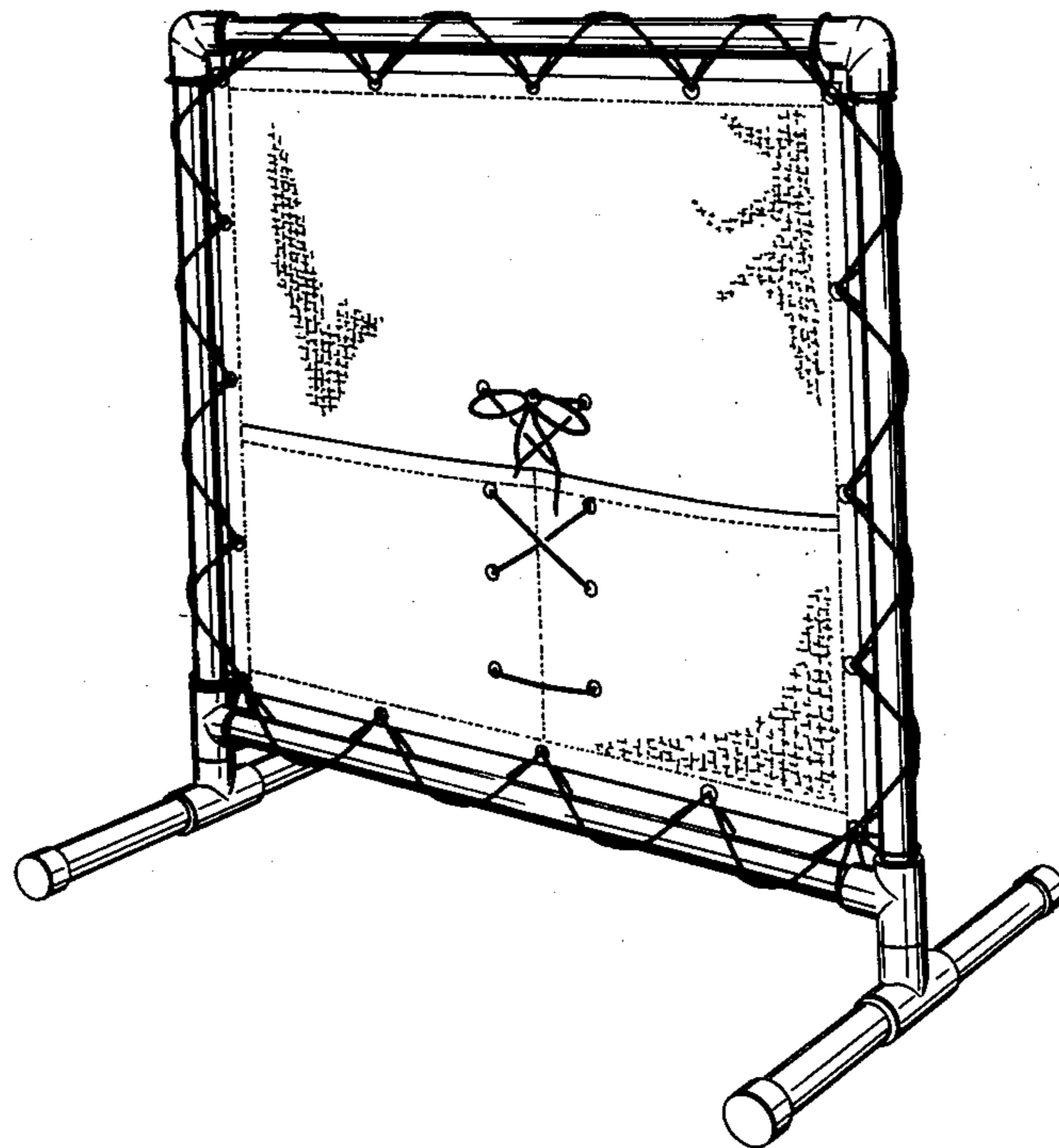

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a room divider showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The fabric weave which is partially shown is understood to repeat uniformly throughout the circumscribed area.



