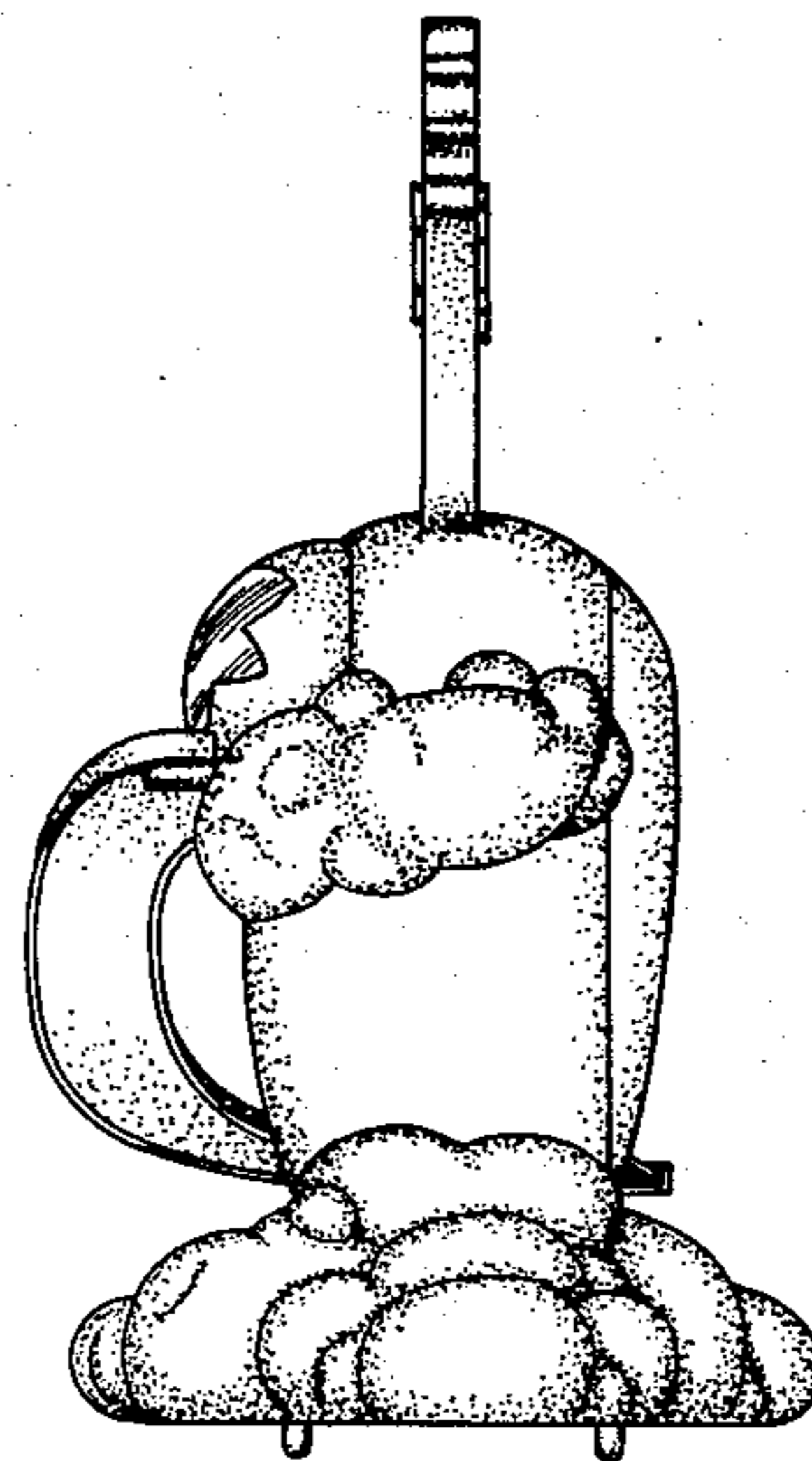
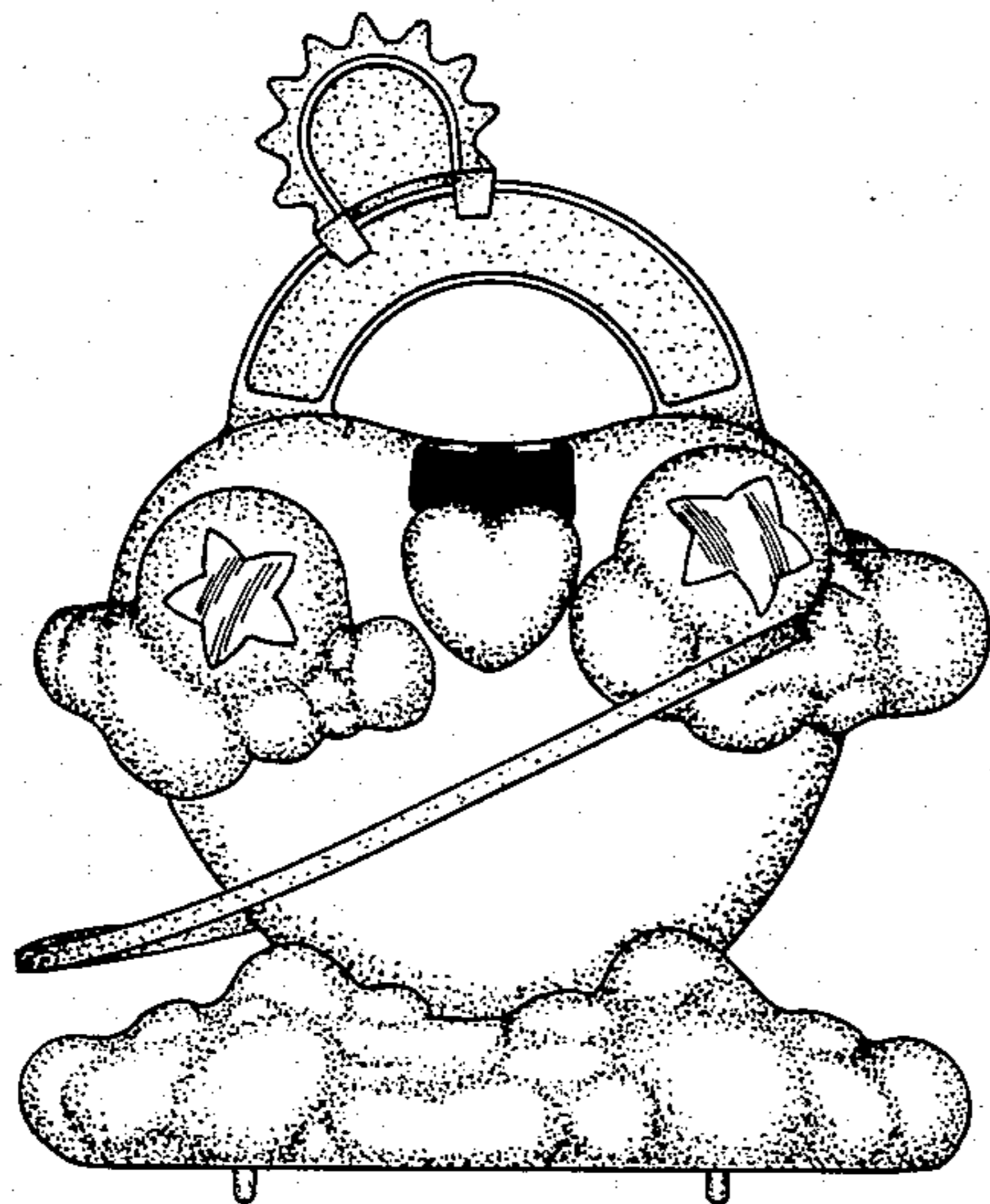

