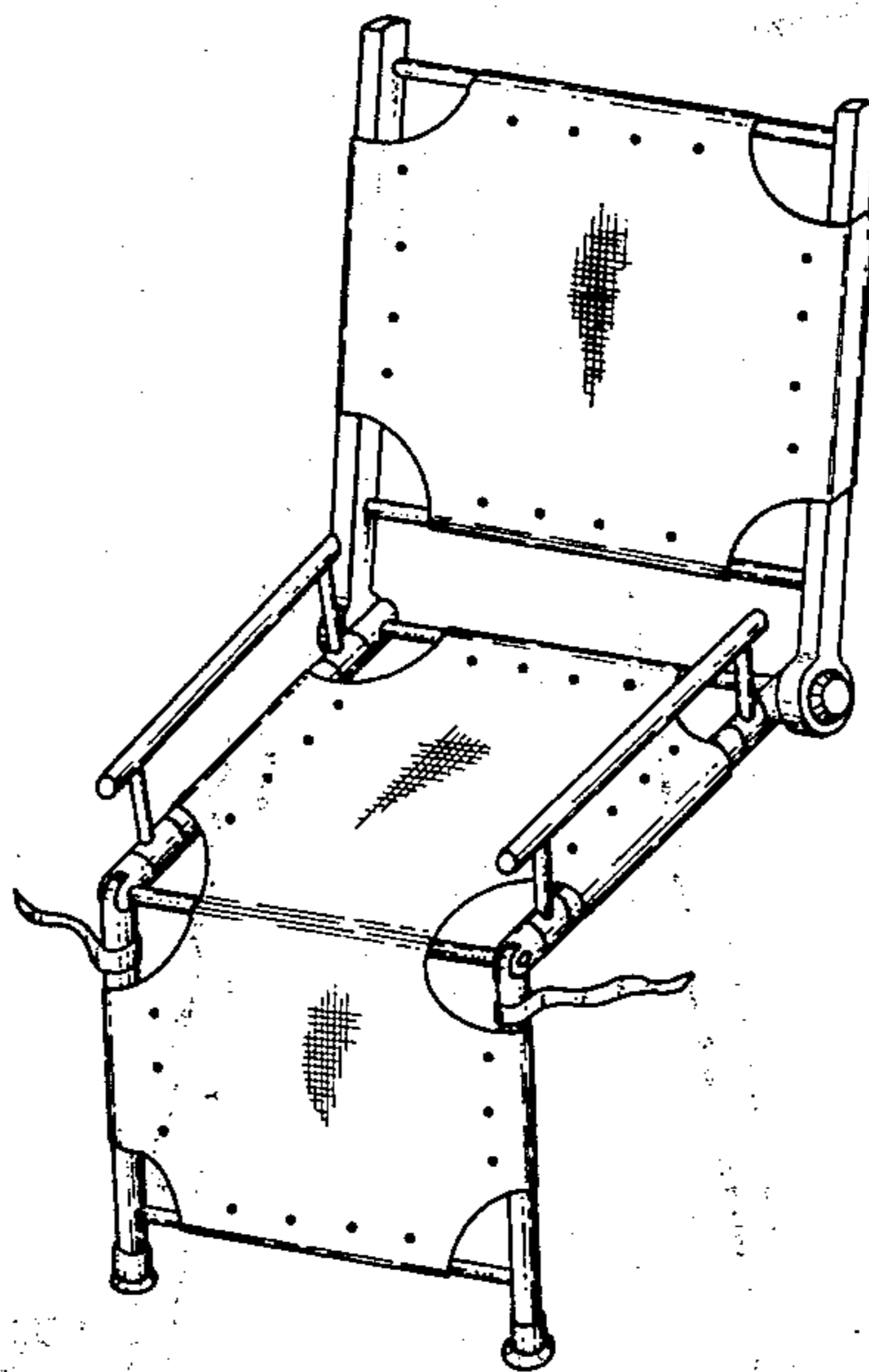

The ornamental design of an adjustable patient's chair for use primarily on a hospital bed, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an adjustable patient's chair for use primarily on a hospital bed showing my design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view; and
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.