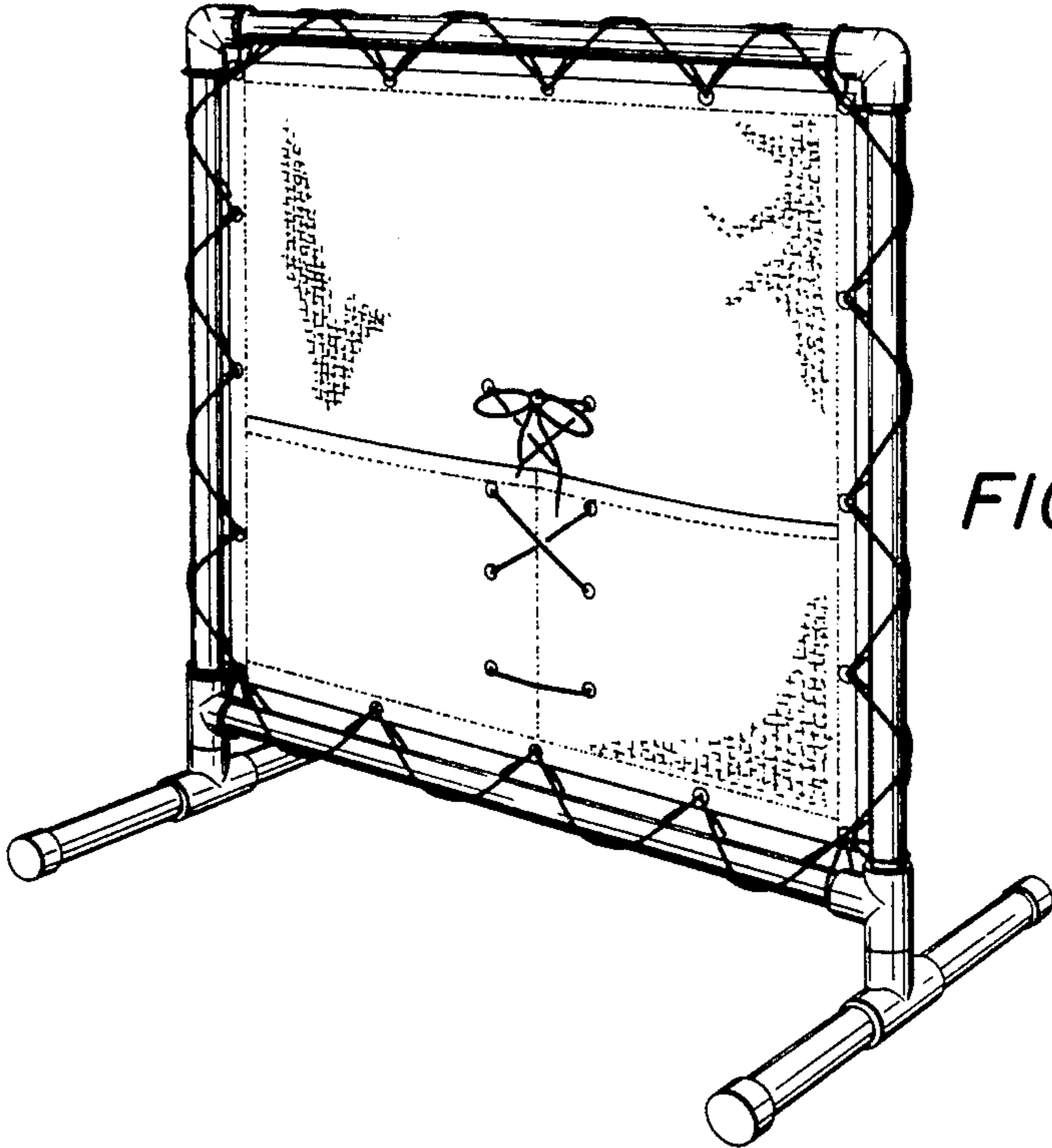

