DESCRIPTION

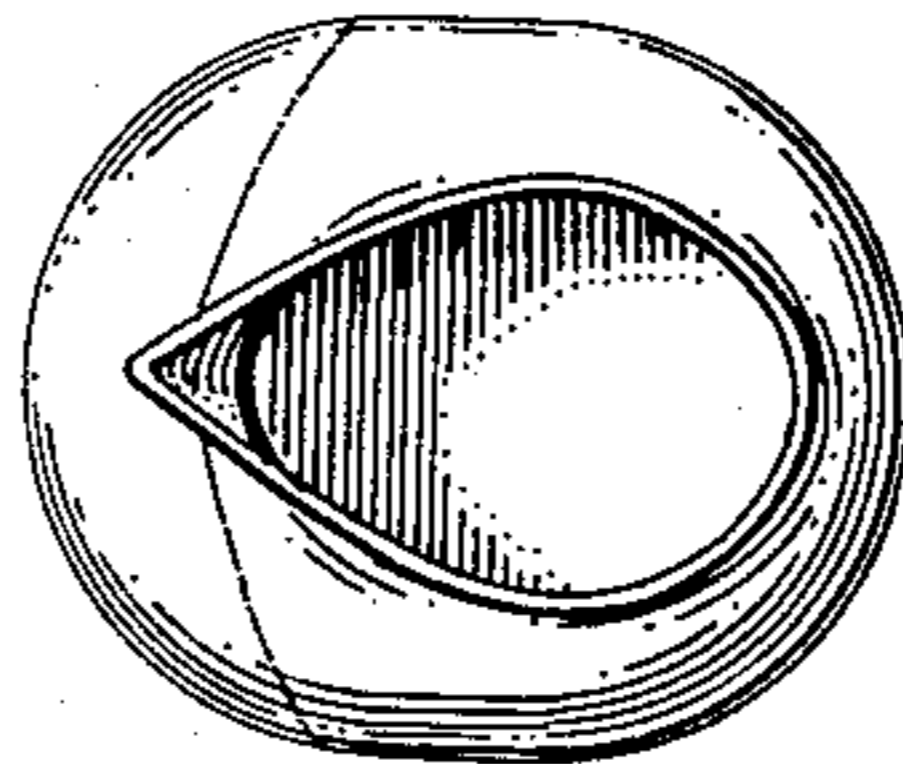
