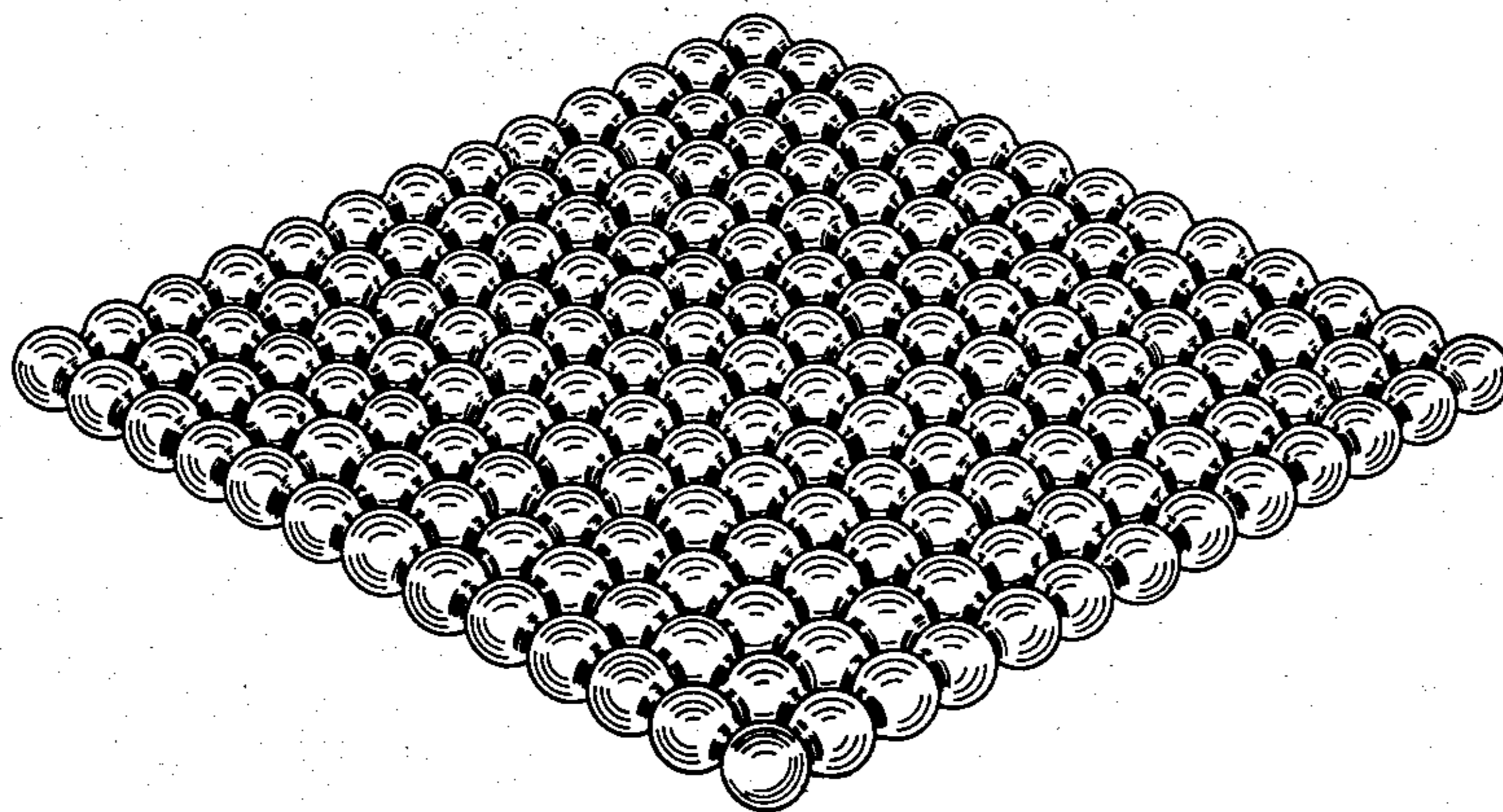
The ornamental design for an antislip flexible mat, as

FIG. 3 is an end view of a fragmentary portion thereof.



