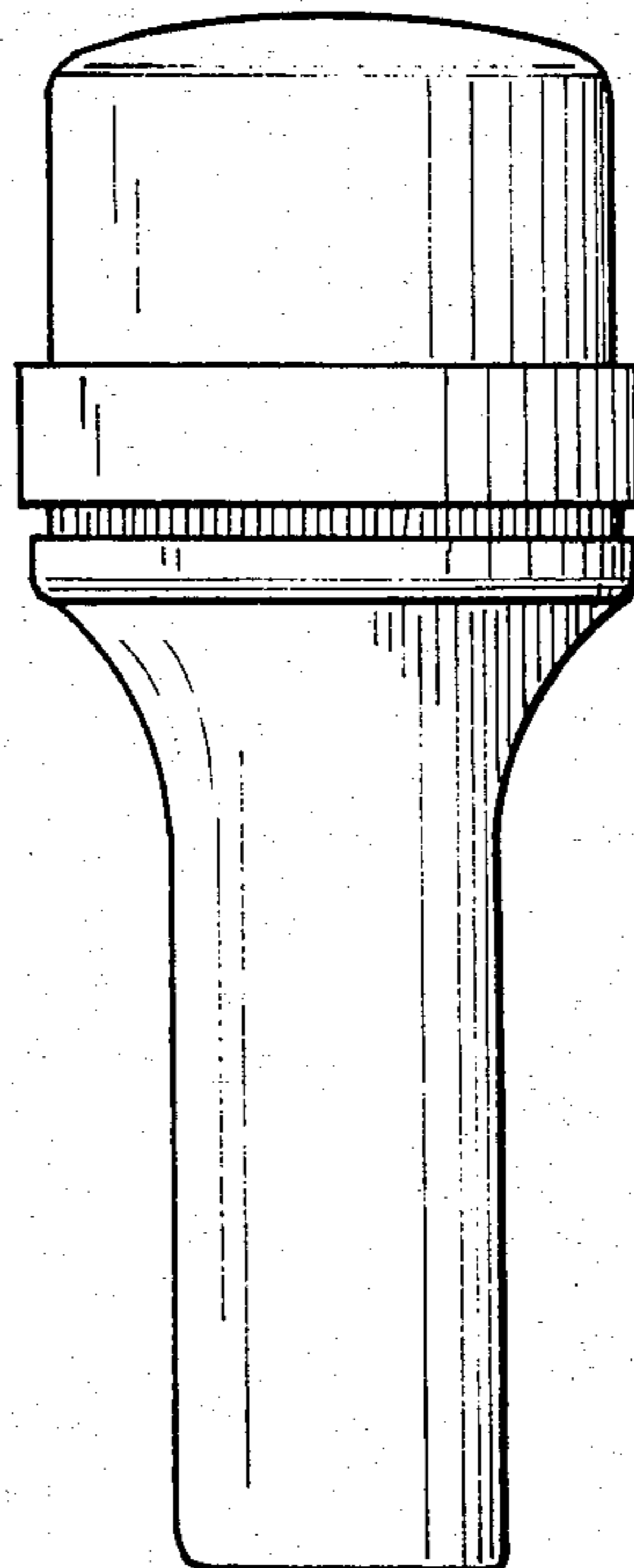

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a combined bottle and cap, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined bottle and cap showing my new design, the rear being identical to the front;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view looking from the right side, the left side being identical to the right;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 4 is a top plan view.



