[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a video display unit, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the video display unit showing our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of the side opposite that shown in FIG. 4; and  
FIG. 7 is a front perspective view thereof on an enlarged scale.  
The vents in the top surface of the unit are partially shown in FIG. 1 and are omitted in FIGS. 5 and 7 for convenience of illustration.

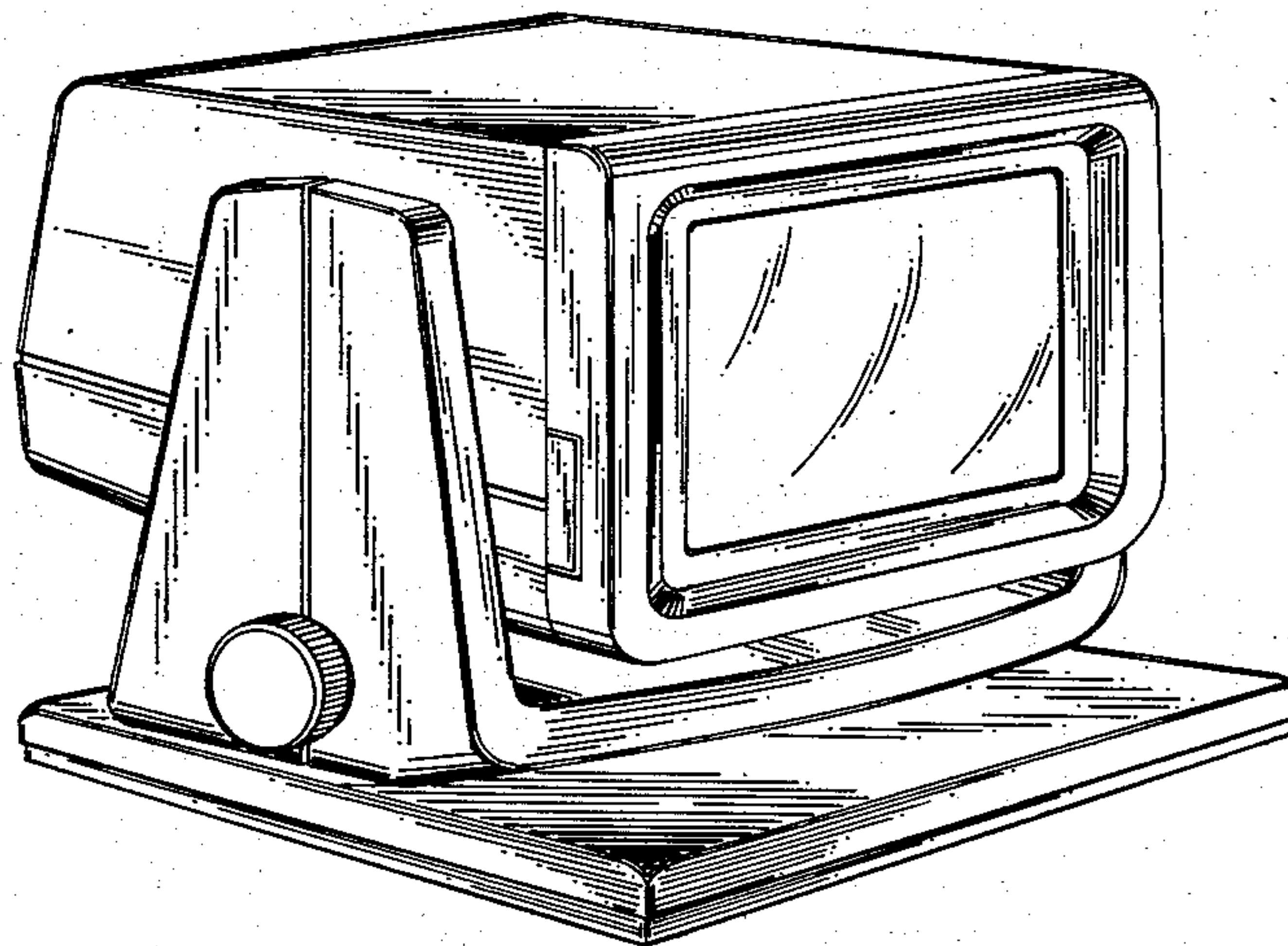

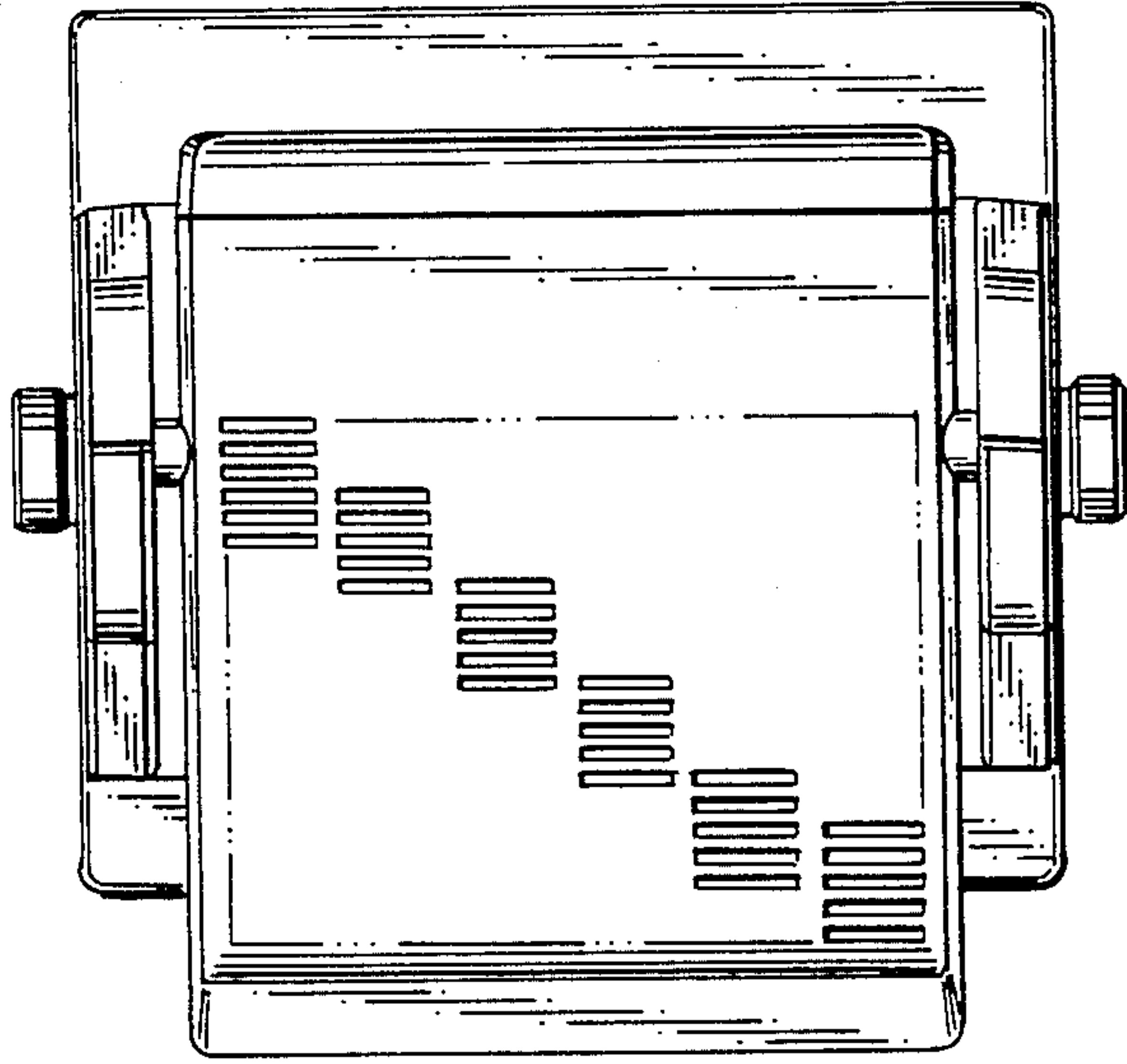

