[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a multi product holder for sewing accessories or hardware items or the like, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front perspective view of a multi product holder for sewing accessories or hardware items or the like showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an exploded top perspective view thereof with the other holders having been omitted for convenience of illustration;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is an exploded perspective view of one of the plurality of separately removable elements out of the holding ring with its cap removed;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the holding ring;

FIG. 8 is a side elevational view of the holding ring;

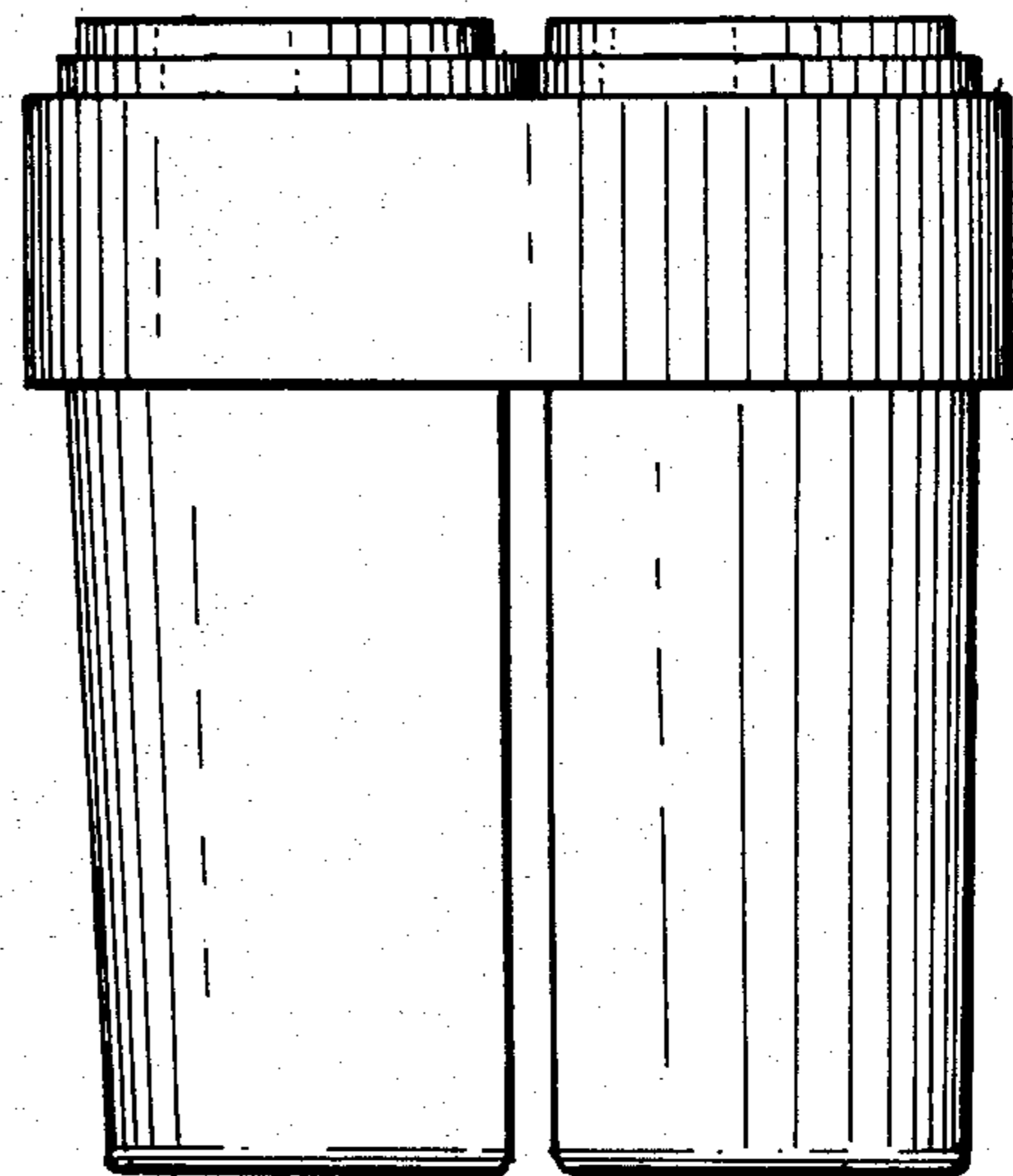
