The ornamental design for a toy vehicle, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a toy vehicle showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, the umbrella has been removed so that the top of the vehicle can be viewed;
 FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being substantially a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

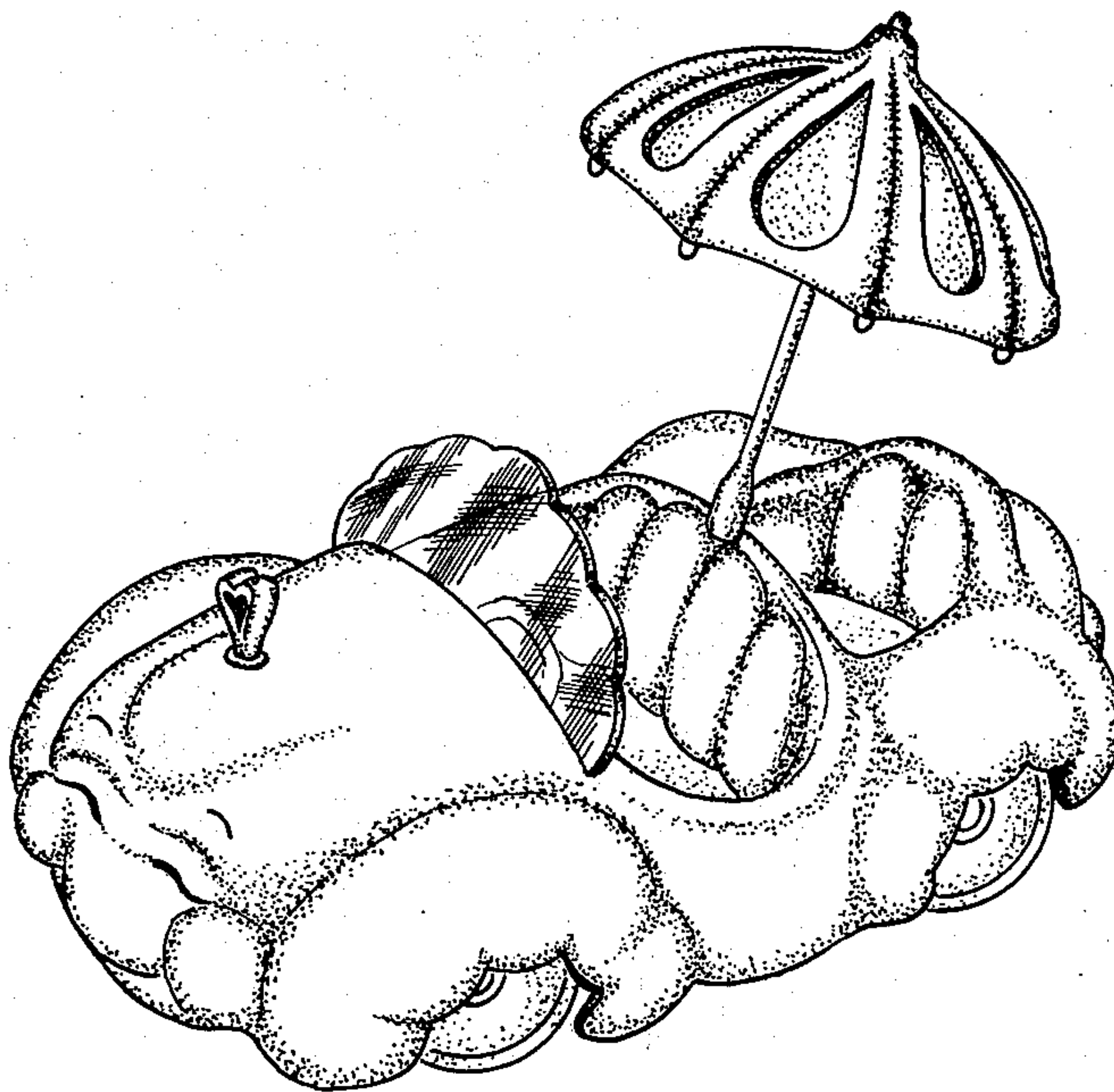

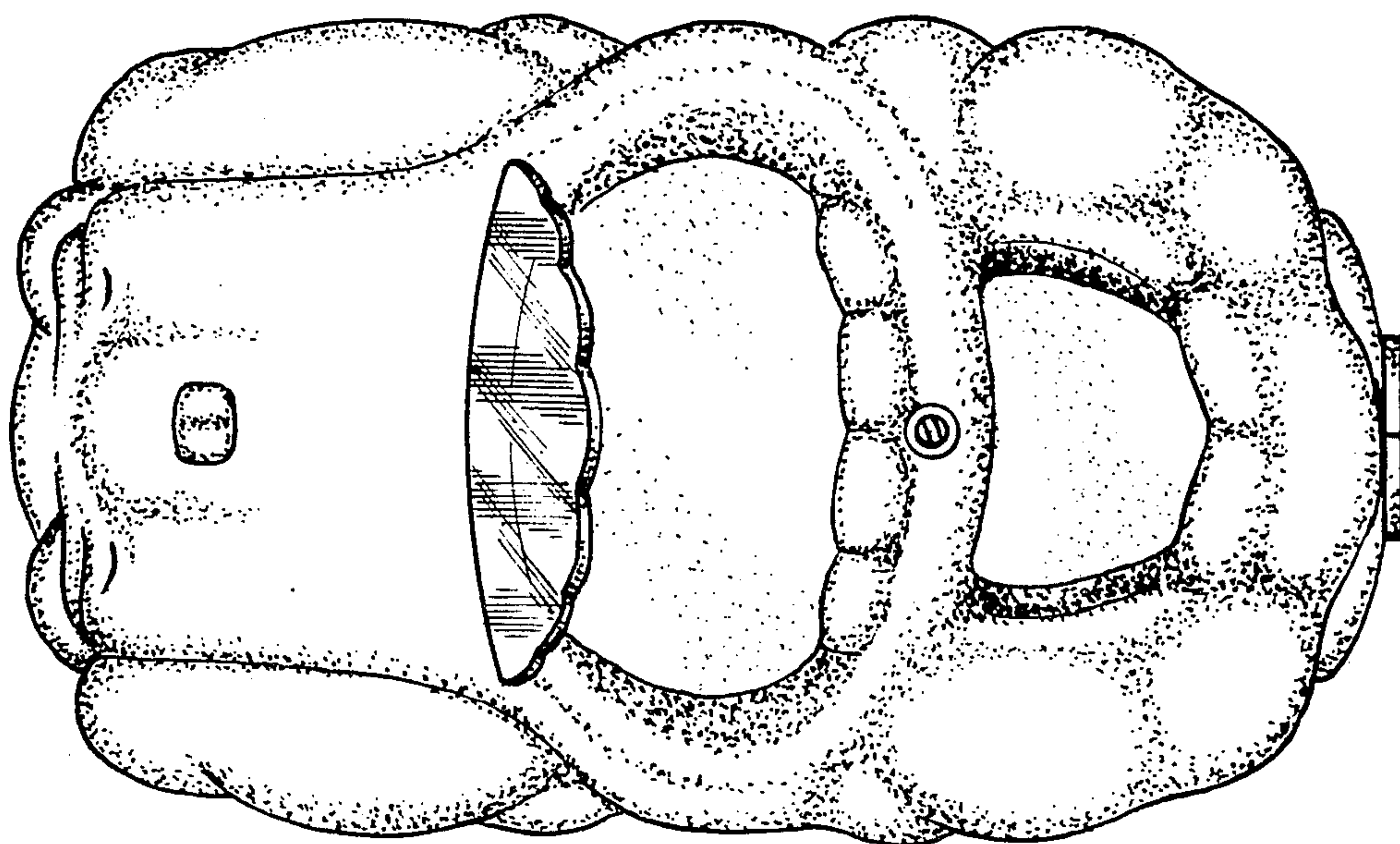
