[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for the brassiere, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a brassiere showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a plan view of the outside thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a plan view of the inside thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a view like FIG. 1 of a second embodiment of a brassiere showing our new design, wherein the front center seam and the seams at the outside of the cups are eliminated and "underwiring" seams are added on the cups;
 FIG. 5 is a view like FIG. 2 thereof; and
 FIG. 6 is a view like FIG. 3 thereof.

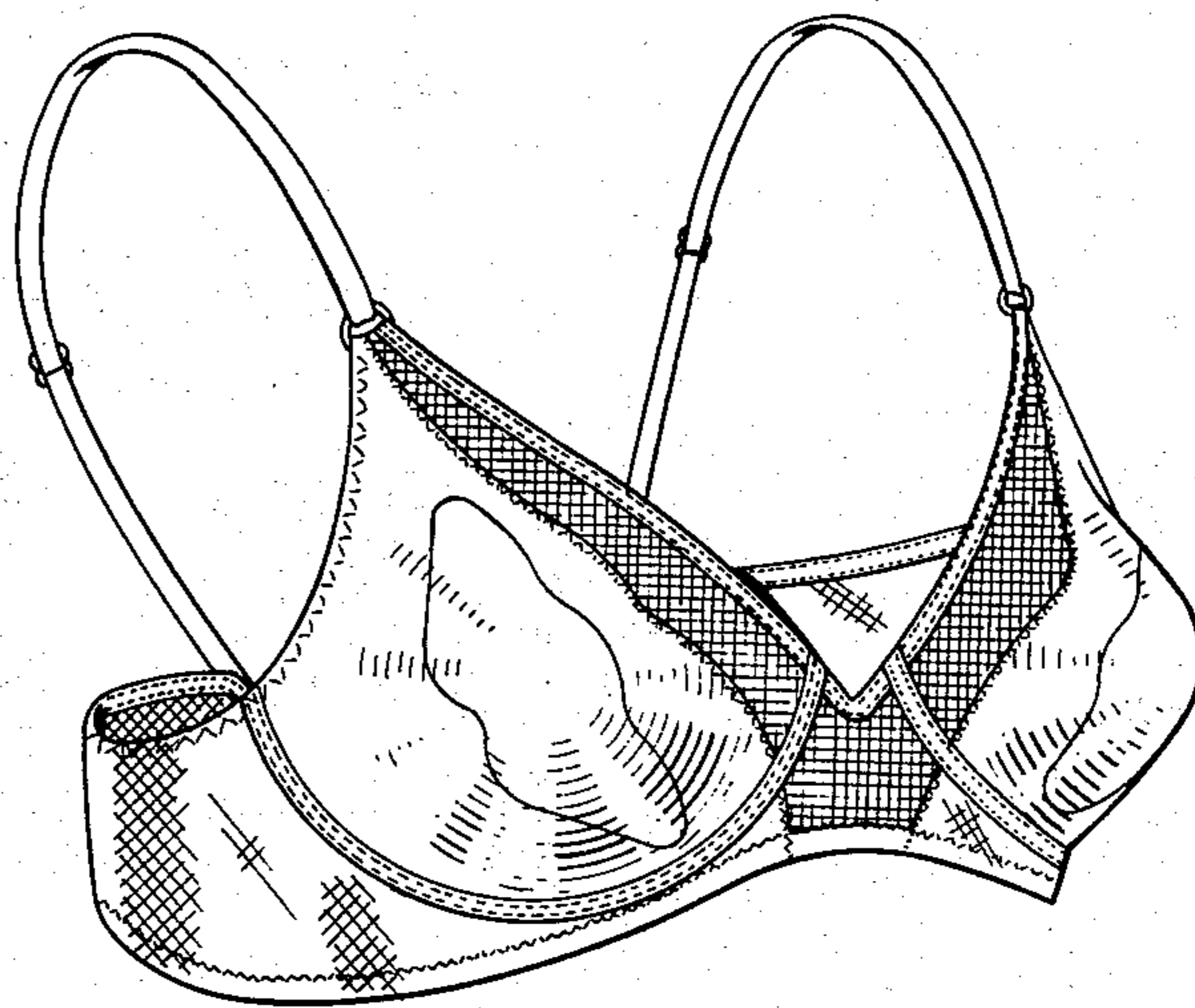
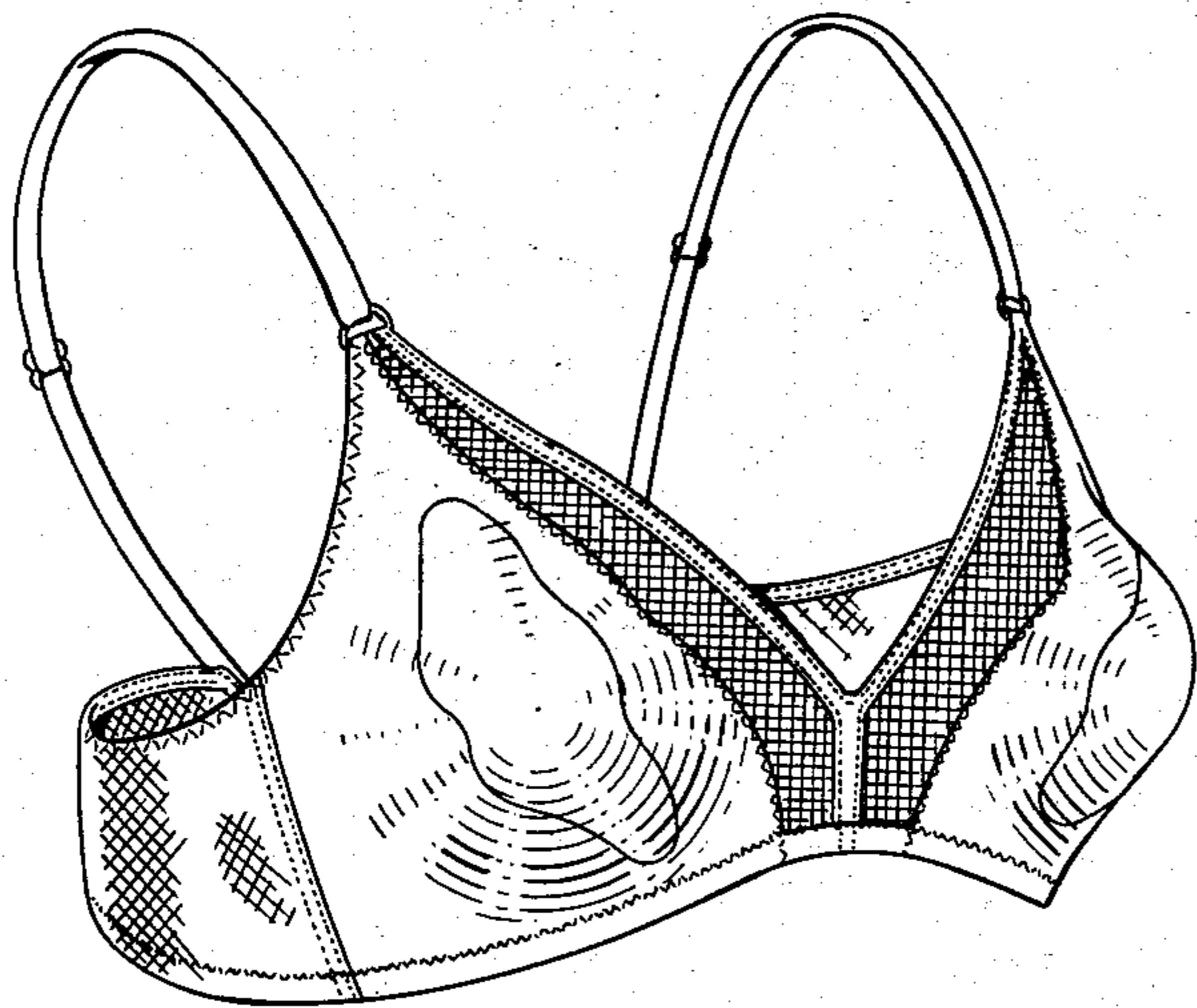

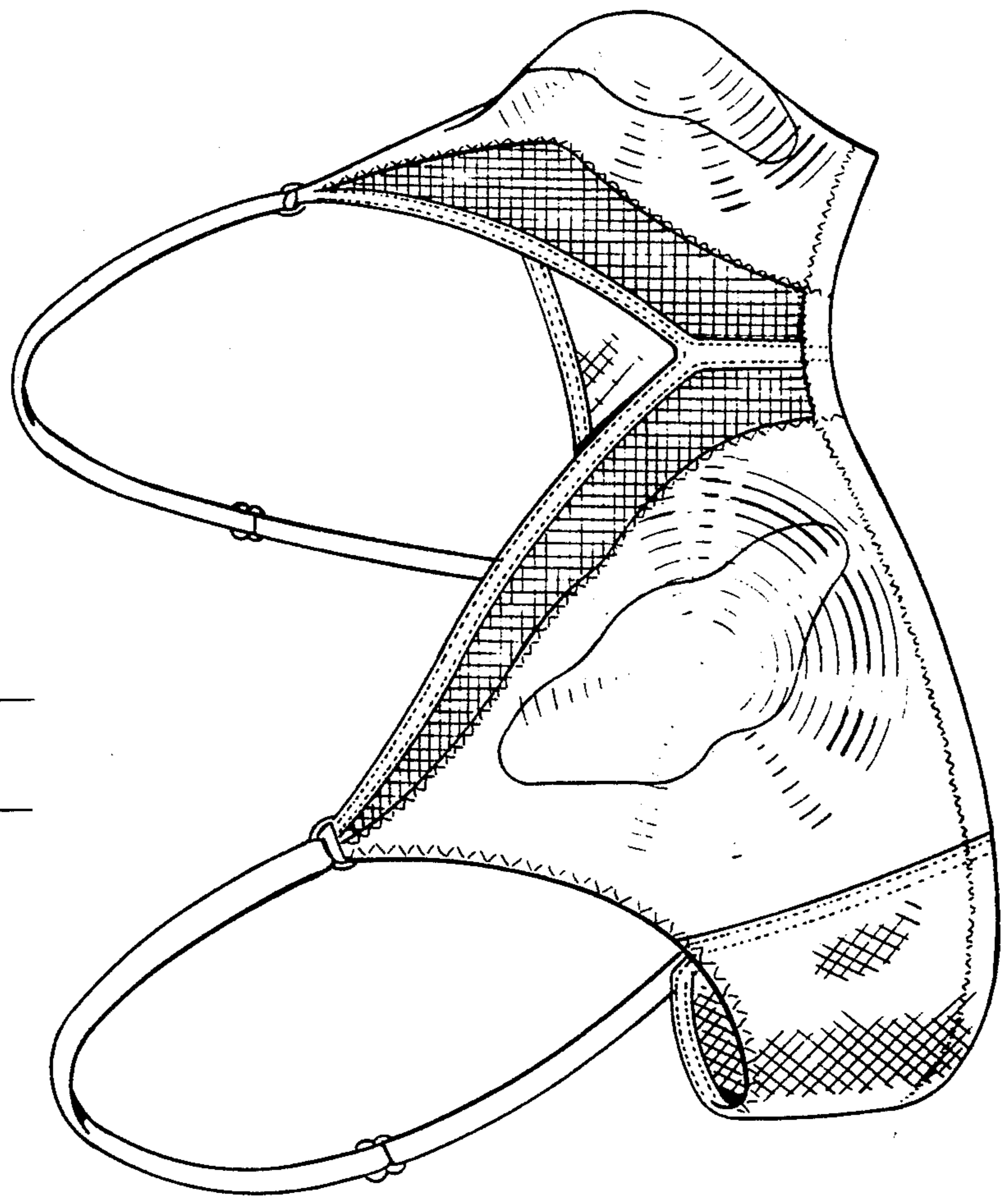

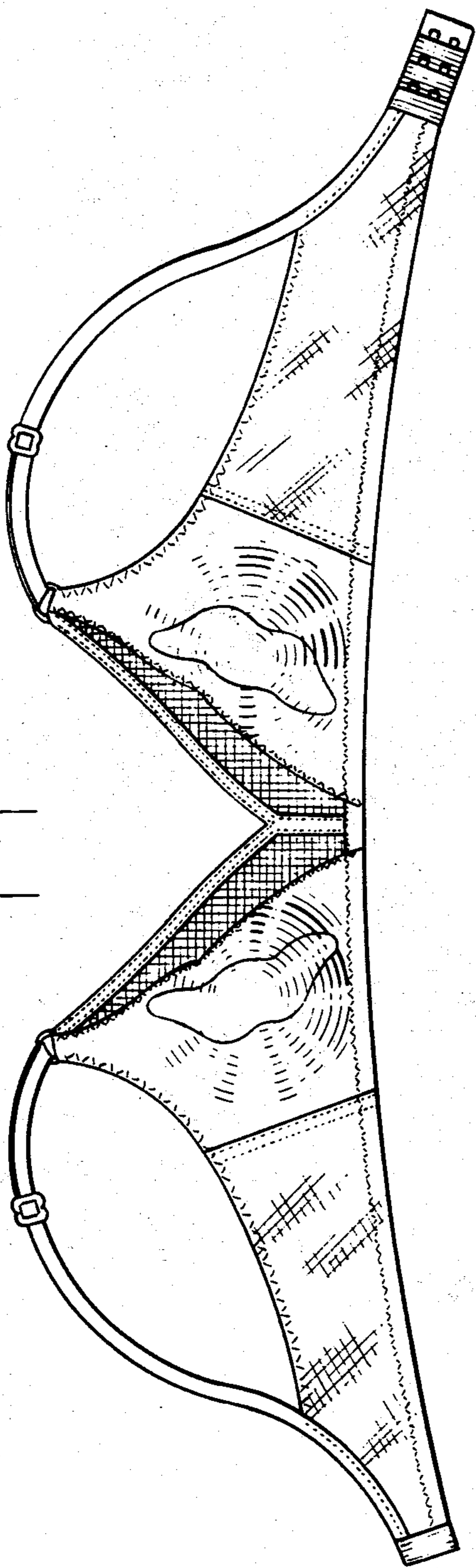

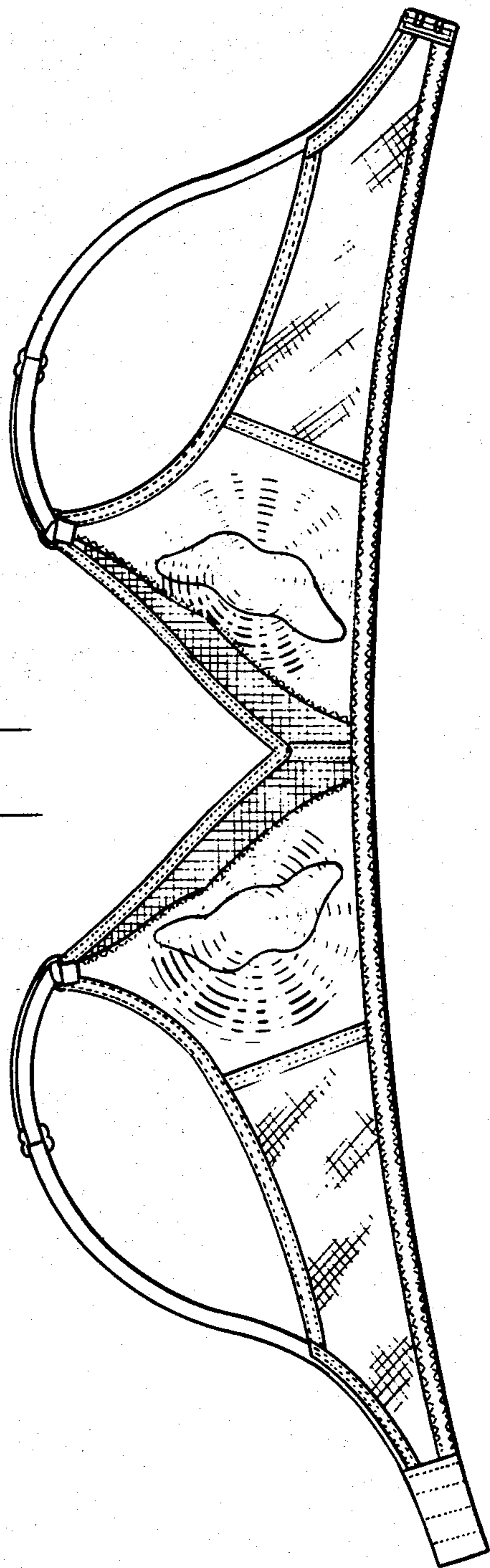
