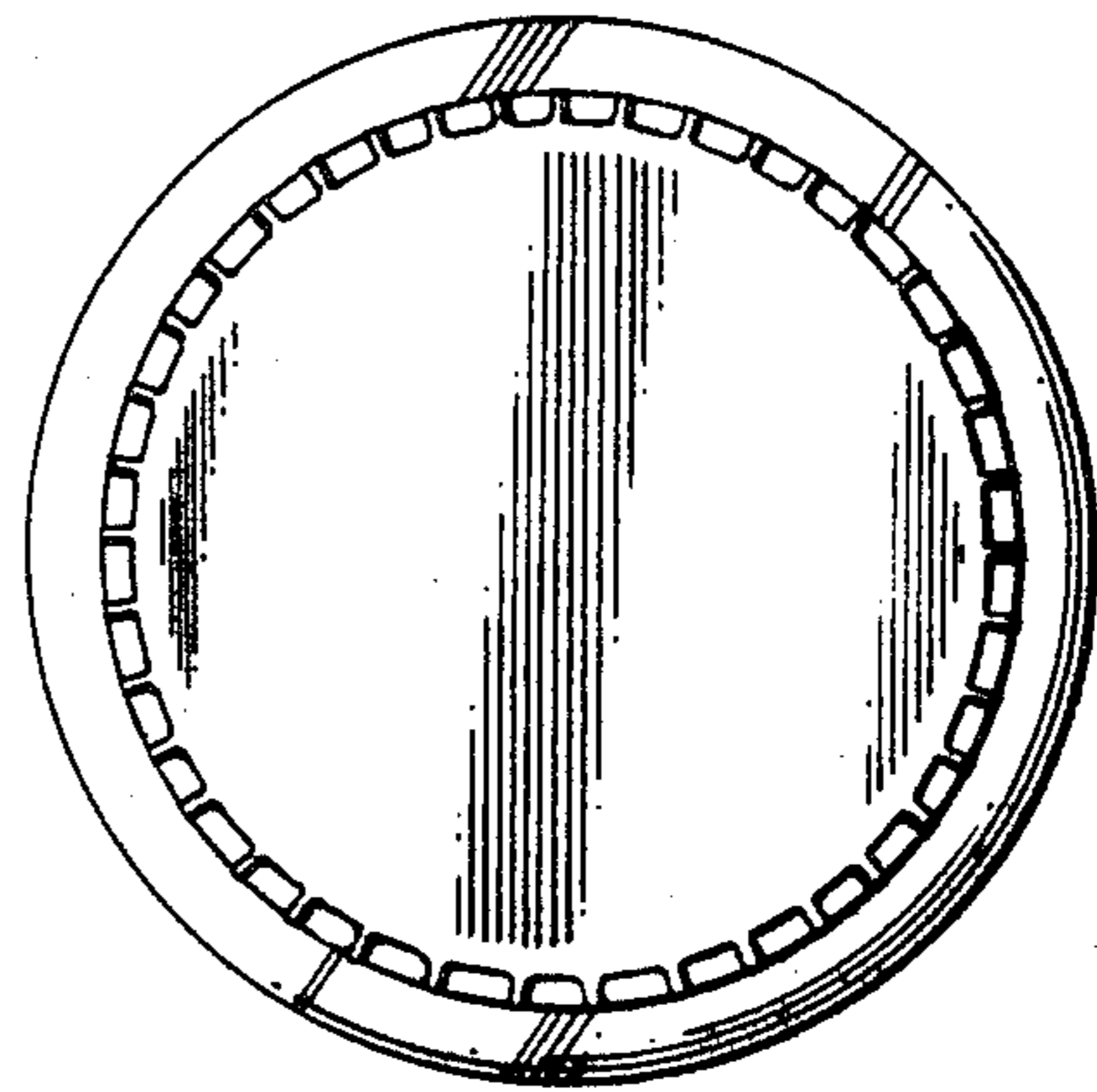

