DESCRIPTION

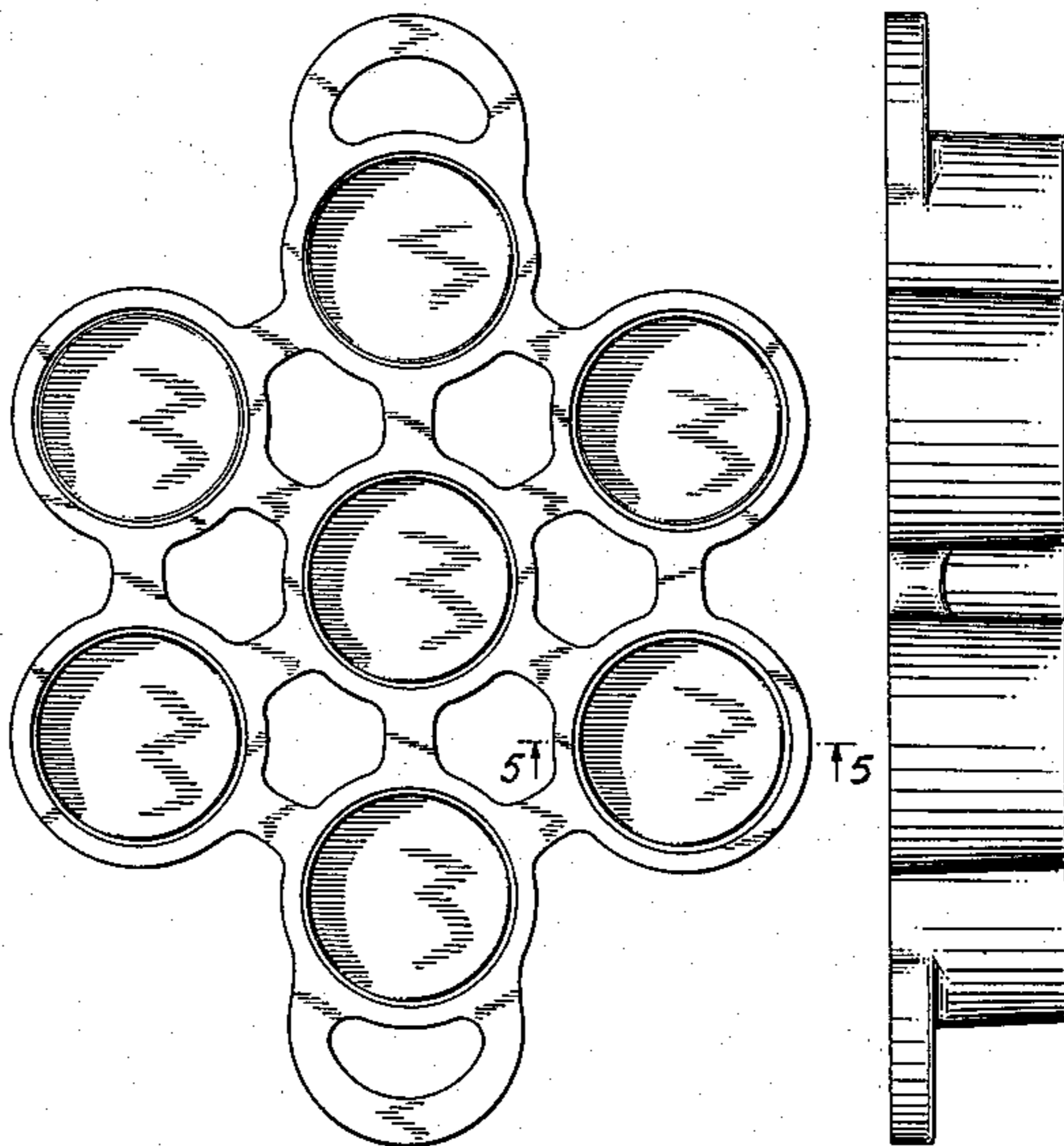
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a popover baking pan showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 1.