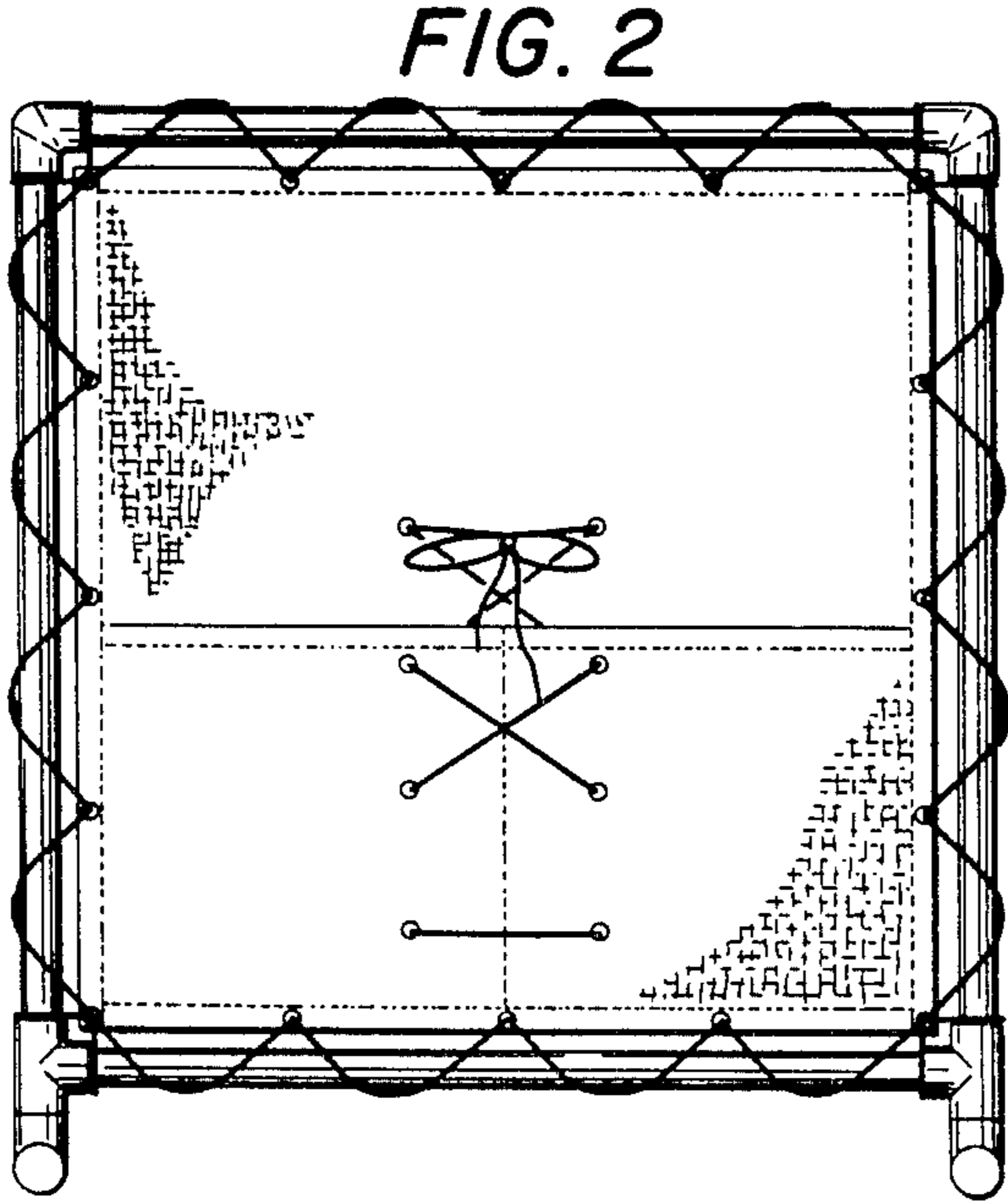