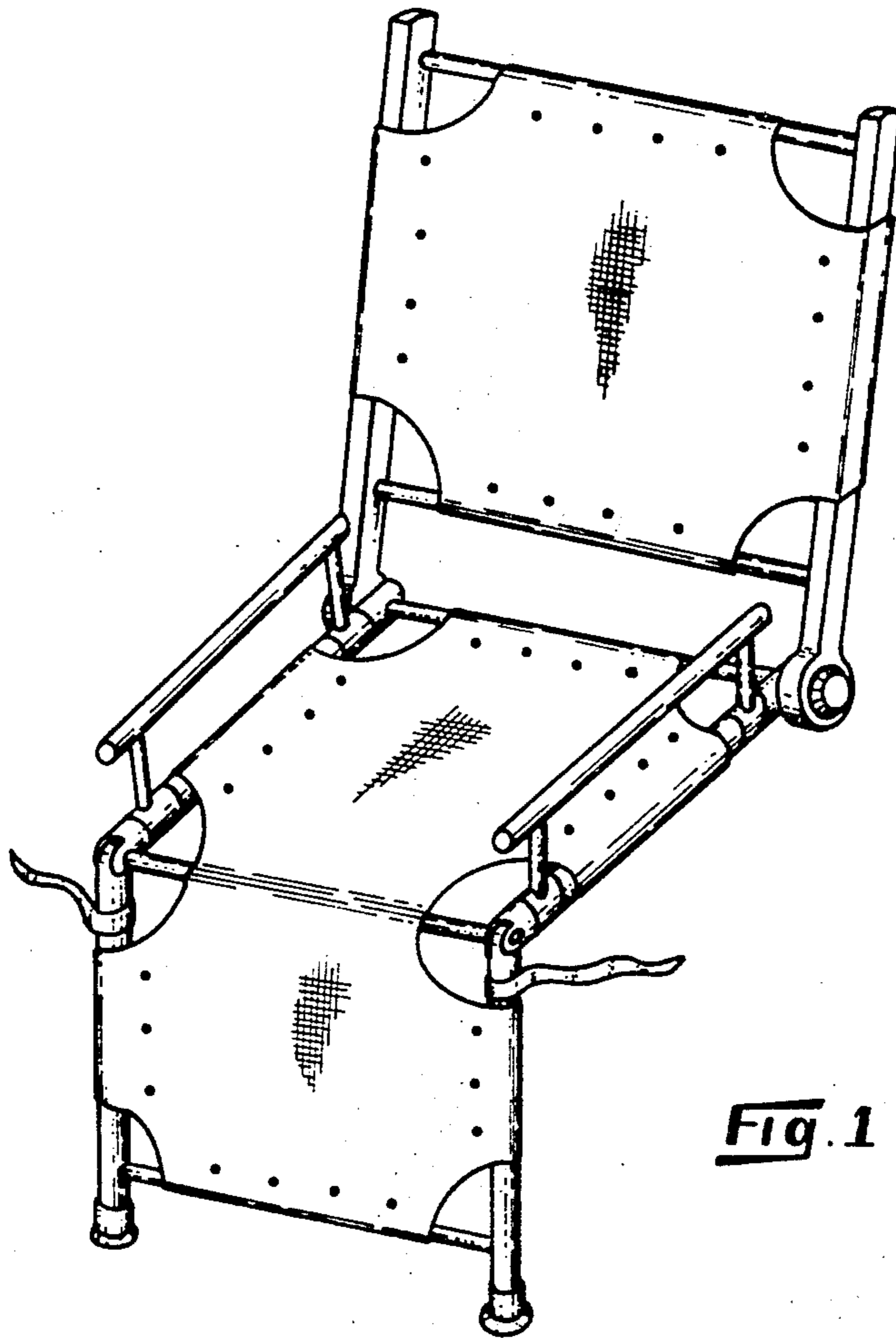

