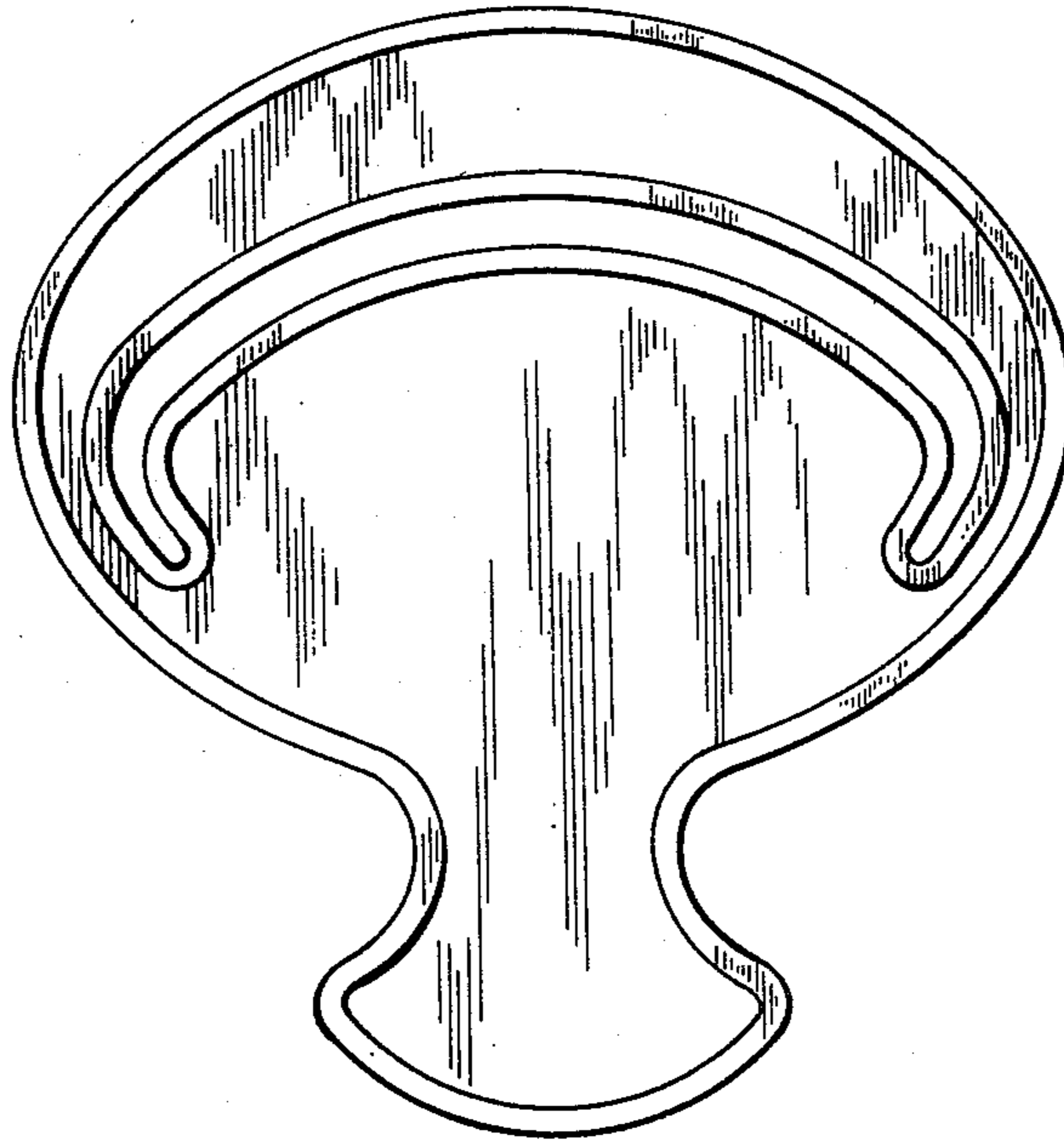

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a playing card holder, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a playing card holder showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side edge elevational view; FIG. 3 is a top edge view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a bottom edge view thereof. The playing card holder has the same appearance from front and rear.