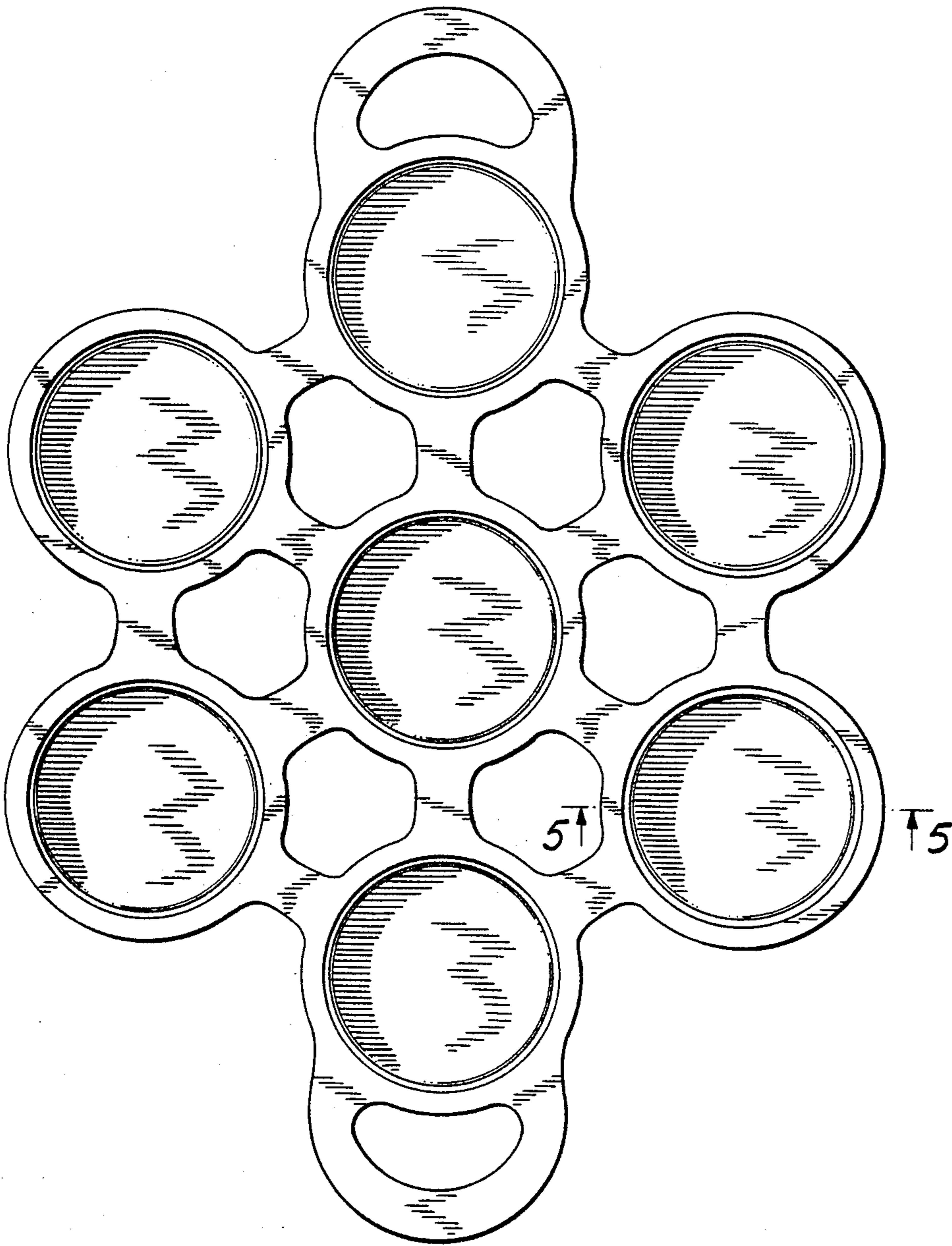

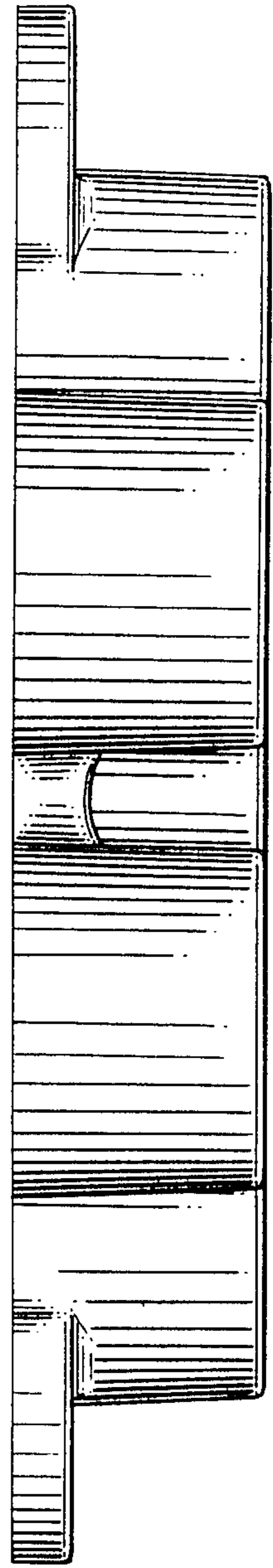