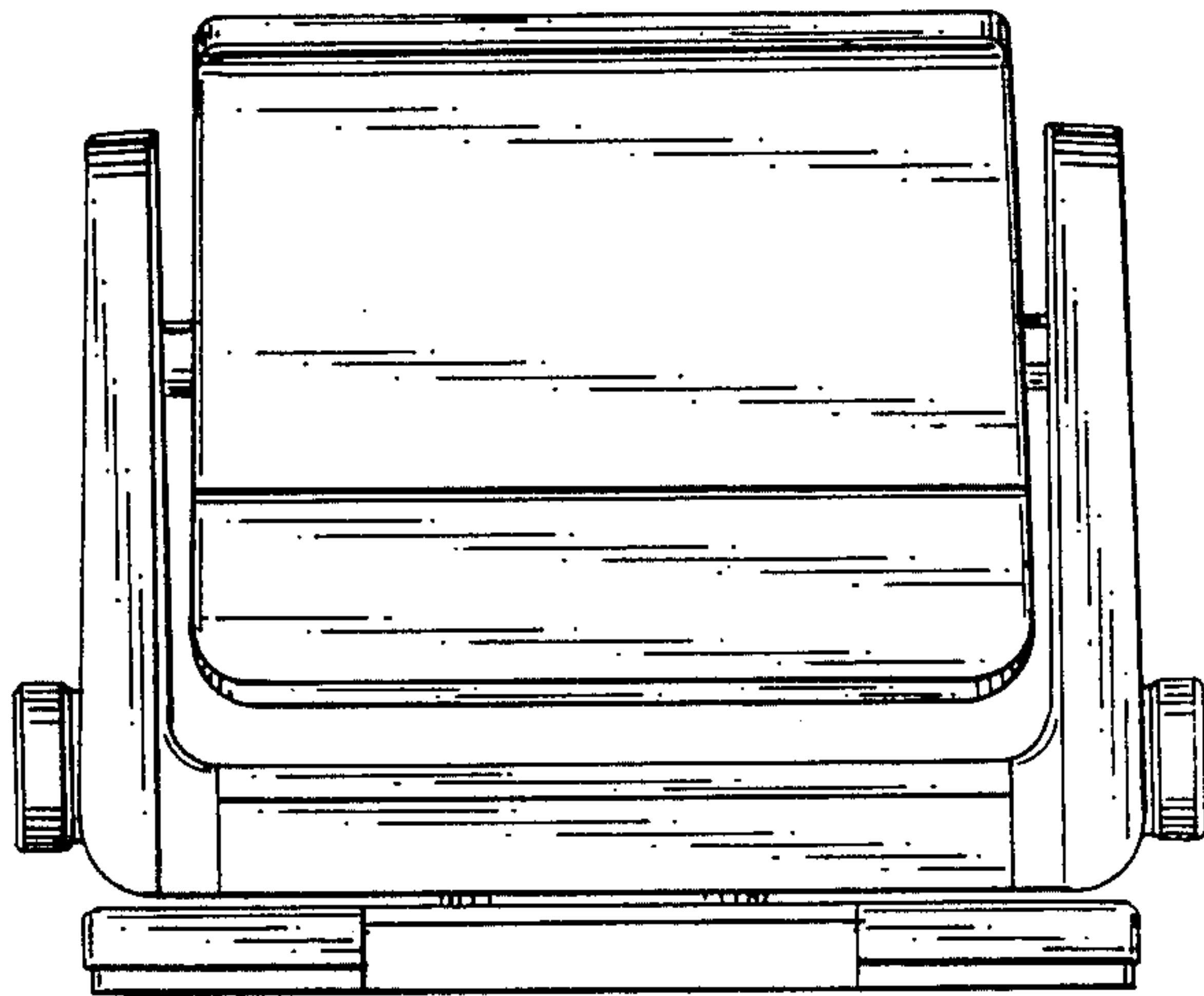

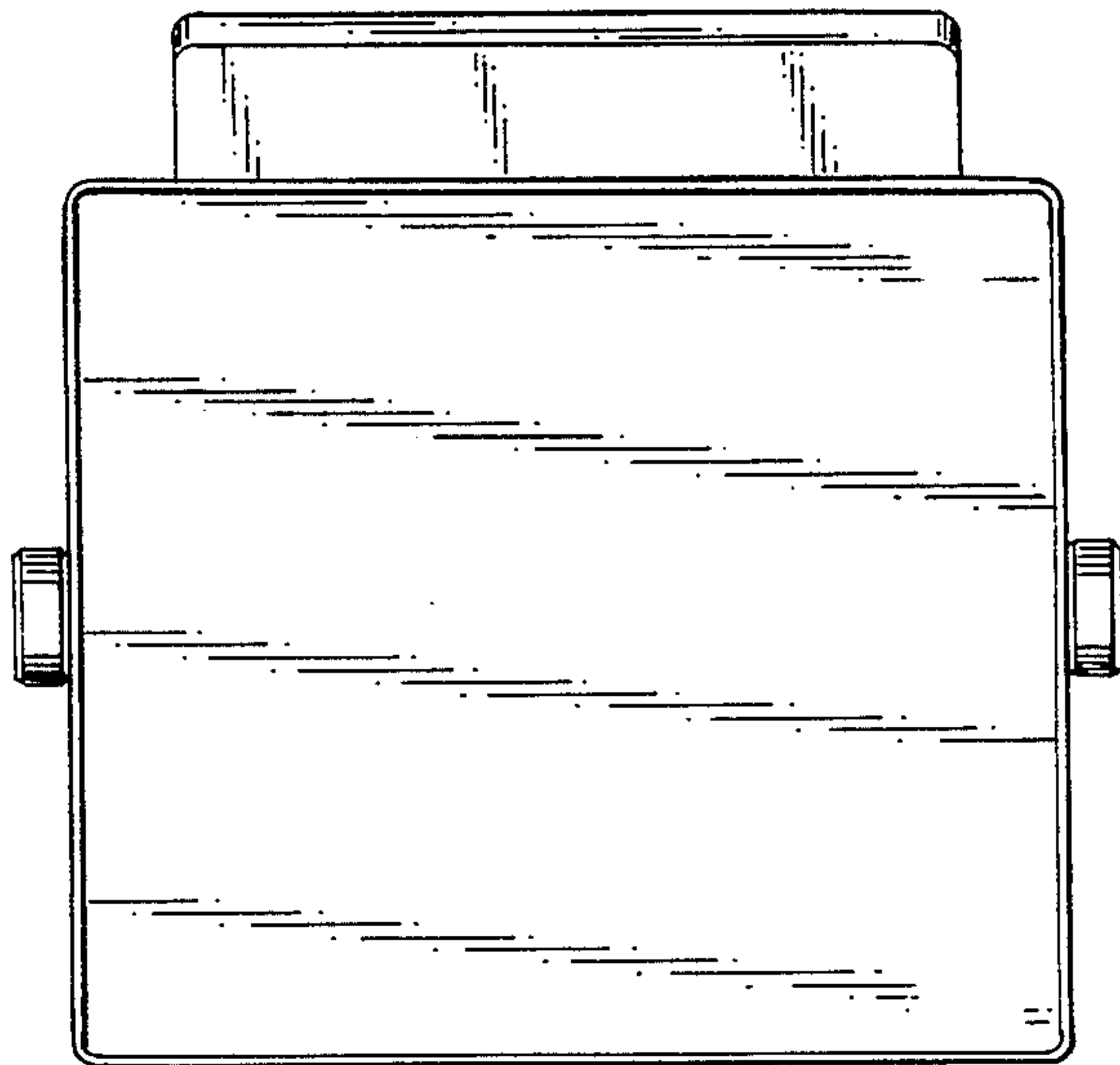