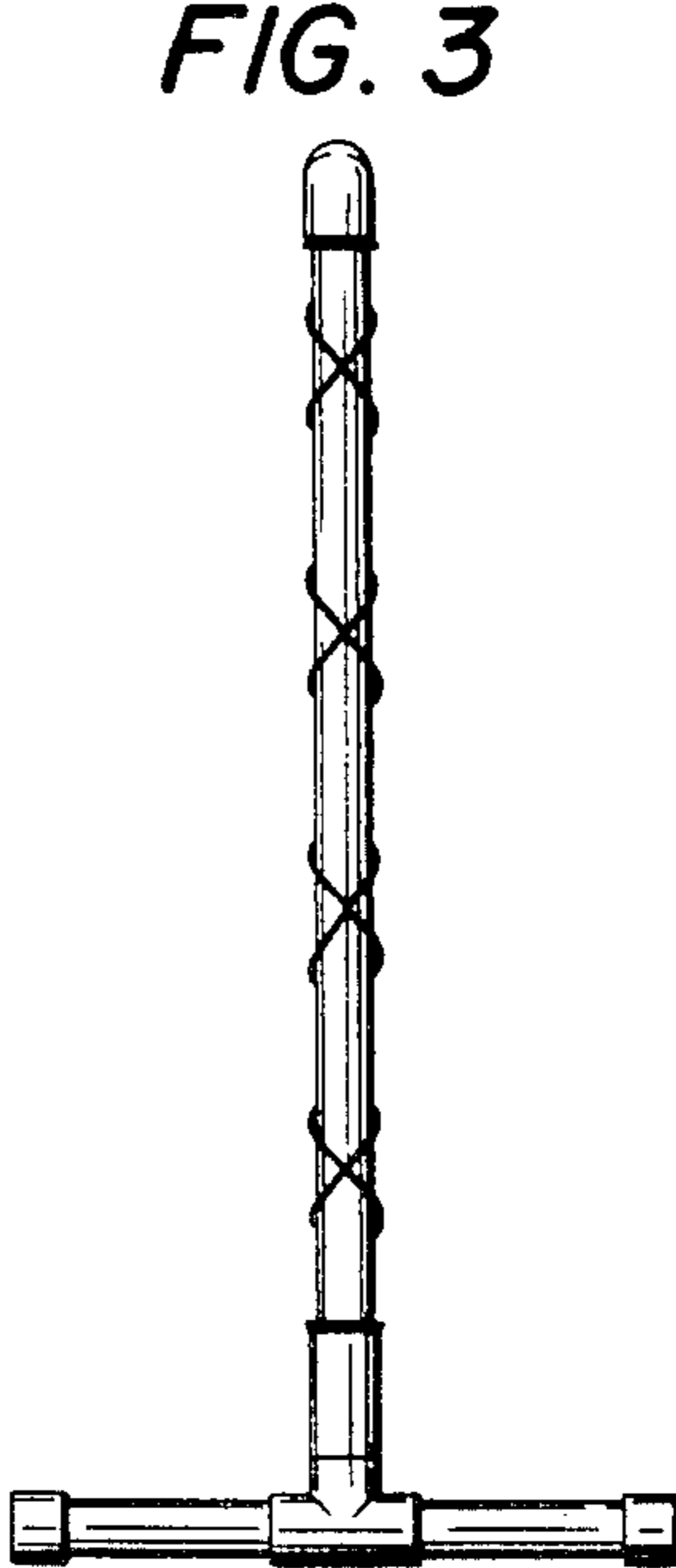