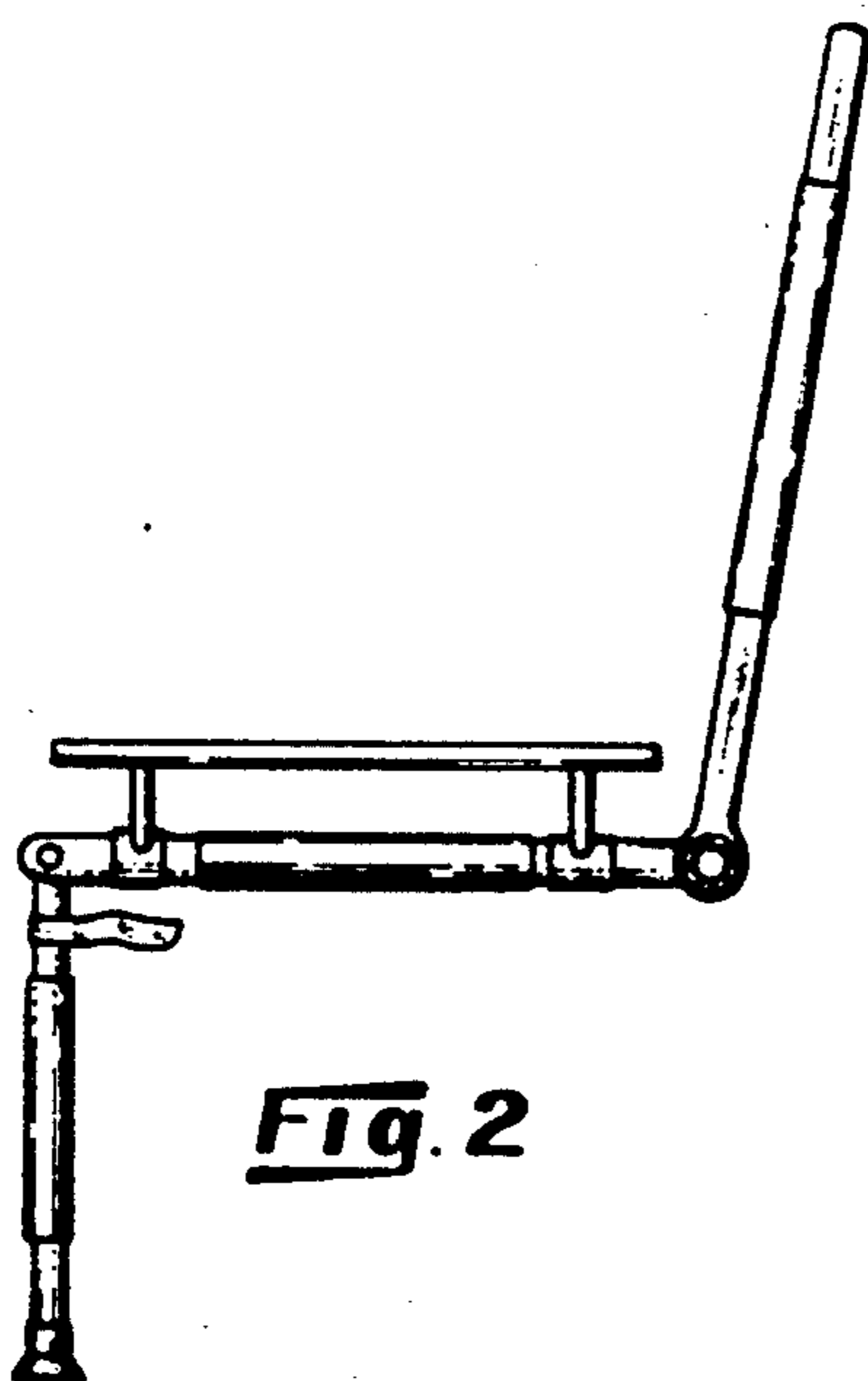