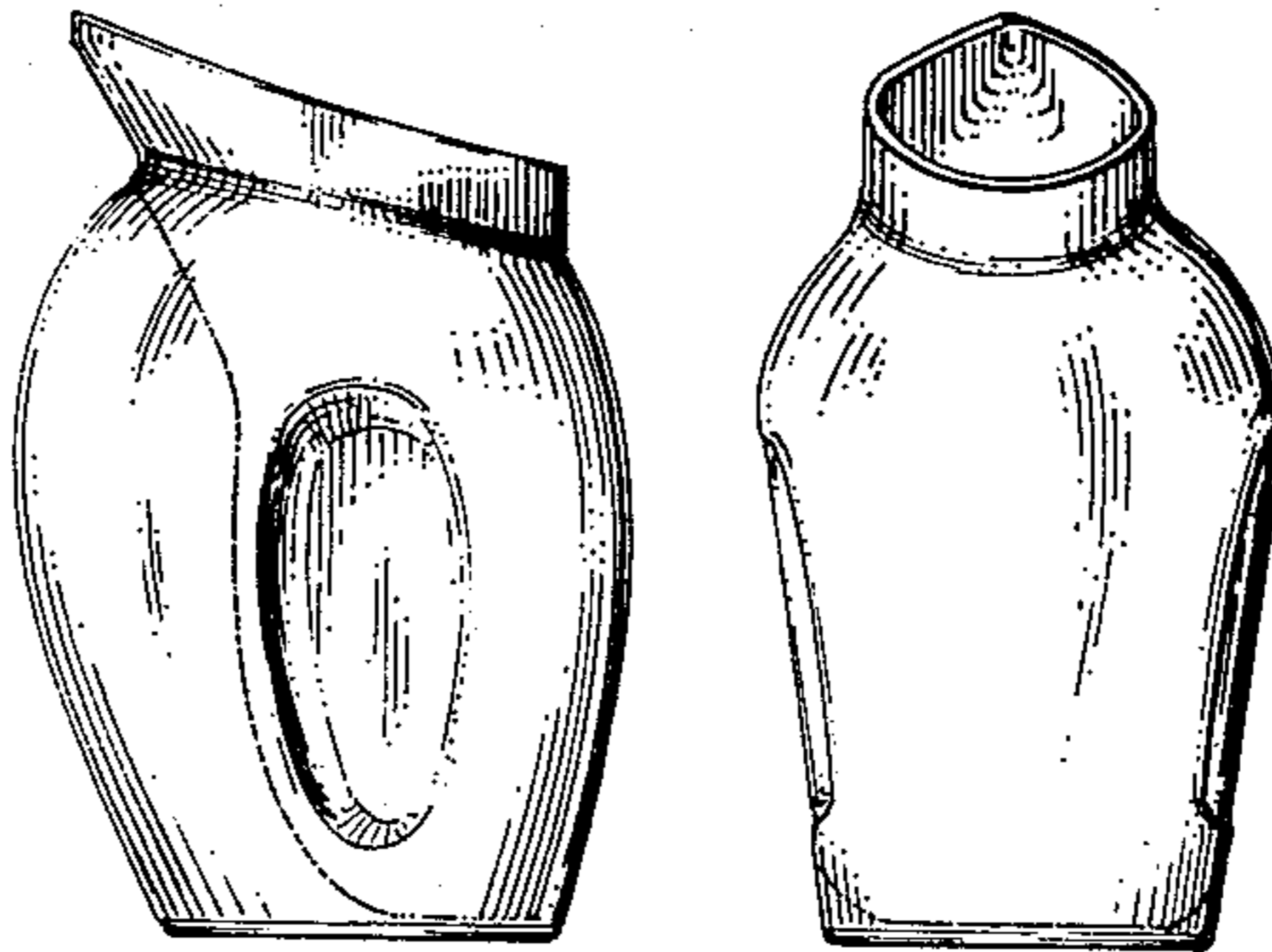
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a