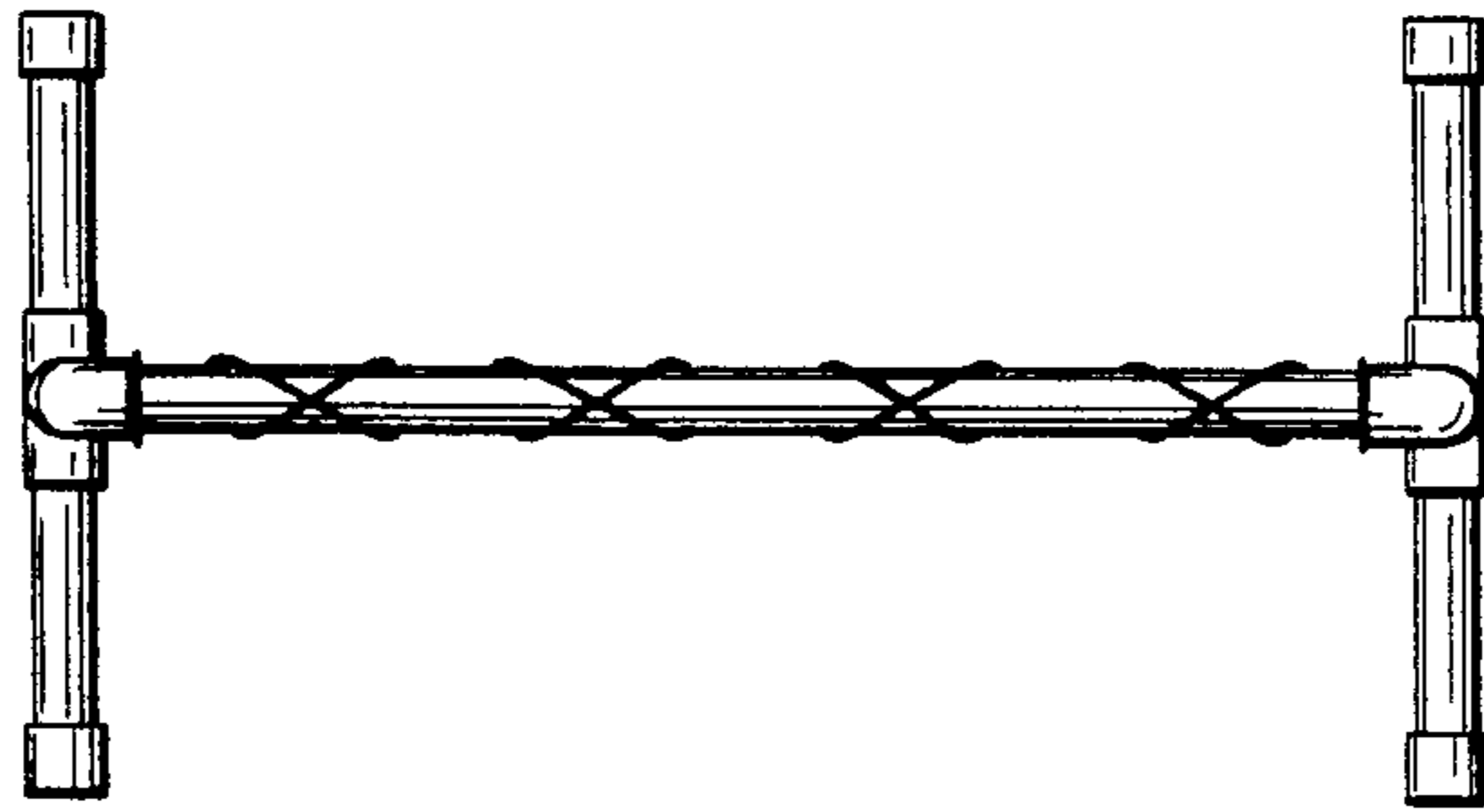