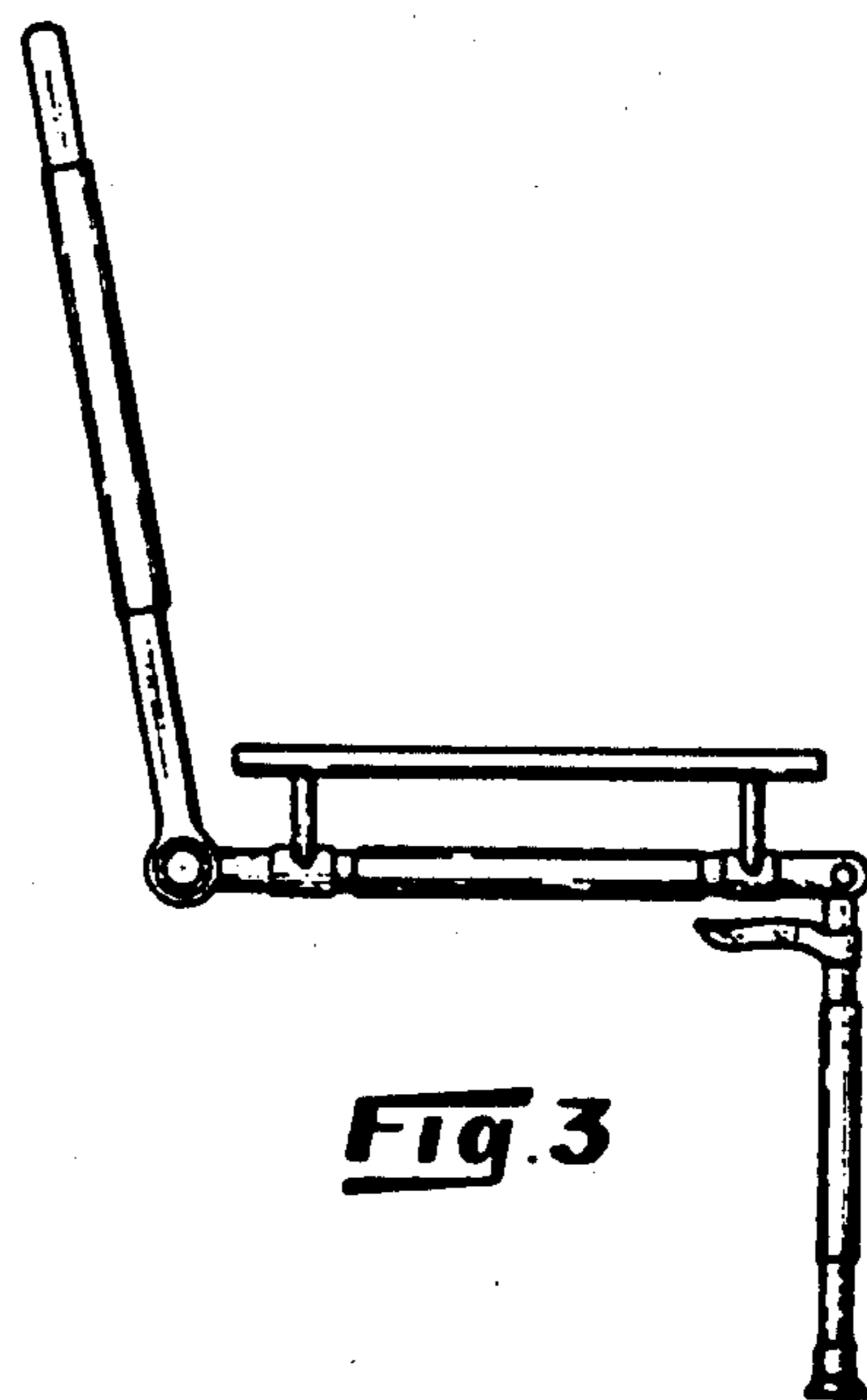