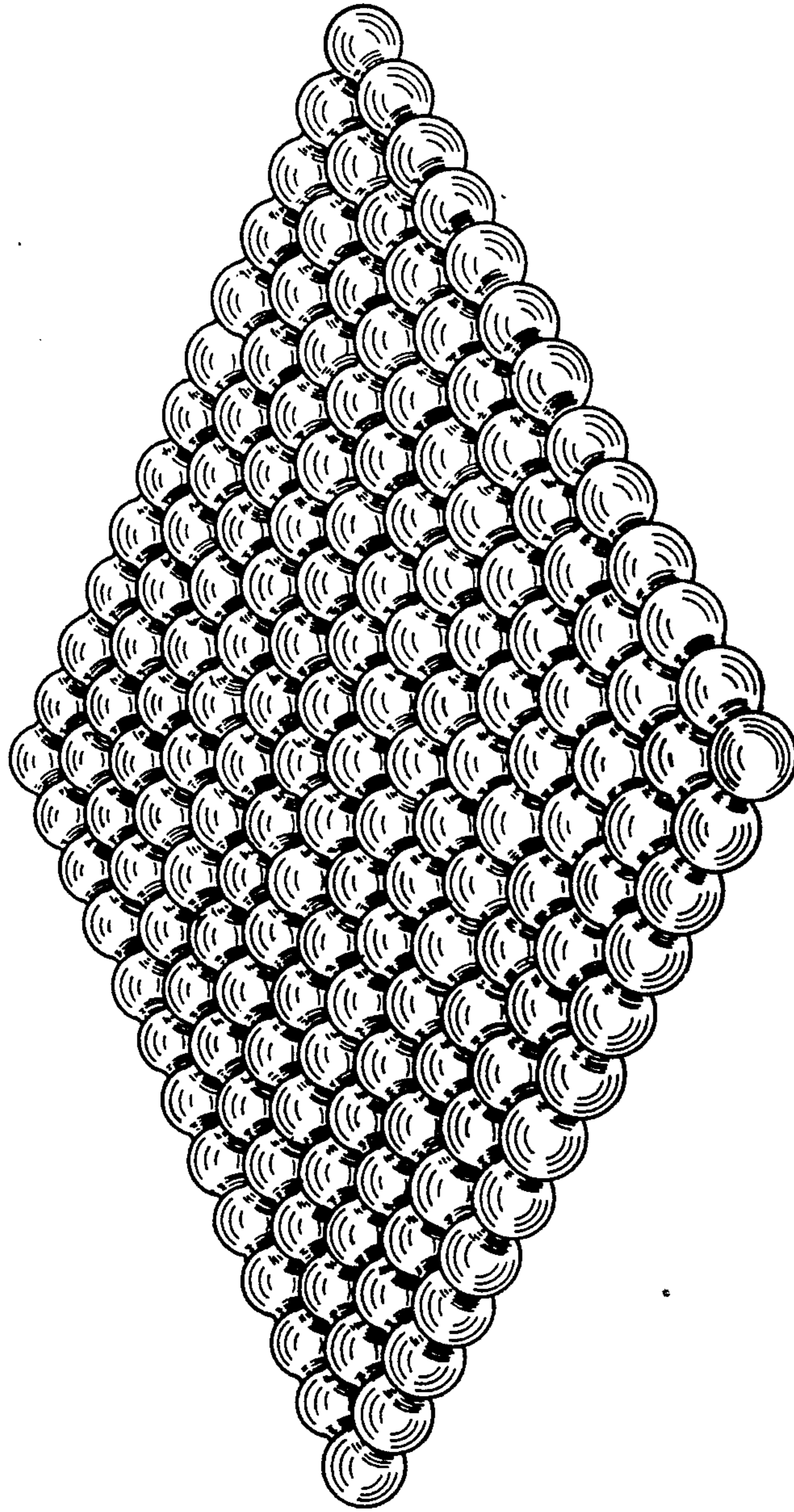