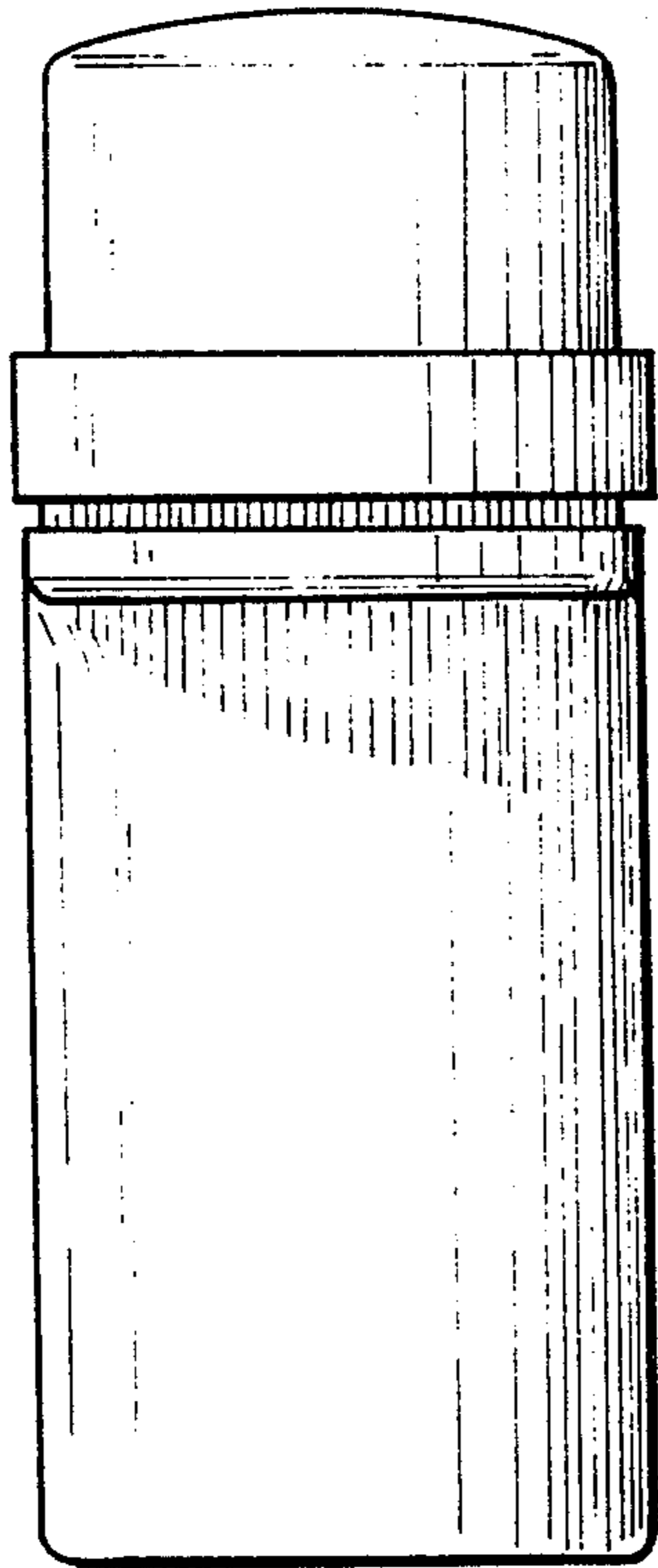

