[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a portable electronic calculator, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side view of a portable electronic calculator showing my new design, the broken line showing of a supporting surface being illustrative of environment only;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof taken along lines 2—2 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof taken along lines 3—3 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof taken along lines 5—5 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof taken along lines 6—6 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 7 is a top front right perspective view of the portable electronic calculator of FIG. 1 with the pivotable rear legs folded flat; and
FIG. 8 is a top front right perspective view of the portable electronic calculator of FIG. 1 with the portable rear legs folded flat, the cover member in position on the top thereof and the retractable handle of the calculator extended.

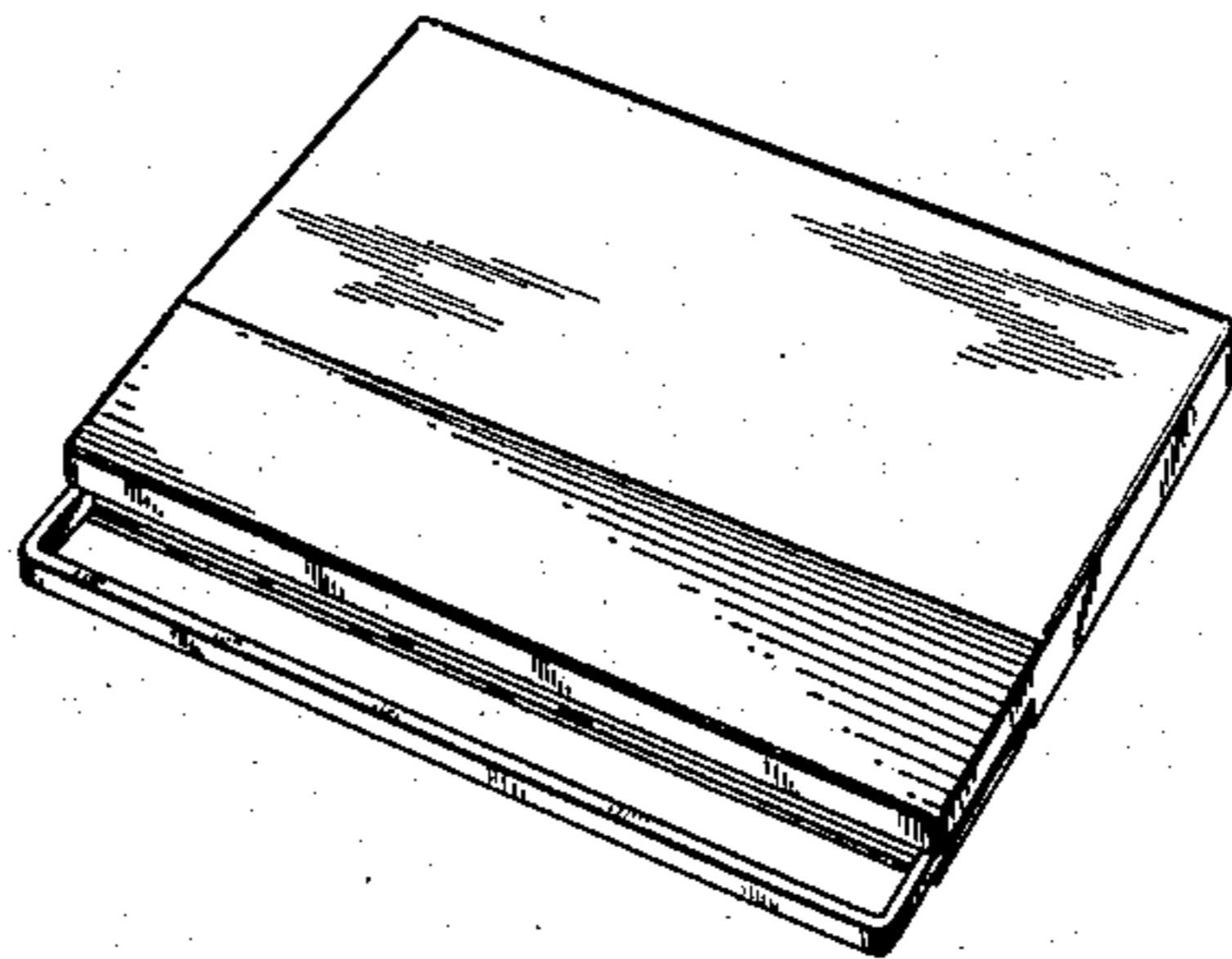
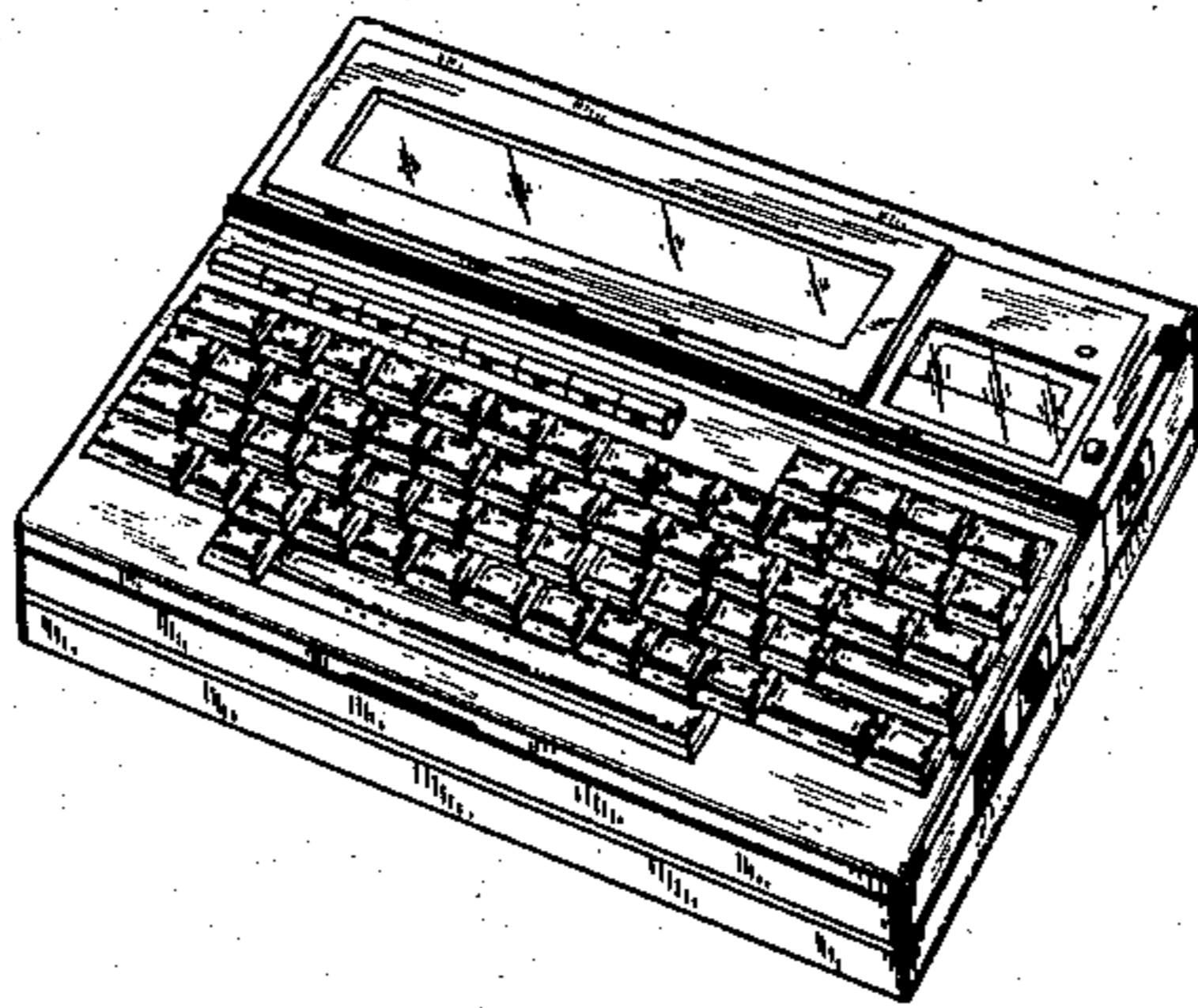

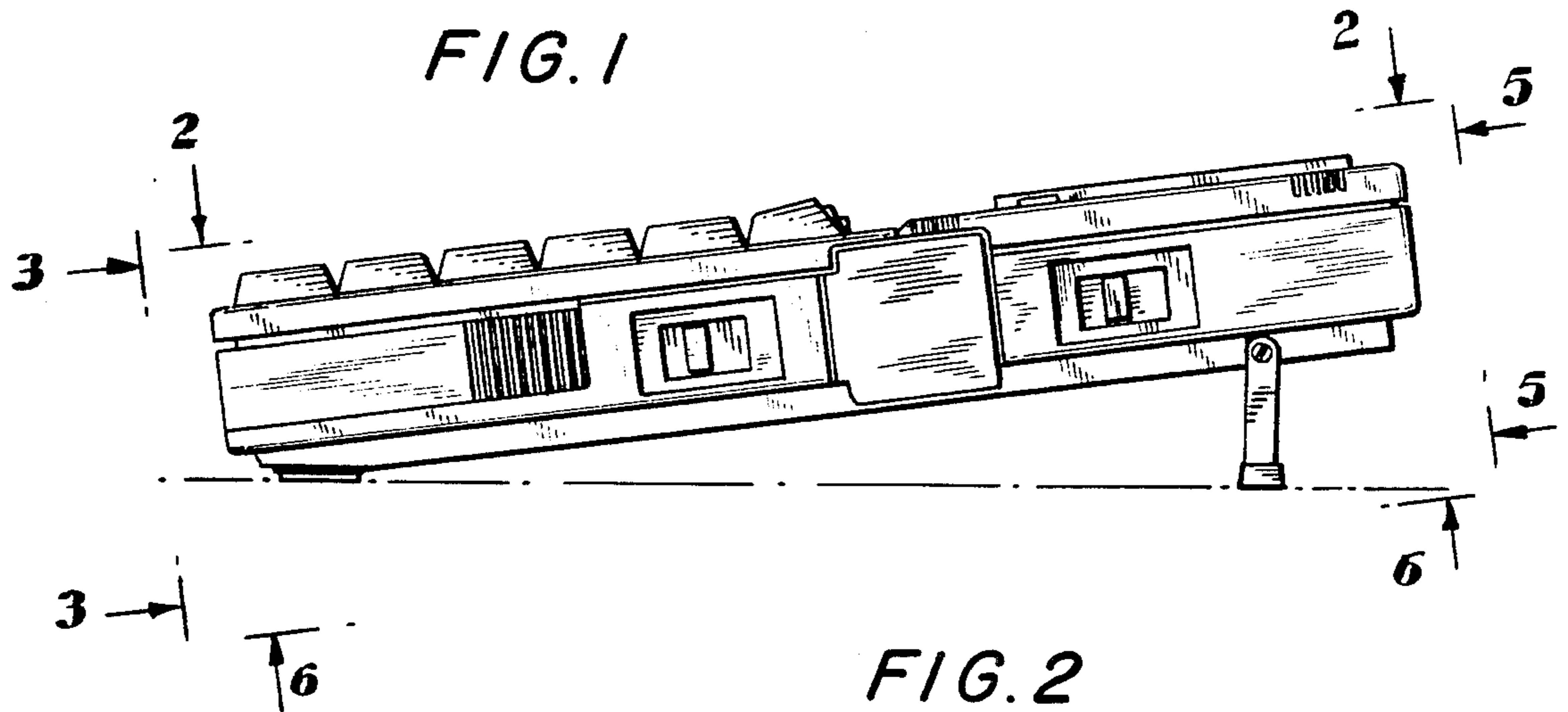

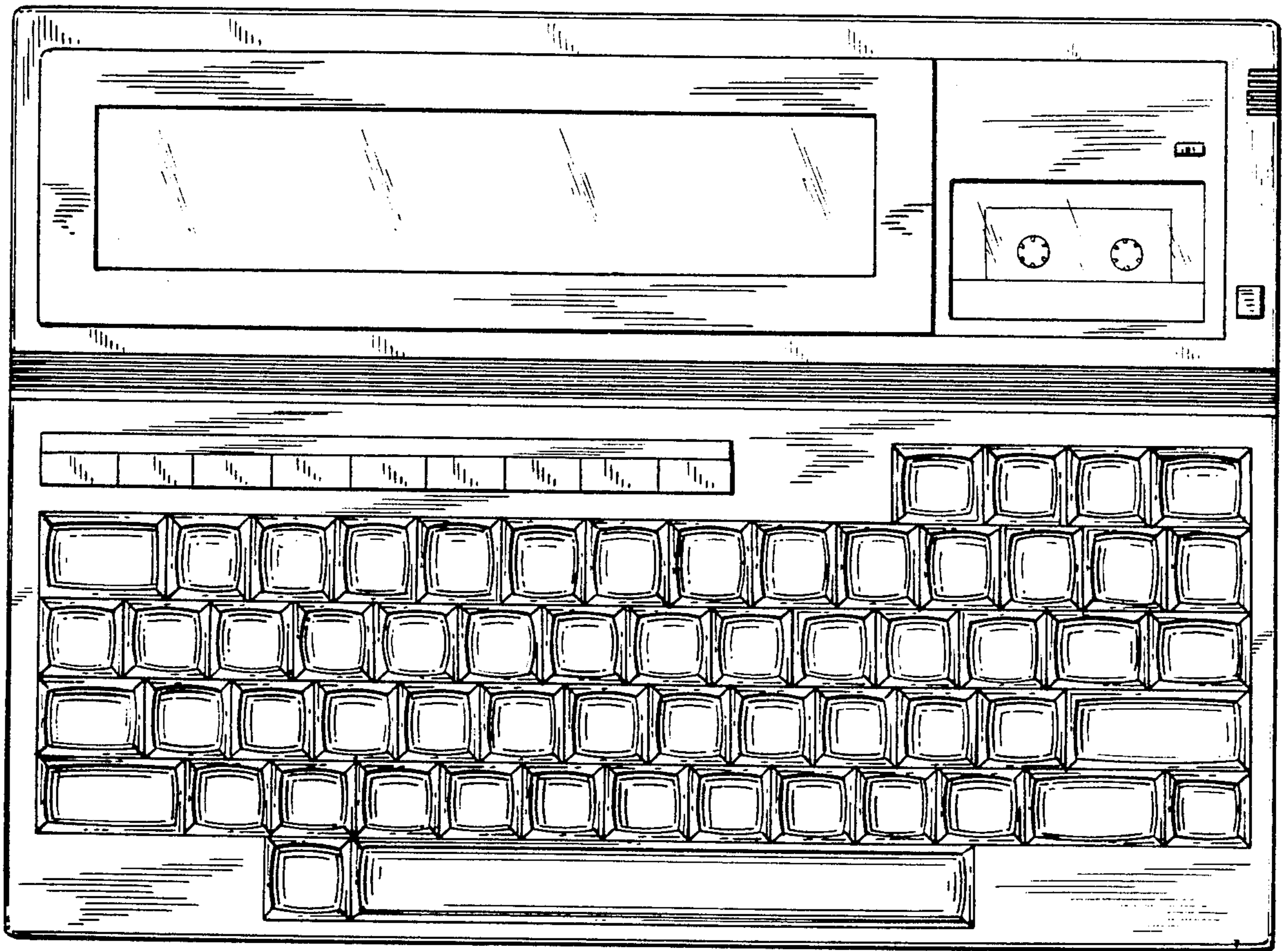