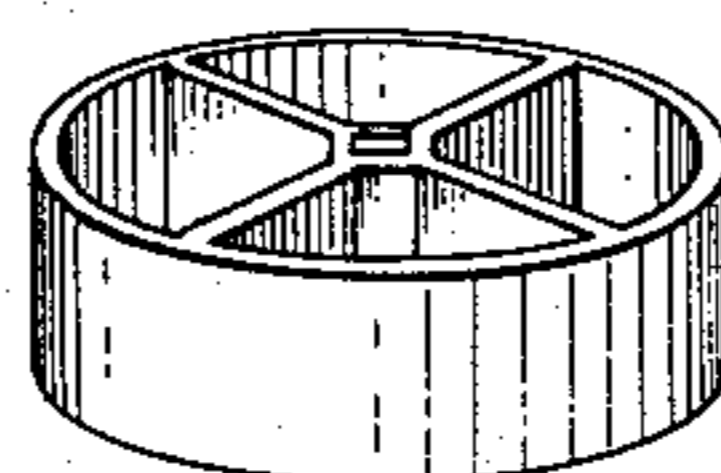
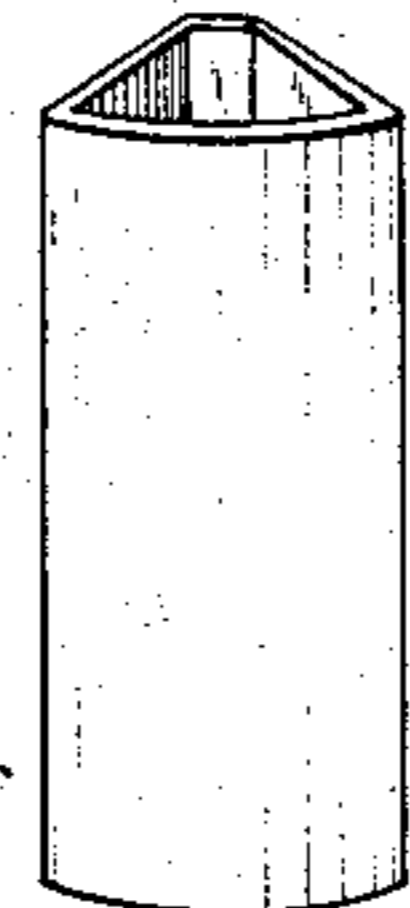
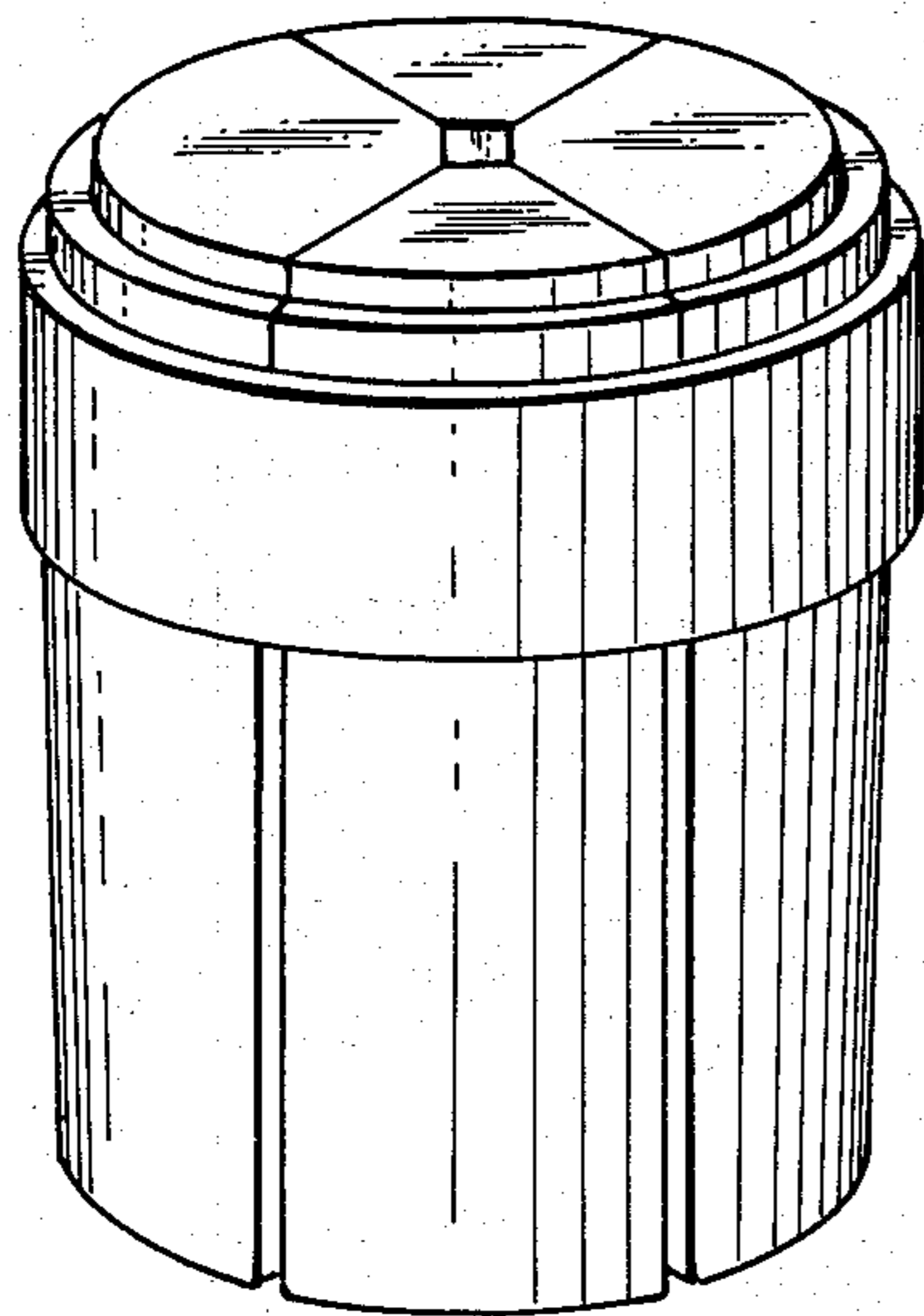
FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of one of the holders thereof;