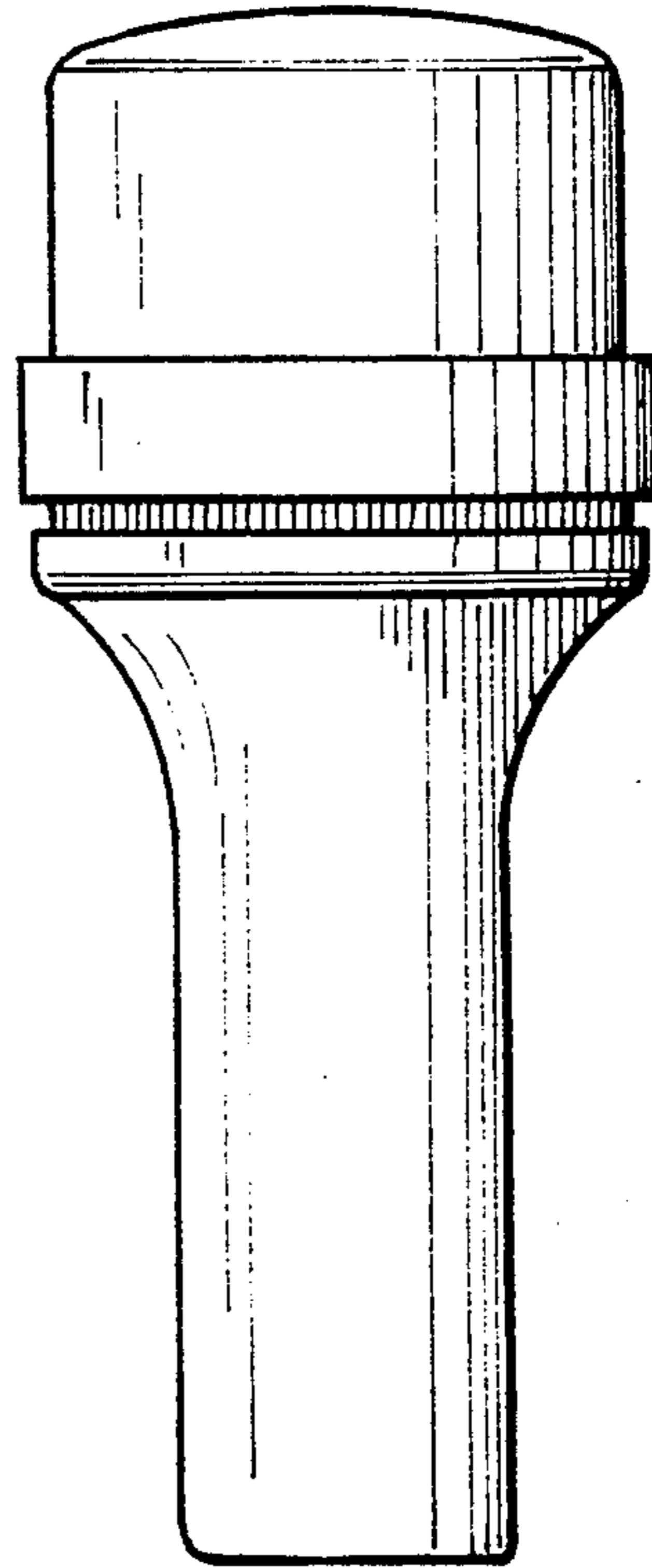

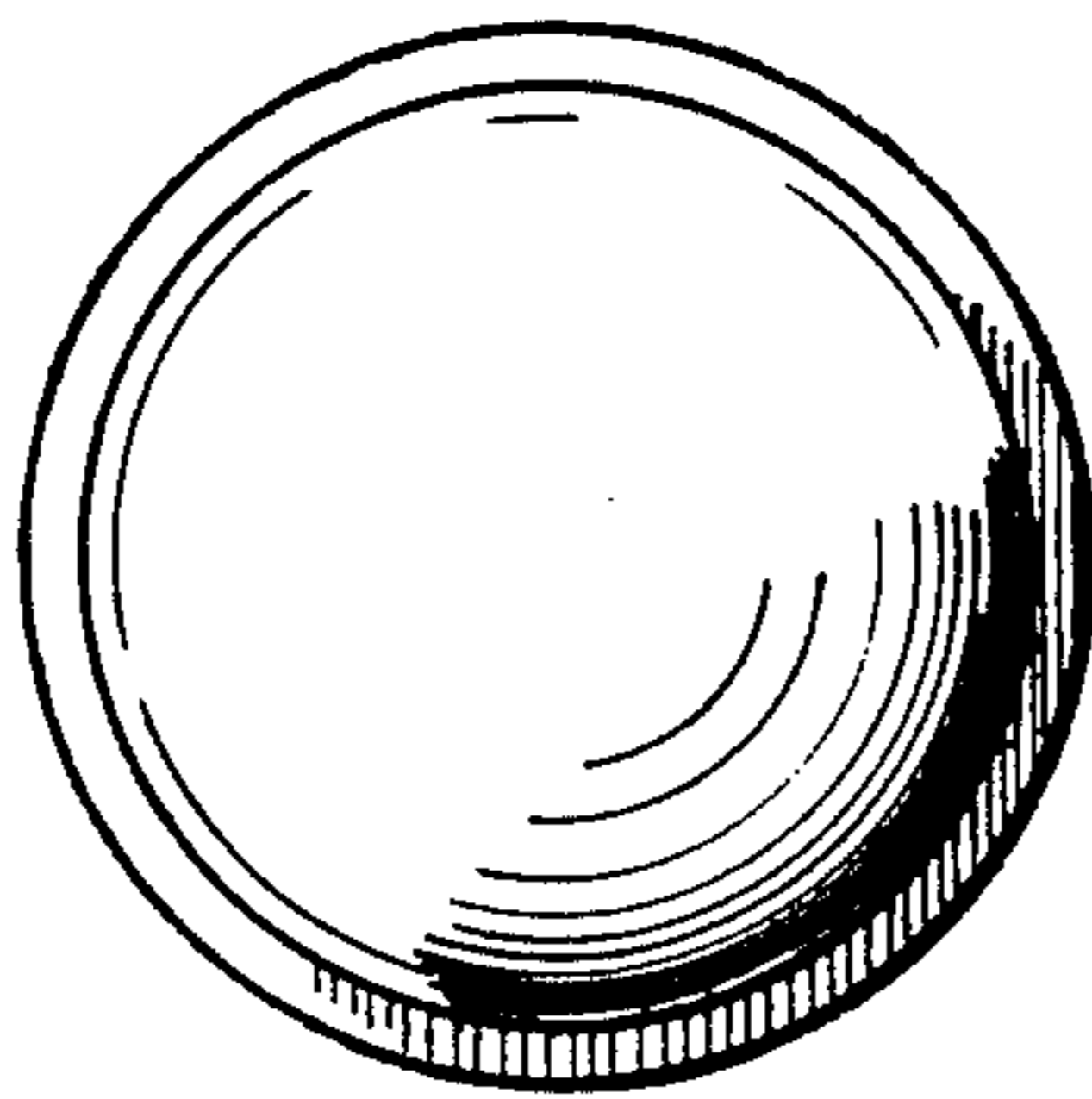

