[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an insulated carrier for wine bottles and the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an insulated carrier for wine bottles showing my new design, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

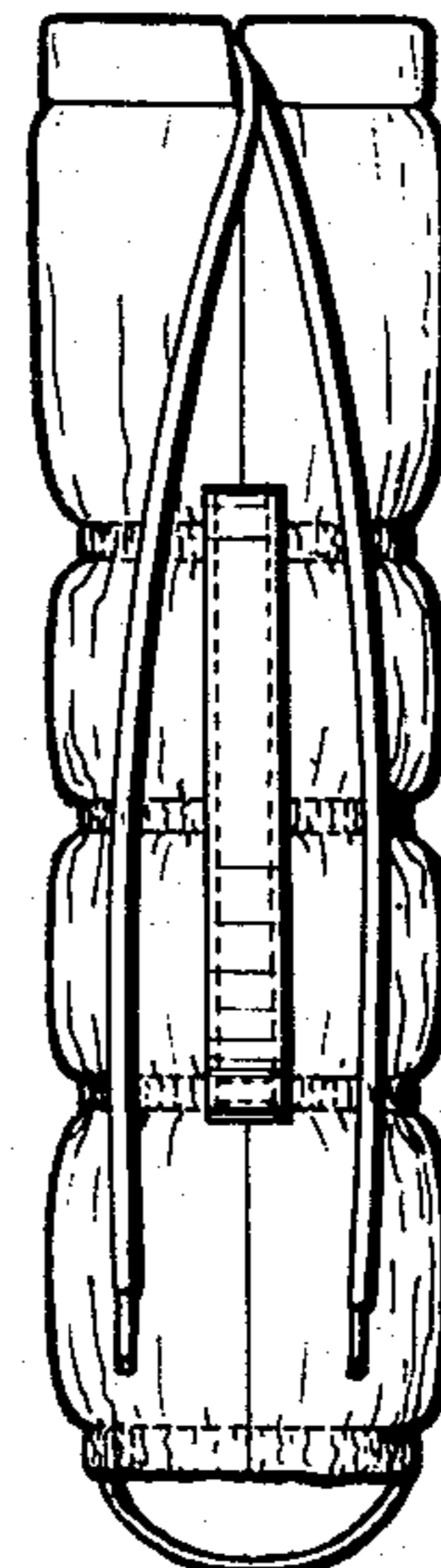
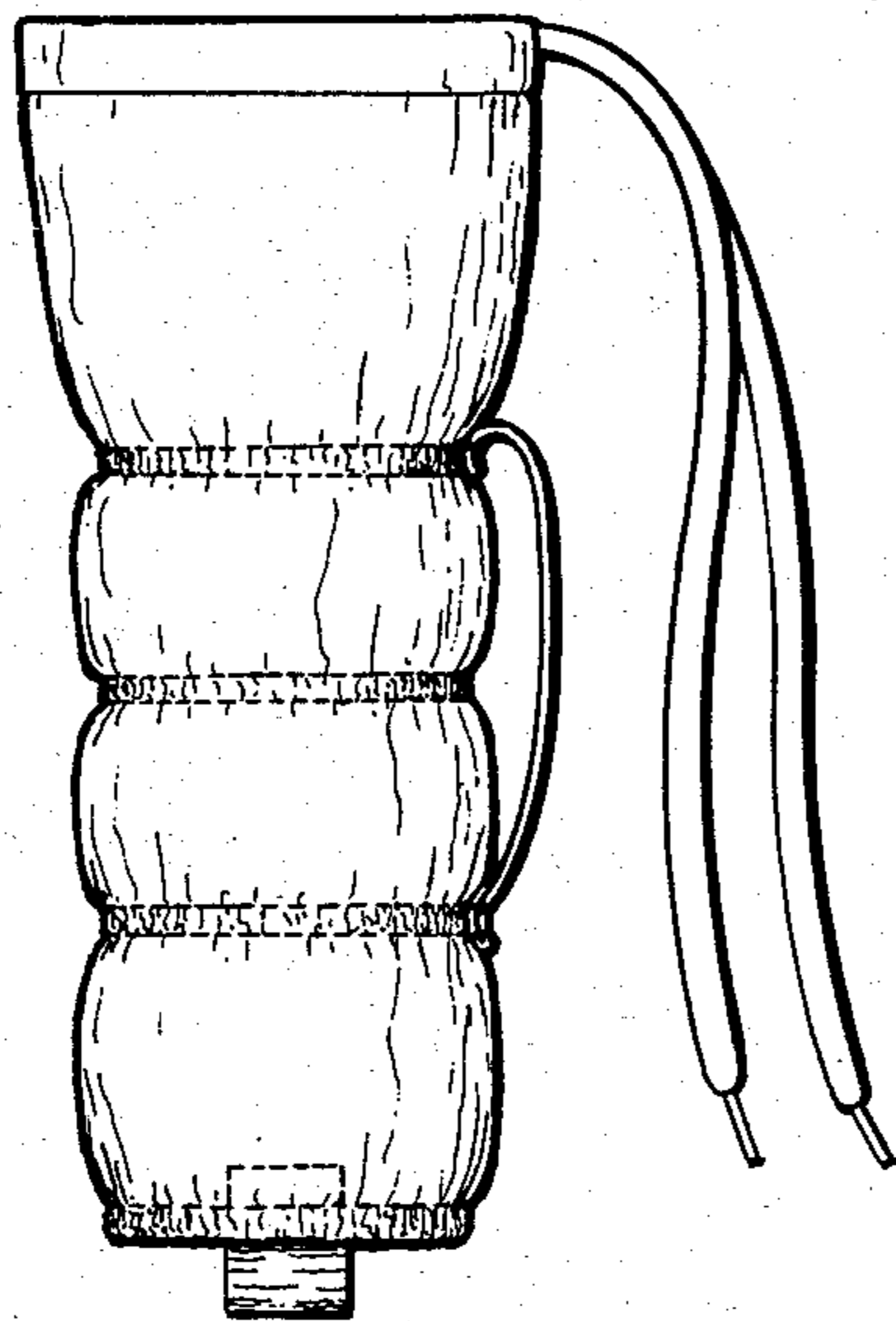

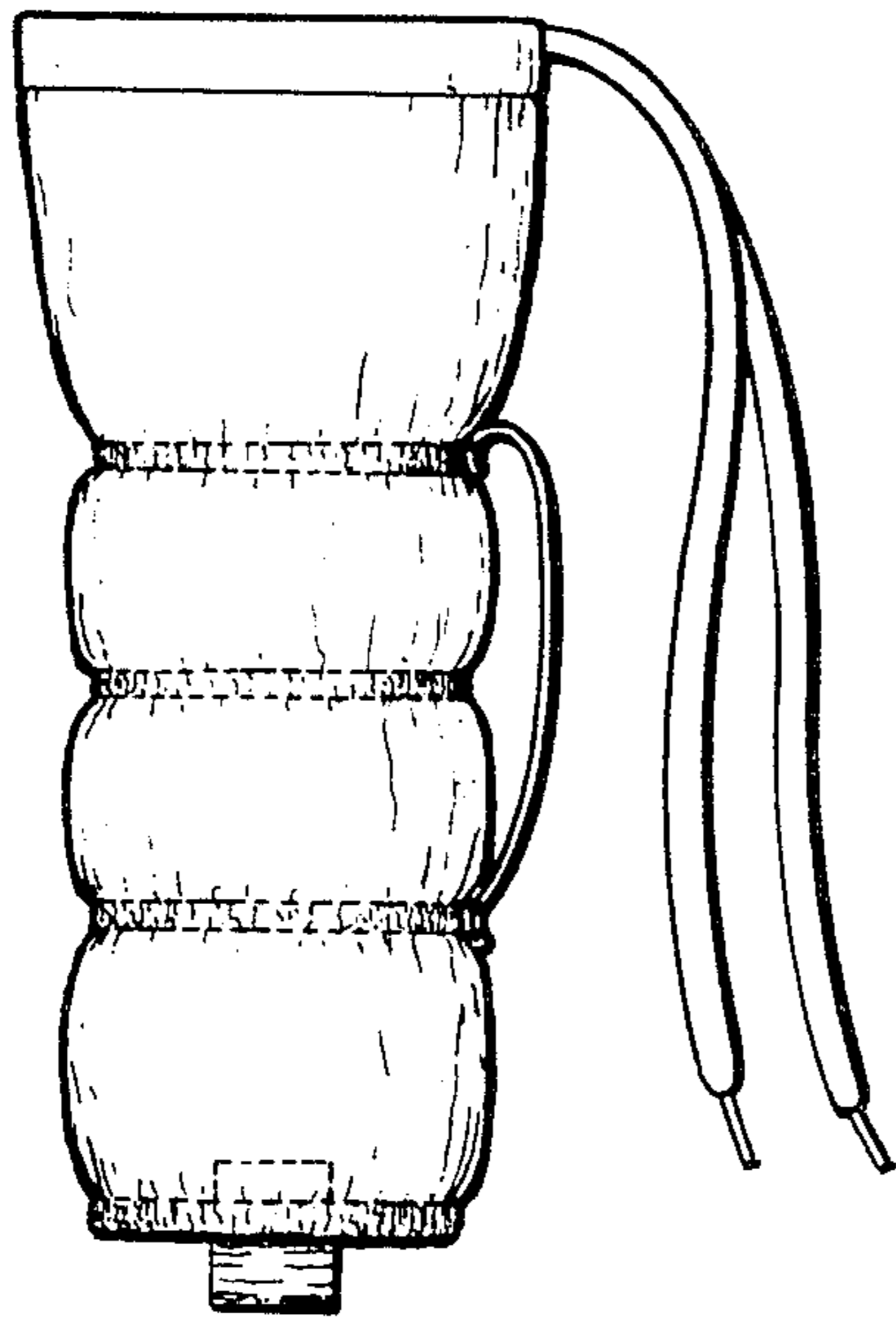