FIG. 13 is a rear elevational view thereof.



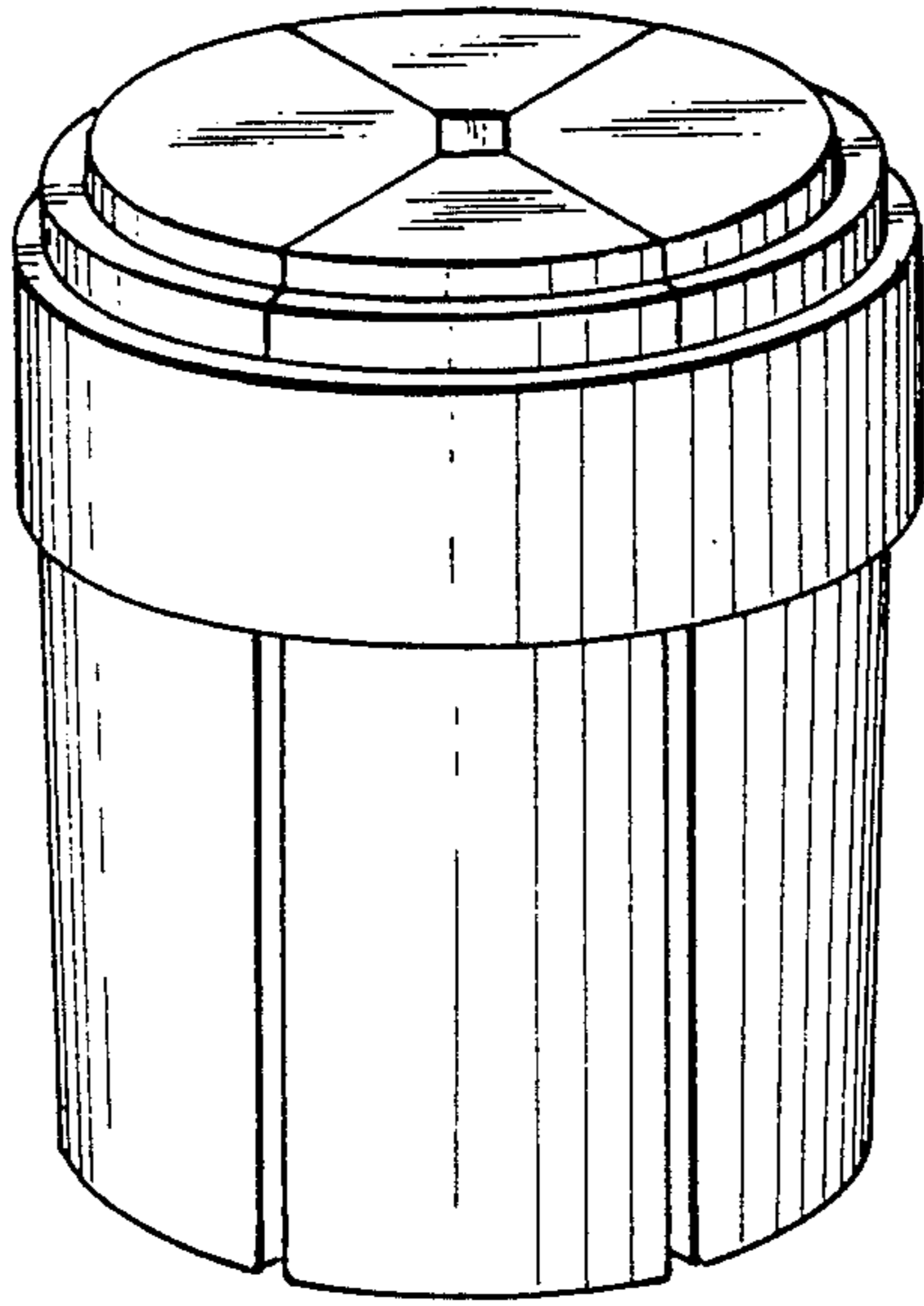

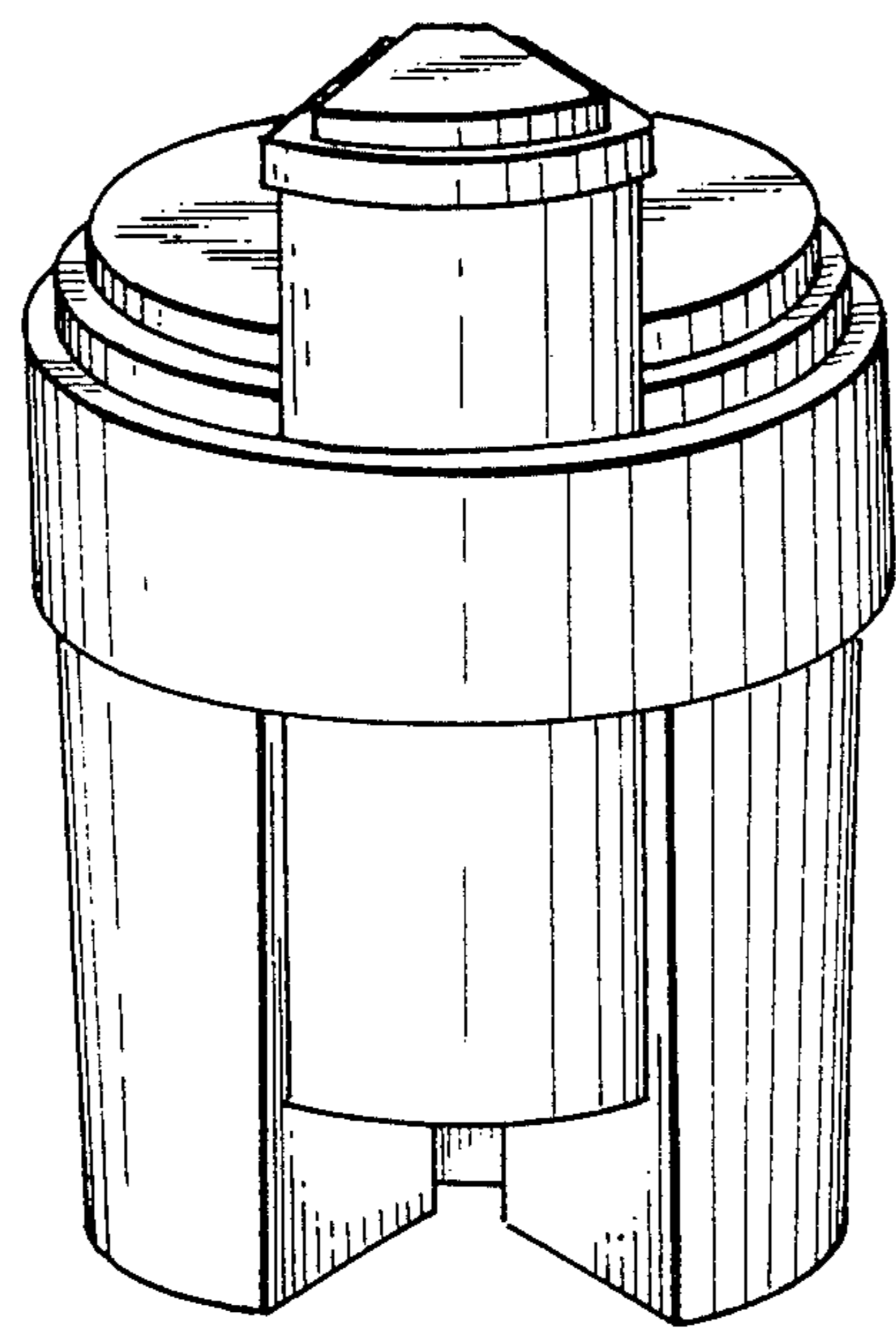

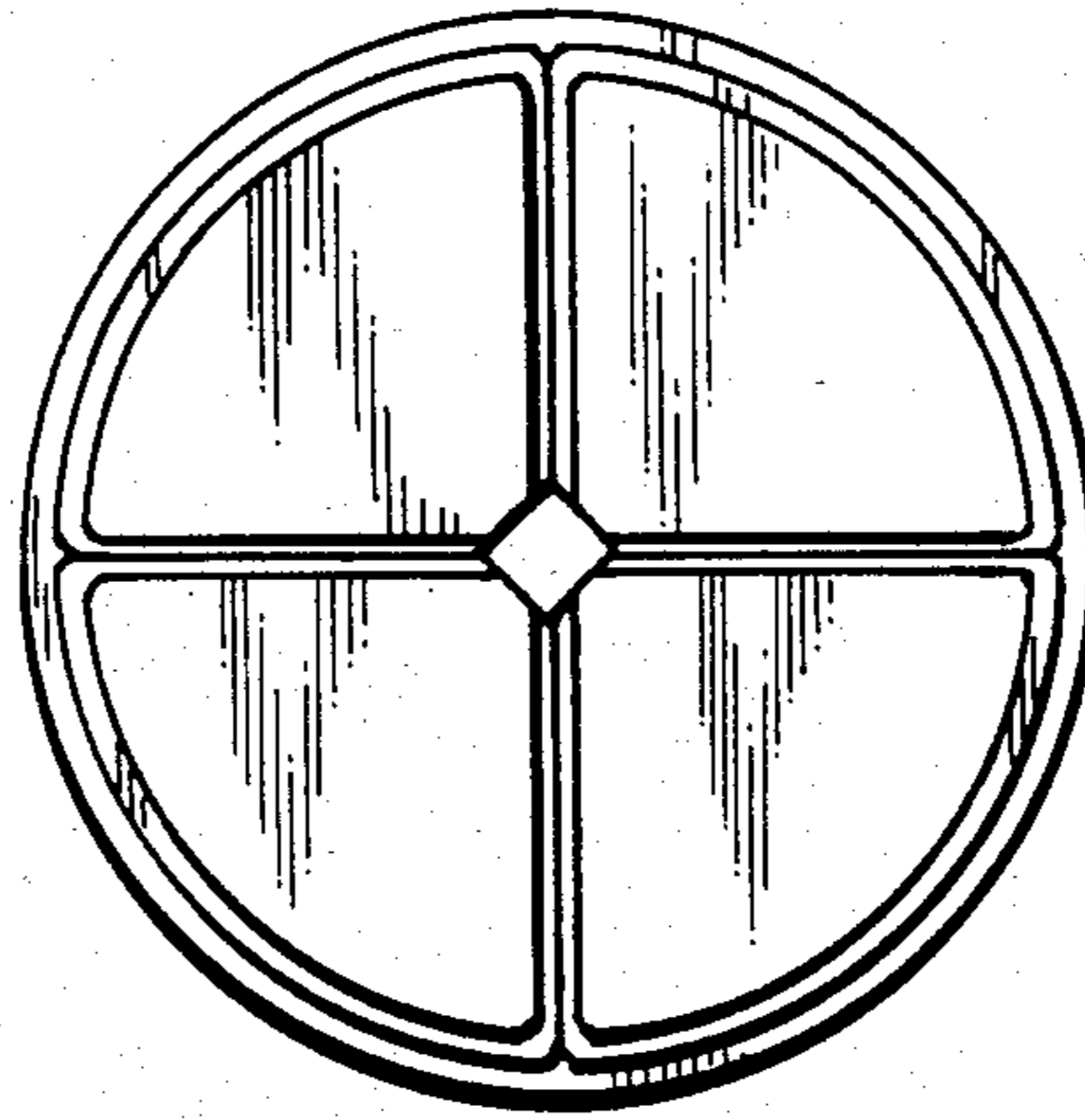