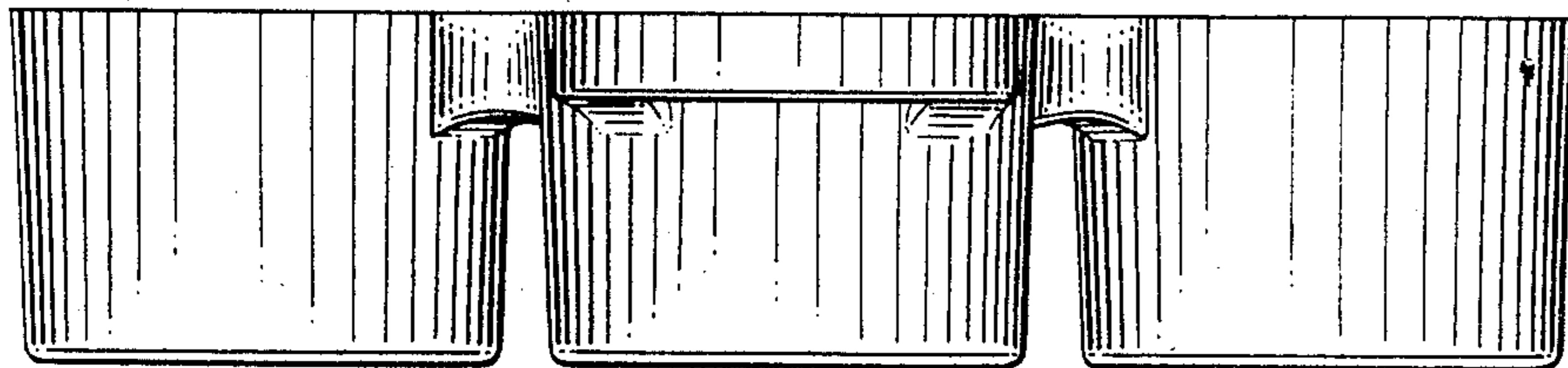