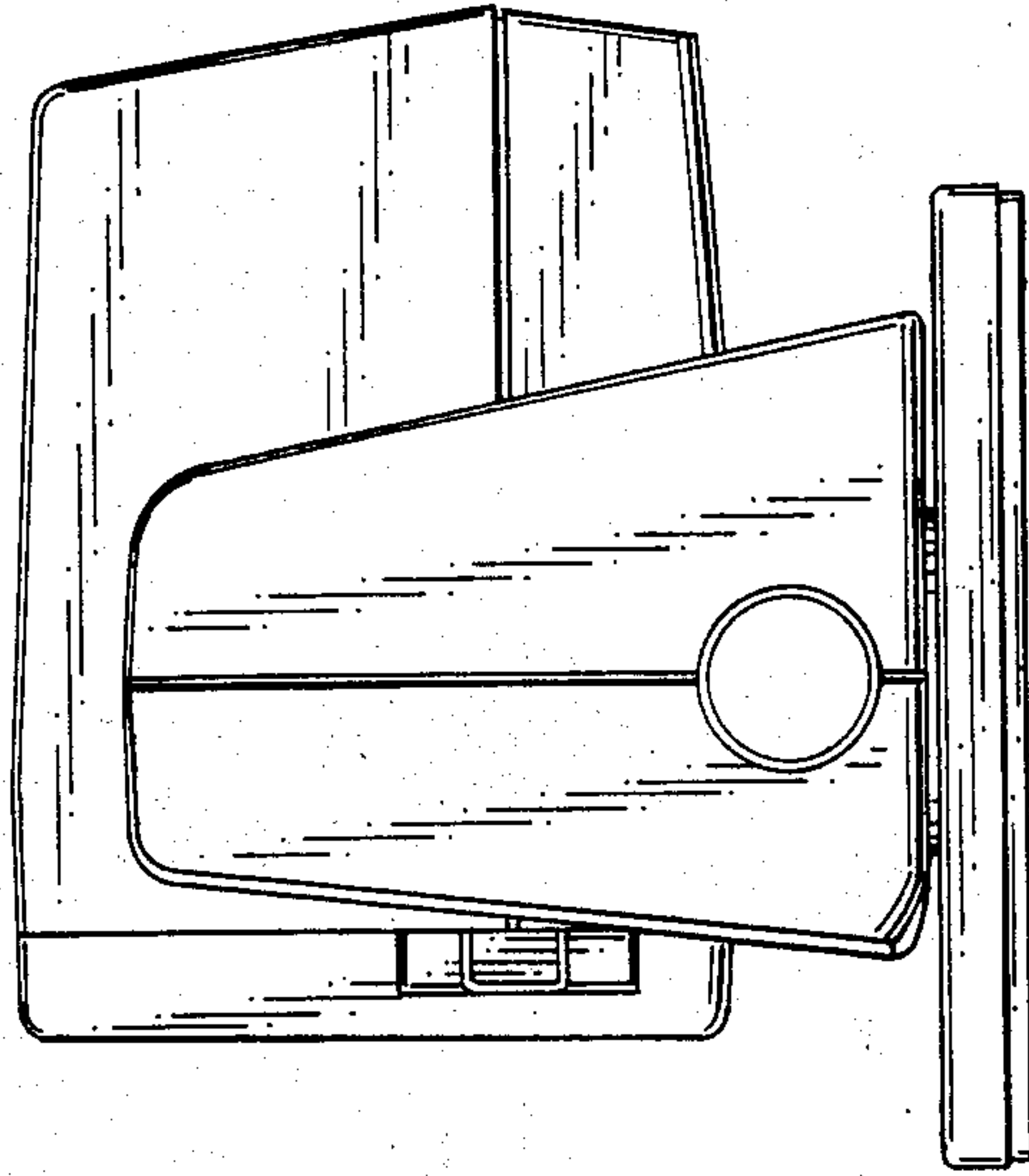

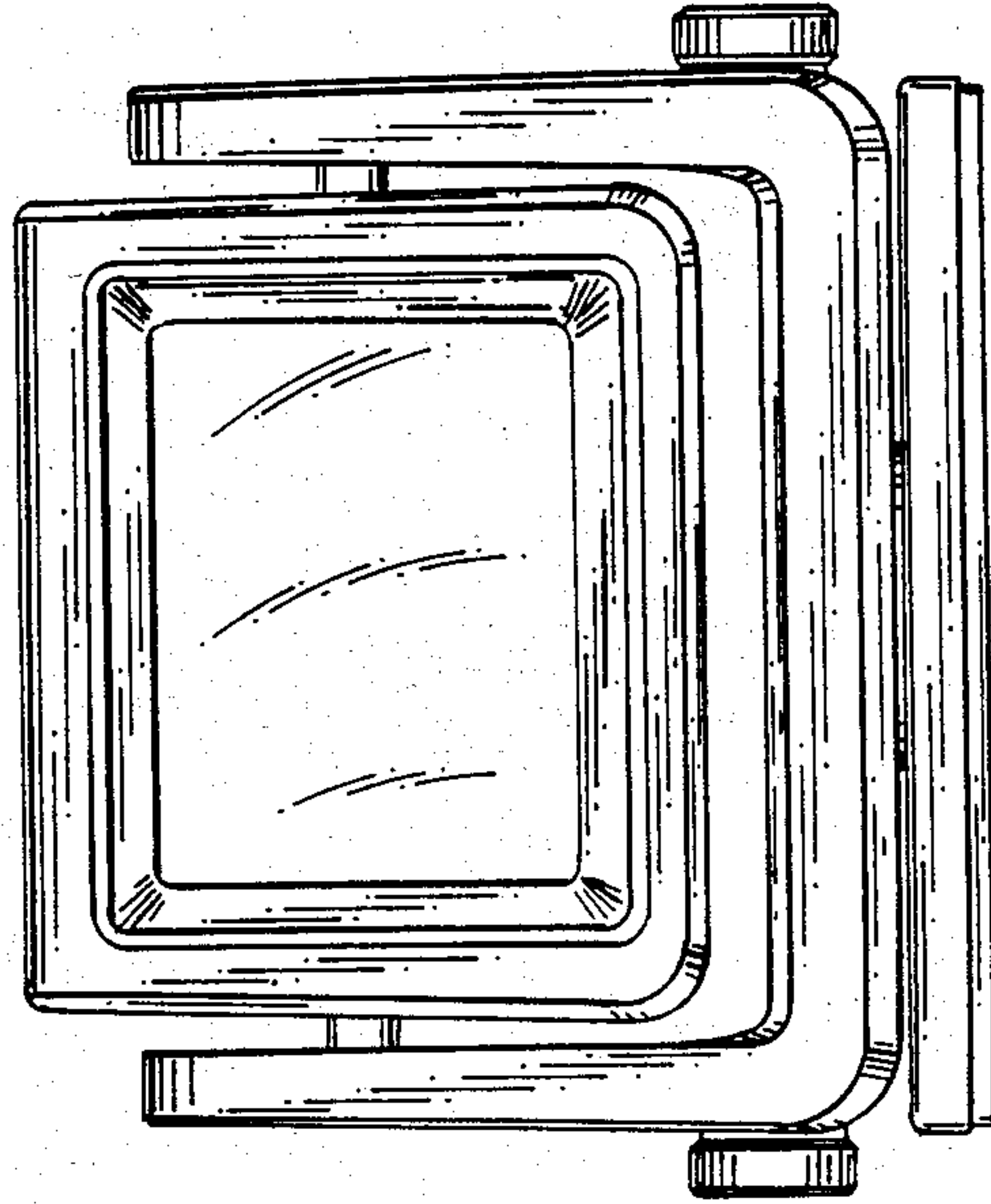

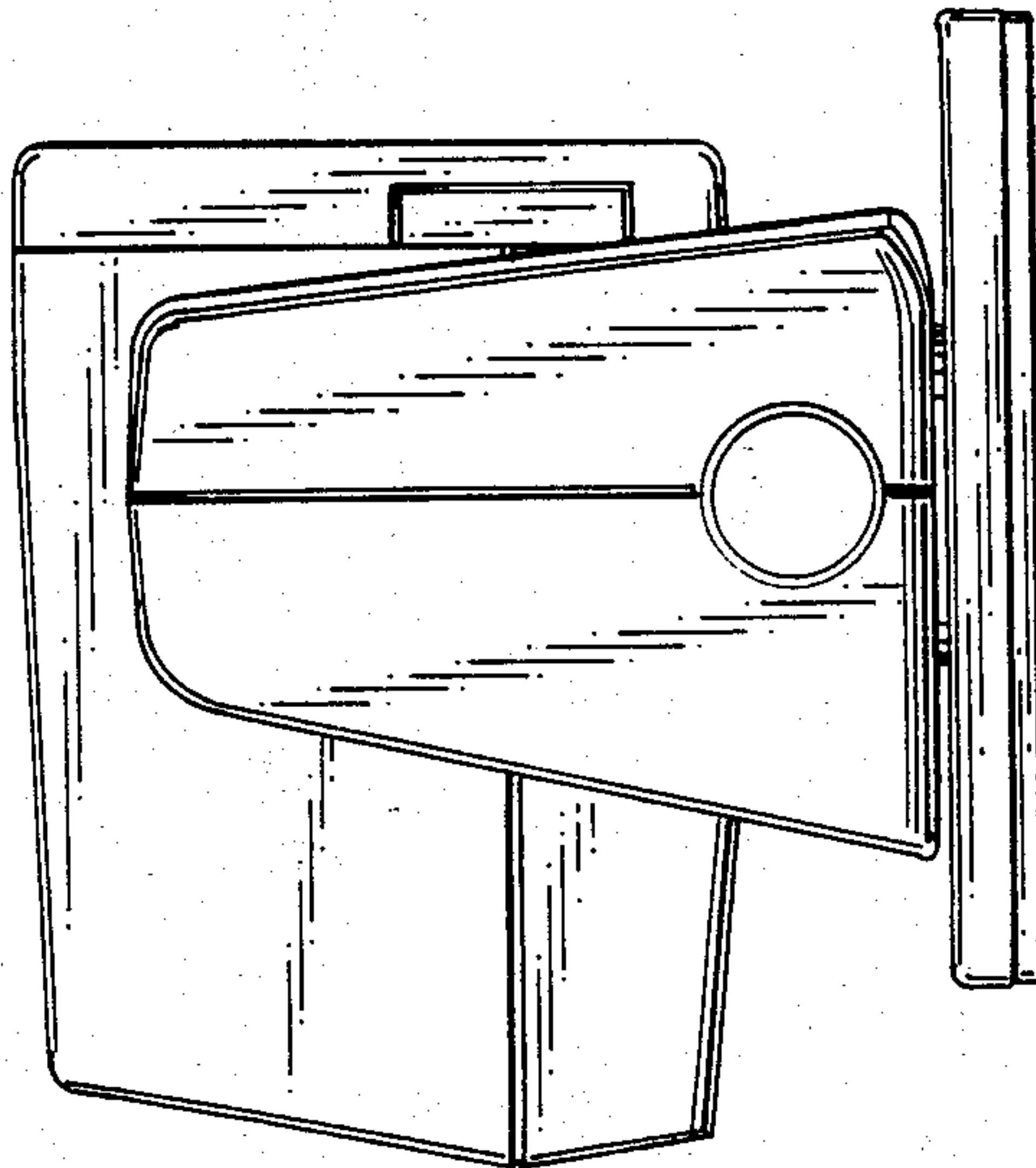