pitcher showing

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



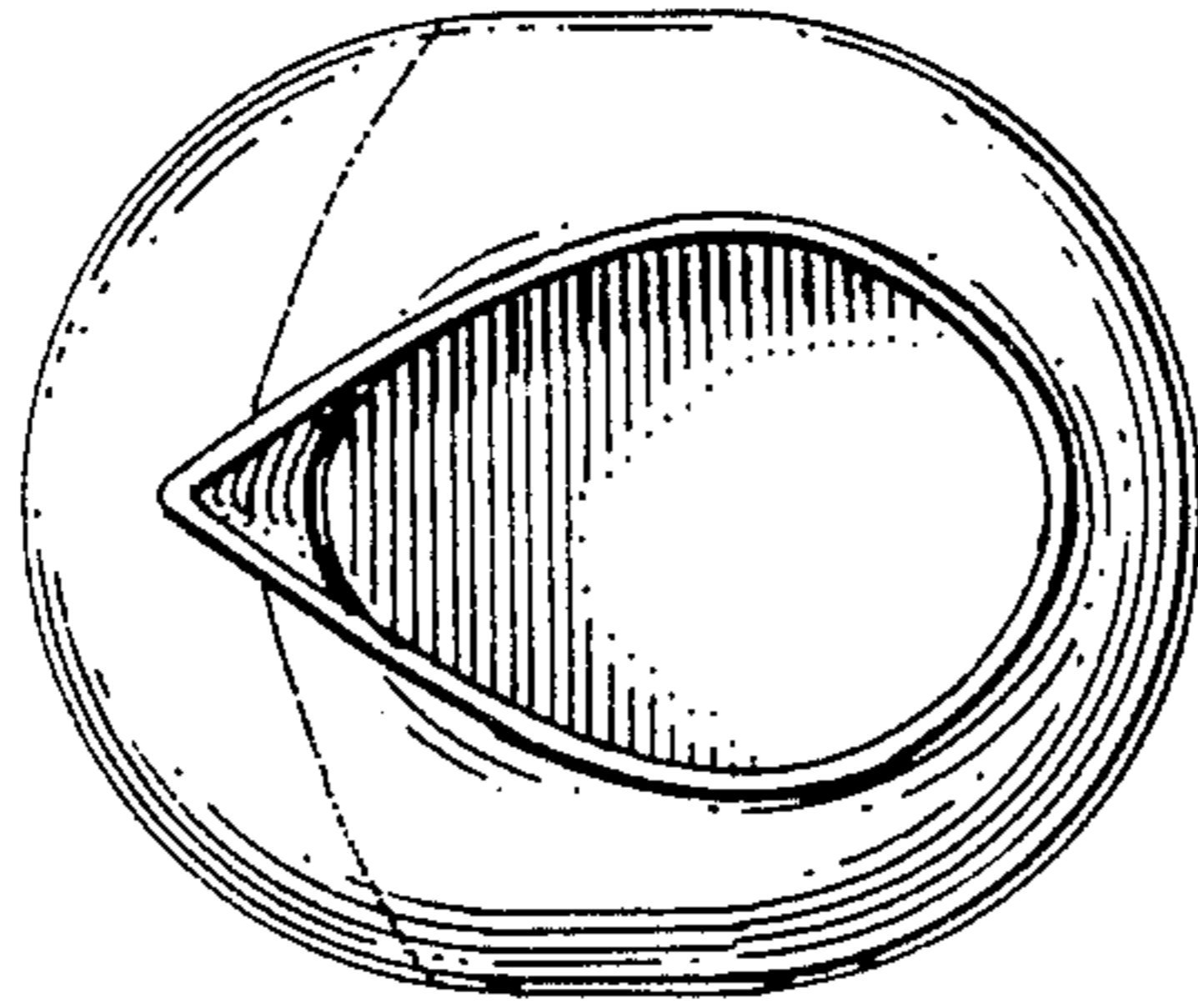

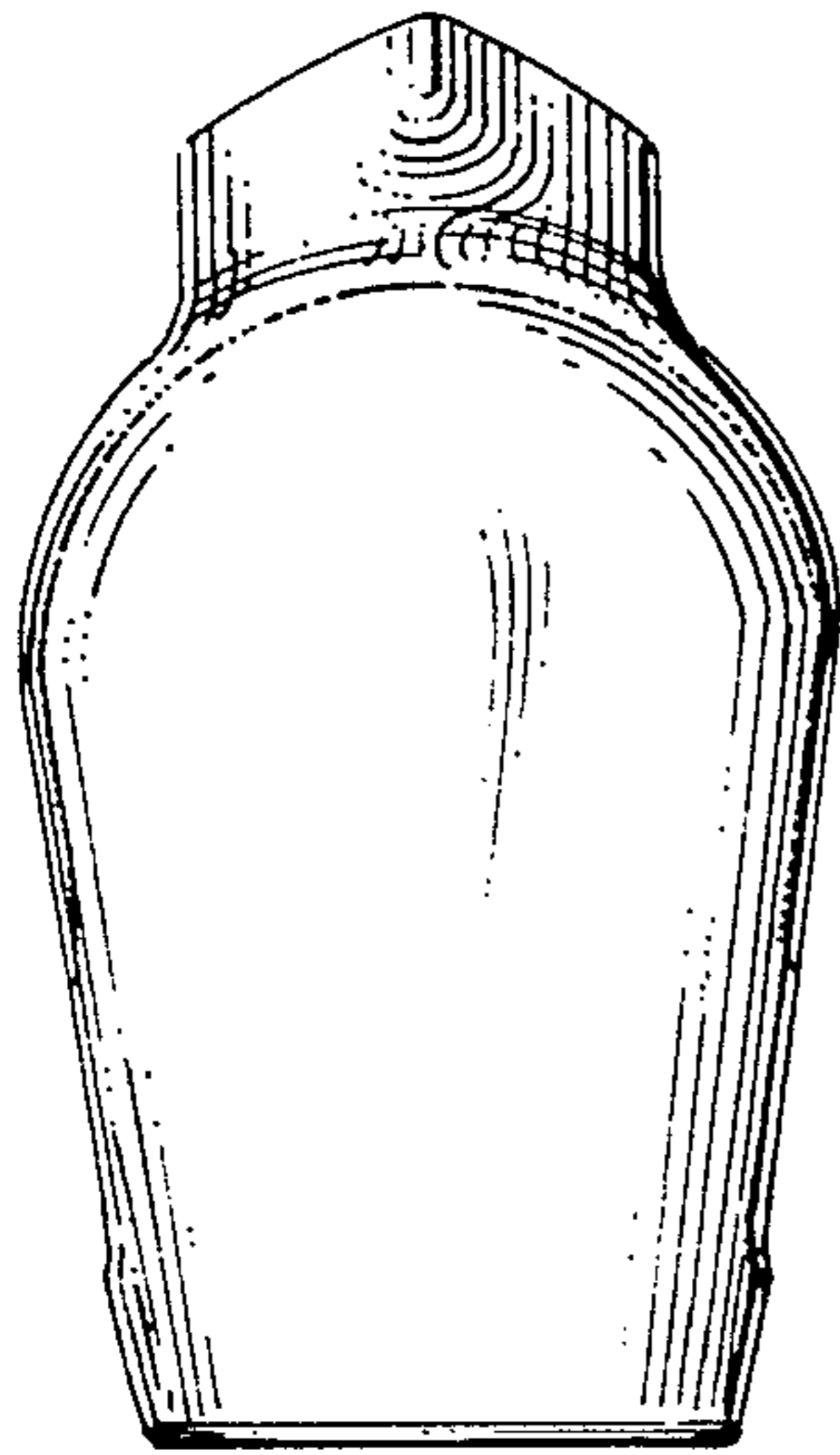