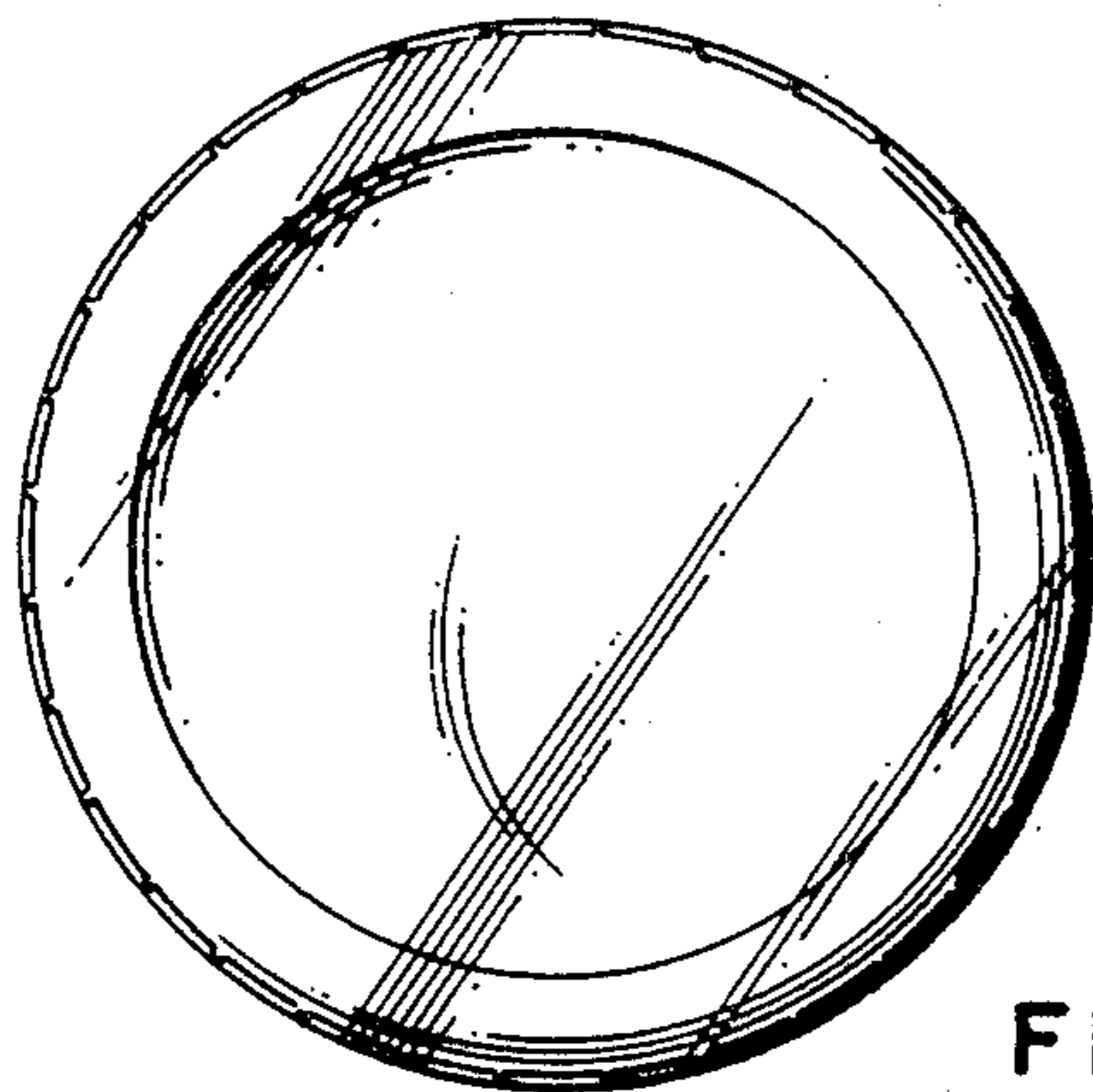