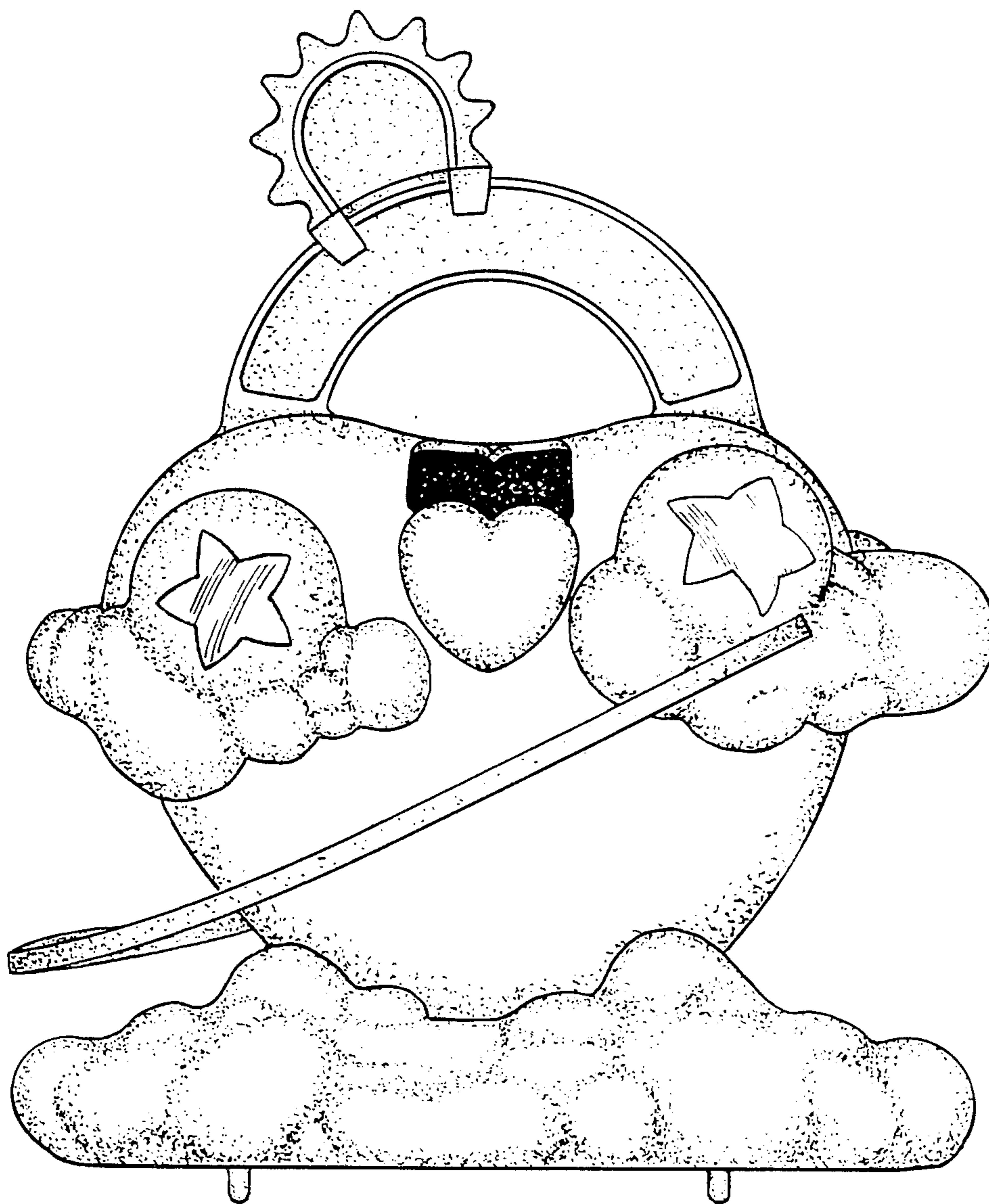

The ornamental design for a toy carrying case, substantially as shown and described.