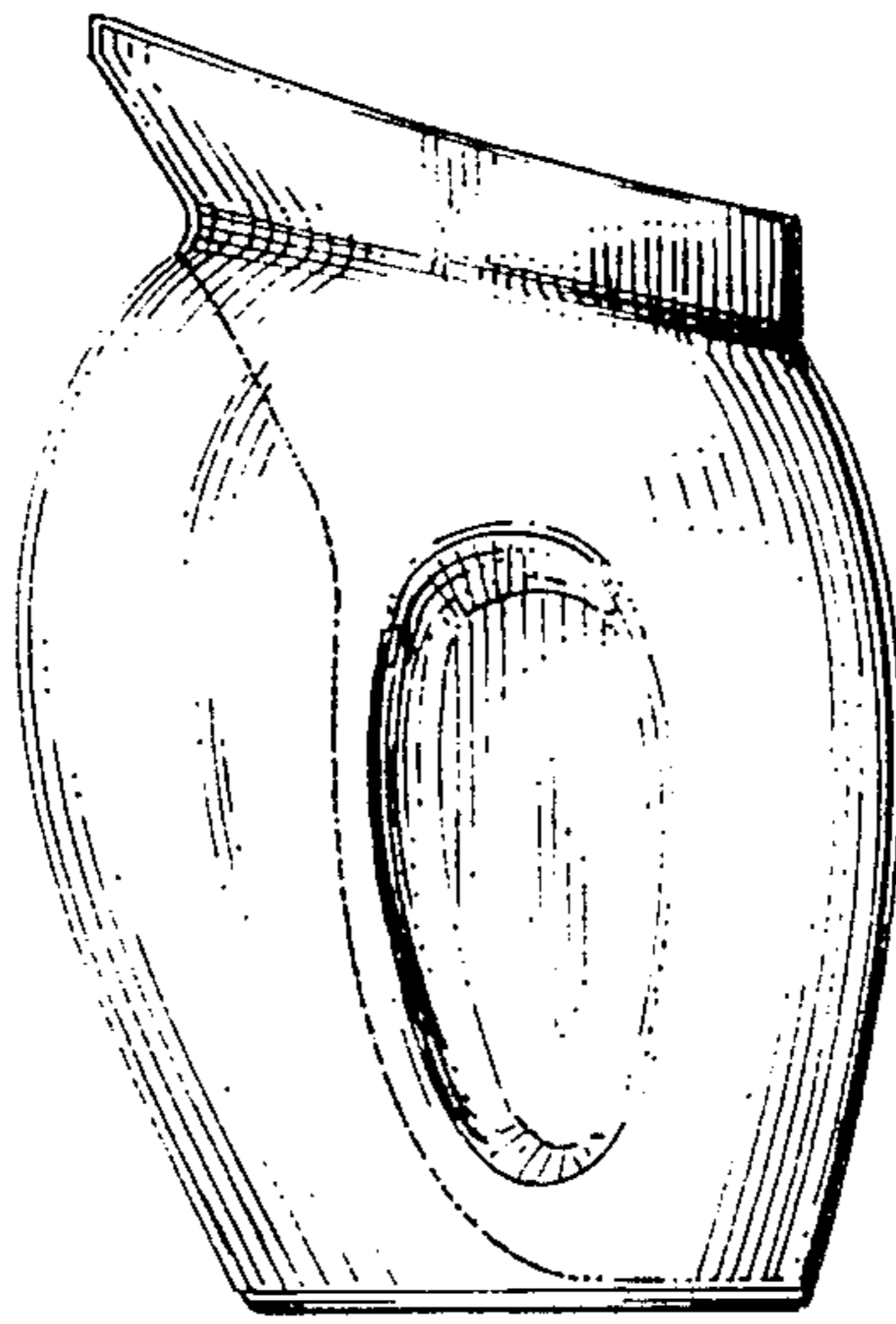