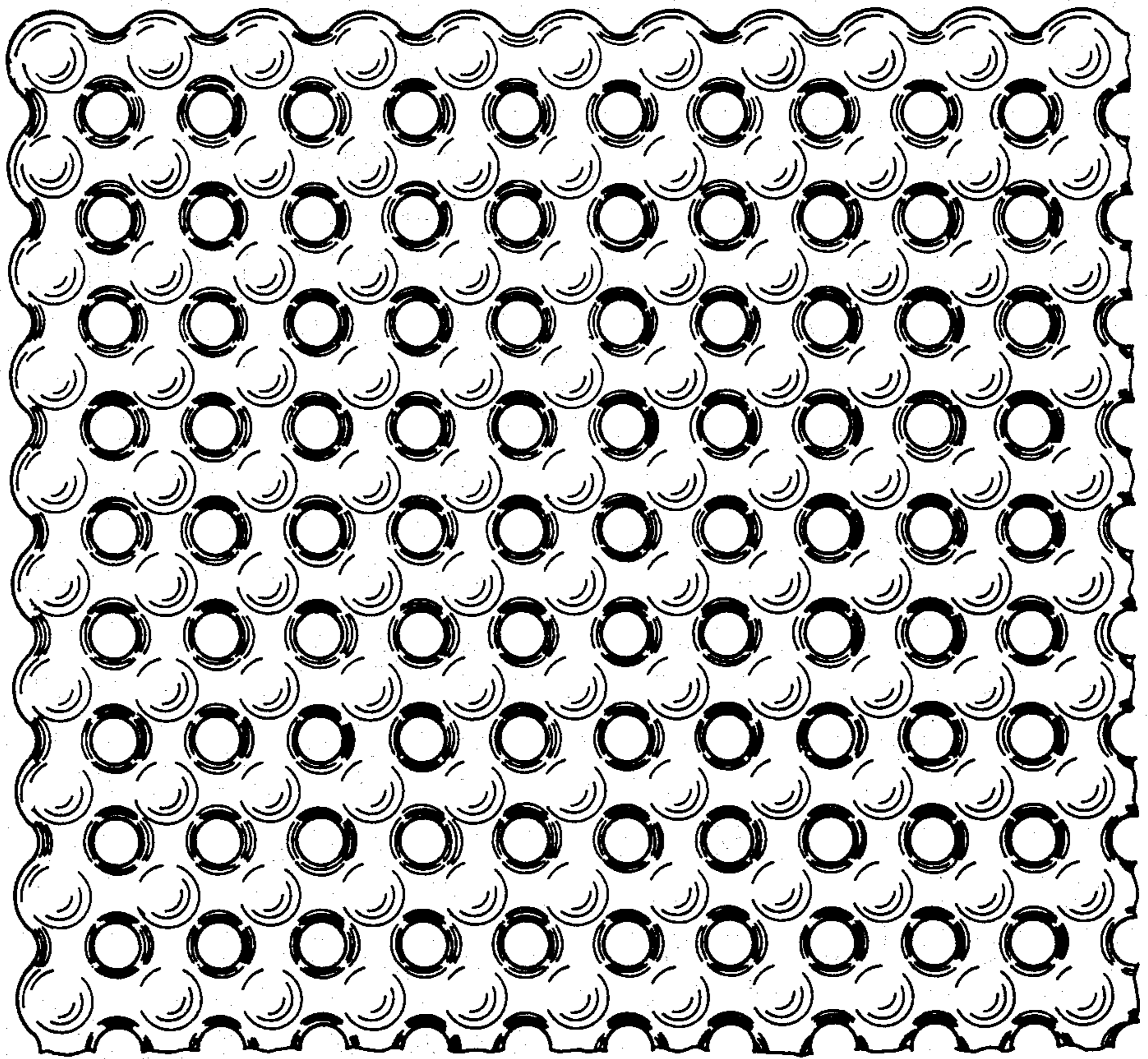