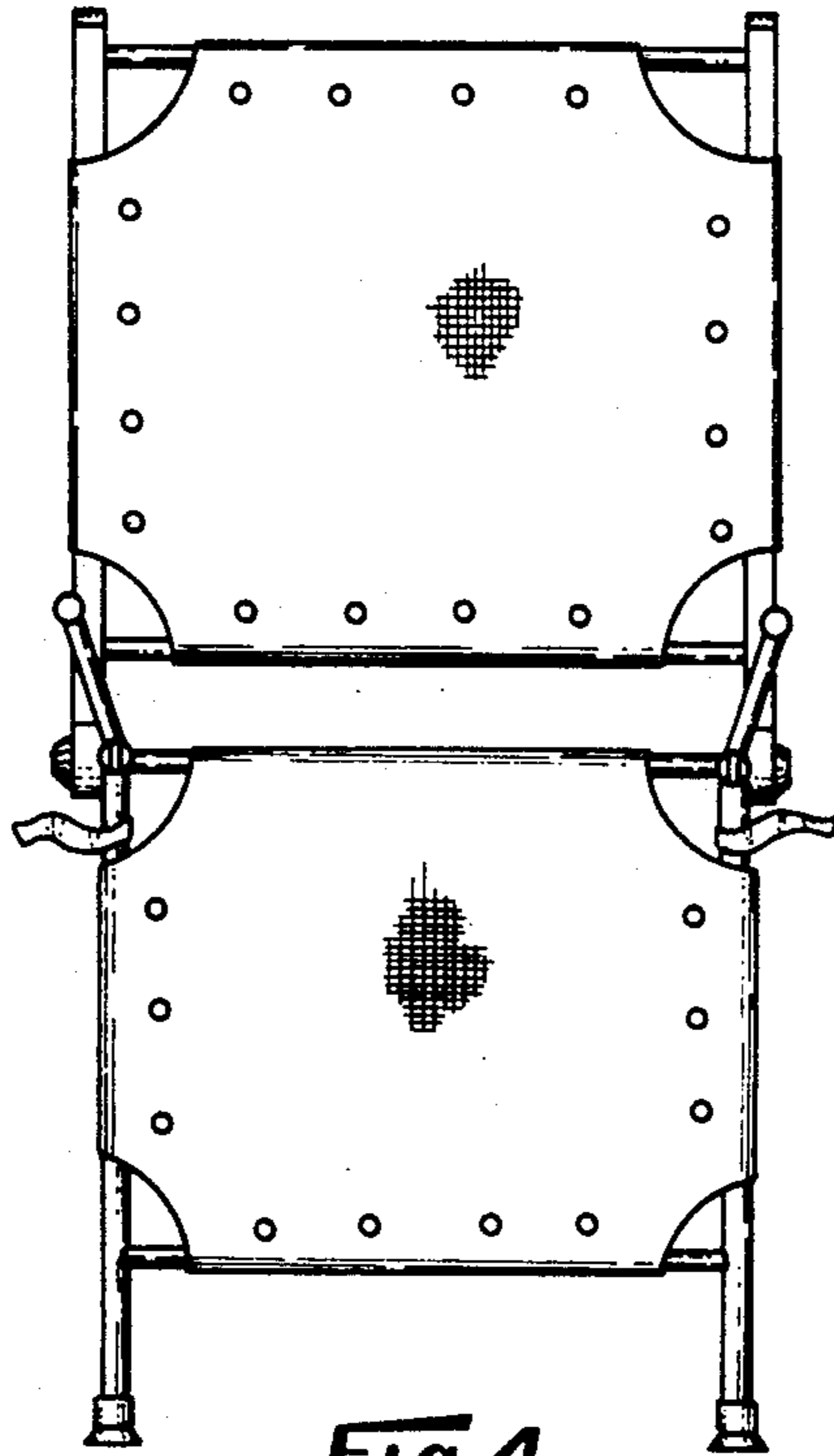