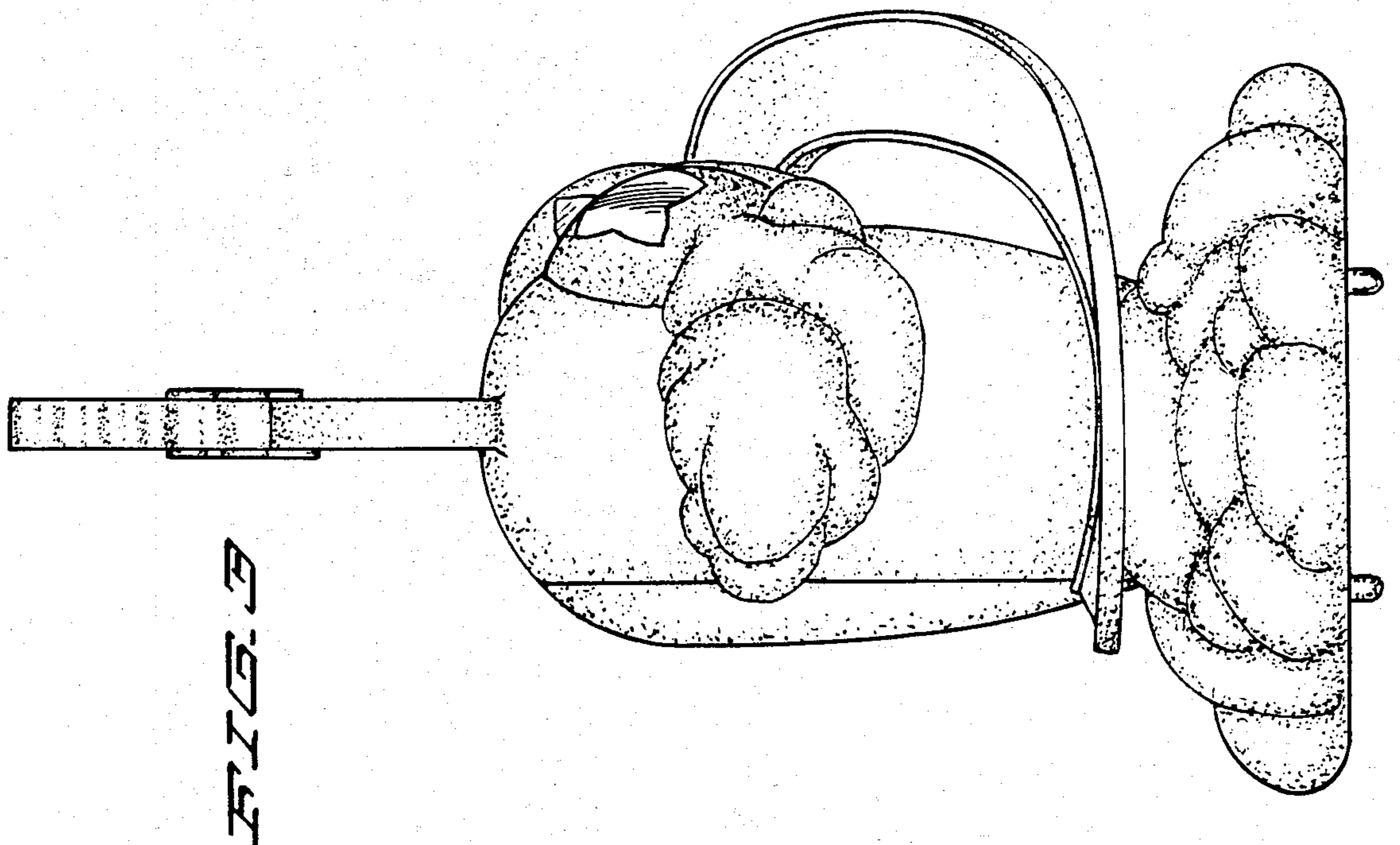
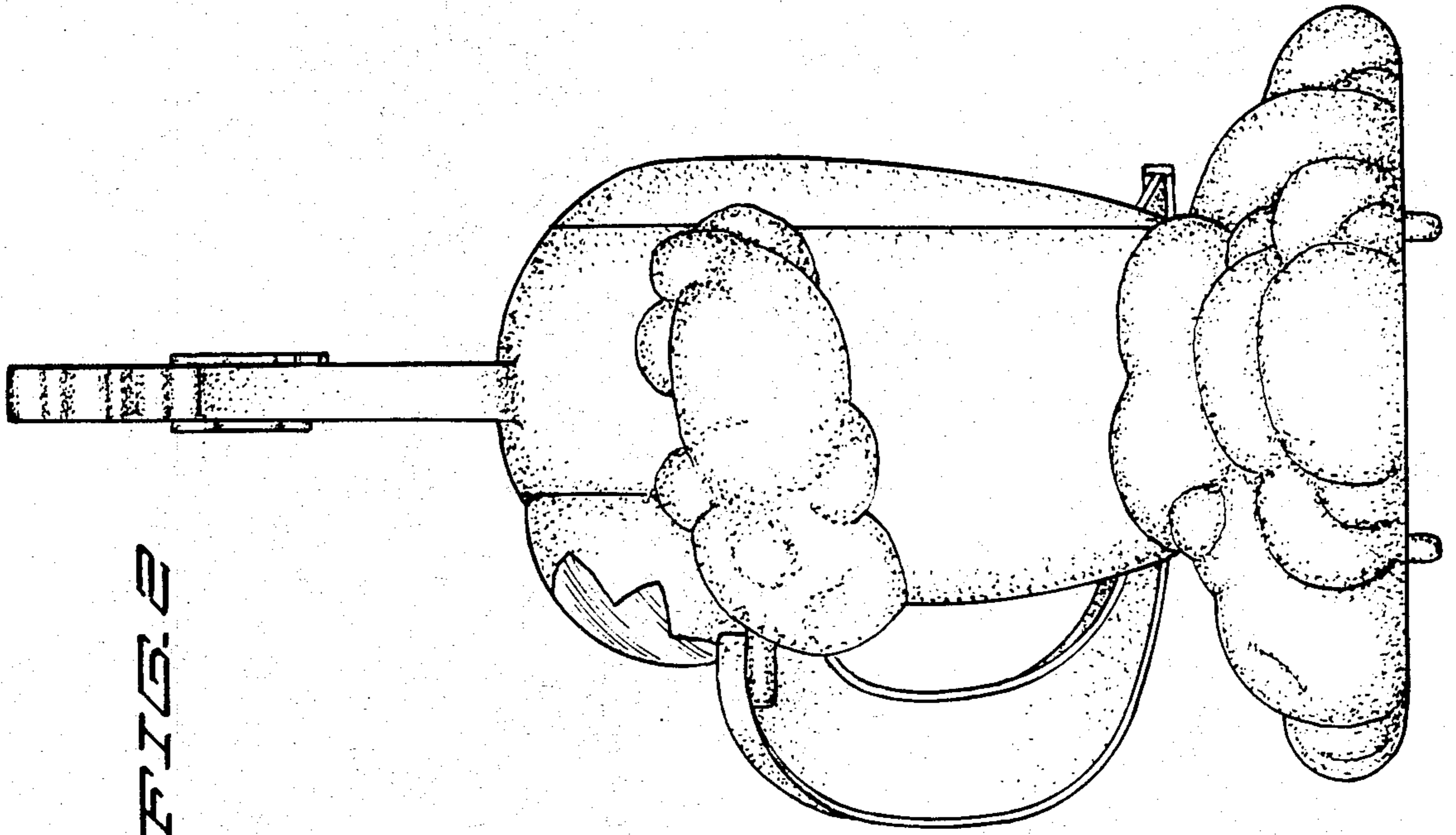