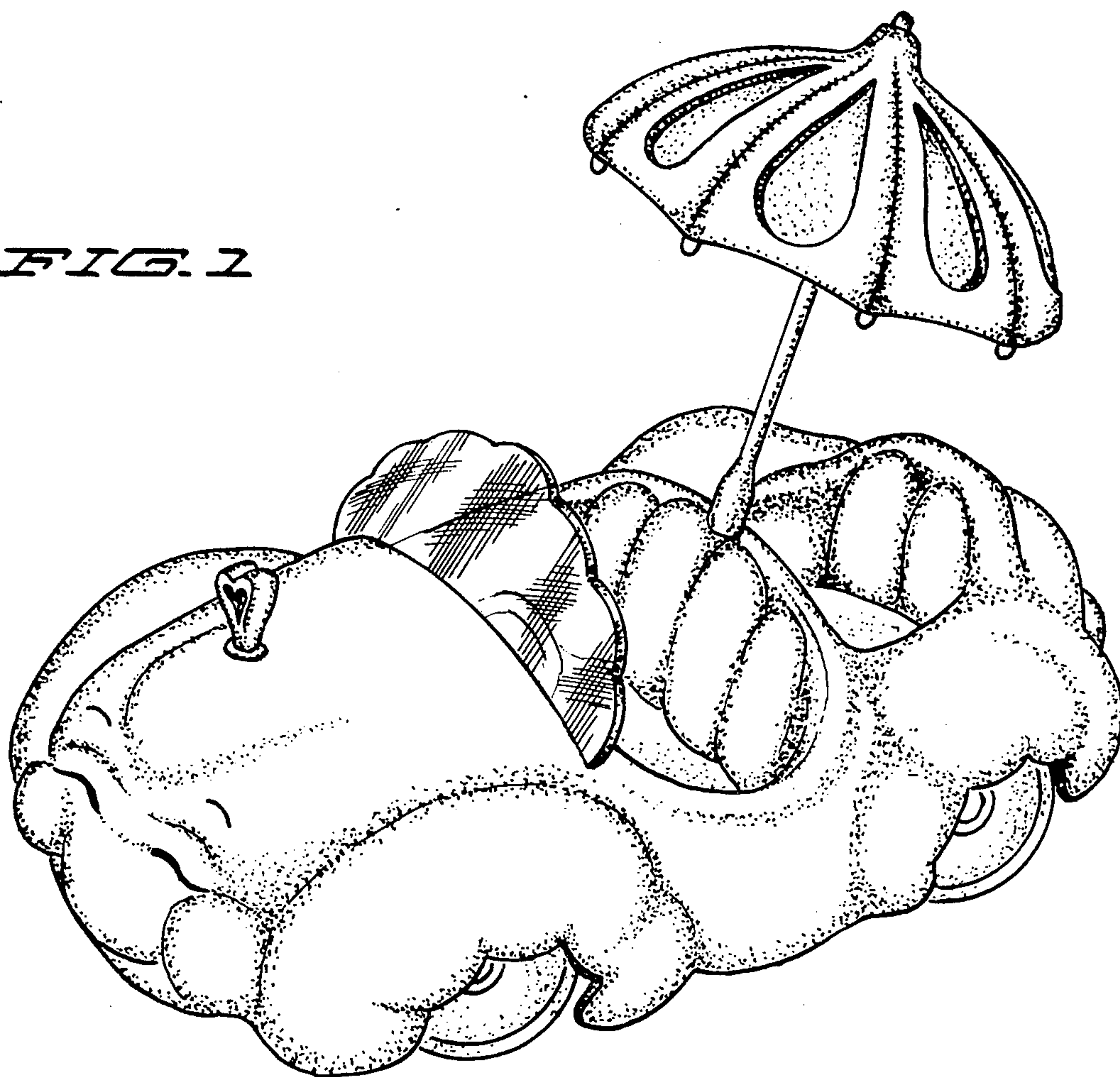

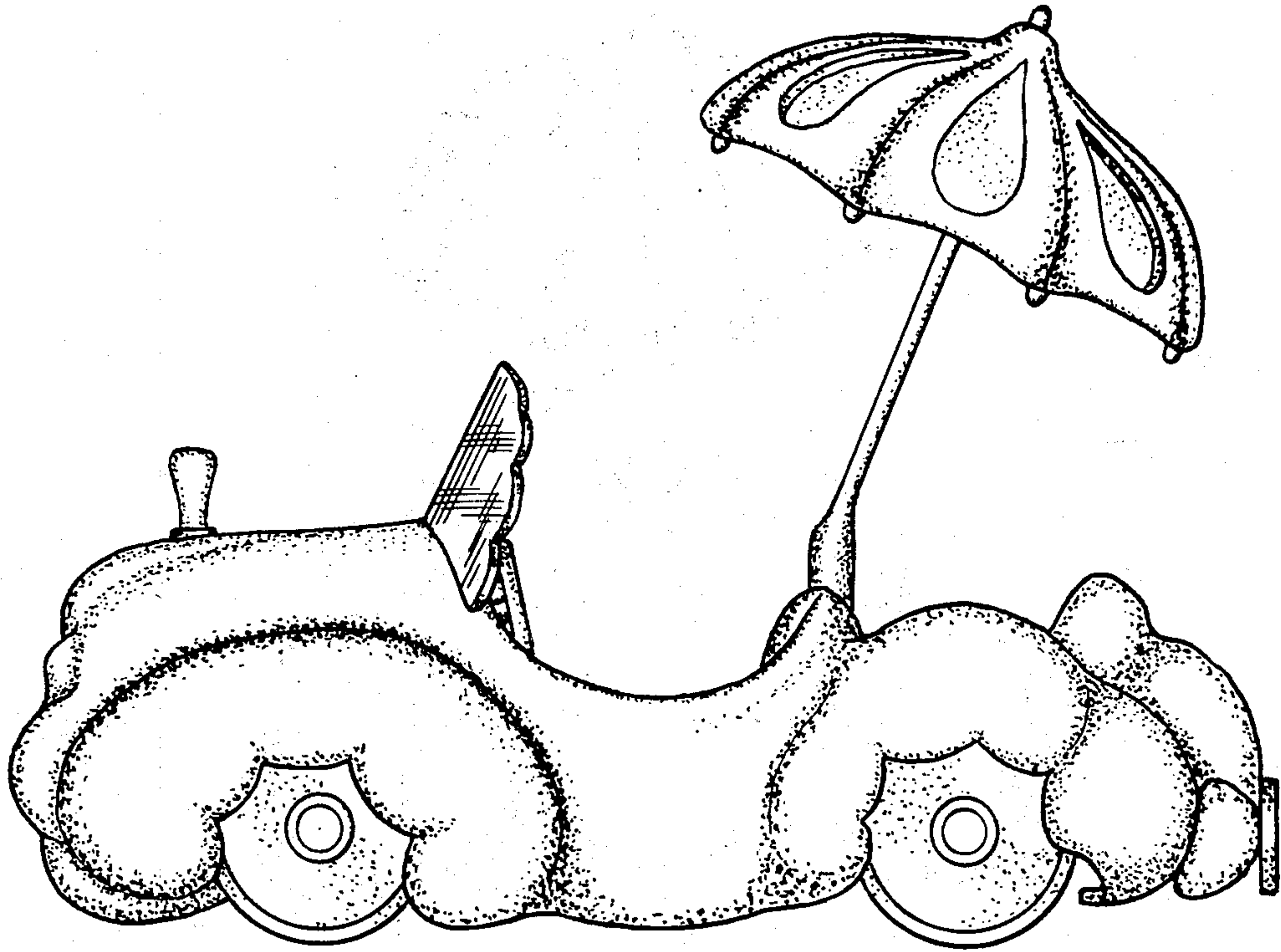

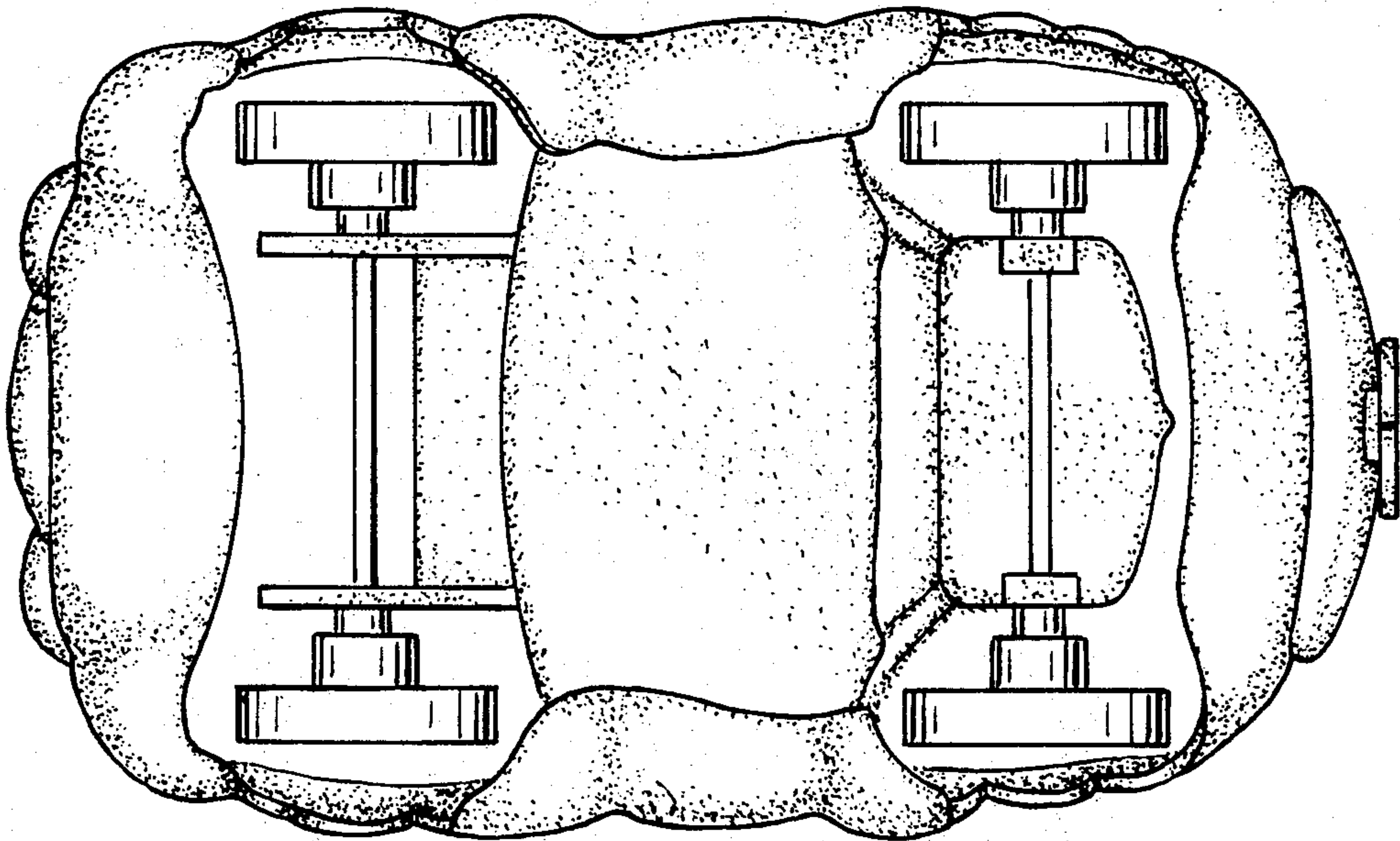