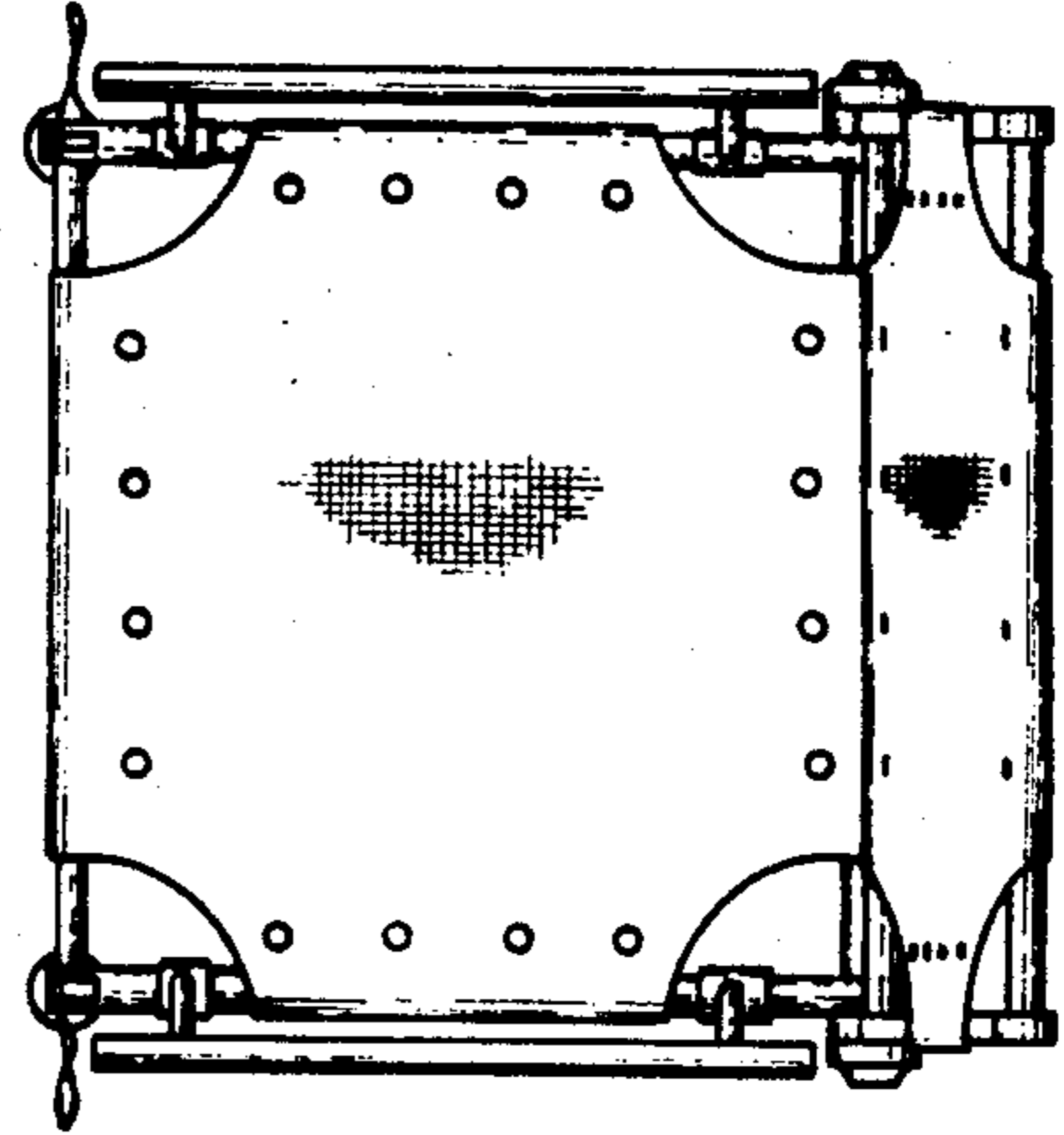