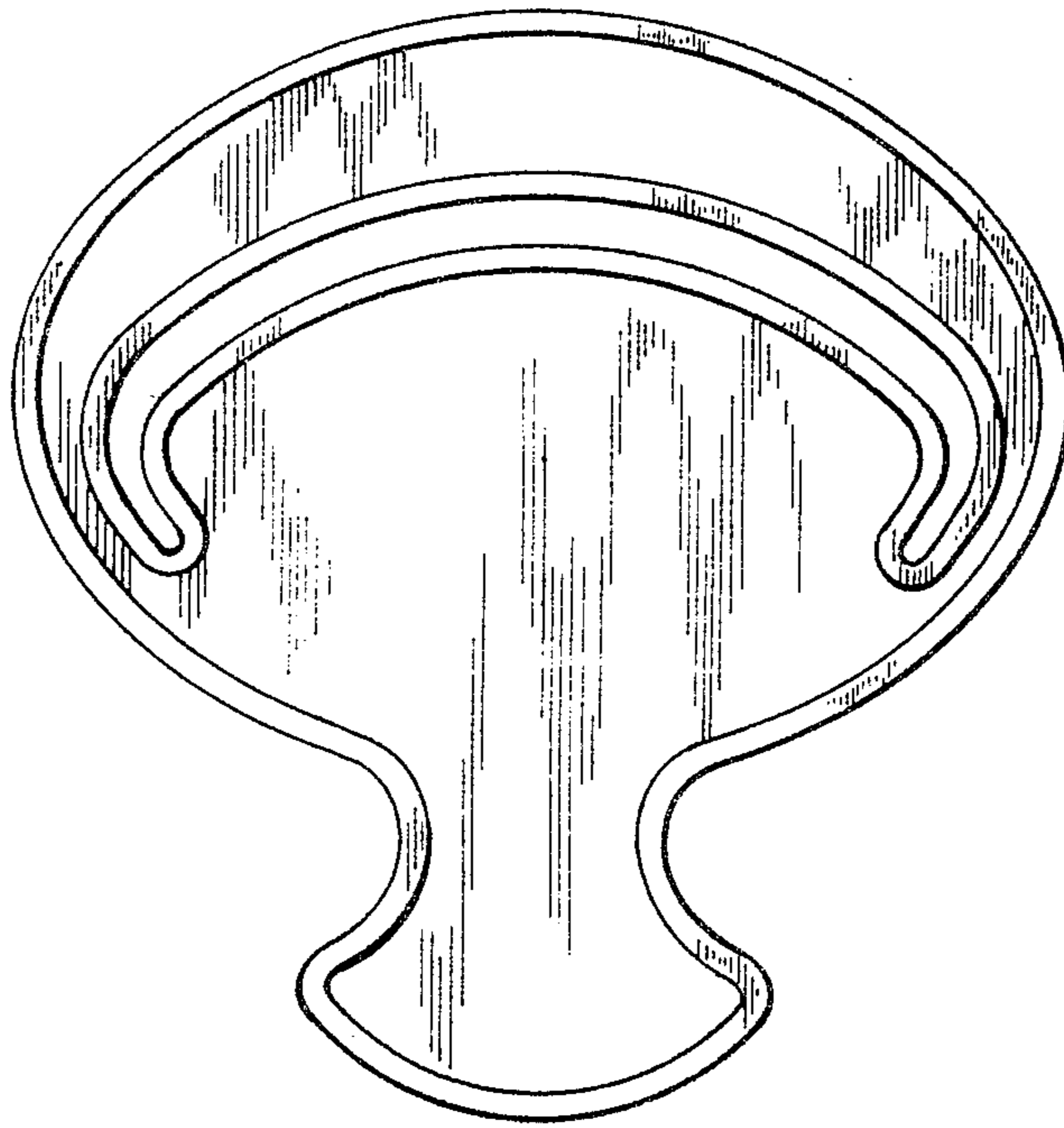

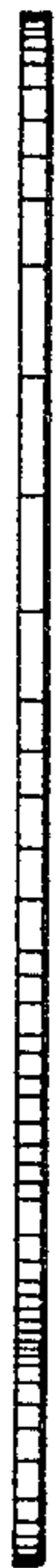

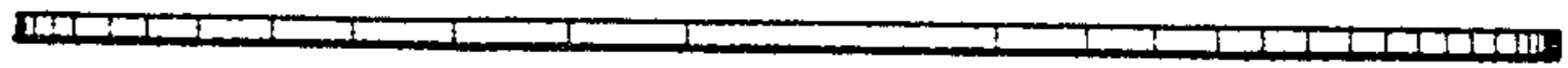
