The ornamental design for a figurine of a wolf, substan-
tially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side perspective view of the figurine of a
wolf showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is an opposite side perspective view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a front end elevational view of FIG. 1;