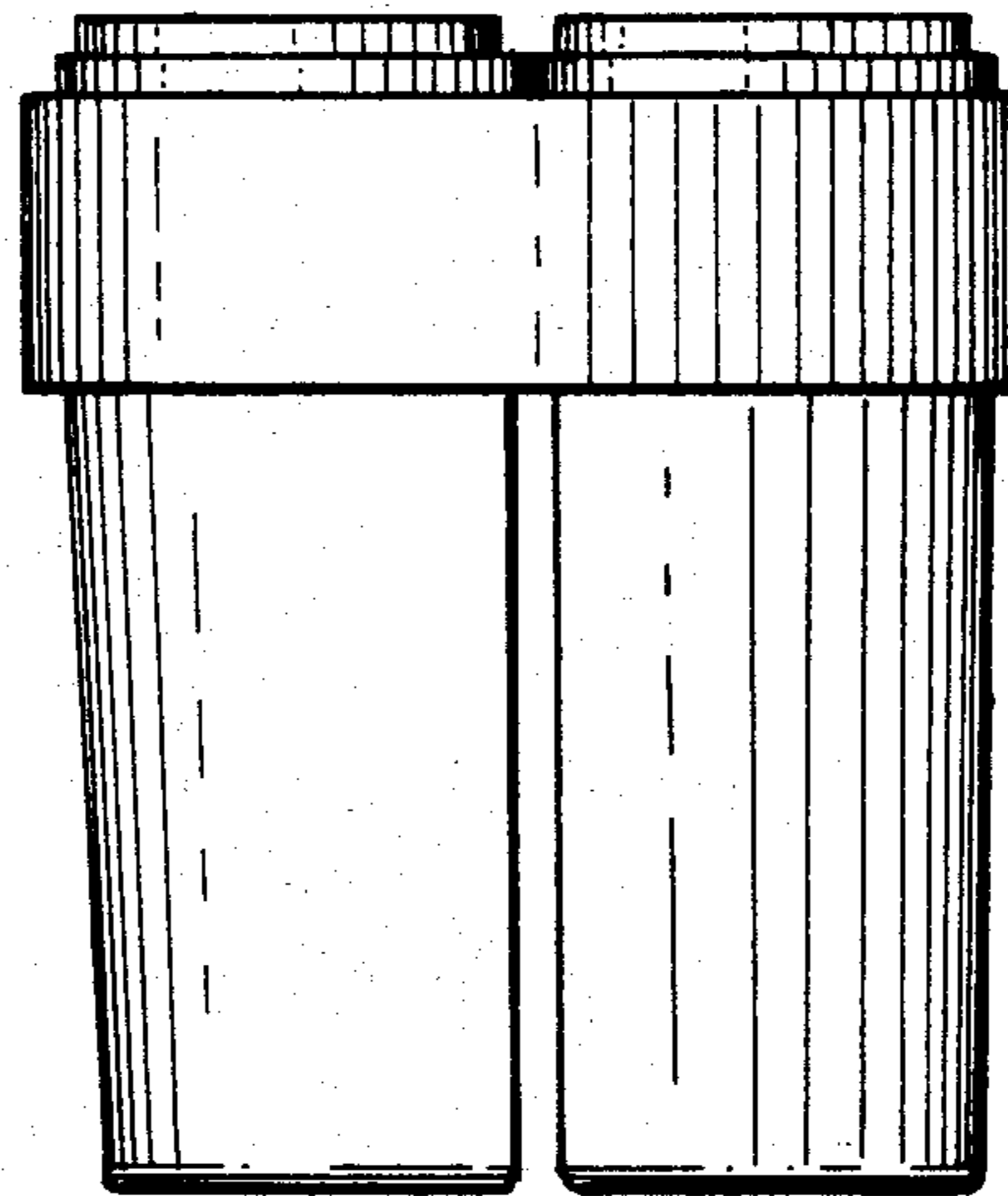

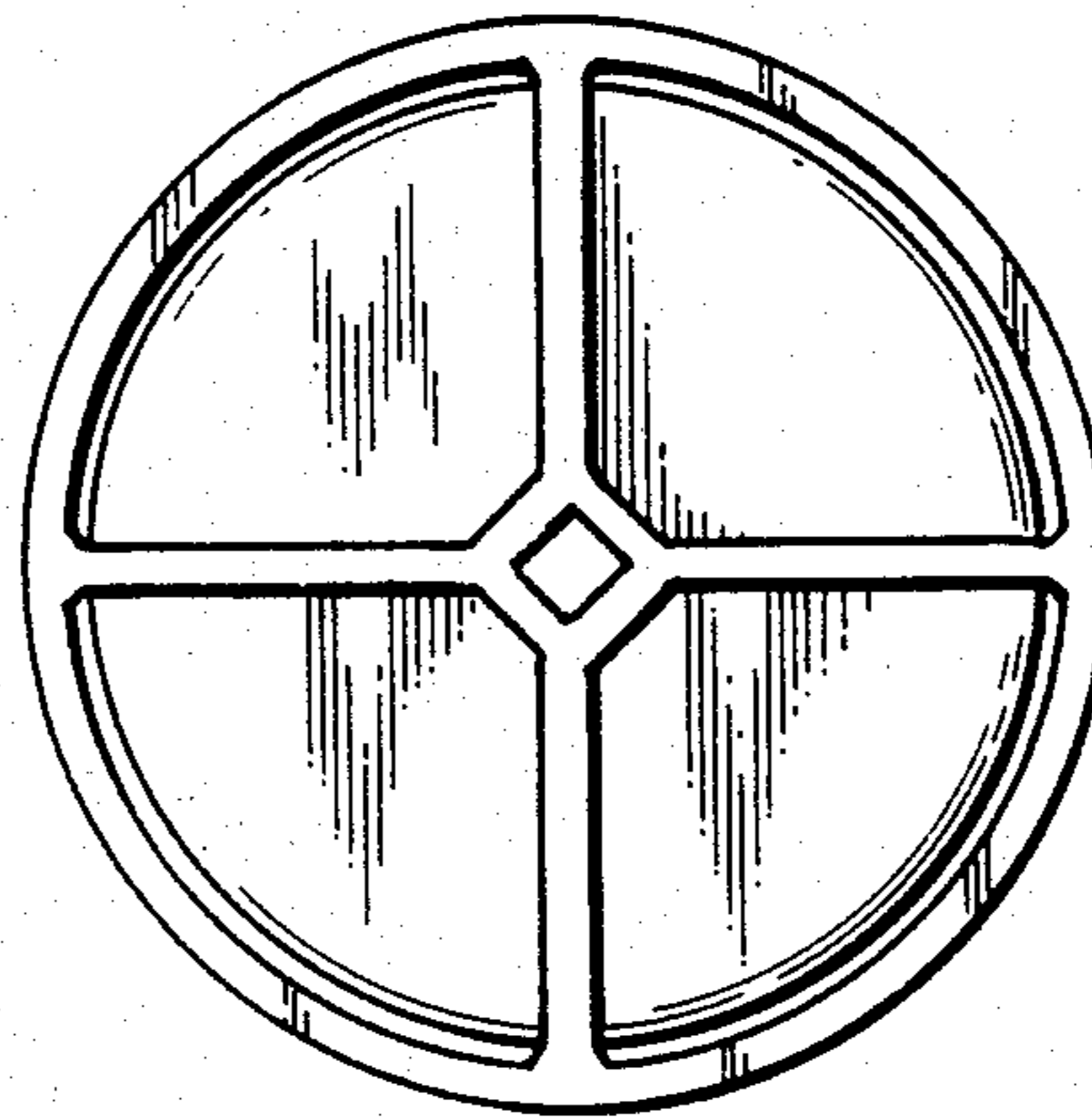
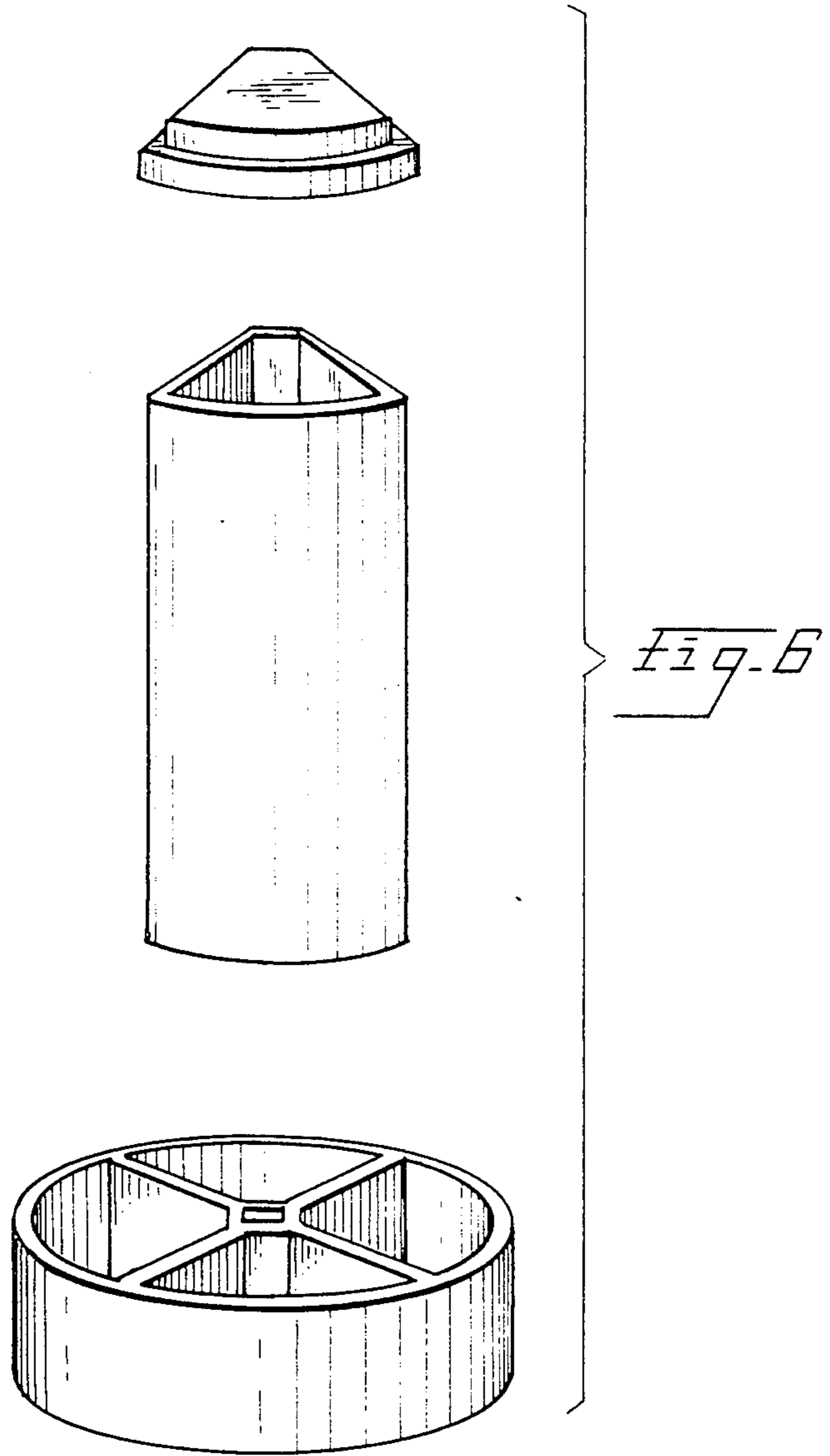
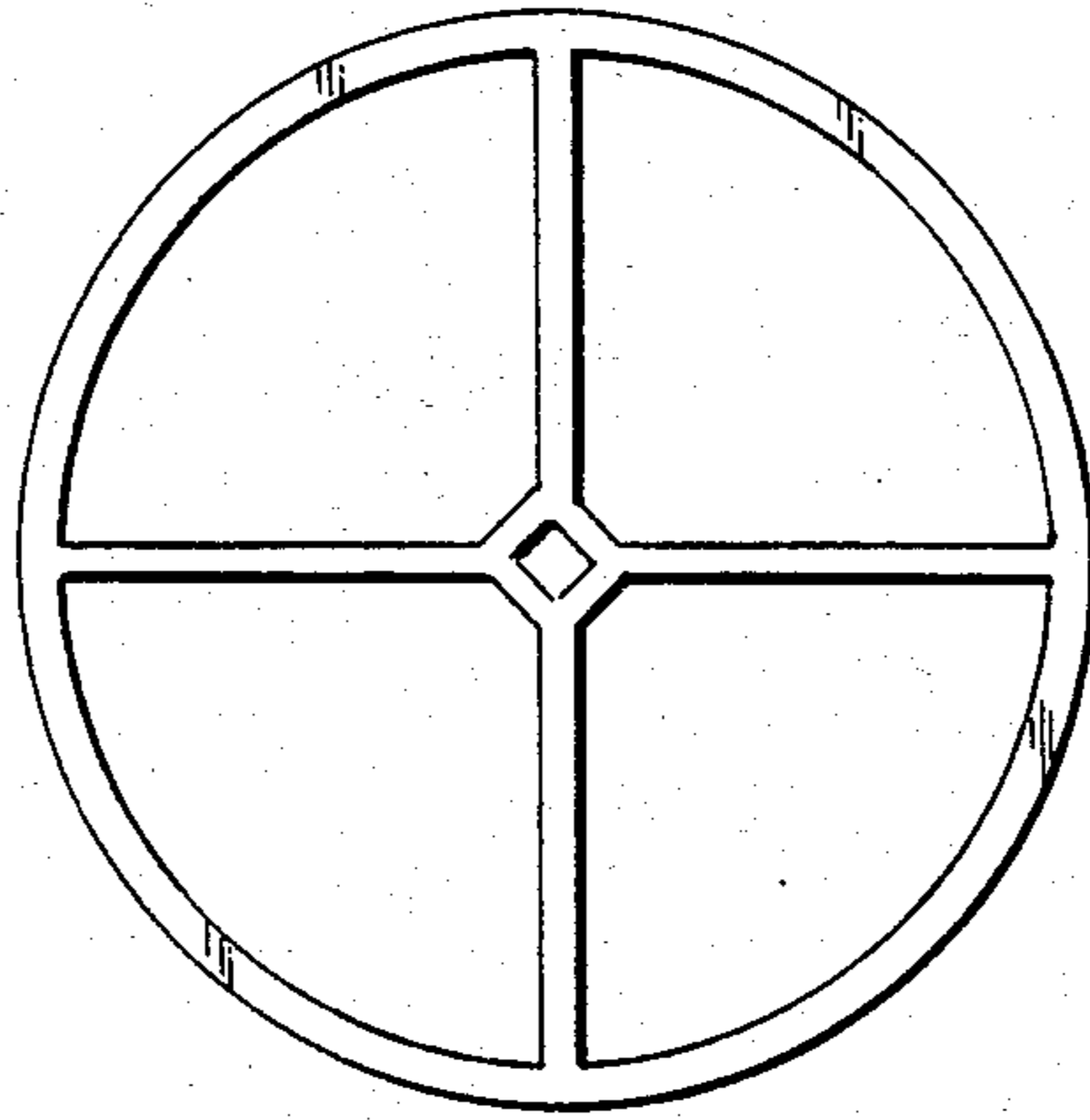

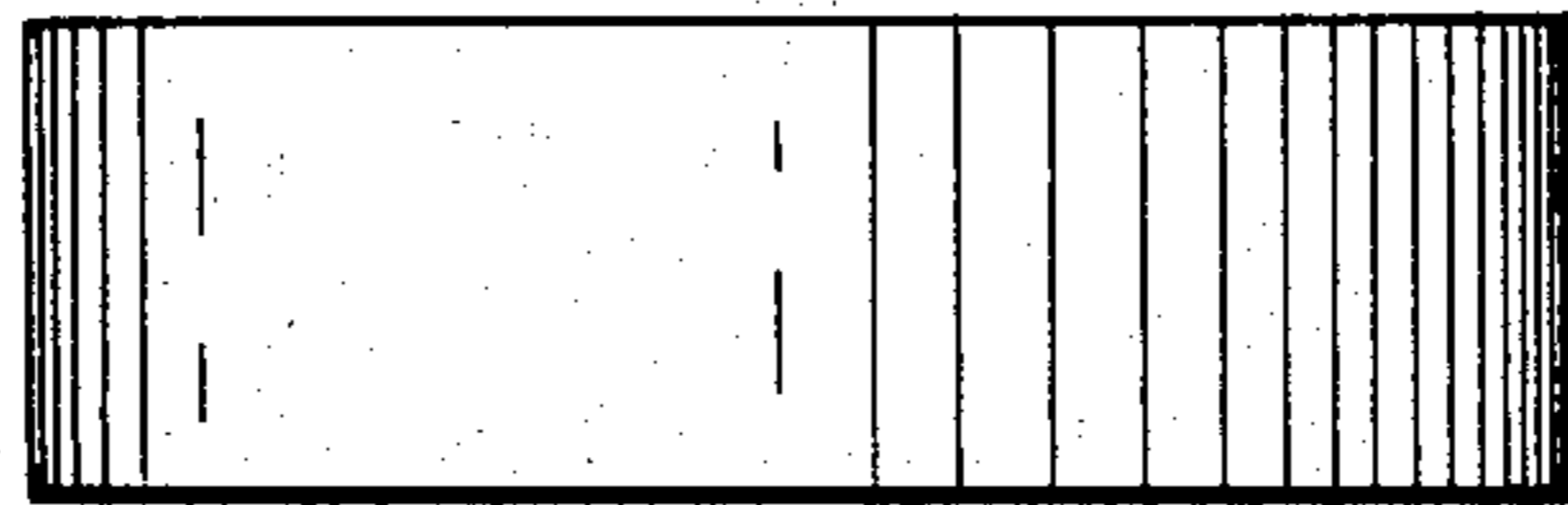