DESCRIPTION

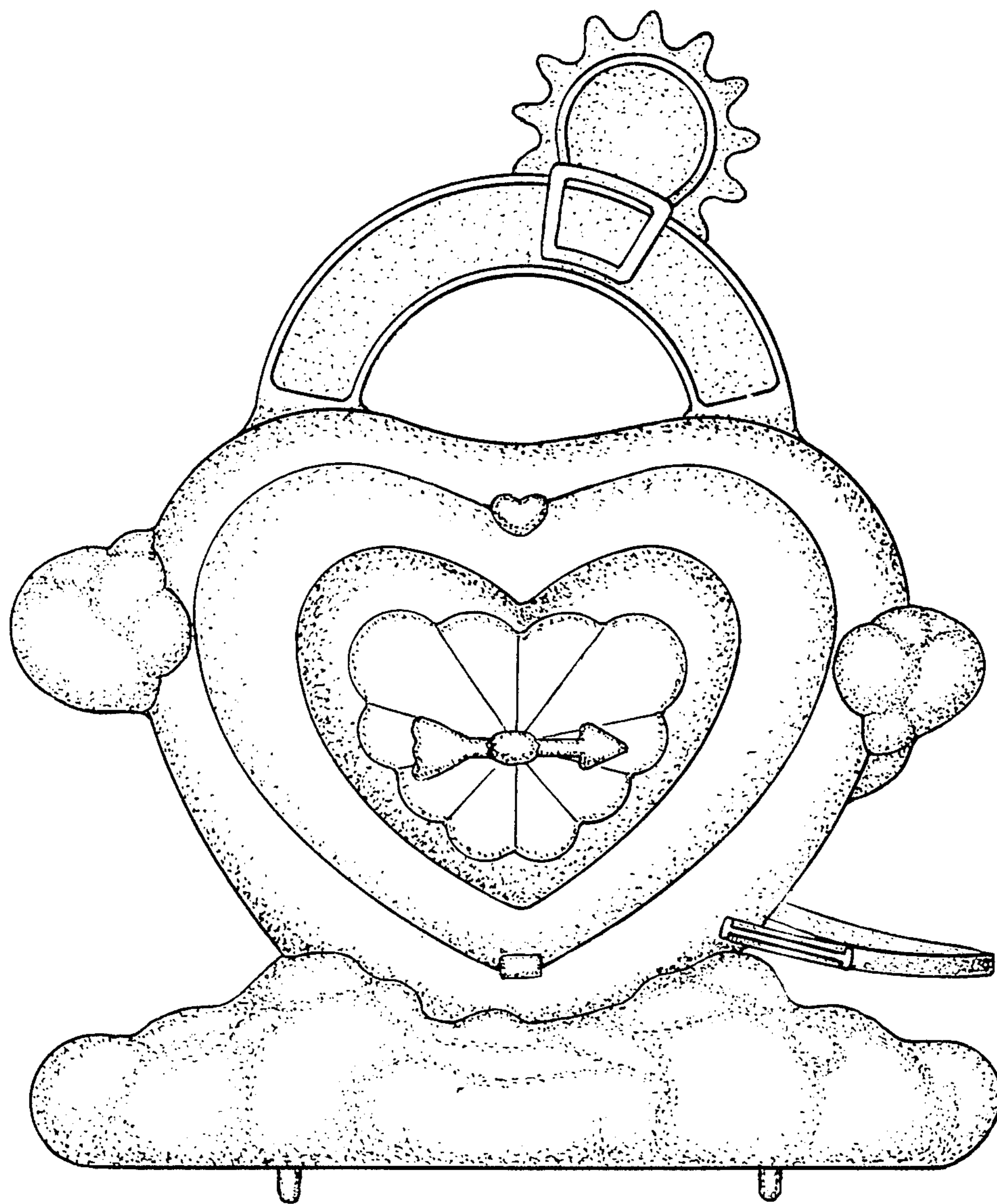