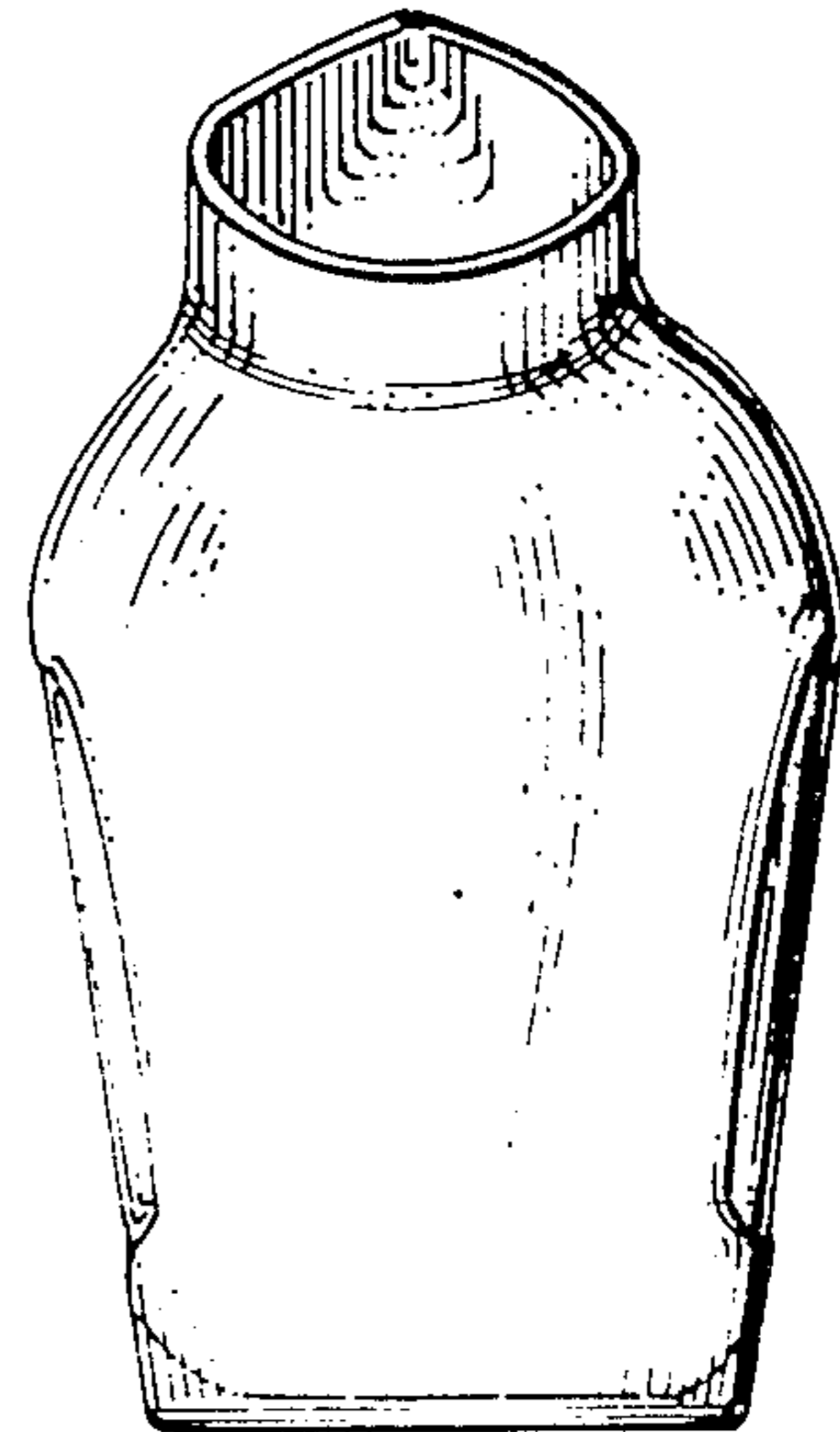

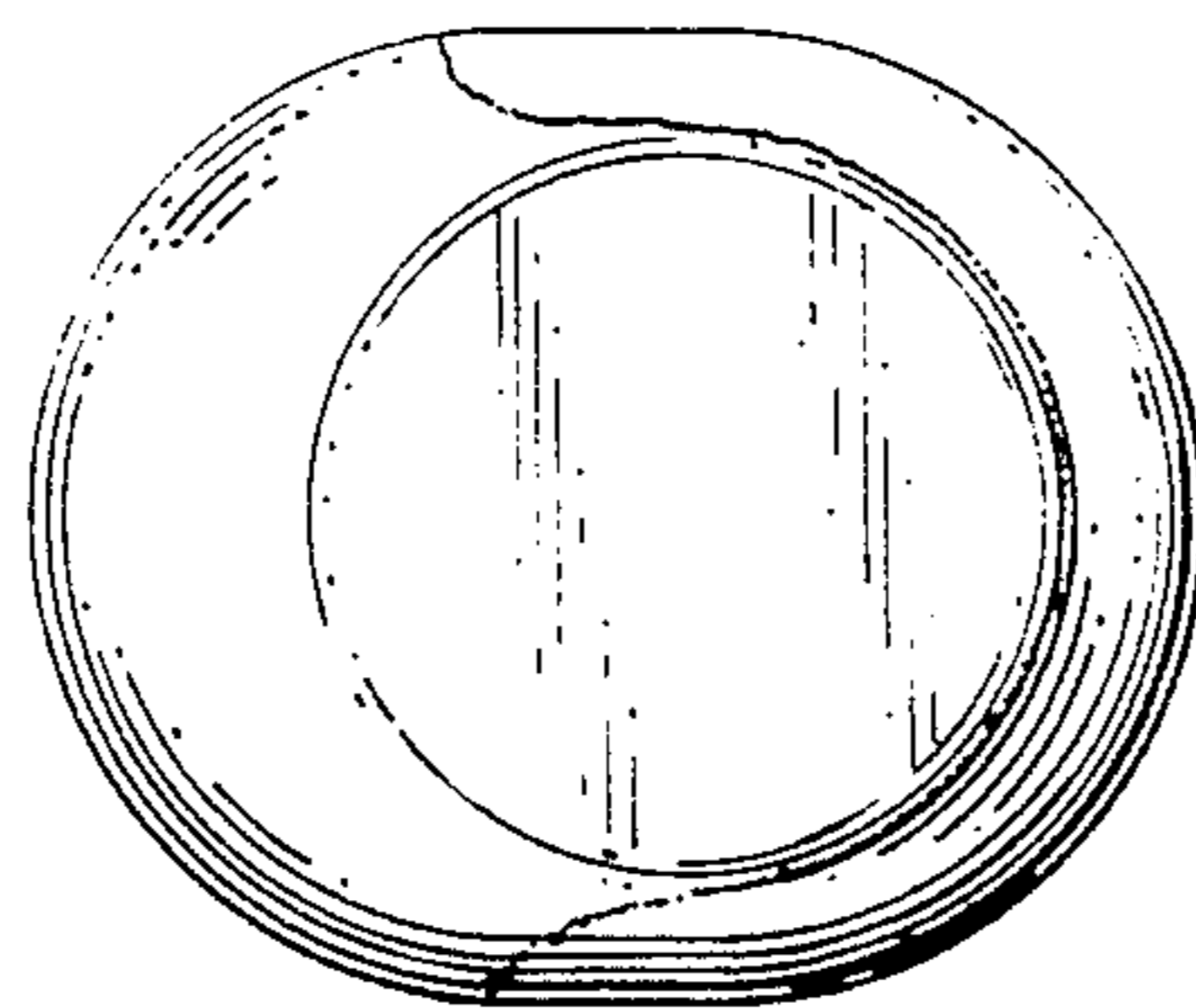