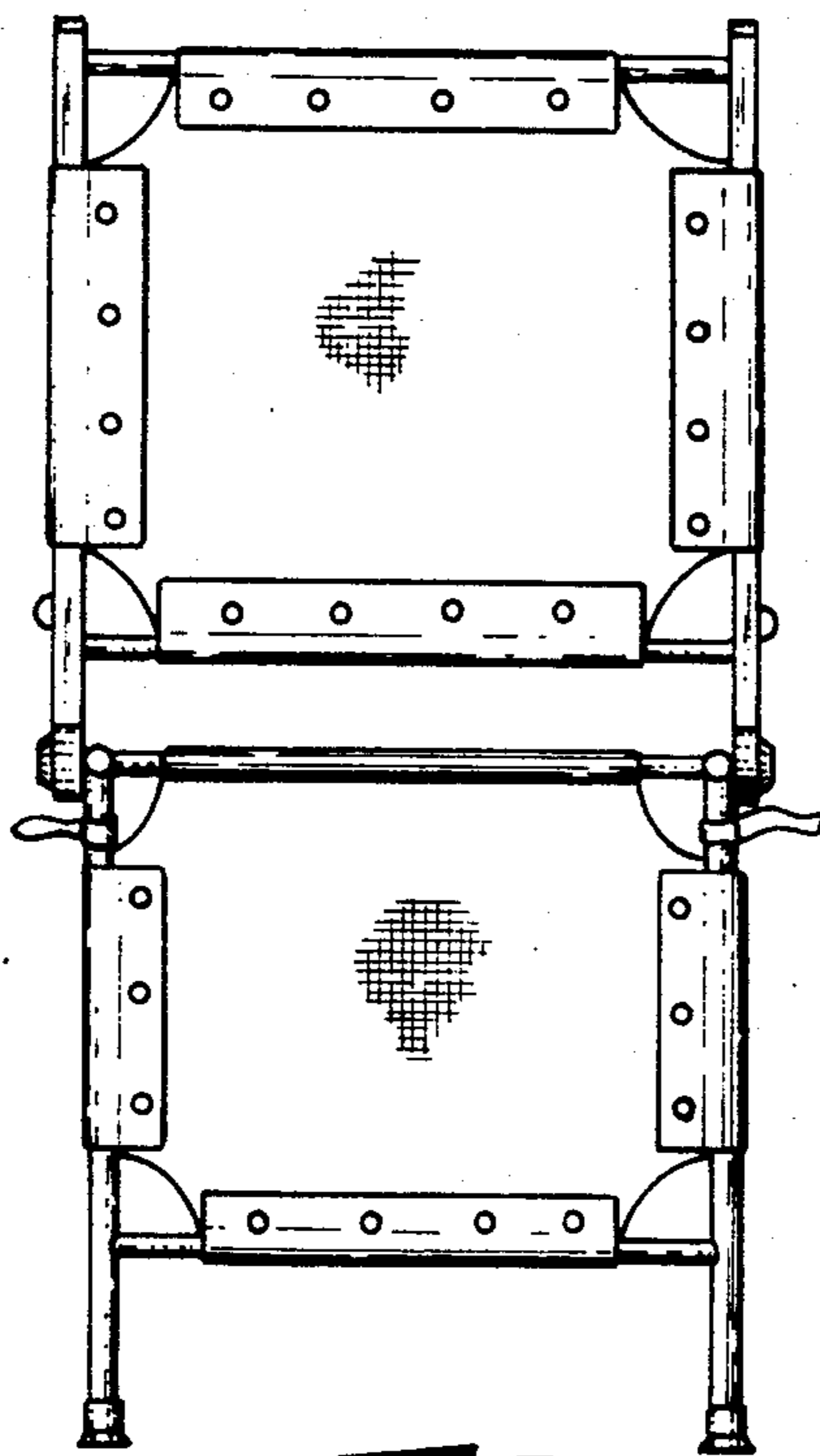