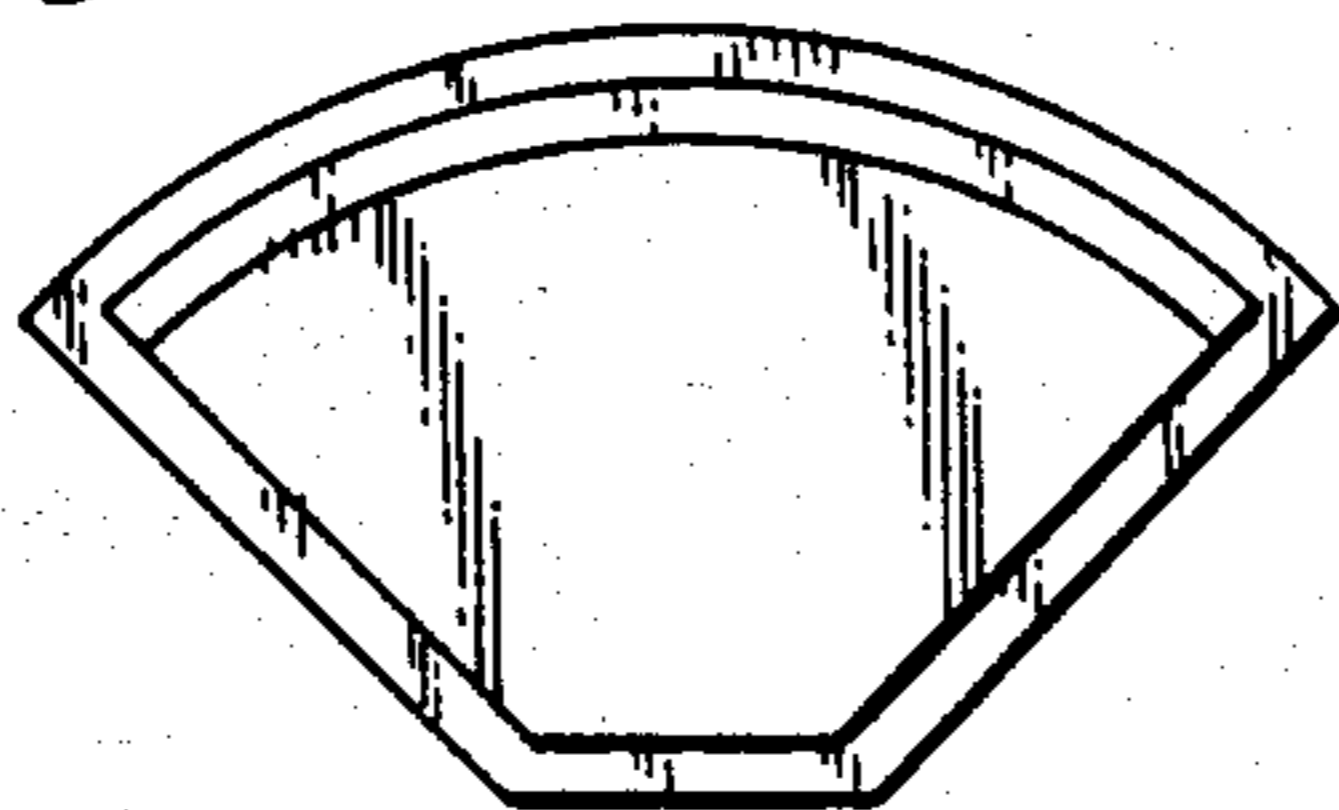

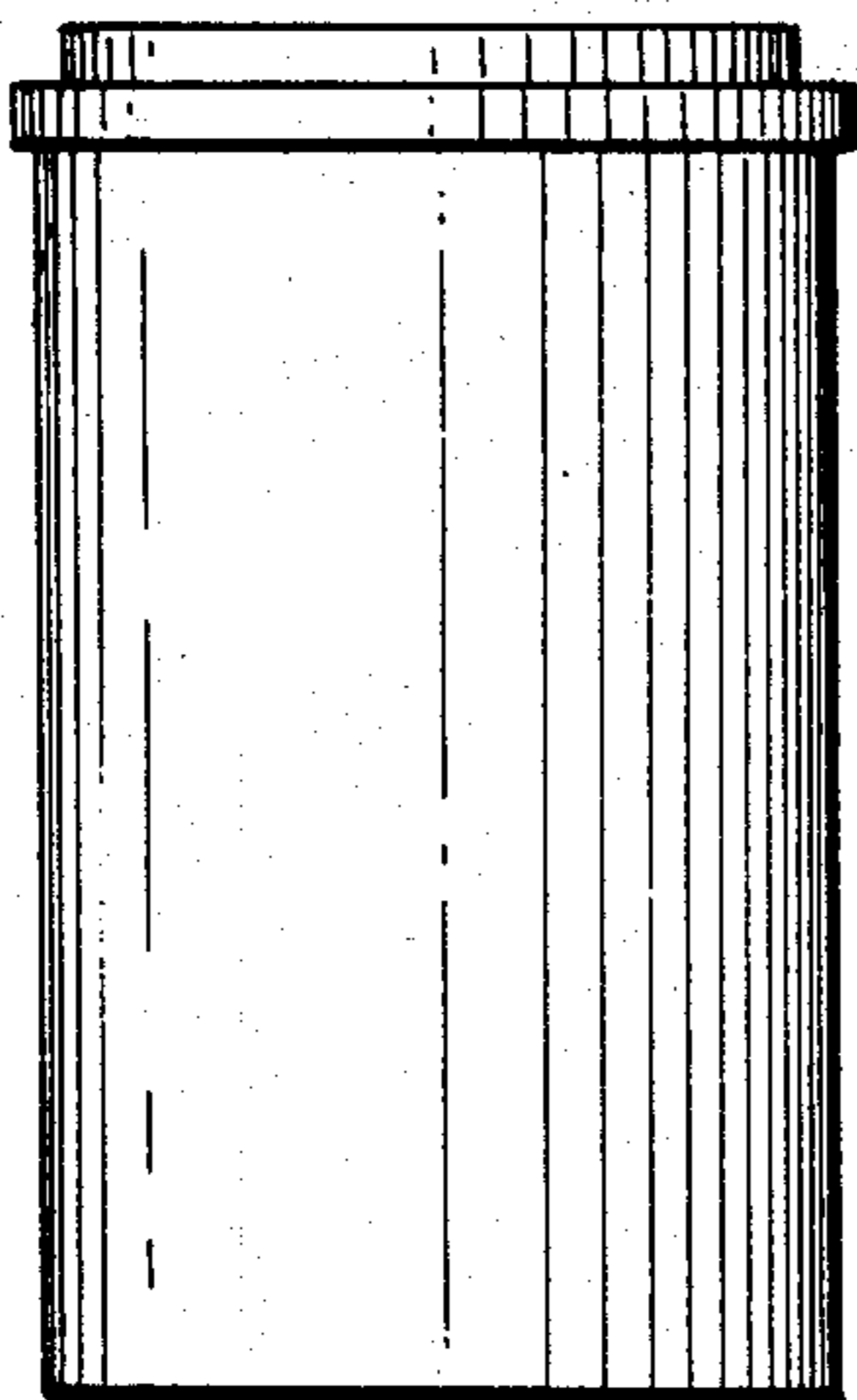
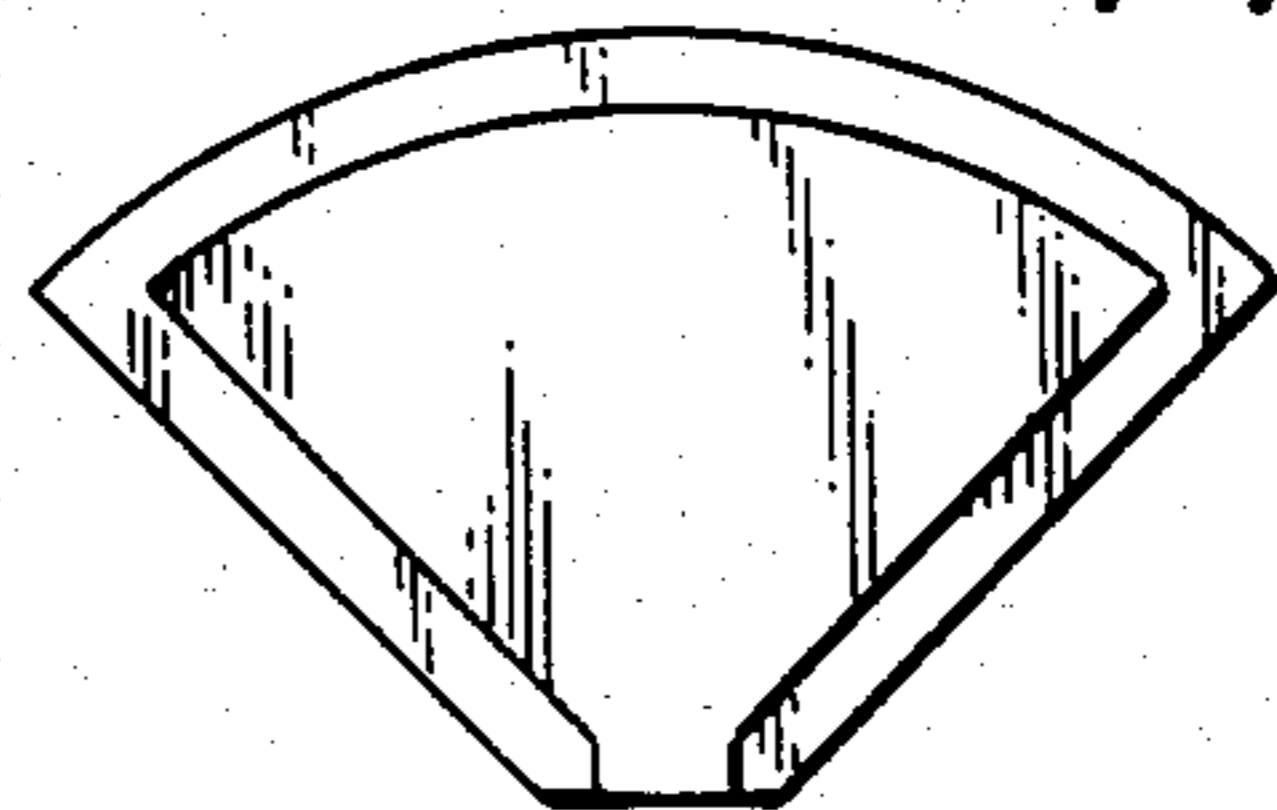

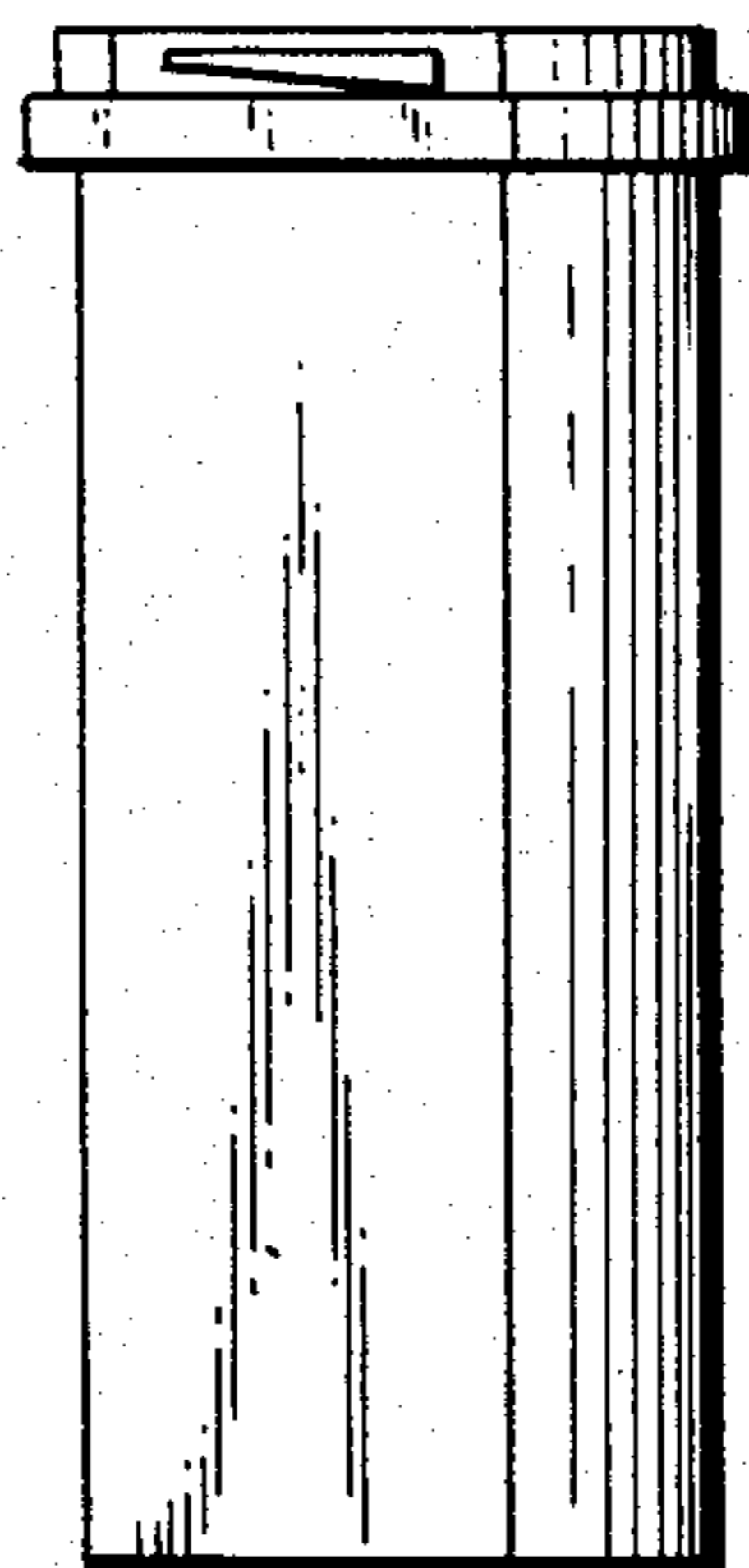

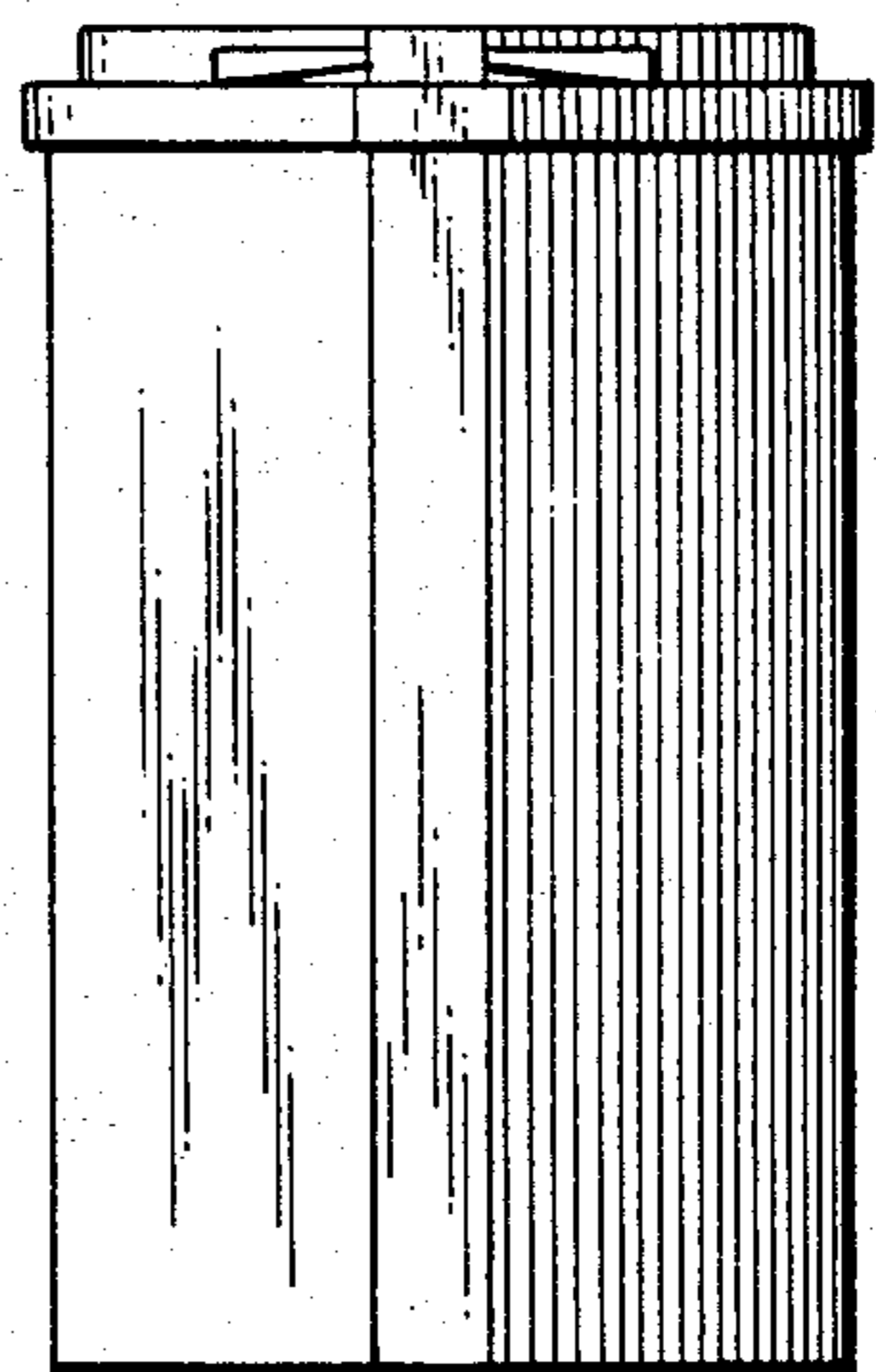