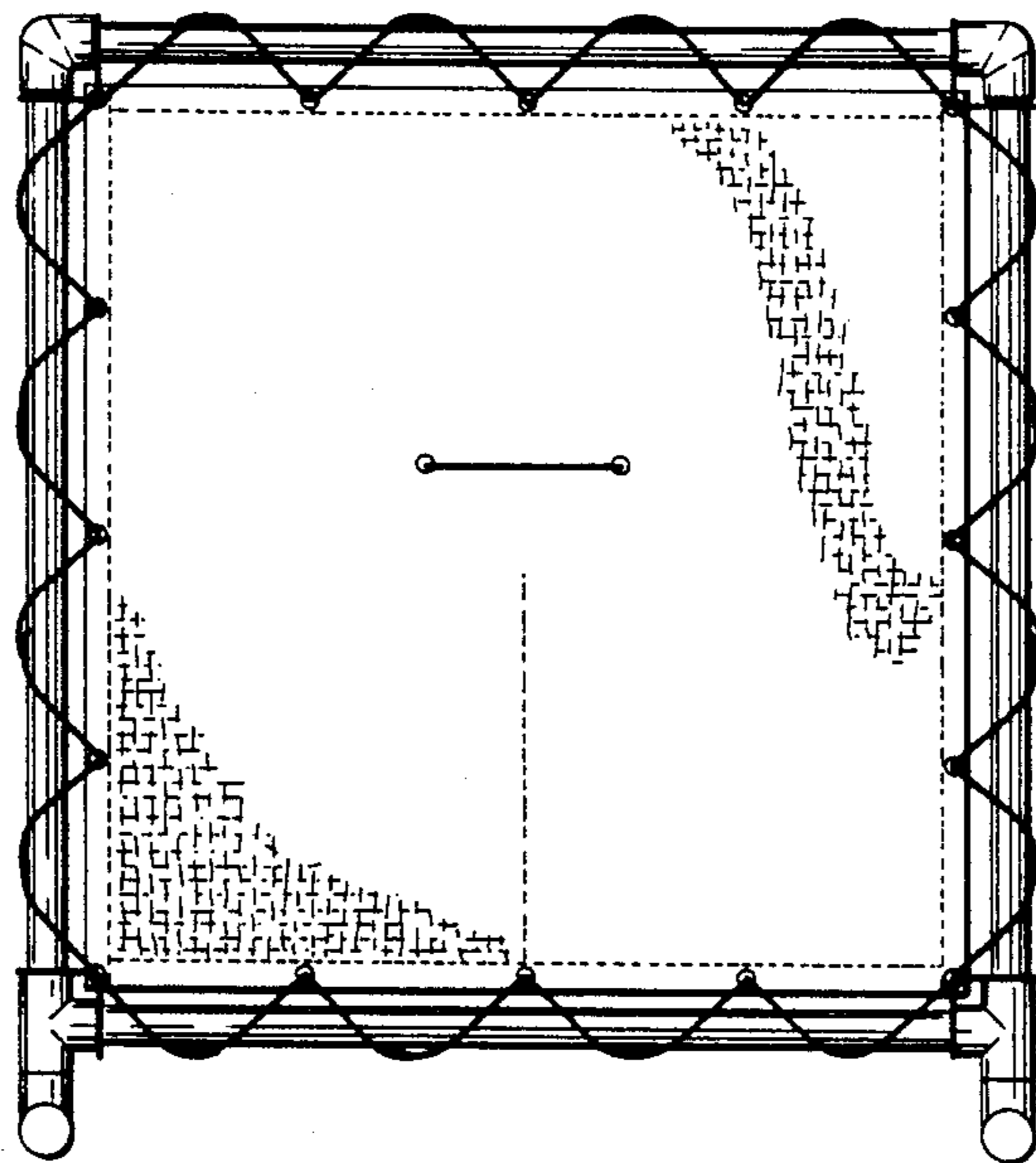