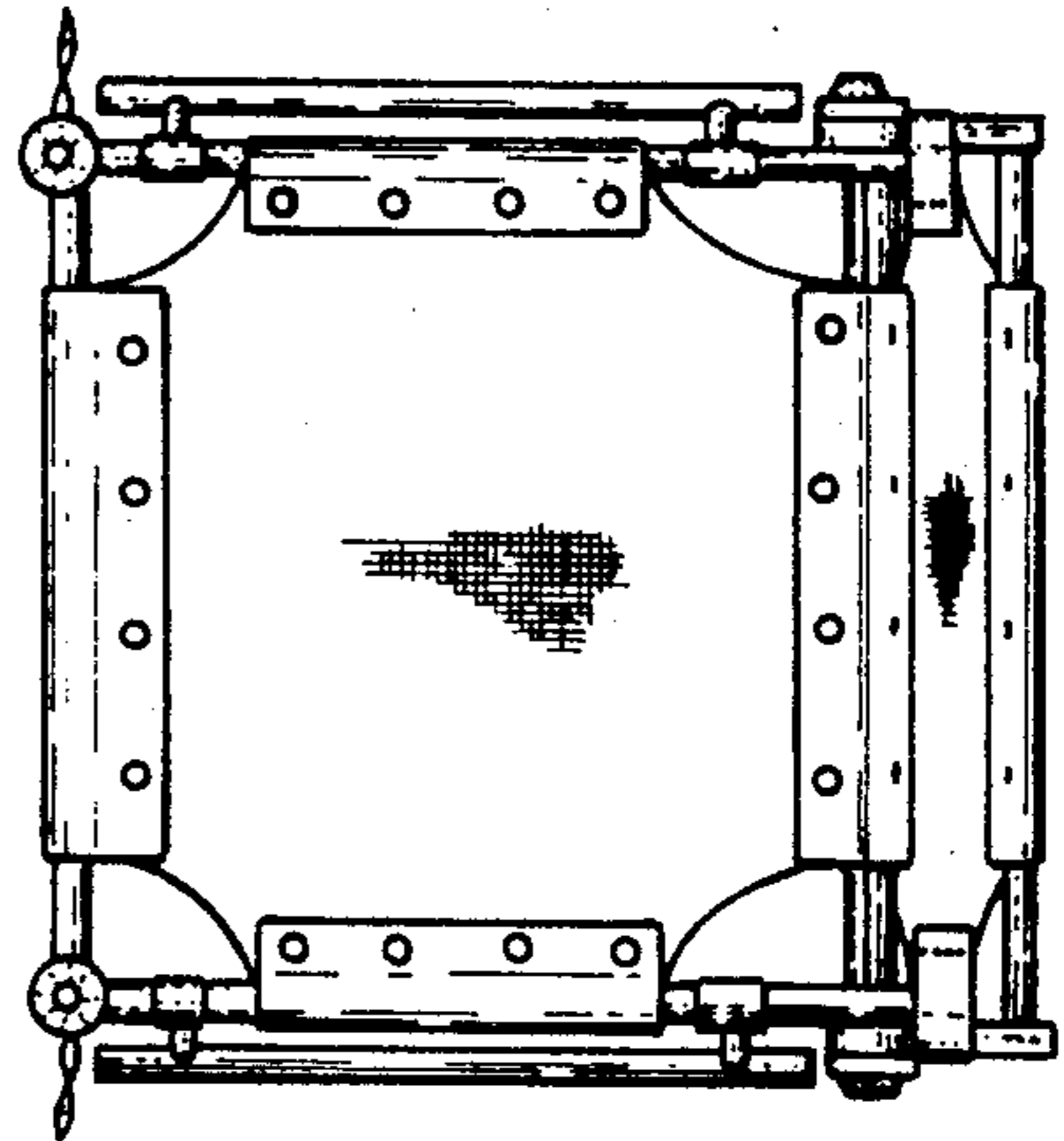