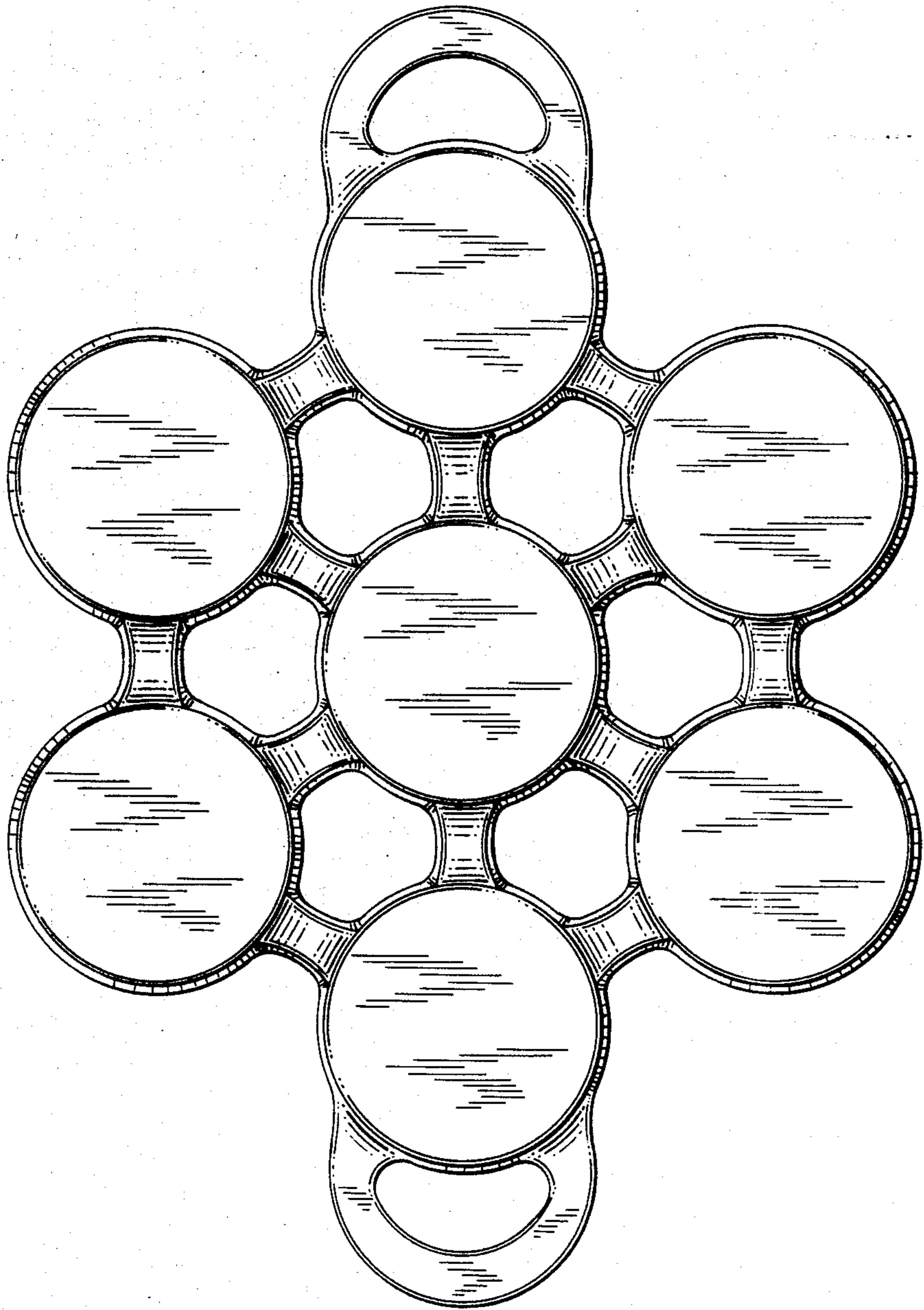

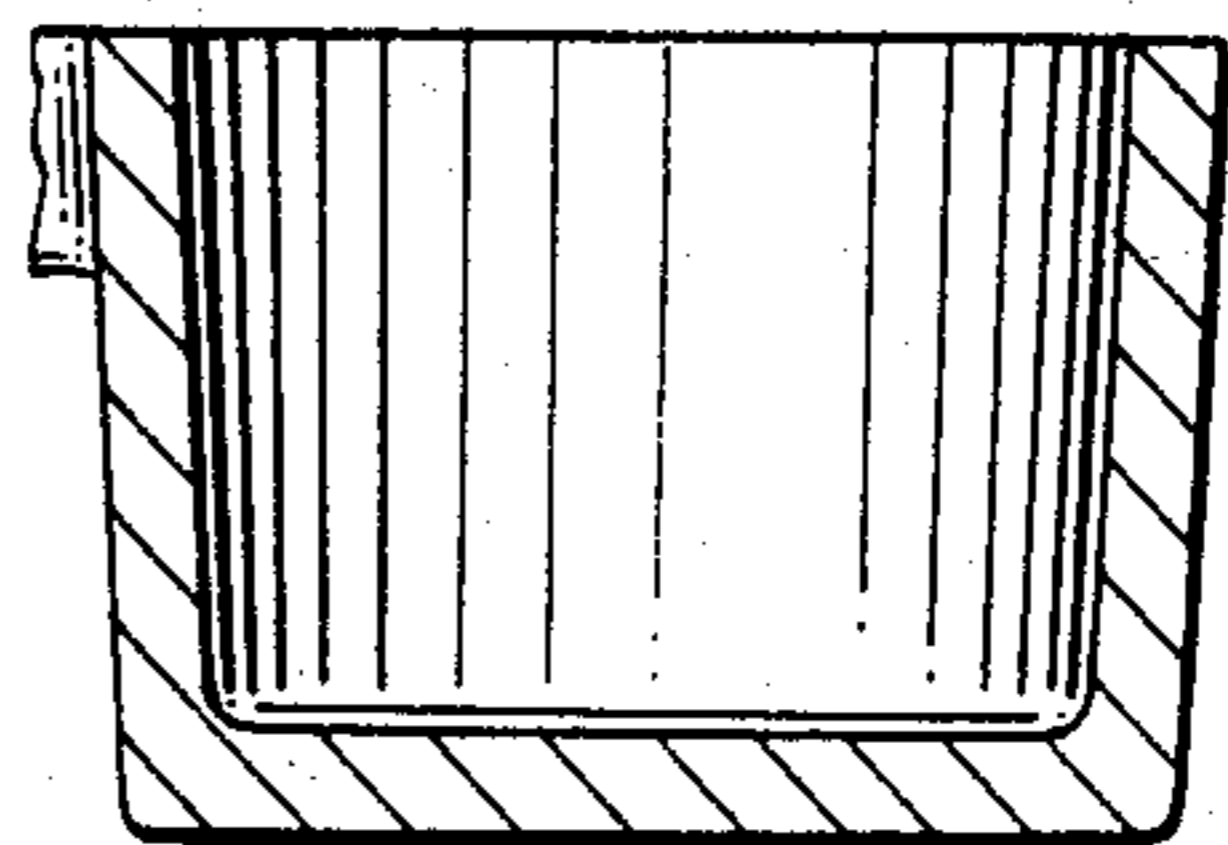