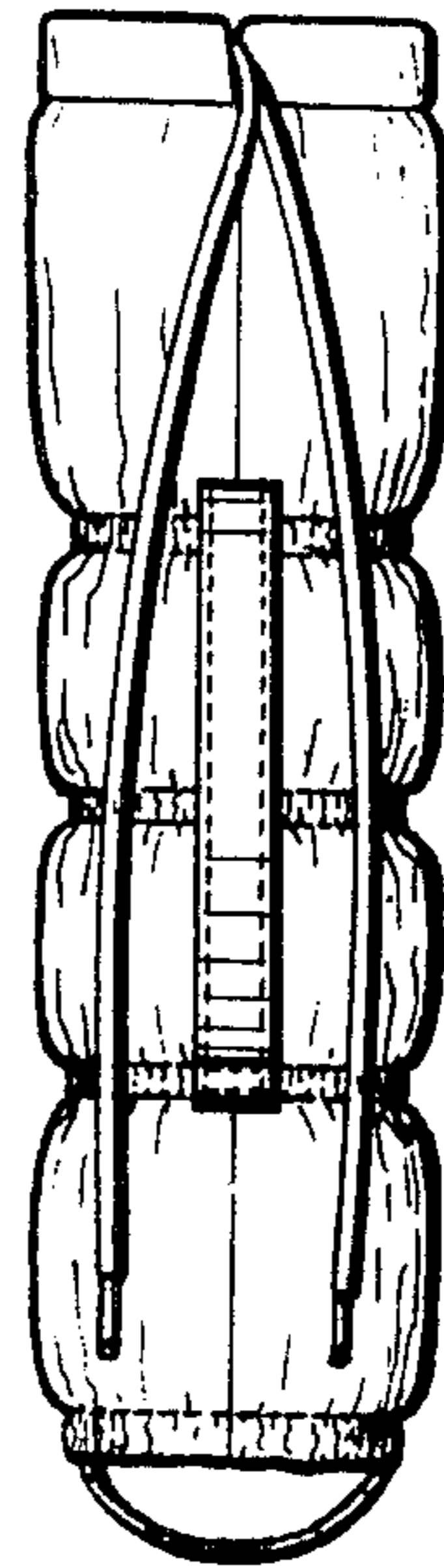

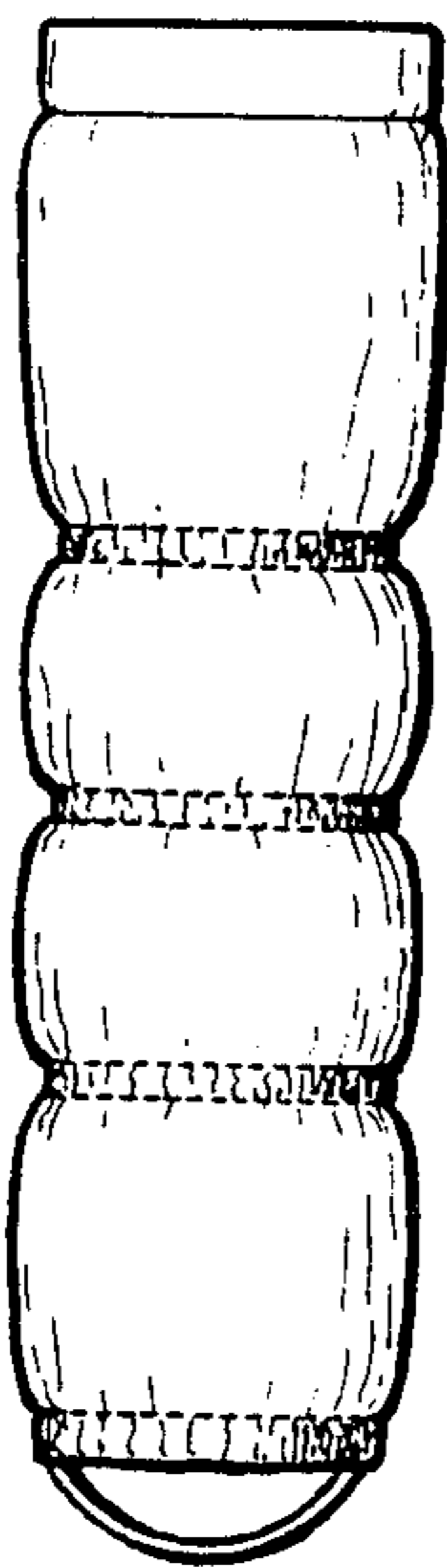

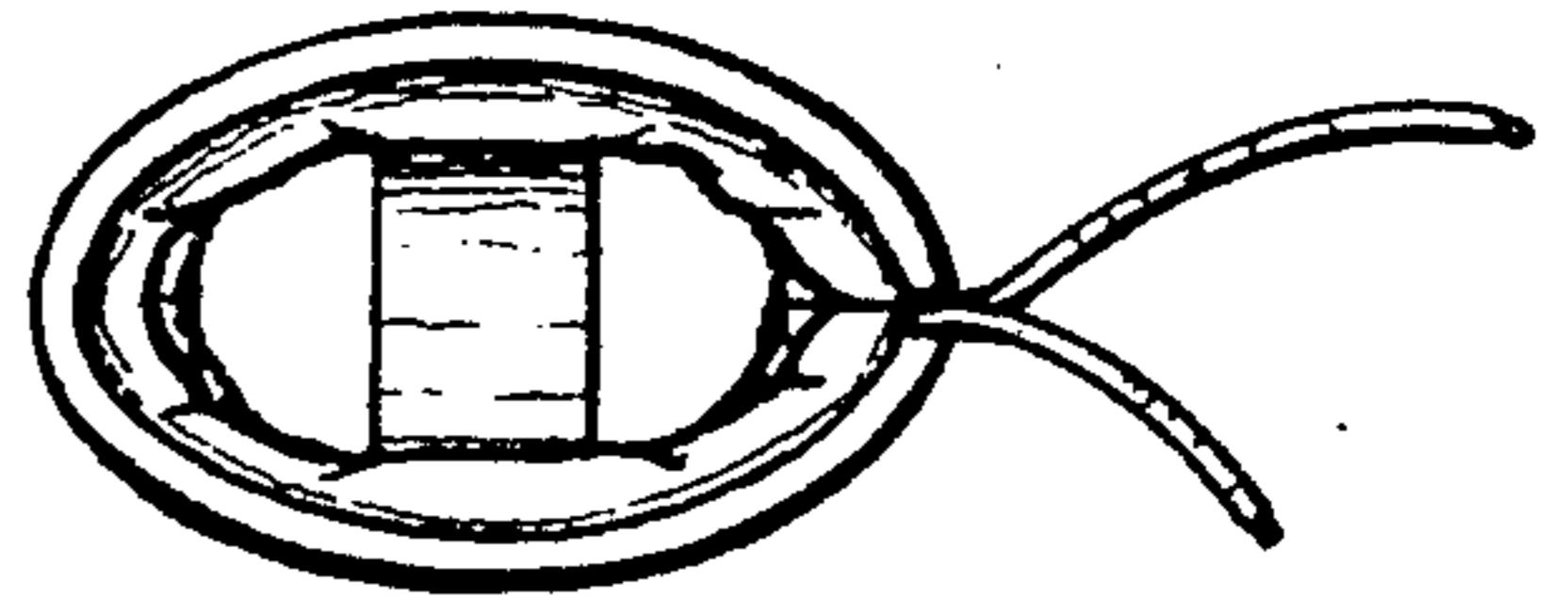