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a toy carrying case showing our new design;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



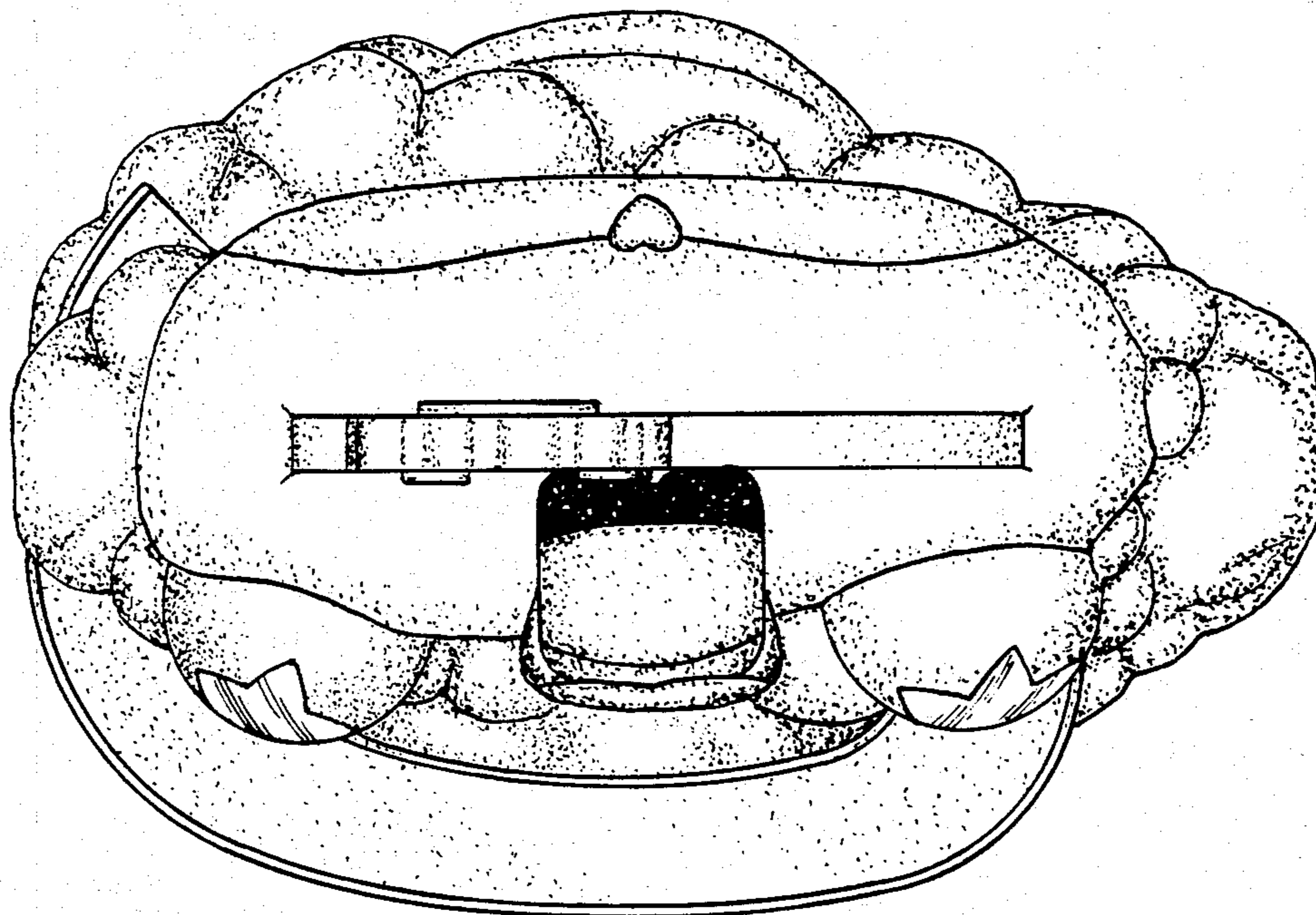

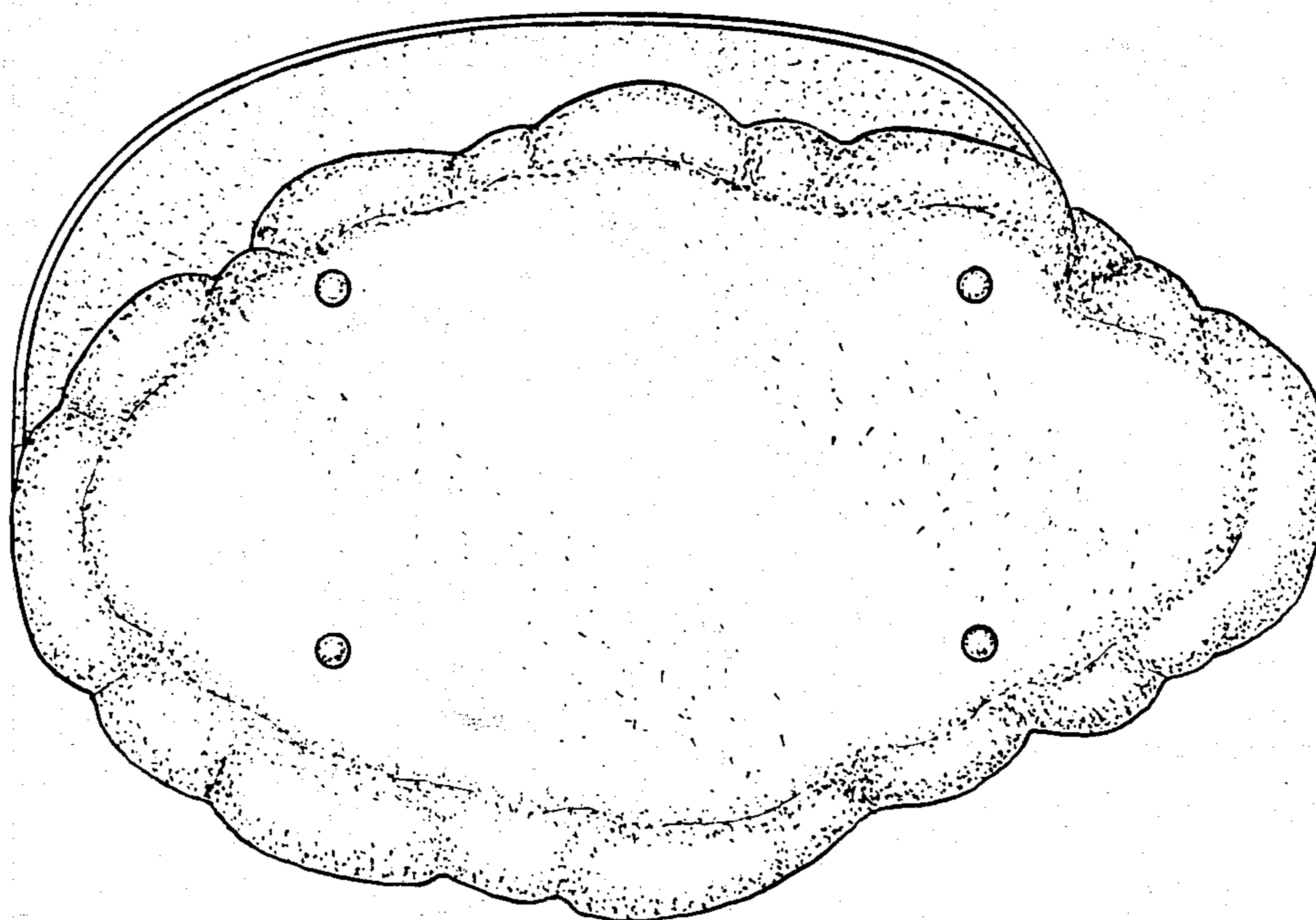