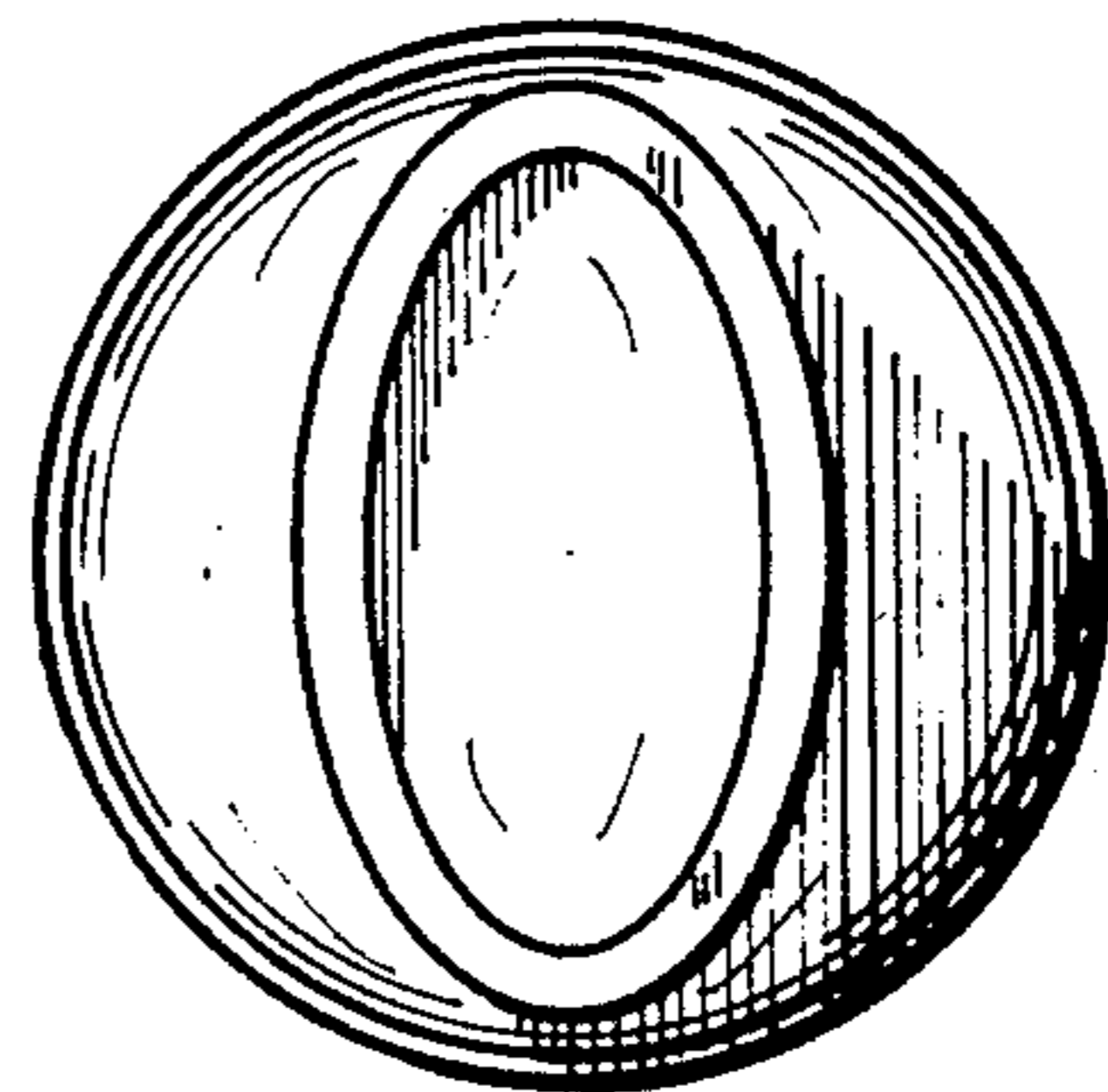
