[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a blank for a shipping and display carton, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The FIGURE is a plan view of a blank for a shipping and display carton embodying my new design, the bottom plan view being substantially the same in appearance.

The blank is constructed of material of conventional thickness and the dash lines in the drawing represent fold lines.