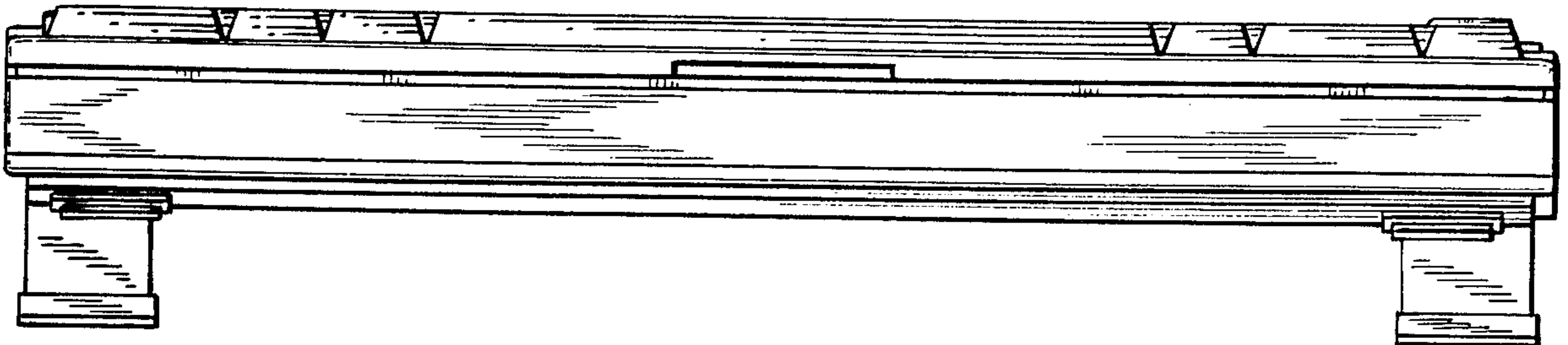

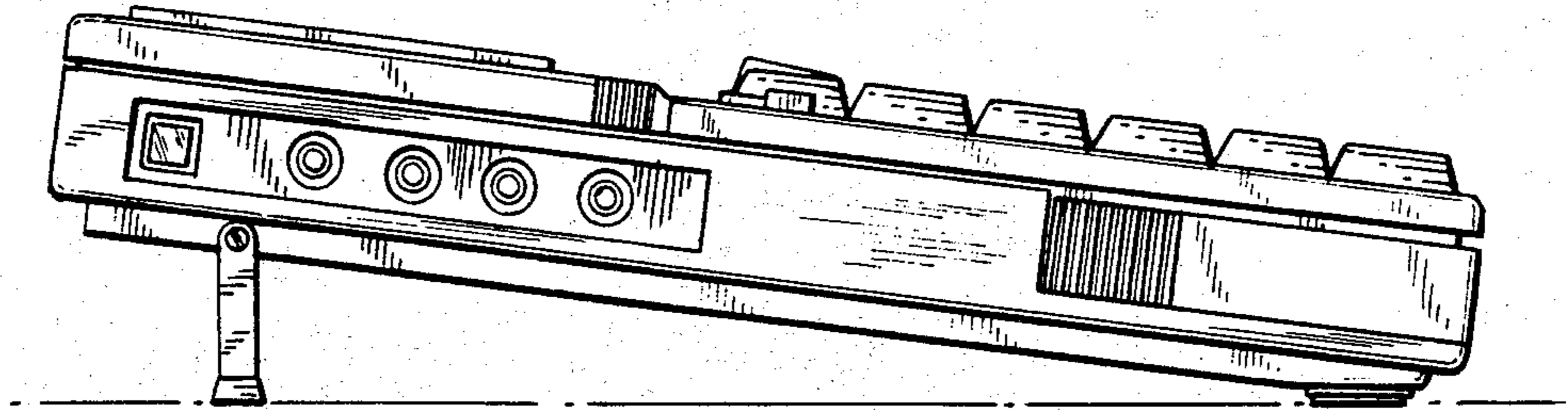

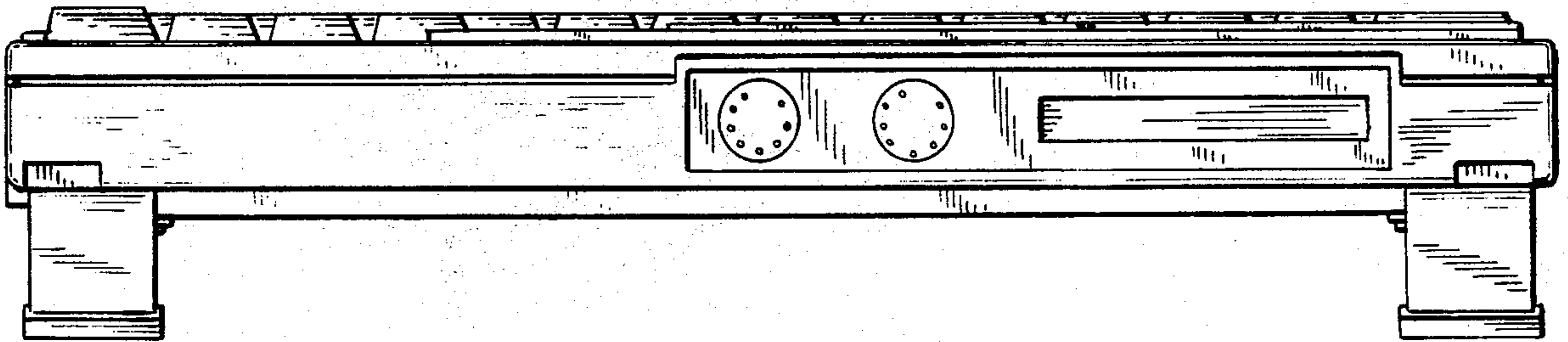

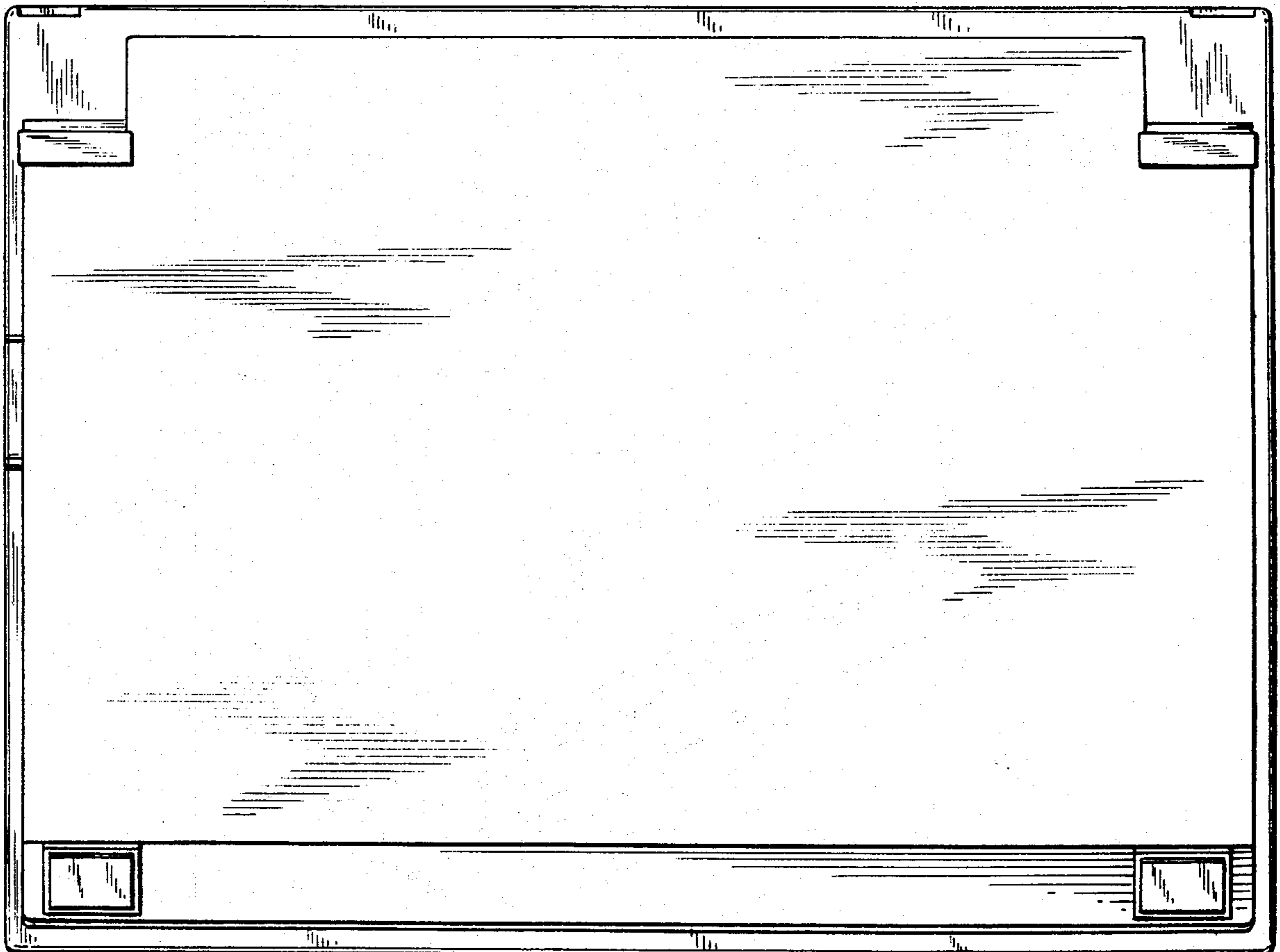

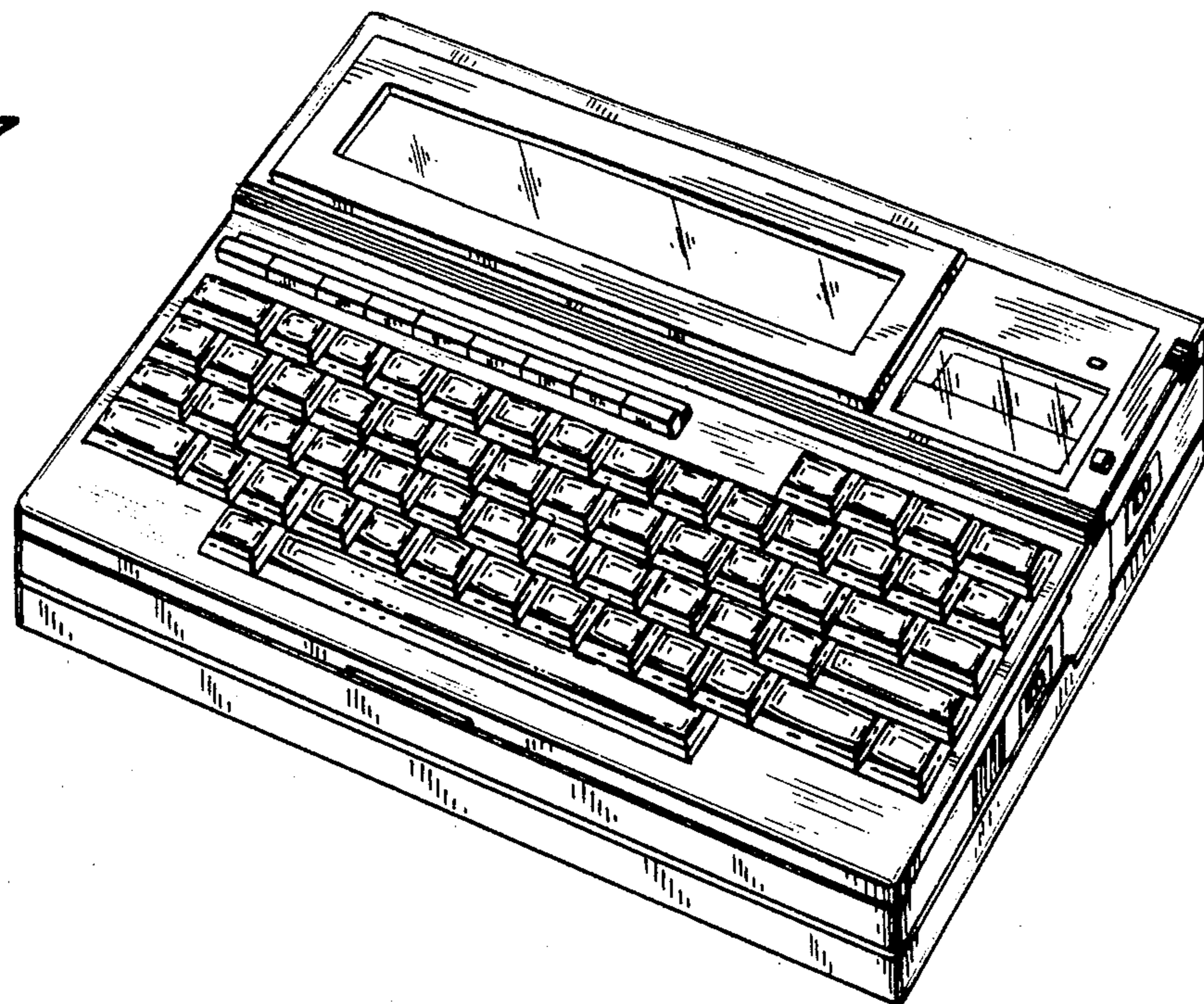