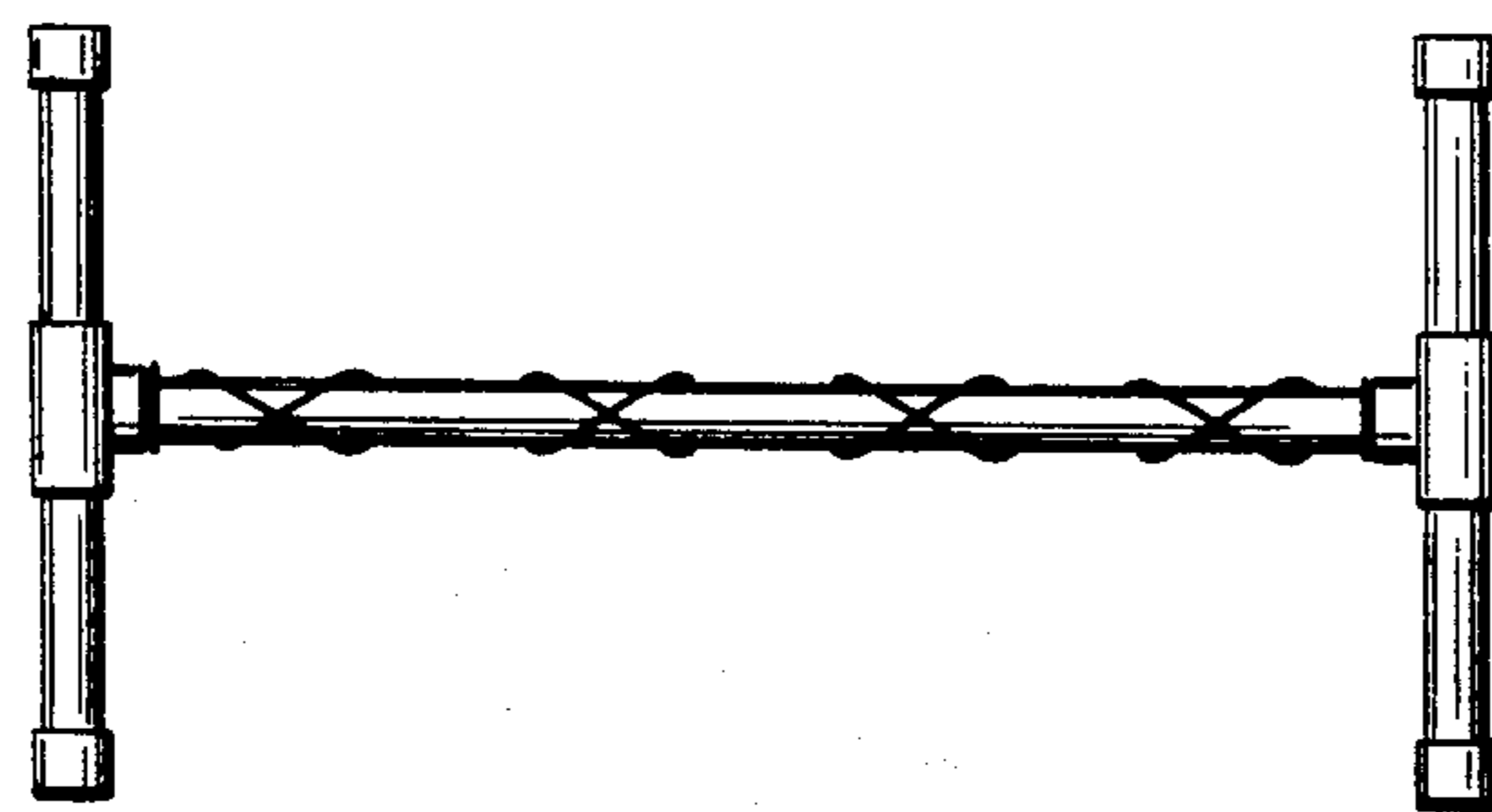
