[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a character-carrier row strip for a changeable sign panel or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a character-carrier row strip for a changeable sign panel or similar article, showing our new design and shown broken away for ease of illustration;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left end elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right end elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a rear perspective view thereof.

A bottom plan view of the character-carrier row strip for a changeable sign panel or similar article would be a mirror image of FIG. 2.

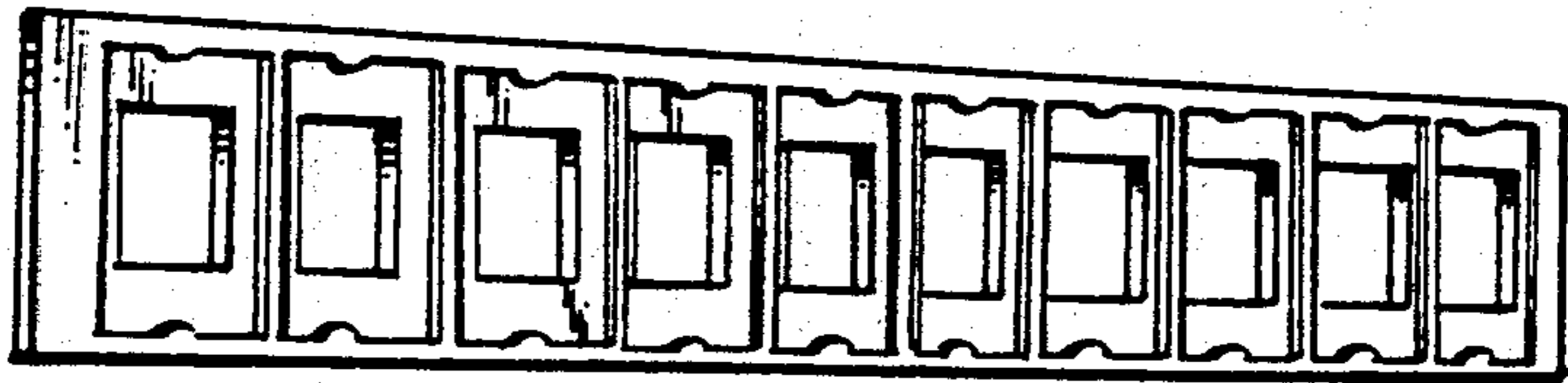

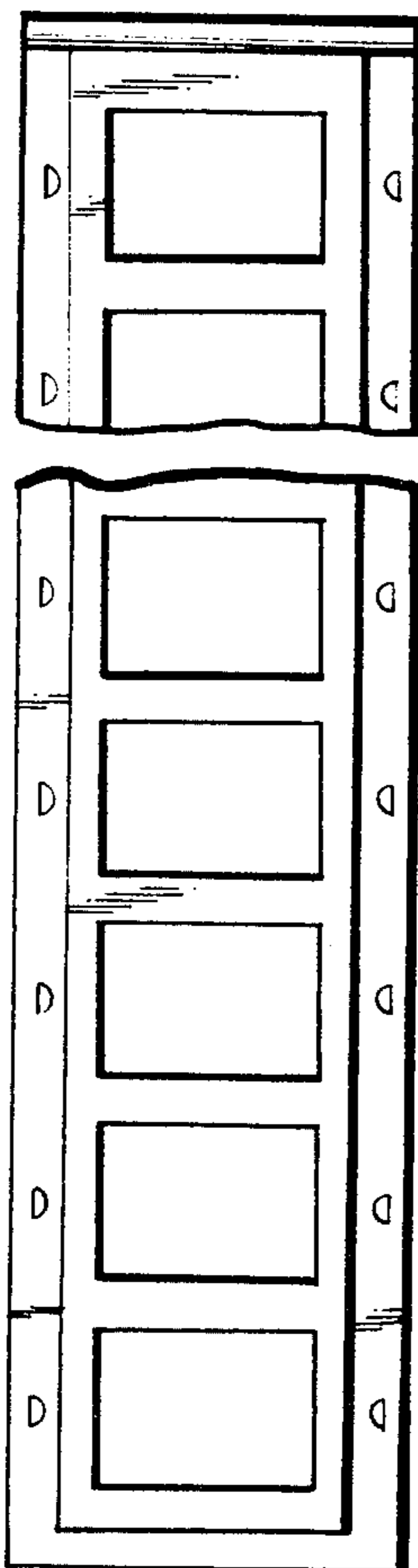

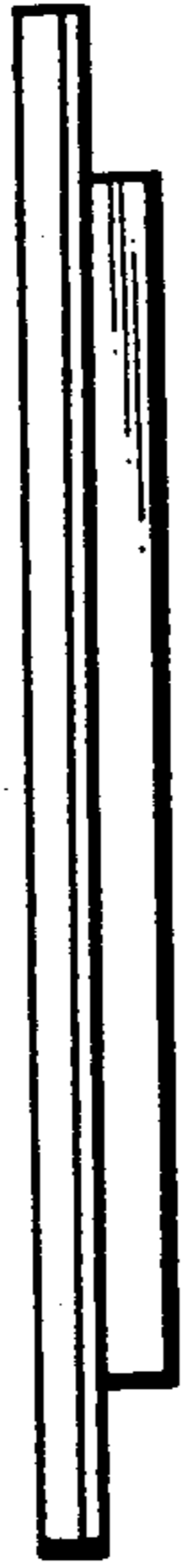

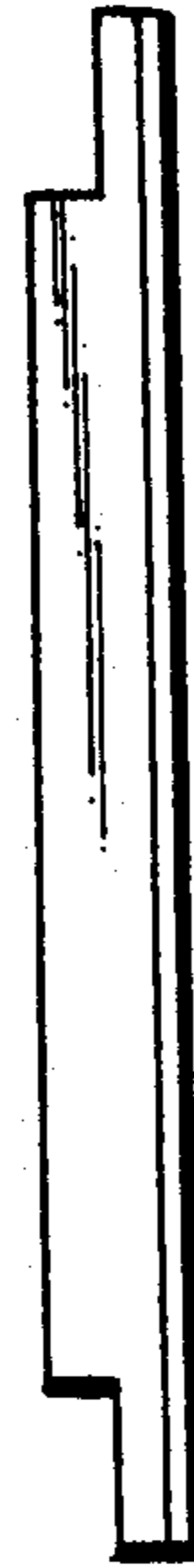