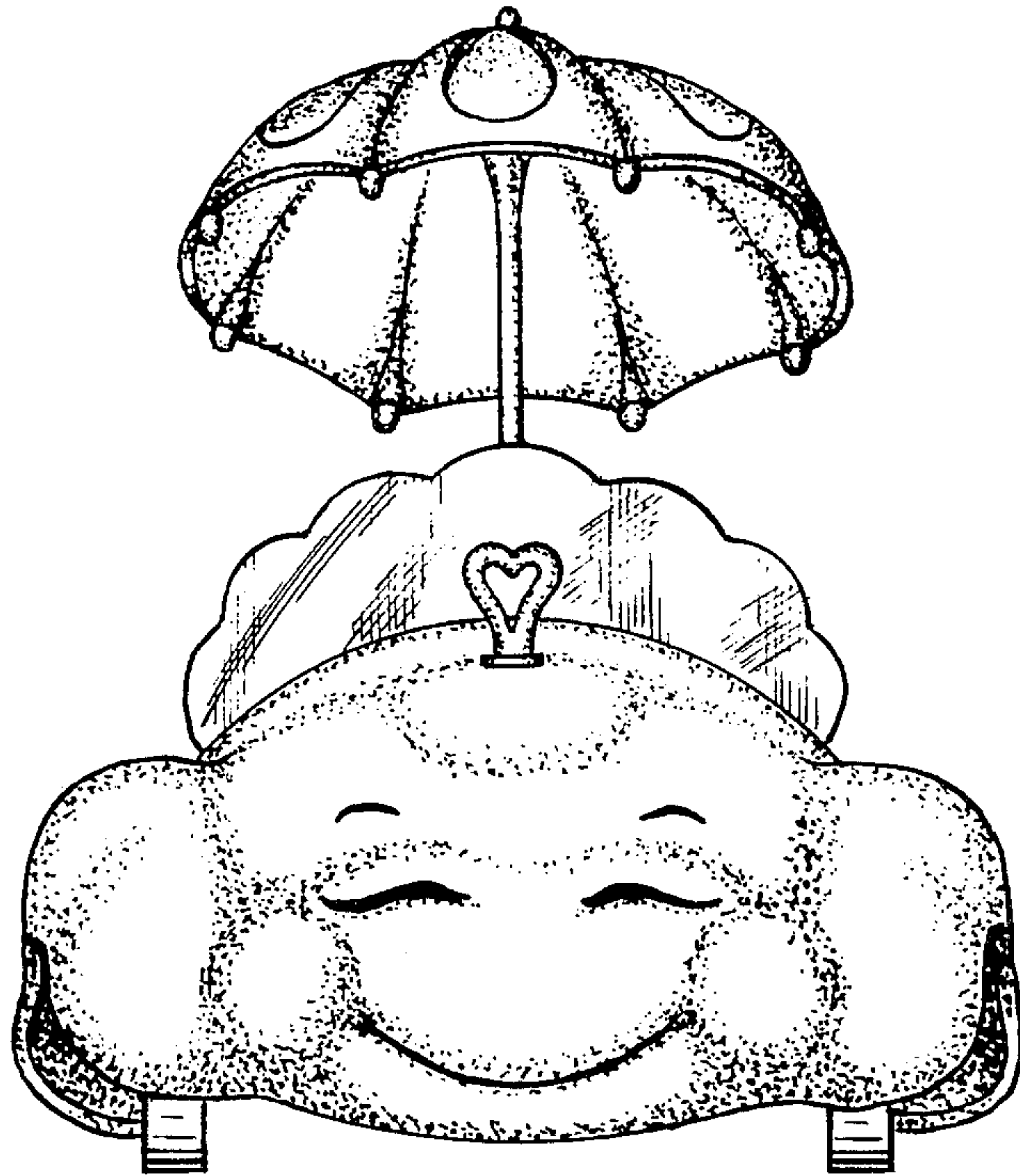

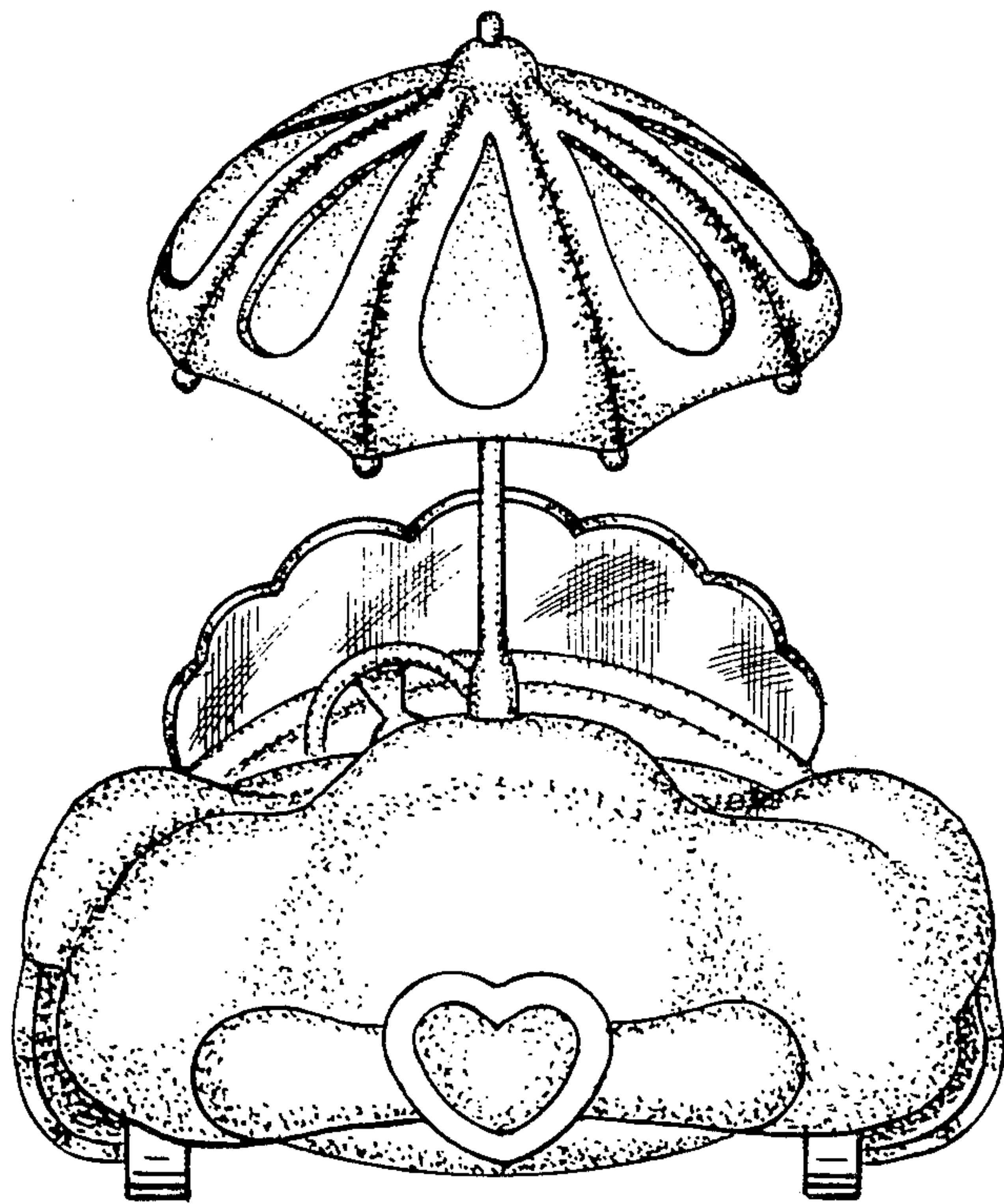
